Men's Notes

This Week

The 52nd-ranked San Diego State men's tennis team (2-0) begins what is the likely the most challenging month in school history with a Saturday afternoon match at second-ranked Stanford. Match time is set for noon at the Taube Family Tennis Center.

Last Week

The Aztecs defeated two Mountain West Conference opponents en route to ITA Indoor Region VII Team Championship last weekend in Boise, Idaho. The Aztecs defeated 63rd-ranked New Mexico 6-1 on Friday and got past 69th-ranked Brigham Young 4-3 to claim the title. With the championship, the Aztecs will return to the USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Championship in Louisville, Ky.

And who is the opponent in the first round of the indoor national championship? Stanford. In an odd scheduling quirk, the Aztecs will face the Cardinal twice in a six-day span. The tournament draw consists of 16 teams, the top eight based on national team rankings while the other eight consists of regional champions.

Strength Of Schedule

As if playing Stanford twice in a week was not difficult enough, the Aztecs also have upcoming matches with third-ranked UCLAand seventh-ranked Pepperdine. That gives the Aztecs at least four matches against the top seven teams in the country in a three-week period to open the month. SDSU will likely face more of the nation's elite in subsequent rounds of the USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Championship.

On A Run

The Aztecs have now won 10 straight regularseason matches, outscoring their opponents by a 52-16 margin.

Aztec Honors

Junior Oliver Maiberger was named the MWC's men's tennis player of the week for the period ending Jan. 29. It is Maiberger's eighth career player of the week honor. Last Friday, Maiberger defeated New Mexico's Divan Coetzee in No. 1 singles and teamed with Ryan Redondo to defeat Bart Scott and David Kowalski at No. 1 doubles. SDSU won the match 6-1. On Saturday, with a berth to the ITA National Indoor Team Championship on the line, Maiberger rallied from one-set down to defeat Brigham Young's Gert Vilms, 3-6, 7-6, 6-4, to lift the Aztecs to a 4-3 victory.

from a preseason mark of 53rd to 52nd. That means singles and doubles rankings remained unchanged. Oliver Maiberger and Ryan Redondo, who claimed the ITA national indoor doubles title last fall, were rewarded with a number two preseason ranking in the ITA poll. The duo, which entered fall play ranked 46th, made the biggest jump in the rankings. Maiberger's solid singles play in the fall resulted in a boost in his individual rankings as well. The junior moved from 13th in the fall to 11th in the preseason spring rankings.

Women's Notes

This Week

Fresh off a doubleheader sweep of Saint Mary's and Cal Poly, the 44th-ranked San Diego State women's tennis team ventures to the Apple State to do battle with 11th-ranked Washington on Friday and 29th-ranked Washington State on Sunday

Up To Speed

The women's tennis program is in its 26th season of play and ninth under head coach Peter Mattera. San Diego State returns five letterwinners off a squad that ended the 2000-01 season with a 17-8 record and a final ranking of 43rd. The Aztecs have advanced to the NCAAteam tournament in three of the past four seasons.

Who To Watch

Juniors Lindsey Hedberg and Silvia Tornier, who split time at number one singles a year ago and formed the number one doubles pairing, led a talented group of players returning this season.

Looking Ahead

Following the trip to Washington, the Aztecs will open a three-match homestand with a contest against Oregon on Feb. 10.

Fun With Numbers

Only team rankings were updated this week with individual and doubles rankings remaining from the preseason. San Diego State remained 44th in the national poll, the same position the Aztecs had in the preseason poll.

The ITA spring preseason poll also listed the doubles team of Hedberg and Tornier as the 60th-ranked team in the country. Last season, the duo compiled a 20-10 record, including a 14-9 record at number-one singles.

Last Week

SDSU opened the 2002 spring season Saturday with 7-0 victories over Saint Mary's and Cal Poly at the SDSU Tennis Courts. The Aztecs won 25 of 26 singles sets and all six pro-set doubles sets in cruising to their sixth and seventh consecutive victories at home.

A Year Ago

Last February the Aztecs traveled to Reno to compete in the Bill Cosby Invitational. Tricia Gutierrez set a personal best in the pole vault and classmate Deveetta Shepard won the 55-meter hurdles to lead the SDSU to a fourth-place finish. Host school Nevada won the meet with 102 points, while Fresno State (97.50) and UNLV (74) finished second and third, respectively. Other notable performances by Aztec athletes included senior Promise Mose's fourth-place finish in the 55-meter dash, sophomore Melinda Smedley's second-place clocking in the 200 meters, and Alicia Stewart's fourth-place finish in the mile run.

The Indoor Season At A Glance

The Aztecs continue the indoor season next Saturday (Feb. 9) when the team will be in Flagstaff, Ariz., for the NAU Invitational. The Mountain West Conference Indoor Championships will be held Feb. 21-23 in Colorado Springs, Colo., on the Air Force Academy campus.

The San Diego State rowing team get its 2002 spring season underway on Saturday by competing at the San Diego Indoor Classic. The event is hosted by the San Diego Rowing Club on Mission Bay. Racing is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m.

About The S.D. Indoor Classic

The San Diego Indoor Classic is an official qualifying regatta for the World Indoor Championships. Athletes who meet qualifying standards will be eligible to compete in the World Indoor Championships held in Boston on Feb. 24. The indoor classic will send the top 4 individuals, who meet or better the qualifying times, to Boston. Competitors will race on new *Concept 2* ergometers. All races will be 2,000 meters.

Last Time We Were Out

The Aztecs defended its crown at the San Diego Fall Classic on Nov. 11, placing first in the regatta's varsity eight race for the third consecutive year. It was the Aztecs' "A" team that earned the top spot in the varsity eight, racing to a time of 22:26 - 11 seconds faster than its closest competitor. The squad's "B" team finished fifth with a time of 23:12. SDSU also posted wins in the open four and novice eight portion of competition. The Aztecs' "A" boat finished the open four in a time of 24:34. The SDSU Alumni team helped claim a 1-2 sweep in the event with a 25:05 second-place clocking. It was the team's "C" boat that took top honors in the novice eight, crossing the finish line in 24:12. The "A" and "B" teams finished third (24:37) and fifth (24:59), respectively. SDSU also competed in the novice four event where it placed second (24:59).

SDSU This Season

Prior to the San Diego Fall Classic, SDSU was in Newport, Calif., for the Autumn Rowing Festival. The Aztecs came away from that event with four top-five finishes. The team's varsity eight "A" team finished in fifth place in a 22team field with a time of 16:56. In the day's novice eight event, the SDSU "B" team's time of 18:02 helped it secure second place out of 25 teams. The Aztecs scored a 3-4 finish in the open-four event, with the "A" team finishing in 18:49 and the "B" team in 18:51. The SDSU alumni team, made up of last year's graduates, finished second in the competition with a time of 18:27. On Oct 21, SDSU's varsity eight squad competed in the prestigious Head of the Charles Regatta in Boston. The boat placed 44th in a field consisting on the nation's best crews with a time of 18:16.46.

Aztec Coaching Staff

SDSU is led by fifth-year head coach Scott Steckel. Steckel is assisted by Kevin Waldick, in his fourth year with the Aztec program and first-year assistant Meredith Johnson. Steckel is a 1994 graduate of San Diego State and has coached the program since 1993 when it was a club sport. Waldick is also an SDSU alum and rowed on the school's men's club team from 1992-96. Johnson is also a graduate of SDSU and was an All-American rower for the Aztecs in 2000

Looking Ahead

SDSU will scrimmage with Orange Coast College and USD on Feb. 23 in Mission Bay. On Mar. 2 the team will hold its annual alumni race. On Mar. 9, the Aztecs will compete against Loyola Marymount and UC Irvine in the Parker Cup Regatta held at Mission Bay.
