### #AztecWBB Faces Tough Test vs. Washington at Home Thursday

Following a nine-day break for final exams, San Diego State returns to the hardwood on Thursday when it plays host to Pac-12 foe Washington, starting at 6 p.m. PT inside Viejas Arena. A live video stream of the Aztecs-Huskies clash will be available via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play duties.

In addition, Thursday's contest will feature a free Aztec women's basketball T-shirt giveaway to the first 500 fans in attendance.

SDSU is coming off a 66-44 setback on the road to crosstown adversary San Diego in its last game on Dec. 9, as the freshman duo of Cheyenne Greenhouse (11 pts.) and McKynzie Fort (10 pts.) each finished in double figures. Washington, meanwhile, won its eighth straight last Sunday after recording an 83-54 triumph over Grambling at home.

The Aztecs will be facing the Huskies for just the third time in program history. The teams split their two previous meetings, with SDSU posting a 63-51 victory at Viejas Arena in 2011, before UW rallied from a 19-point deficit the following year to claim a narrow 59-58 decision in Seattle. That defeat to the Huskies in 2012 marked the only occasion in the past three-plus seasons in which the Aztecs ultimately lost when leading with five minutes remaining in the game (65-1).

Thursday's matchup will be SDSU's lone encounter of the regular season against a Pac-12 school. The Aztecs last scheduled a single Pac-12 opponent during the 2009 non-conference slate when they registered a 57-38 home triumph over Arizona. SDSU has dropped its last three meetings to Pac-12 squads (Washington - 2012; USC - 2013; UCLA - 2013) and is 68-111 all-time against current members of that conference. Conversely, the Huskies are 36-8 vs. teams that are presently aligned with the Mountain West.

The Aztecs have been buoyed by the return of junior Erimma Amarikwa, who missed the final 23 games of the 2013-14 campaign after undergoing hip surgery. Through eight games this year, the Vacaville, Calif., native leads the Scarlet and Black with 9.8 points and 6.4 rebounds per outing, while her .508 field-goal percentage ranks second on the team.

Collectively, SDSU finds itself among the top half of the MW in several categories, including three-point field goal percentage defense (2nd - .284), rebounding defense (2nd - 35.9/gm), rebounding margin (3rd - (+2.9)), field-goal percentage (4th - (.414)) and three-point field goal percentage (5th - (.324)).

## Scouting the Huskies

Washington, which received votes in both the AP and coaches polls this week, is off to an 8-1 start, having knocked off Grambling by an 84-53 count at home in its last outing on Sunday. In a game that witnessed nine lead changes and three ties, the Huskies trailed the Tigers 23-22 at the 15-minute mark of the opening period, before closing with a 16-5 run to take the lead for good by intermission, 38-28.

Entering the week, Washington ranks sixth in the country as a team in three-point field goals (9.7/gm) and occupies the seventh spot in scoring offense (87.2 ppg). In addition, the Huskies find themselves among the nation's leaders in field-goal percentage (17th - (.467)), free-throw percentage (17th - (.765)) and three-point shooting percentage (24th - (.383)).

Individually, Washington is led by sophomore Kelsey Plum, a 5-8 guard from nearby Poway, Calif., who attended La Jolla Country Day School. Heading into Thursday's game, Plum ranks second in the nation in scoring (26.2 ppg), highlighted by a school-record 45-point performance in the season opener at Oklahoma on Nov. 14, while senior Jazmine Davis (16.7 ppg) and junior Talia Walton (12.6 ppg) have also posted double-digit scoring averages. Davis, who recently joined Plum on the Naismith Trophy watch list, tops the squad with 4.8 assists per contest, while senior Aminah Williams is the team's leading rebounder (9.4/gm) and has four double-doubles to her credit. Elsewhere, sophomore Chantel Oshahor (7.1 rpg) was a prep teammate of Aztec guard Chloe Johnson at St. Mary's Catholic High in Phoenix, Ariz.

Mike Neighbors is in his second season at the helm of the Husky program and has amassed a 28-15 overall record after serving a two-year stint as Washington's top assistant. Prior to his arrival in Seattle, Neighbors spent four seasons as an assistant at Xavier from 2007-11 and also held similar positions at Arkansas, Colorado and Tulsa.

San Diego State head coach Stacie Terry squared off against Washington six times when she was an assistant at UCLA, with her Bruin squad posting a 5-1 mark in those games.

### With a Victory...

An SDSU win over Washington on Thursday will mean:

- The Aztecs move to 3-1 at home this season.
- SDSU raises its all-time record to 2-1 against the Huskies.
- The Aztecs improve to 35-14 in December games since 2006.
- SDSU ends a three-game losing skid against Pac-12 schools.

### Flashback: Aztecs-Huskies 2012 Edition

Despite double-doubles from seniors Courtney Clements and Chelsea Hopkins, the San Diego State women's basketball team dropped a heartbreaker to Washington, 59-58, in the last meeting between the two schools on Dec. 5, 2012.

The Huskies' Talia Walton nailed a three-pointer with 10 seconds left on the clock to complete a furious comeback that saw the host school trail by as many as 19 points in the second half.

Clements led all players with 22 points and a career-high 13 rebounds, while Hopkins added 14 points and 10 boards of her own. The SDSU cause was also aided by senior Malia Nahinu, who finished with 12 points to go along with six rebounds and two blocks, but it wasn't enough as Washington drained 10 of 19 shots from beyond the 3-point arc, including a 6-for-10 clip in the second half to escape with the win.

Despite maintaining a 45-34 advantage in rebounds and a 15-7 edge in free throws made, the Aztecs were just 3-for-12 from three-point territory and were minus-3 in the turnover department (15-12) as the Huskies outscored the visitors, 19-11, off those miscues.

Walton paced Washington with 17 points, while Aminah Williams completed a double-double as well with 15 points and 12 rebounds. In addition, Mercedes Wetmore (13 pts.) and Jazmine Davis (11 pts.) posted double-digit scoring totals, while Kristi Kingma notched nine boards and a game-high three steals.

SDSU raced to a 10-4 lead in the first half following a Nahinu jumper with 12:48 remaining. However, the Huskies gradually whittled away at the deficit over the ensuing eight minutes, eventually jumping in front 20-19 on a Wetmore basket at the 4:21 mark.

The Aztecs responded with eight consecutive points, capped by Clements' old fashioned three-point play with 1:49 left on the clock. Davis ended the run with a triple for Washington, but junior Danesha Long soon hit a pair of free throws, while Erimma Amarikwa converted a layup just before the horn sounded to give SDSU a 31-23 cushion heading into the locker room.

The Aztecs took advantage of some cold shooting by the Huskies, who connected on three of their first 13 shots to begin the second

half. Following a Clements triple and an Amarikwa foul shot, SDSU enjoyed its biggest lead of the evening at 48-29 with 12:31 left to play.

However, Washington fought itself off the ropes with a 21-4 blitz, highlighted by five 3-pointers, including two by Davis, over the ensuing 9:38 to pull within 52-50 by the 2:53 mark. Two baskets by Hopkins on consecutive possessions seemingly put the Aztecs in the driver's seat at 56-50 with 1:54 remaining. Moments later, though, the Huskies crept back into contention following an and-1 conversion by Walton and a Davis free throw.

With 26 seconds left on the clock, Hopkins was fouled and subsequently drained two clutch free throws, giving SDSU a four-point bulge at 58-54. Wetmore then connected on a jumper, while the Aztecs missed the front end of a 1-and-1 opportunity at the other end. Washington quickly worked the ball up to Walton, who sank the go-ahead 3-pointer from the top of the key. SDSU had one last shot, but a jumper from the right hand side was off target, saddling the Scarlet and Black with the hard-luck defeat.

## The Last Time Out: Aztecs-USD

Visiting San Diego State was unable to overcome a slow start in its annual crosstown battle with the University of San Diego, dropping a 66-44 decision at Jenny Craig Pavilion on Dec. 9. With the loss, the Aztecs slip to 3-5 on the season, while the Toreros captured their third straight to raise their record to 7-1 overall.

SDSU misfired on its first six field-goal attempts, allowing USD to build a 9-0 advantage in the opening three minutes of the game. The Aztecs subsequently broke their scoring drought with consecutive baskets by junior Erimma Amarikwa and a layup by freshman McKynzie Fort, but found themselves in pursuit mode for the remainder of the evening.

After the Toreros answered with an old-fashioned three-point play by Maya Hood at the 13:08 mark, SDSU managed to pull within four points on five occasions over the ensuing four-and-a-half minutes, including a 20-16 spread following a pair of free throws by junior Ahjalee Harvey. However, USD began to seize control at this juncture, as another and-one opportunity by Hood capped an 11-5 spurt that put the host school up 31-21 with 4:32 remaining in the first half.

The Aztecs seemed poised to creep back into contention after a layup by freshman Cheyenne Greenhouse and a clutch jumper by Fort with 18 ticks left on the clock. However, the Toreros picked themselves off the mat following six straight misses from the perimeter, as a layup by Brooke Jelniker at the buzzer snuffed out

the SDSU momentum and gave the contest its 33-25 score at intermission.

The Aztecs trimmed the margin to five at 37-32 on a Harvey layup with just under three minutes elapsed in the second half, but could draw no closer. USD uncorked a 10-1 spurt over the next five minutes to build a 47-33 advantage that essentially quashed SDSU's comeback hopes. During that span, the Aztecs committed three turnovers and came up empty on three shots from the floor.

The Scarlet and Black cut the deficit to 10 three times over the ensuing six-plus minutes, including a 53-43 margin on a Greenhouse layup with 4:57 remaining, but Maya Hood's trio of three-pointers highlighted a 13-1 closing run, as USD won going away.

Greenhouse (11 pts.) and Fort (10 pts.) each surpassed double digits in scoring for SDSU, while senior Khristina Hunter grabbed eight rebounds in the loss.

Conversely, the Toreros were paced by Malina Hood's 22-point performance, while twin sister Maya Hood added 14 points of her own to go with a game-high seven assists. In addition, USD received eight points, eight rebounds and three blocks by Sophia Ederaine, while Katelyn McDaniel contributed eight points and four boards.

Despite maintaining a slim 38-36 advantage in rebounds, the Aztecs were outscored by a 20-12 margin on second-chance points and a 17-4 spread off turnovers by USD, which also drained 10 more field goals (27-17) to help key its victory.

### Noting the USD Game

■ The home team in the Aztecs-Toreros series won for the first time in five years.

■ Desi Culberson played in her 100th game at SDSU.

■ With her three points and eight rebounds, Khristina Hunter surpassed 500 points and 400 rebounds for her career.

■ Ahjalee Harvey scored a pair of baskets to give her 100 field goals for her career.

■ SDSU was 0-for-5 from three-point territory, marking the second time this season in which the Scarlet and Black came up empty from beyond the arc.

### Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 34-14 during the month of December since 2006. Seven of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to No. 23 Texas A&M and a setback to North Carolina State (rv) last year in the final of the San Diego Surf 'N Slam. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous years against No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 14 Oklahoma State, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other six defeats were against UCLA in 2013, at Washington in 2012, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opener of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam. Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 35 of those 48 December contests at home.

### Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State point guard McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year last month in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW preseason freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurrey and Desi Culberson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the preseason poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134 points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted

for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

### Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

### 2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

- SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.
- In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.

SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

- SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).
- The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/game).
- SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.
- The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two years.
- The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.

• Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

### 2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch for the remainder of the 2014-15 campaign:

- SDSU has claimed 37 of its last 48 home games and has gone 69-23 (.747) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 65 Mountain West victories in the last six seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU is 65-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 7. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- SDSU is 34-14 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with seven of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

### SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a selected group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JCY Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

# STACIE TERRY

## Head Coach Second Season UT Arlington (1998)

San Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amarikwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
