AZTECS TO CONCLUDE 2011 CAMPAIGN BY HOSTING TURKEY TIME TOURNAMENT

- ◆ San Diego State will wrap up its 2011 volleyball season by hosting the four-team Aztec Turkey Time Tournament this weekend.
- ◆ In addition to the Aztecs, other teams competing will include TCU, Pittsburgh and UC Santa Barbara.
- ◆ Each team will play a single match on Friday and Saturday. SDSU and TCU will not meet as they played each other twice during the regular season as members of the Mountain West. Likewise, Pitt and UC Santa Barbara will not face each other either.
- ◆ San Diego State will play UC Santa Barbara on Friday at 7:00 p.m. on Aztec Court and wind up its season with a contest vs. UC Santa Barbara on Saturday (Nov. 26) at the same time.
- ◆ The complete schedule for the two-day tourney appears below.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ SDSU's all-time record against UC Santa Barbara stands at 21-19 since the teams first met back in 1978. The teams last faced each other in last season (Sept. 18, 2010) a match that UCSB won in five sets after coming back from a 2-1 deficit. SDSU's last win over the Gauchos came in 2007 in the season opener in a match that the Aztec won in five sets. Prior to that, the Gauchos had won the previous 10 matches going back to 1989.
- ◆ The Aztecs hold a 3-1 edge in the series against Pitt although the teams have not met since the 1990 season. They first squared off in 1979 with a pair of matches in San Diego State which SDSU won. The Panthers' lone win in the series came in 1990, a five set-set decision at the Midlands Classic in in Syracuse.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- ◆ UC Santa Barbara enters the week with a record of 18-11 as the Gauchos have won their last six matches in a row. UCSB is led by outside hitter Leah Sully (3.00 kills, 3.77 digs per set) and middle blocker Stacey Schmidt (2.97 kills, 1.62 digs, 0.94 blocks per set. Libero Chelsea Love, a transfer from University of San Francisco, is averaging 5.38 digs per set.
- ◆ Pittsburgh, which will face TCU in the tourney's opening match on Thursday, has a record of 18-13 and has won four of its past five contests. The Panthers' top players include Kiesha Leggs (3.62 kills, 1.13 blocks per set) and Monica Wignot (3.31 kills, 1.91 digs per set). Lindsey Zitzke ranks 35th in the nation in Division I in service aces at 0.42 per set.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named to the position prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 47-40.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 16-year career record stands at 209-231.
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.

- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

- ◆ With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.

BEST FINISH SINCE...

- ◆ San Diego State's second-place finish in the Mountain West was its best since the 2002 campaign when it ended the league season in the same position.
- ◆ The Aztecs' 10-4 conference record is also its best since that same season when it finished 11-3. It is the first time SDSU has been over the .500 mark in its league record since that same season.
- ◆ The team's 17 total wins is its highest victory total since the 2003 campaign when it went 18-14.

HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch led Aztecs with 15 kills in the match vs. UNLV at last week's Mountain West tournament.
- ◆ She leads the San Diego State offense in kills, blocks and points.
- ◆ She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories as well as hitting percentage.
- ◆ She turned in her fourth double-double of the season with 10 kills and 10 digs in the win over New Mexico on Nov. 3.
- ◆ The 10 digs in that match marked her season high.
- ◆ It was her first double-double this season with kills and digs. The other three came with kills and blocks.
- ◆ Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She set new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She also tied her Aztec bests with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her .765 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State (Oct. 15) was a career high as she had no errors in the match on 17 attacks.

FOUCH ASSISTS

- ◆ Johnna Fouch had 41 assists in the loss to UNLV last Friday for an average of 13.67 in the match.
- ◆ She also recorded a career-high three solo blocks in that match.
- ◆ She leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.30 assists per set while her final league-match average of 11.84 was the best in the Mountain West by one assist per set.
- ◆ Her overall assist average ranks 22nd in NCAA Division I this week.
- ◆ Fouch set a career high with 65 assists in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She recorded a season-high 31 digs at Wyoming last Saturday (Oct. 29).
- ◆ Her average of 2.45 digs per set is second only to libero Kristi Jackels.
- ◆ She set a career high with six blocks in the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29.
- ◆ Fouch has recorded nine double-double performances (assists-digs) in 2011, the latest being a 54 assist-31 dig effort at Wyoming on Oct. 29.

NASH CONTRIBUTES

- ◆ After notching a dozen kills in each of the four previous matches, Summer Nash saw a sting of double-figure kill efforts end against UNLV on Nov. 18.
- ◆ In the contests vs. Boise State and Air Force (Nov. 10 and 12), she was the only player on either team to record double figures in kills.
- ◆ Her .478 and .455 hitting percentages respectively in those matches were her season-best and second-best.
- ◆ She had career-highs of five block assists and six total blocks in the four-set victory vs. New Mexico on Nov. 3.
- ◆ Nash made a start at Wyoming on Oct. 29 after having appeared off the bench in the previous nine matches.
- ◆ She responded with eight kills, three digs and block in the three sets in which she played.
- ◆ Nash's 13 kills and 10 digs vs. Cal State Fullerton on Sept. 20 was her first double-double as an Aztec.
- ◆ Her season high of 16 kills came vs. Valparaiso on Sept. 17.

HARRIS ON THE BLOCK

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris has emerged as one of the top blockers in the Mountain West after averaging 1.56 blocks per set over SDSU's last five matches.
- ◆ She is also hitting .467 over the past three contests and her .333 attack percentage for the season leads the team among the regulars.
- ◆ Harris had a career-high 10 blocks in the match against New Mexico on Nov. 3. She also had eight kills and a .333 hitting percentage in that contest.
- ◆ In SDSU's last four matches, she recorded a total of 16 blocks for an average of 1.77 per set.
- ◆ Her overall average of 1.11 blocks per set ranks fifth in the Mountain West while her final mark of 1.20 in league matches was third in the conference stats.
- ◆ Harris set career highs with 15 kills, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.



SHELTON SOLID UP FRONT

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton recorded her 10th and 11th double-figure kill efforts of the season with 10 against New Mexico (Nov. 3) and 14 vs. TCU (Nov. 6).
- ◆ Against UNLV (O. 21), she tied her career highs of 21 kills and four blocks while setting a personal best with 23.5 points.
- ◆ She had recorded a career-highs in those categories with 21 kills and 21.5 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Her eight digs at New Mexico on Oct. 9 tied her career best.
- ◆ She was named MW Player of the Week after leading the Aztecs to road wins over New Mexico and TCU in early October.
- ◆ Shelton's final average of 3.12 kills per set in Mountain West matches ranked seventh in the league.

JACKELS DIGGING AWAY

- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels led all players with 15 digs (an average of 5.0 per set) against UNLV in SDSU's most recent match on Nov. 18.
- ◆ She recorded a total of 56 digs in the matches vs. New Mexico (Nov. 3) and TCU (Nov. 5) for an average of 8.00 per set over those seven sets.
- ◆ Her 32 digs against New Mexico tied her career high which she set at Brigham Young on Nov. 6, 2010.
- ◆ In SDSU's last five matches she is averaging 5.94 digs per set.
- ◆ She has finished in double figures in digs in 24 of SDSU's 26 matches this year.
- ◆ Jackels has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,321 digs to rank fourth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ She finished third in the conference in digs in Mountain West play at 4.65 per set.
- ◆ She was also fourth in service aces at 0.31 service aces per set in league matches.

PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- ◆ Senior Pajje Pearson went for 10 kills, six digs, two blocks and an assist in the match vs. UNLV on Nov. 18.
- ◆ She had back-to-back double-figure kill matches for the second time this season with 13 vs. New Mexico and 10 vs. TCU (Nov. 3 and 5).
- ◆ Her average of 3.29 kills per set over those two matches was over a point higher than her season average (2.15 kps).
- ◆ She had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.

- ◆ Pearson set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ At UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- ◆ Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- ◆ In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

THE RECORD BOOK

- ◆ A trio of Aztecs have entered the SDSU career record listings this season.
- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels' 1,321 digs is fourth on the career Aztec top 10. Third place is currently held by Juliana Cezar (1993-96) with 1,369 career digs.
- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch has moved into the number-eight spot in career assists with 2,346. Former Aztec Leah Lathrop (2005-08) ranks seventh on the list with 2,624 assists.
- ◆ In addition, Andrea Hannasch is now ninth on the career blocks assists chart with 347. Eighth place is occupied by Shannon Matthews (1988-89) with 358.

GOING LONG

- ◆ San Diego State's wins at TCU (Oct. 6) and New Mexico (Oct. 9) marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 4-3 in five-set matches this season.

PEARSON WINS MW HONOR

- ◆ Outside hitter Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Nov. 7 for her efforts in the Aztecs' to two wins over New Mexico and TCU the previous week. It was the second weekly honor for Pearson in her SDSU career.
- ◆ She led the Aztecs with 13 kills in the 3-1 win over New Mexico on Nov. 3. She also tied her career-high with four assists to go along with seven digs and five blocks.
- ◆ In the 3-0 Senior Day win over TCU, Pearson was errorless in her attack with 10 kills on 20 attempts (.500). She also has three assists, a service ace, six digs and four blocks in the match.
- ◆ For the week, Pearson averaged 3.29 kills, 1.86 digs, 1.29 blocks and 1.00 assists per set, while hitting .354. She averaged 4.07 points per set over seven total sets.

SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs on Oct. 6, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Against New Mexico on Sunday (Oct. 9), Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch earned MW Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It was the third weekly honor of her career.
- ◆ Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26.
- ◆ In the 3-2 win against Portland, she recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. In the nightcap she had a 12 kills and five blocks.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Paije Pearson were named to the all-tourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.
- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Kiley Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- ◆ Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ SDSU's has had a pair of four-match win streaks this season. Those win streaks in 2011 are the longest for the team since 2007 when it put together six victories in a row.
- ◆ The win over TCU on Nov. 5 by scores of 30-28, 28-26, 26-24 marked the first time that SDSU was involved in a match in which every set went to extra points since rally scoring was introduced in 2001. Prior to rally scoring, SDSU never played in a match in which every set went to extra points (including two-set tournament matches).
- ◆ San Diego State's losses at Colorado State and Wyoming (Oct. 27 and 29) marked the only time that the Aztec has lost two matches in a row this season.
- ◆ Kyla Oropeza's 13 digs at Wyoming on Oct. 29 tied her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ Defensive specialist Courtney Vaccarello tied her SDSU career high with nine digs vs. TCU on Nov. 5. She had just set that mark two matches earlier at Wyoming on Oct. 29.
- ◆ As a team, San Diego State finished first in kills and assists in league matches. In all matches, the Aztecs rank second in the MW in those two categories and are first in service aces.
- ◆ San Diego State's .396 hitting percentage in the match vs. Air Force on Nov. 12 was its highest of the season.
- ◆ The team's 11 service aces against Cal State Fullerton were a season high.
- ◆ SDSU has captured the titles at a pair of tournaments in 2011. The Aztecs won the Aztec Invitational with a 3-0 mark and were declared co-champions of the Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic at Tulane along with Southern Illinois when that tourney was cut short due to weather.
- ◆ Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels). Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match. Paije Pearson has started 24 of 25 contests.
- ◆ The Aztec roster has three sophomore transfers from four-year schools: Andrea Terpstra (Pacific), Emily Harris (Western Michigan) and Courtney Vaccarello (Oregon).

Libero Chelsea Love, a transfer from University of San Francisco, is averaging 5.38 digs per set.
- ◆ Pittsburgh, which will face TCU in the tourney's opening match on Thursday, has a record of 18-13 and has won four of its past five contests. The Panthers' top players include Kiesha Leggs (3.62 kills, 1.13 blocks per set) and Monica Wignot (3.31 kills, 1.91 digs per set). Lindsey Zitzke ranks 35th in the nation in Division I in service aces at 0.42 per set.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named to the position prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 47-40.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 16-year career record stands at 209-231.
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.

- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

- ◆ With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.

- ◆ San Diego State's second-place finish in the Mountain West was its best since the 2002 campaign when it ended the league season in the same position.
- ◆ The Aztecs' 10-4 conference record is also its best since that same season when it finished 11-3. It is the first time SDSU has been over the .500 mark in its league record since that same season.
- ◆ The team's 17 total wins is its highest victory total since the 2003 campaign when it went 18-14.

HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch led Aztecs with 15 kills in the match vs. UNLV at last week's Mountain West tournament.
- ◆ She leads the San Diego State offense in kills, blocks and points.
- ◆ She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories as well as hitting percentage.
- ◆ She turned in her fourth double-double of the season with 10 kills and 10 digs in the win over New Mexico on Nov. 3.
- ◆ The 10 digs in that match marked her season high.
- ◆ It was her first double-double this season with kills and digs. The other three came with kills and blocks.
- ◆ Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She set new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She also tied her Aztec bests with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her .765 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State (Oct. 15) was a career high as she had no errors in the match on 17 attacks.

- ◆ She also recorded a career-high three solo blocks in that match.
- ◆ She leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.30 assists per set while her final league-match average of 11.84 was the best in the Mountain West by one assist per set.
- ◆ Her overall assist average ranks 22nd in NCAA Division I this week.

HARRIS ON THE BLOCK

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris has emerged as one of the top blockers in the Mountain West after averaging 1.56 blocks per set over SDSU's last five matches.
- ◆ She is also hitting .467 over the past three contests and her .333 attack percentage for the season leads the team among the regulars.
- ◆ Harris had a career-high 10 blocks in the match against New Mexico on Nov. 3. She also had eight kills and a .333 hitting percentage in that contest.
- ◆ In SDSU's last four matches, she recorded a total of 16 blocks for an average of 1.77 per set.
- ◆ Her overall average of 1.11 blocks per set ranks fifth in the Mountain West while her final mark of 1.20 in league matches was third in the conference stats.
- ◆ Harris set career highs with 15 kills, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton recorded her 10th and 11th double-figure kill efforts of the season with 10 against New Mexico (Nov. 3) and 14 vs. TCU (Nov. 6).
- ◆ Against UNLV (O. 21), she tied her career highs of 21 kills and four blocks while setting a personal best with 23.5 points.
- ◆ She had recorded a career-highs in those categories with 21 kills and 21.5 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Her eight digs at New Mexico on Oct. 9 tied her career best.
- ◆ She was named MW Player of the Week after leading the Aztecs to road wins over New Mexico and TCU in early October.
- ◆ Shelton's final average of 3.12 kills per set in Mountain West matches ranked seventh in the league.

JACKELS DIGGING AWAY

- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels led all players with 15 digs (an average of 5.0 per set) against UNLV in SDSU's most recent match on Nov. 18.
- ◆ She recorded a total of 56 digs in the matches vs. New Mexico (Nov. 3) and TCU (Nov. 5) for an average of 8.00 per set over those seven sets.
- ◆ Her 32 digs against New Mexico tied her career high which she set at Brigham Young on Nov. 6, 2010.
- ◆ In SDSU's last five matches she is averaging 5.94 digs per set.
- ◆ She has finished in double figures in digs in 24 of SDSU's 26 matches this year.
- ◆ Jackels has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,321 digs to rank fourth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ She finished third in the conference in digs in Mountain West play at 4.65 per set.
- ◆ She was also fourth in service aces at 0.31 service aces per set in league matches.

PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- ◆ Senior Pajje Pearson went for 10 kills, six digs, two blocks and an assist in the match vs. UNLV on Nov. 18.
- ◆ She had back-to-back double-figure kill matches for the second time this season with 13 vs. New Mexico and 10 vs. TCU (Nov. 3 and 5).
- ◆ Her average of 3.29 kills per set over those two matches was over a point higher than her season average (2.15 kps).
- ◆ She had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.

- ◆ Pearson set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ At UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- ◆ Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- ◆ In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch has moved into the number-eight spot in career assists with 2,346. Former Aztec Leah Lathrop (2005-08) ranks seventh on the list with 2,624 assists.
- ◆ In addition, Andrea Hannasch is now ninth on the career blocks assists chart with 347. Eighth place is occupied by Shannon Matthews (1988-89) with 358.

GOING LONG

- ◆ San Diego State's wins at TCU (Oct. 6) and New Mexico (Oct. 9) marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 4-3 in five-set matches this season.

PEARSON WINS MW HONOR

- ◆ Outside hitter Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Nov. 7 for her efforts in the Aztecs' to two wins over New Mexico and TCU the previous week. It was the second weekly honor for Pearson in her SDSU career.
- ◆ She led the Aztecs with 13 kills in the 3-1 win over New Mexico on Nov. 3. She also tied her career-high with four assists to go along with seven digs and five blocks.
- ◆ In the 3-0 Senior Day win over TCU, Pearson was errorless in her attack with 10 kills on 20 attempts (.500). She also has three assists, a service ace, six digs and four blocks in the match.
- ◆ For the week, Pearson averaged 3.29 kills, 1.86 digs, 1.29 blocks and 1.00 assists per set, while hitting .354. She averaged 4.07 points per set over seven total sets.

SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs on Oct. 6, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Against New Mexico on Sunday (Oct. 9), Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch earned MW Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It was the third weekly honor of her career.
- ◆ Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26.
- ◆ In the 3-2 win against Portland, she recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. In the nightcap she had a 12 kills and five blocks.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Paije Pearson were named to the all-tourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.
- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Kiley Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- ◆ Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ SDSU's has had a pair of four-match win streaks this season. Those win streaks in 2011 are the longest for the team since 2007 when it put together six victories in a row.
- ◆ The win over TCU on Nov. 5 by scores of 30-28, 28-26, 26-24 marked the first time that SDSU was involved in a match in which every set went to extra points since rally scoring was introduced in 2001. Prior to rally scoring, SDSU never played in a match in which every set went to extra points (including two-set tournament matches).
- ◆ San Diego State's losses at Colorado State and Wyoming (Oct. 27 and 29) marked the only time that the Aztec has lost two matches in a row this season.
- ◆ Kyla Oropeza's 13 digs at Wyoming on Oct. 29 tied her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ Defensive specialist Courtney Vaccarello tied her SDSU career high with nine digs vs. TCU on Nov. 5. She had just set that mark two matches earlier at Wyoming on Oct. 29.
- ◆ As a team, San Diego State finished first in kills and assists in league matches. In all matches, the Aztecs rank second in the MW in those two categories and are first in service aces.
- ◆ San Diego State's .396 hitting percentage in the match vs. Air Force on Nov. 12 was its highest of the season.
- ◆ The team's 11 service aces against Cal State Fullerton were a season high.
- ◆ SDSU has captured the titles at a pair of tournaments in 2011. The Aztecs won the Aztec Invitational with a 3-0 mark and were declared co-champions of the Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic at Tulane along with Southern Illinois when that tourney was cut short due to weather.
- ◆ Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels). Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match. Paije Pearson has started 24 of 25 contests.
- ◆ The Aztec roster has three sophomore transfers from four-year schools: Andrea Terpstra (Pacific), Emily Harris (Western Michigan) and Courtney Vaccarello (Oregon).
