### AZTECS VISIT USD, HOST UNLV THIS WEEK

- ◆ San Diego State will remain in town this week for a pair of matches, one non-conference contest away and one Mountain West match at home.
- ◆ The Aztecs will be in action on Tuesday, Oct. 18, when they make the short trip across town to face the University of San Diego at 7:00 p.m. (PT) in at USD's Jenny Craig Pavilion.
- ◆ SDSU will resume league play on Friday, Oct. 21, with a contest against UNLV at 6:00 p.m. (PT) on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ The match against the Rebels will be televised live on The MTN network with Anne Marie Anderson and Amy Gant calling the action.

### SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State holds a 25-24 edge in its series vs. San Diego that dates back to the 1977 season. The Toreros have won the last eight and 12 of the previous 13 meetings between the teams. SDSU's last victory over USD came during the 2003 season in a five-set victory in the Jenny Craig Pavilion. The Aztecs are 7-10 vs. San Diego at home, 8-11 at USD and 10-3 on neutral courts.
- ◆ The Aztecs' all-time record against UNLV stands at 20-13 since the teams first met during the 1985 campaign when both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. San Diego State had won the last five encounters between the teams before the Rebels captured a three-set win in Las Vegas last month. SDSU is 12-3 vs. UNLV at home, 8-9 in Las Vegas and 0-1 on neutral courts.

### SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ San Diego enters the week with a record of 20-1 overall and 6-1 in the Big West. The Toreros are ranked 16th in the nation with their only loss coming in their conference opener at San Francisco on Sept. 22. USD is led by outside hitter Amber Tatsch (3.39 kills, 1.97 digs per set) and middle hitter Chloe Ferrari (3.07 kills, 1.15 digs, 0.89 blocks per set). Ferrari is hitting .390 for the season while teammate Katie Hoekman (2.27 kills, 0.95 blocks per set) has a .412 attack percentage.
- ◆ UNLV's record stands at 10-10 (3-4 Mountain West) with its last outing being a three-set win over Air Force at home last Saturday (Oct. 15). The Rebels' top players include outside hitter Makenzie Moea'i (2.92 kills, 0.93 digs per set) and middle blocker Madeline Westman (2.22 kills, 1.07 blocks per set). Candice Thomas is averaging over one block per set (1.11) in league matches to rank fourth in the conference.

### HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named prior to the 2009 campaign. Her two-year record at SDSU is 43-37.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 15-year career record stands at 204-227.
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

### WIN NO. 200

- ◆ With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.
- ◆ She is in her 15th season as a collegiate head coach having previously held that position at UNLV and Colgate.

### HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch led all players in kills in both of SDSU's matches last week as she helped the Aztecs win a pair conference matches.
- ◆ Her 13 kills in each contest were five more than the next-highest individual total.
- ◆ Her .765 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State was a career high as she had no errors in the match on 17 attacks.
- ◆ Over the two wins she averaged 4.83 points per set and hit over .622 for the week.
- ◆ Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She set new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She also tied her Aztec bests with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her 20 kills and 11 blocks at TCU were her third double-double of the season and sixth of her career.
- ◆ She leads the San Diego State offense in kills, blocks, service aces, points and hitting percentage.
- ◆ She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories this week.
- ◆ Hannasch ranks 43rd in blocking in this week's NCAA Division I statistics.

### FOUCH ASSISTS

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch averaged just over 12 assists per set in last week's wins over Air force and Boise State.
- ◆ She leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.32 assists per set while her league-match average of 11.69 ranks second.
- ◆ Her overall assist average ranks 18th in NCAA Division I this week.
- ◆ She set a career high 65 assists in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Fouch set a career high with six total blocks in the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29. Her five blocks assists were her personal best as an Aztec as well.
- ◆ Her average of 2.43 digs per set is second only to libero Kristi Jackels.
- ◆ She has recorded seven double-double performances (assists-digs) in 2011, the latest being a 53 assist-14 dig effort at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ Fouch is hitting .347 (32k-7e-72att) from her setter position and has had only one attack error in SDSU's last six matches.

## SEXTON SERVES IT UP

- ◆ Senior outside hitter Kyley Sexton had five service aces in the five sets in which she played last week including three vs. Boise State.
- ◆ She is averaging 0.39 aces per set, a mark which would lead the conference if she had not missed several matches with an ankle injury in late September.
- ◆ Sexton had a career-high four service aces in the over Nevada on Aug. 27.
- ◆ Her three blocks assists against Boise State last Saturday (Oct. 15) tied her season high.
- ◆ After missing four matches due to spraining her ankle in practice on Monday, Sept. 19, she returned to the floor vs. Colorado State on Oct. 2.
- ◆ She recorded 13 kills in the win at TCU on Oct. 6, her second-best total of the 2011 campaign.

## TOUGH AS STEEL

- ◆ Freshman right side hitter Chaiymin Steel hit .426 is the Aztecs' wins over Air Force and Boise State last week.
- ◆ She averaged 2.80 kills and 1.20 digs per set in those two matches.
- ◆ She had a career-high 12 digs in the victory at TCU last week (Oct. 6).
- ◆ She also contributed four blocks in that contest.
- ◆ Steel had the best match of her young Aztec career in the win at UC Riverside on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She finished with 10 kills while hitting .357, both highs for the first-year player from Reno, Nev.

## SHELTON SOLID UP FRONT

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton continued her steady play of late, hitting .303 in last week's contests vs. Air Force and Boise State.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills at TCU on Oct. 6, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Her 21.5 points in that match were also a personal best.
- ◆ Her eight digs at New Mexico three days later tied her career best.
- ◆ Shelton is averaging 3.17 kills per set through seven Mountain West matches to rank 10th in the league.

## DAVIDSON DEBUTS

- ◆ Senior Amber Davidson made her Aztec debut in the match against Air Force last Thursday (Oct. 13).
- ◆ She appeared in the final set and provided assists on the final two points of the match in SDSU's three-set win.
- ◆ Davidson came to San Diego State in 2010 from San Diego Mesa Junior College.

## HARRIS HEATS UP

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris, a sophomore transfer from Western Michigan, has started each of the last 12 matches after not appearing in SDSU's first five contests of the year.
- ◆ In SDSU's two matches last week she average 1.17 blocks per set.
- ◆ Harris set career highs with eight blocks, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at new Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ She also tied her career highs with 15 kills vs. the Lobos in that match.
- ◆ Over the last three matches she has a .454 hitting percentage.
- ◆ Her previous best effort came at UC Riverside (Sept. 25) where she recorded season highs in kills (15) and blocks (7) along with a .481 hitting percentage.

### JACKELS DIGGIN' IT

- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels saw a streak of double-figure dig efforts end in the win over Boise State.
- ◆ She had finished in double figures in digs in every match this season with a high of 26 vs. Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ Going back to last season, that streak had extended to 19 consecutive matches.
- ◆ Jackels has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,171 digs to rank fifth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ She ranks fourth in the conference this week with an average of 0.31 service aces per set in league matches.
- ◆ She is also fourth in digs in Mountain West play at 4.23 per set.

### PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- ◆ Senior Paije Pearson did a little of everything in the win over Boise State last weekend, finished with six kills, 2 assists, two service aces and four digs along with a .500 hitting percentage.
- ◆ She had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ Pearson set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ In the match at UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- ◆ Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- ◆ In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

### WORKING OVERTIME

- ◆ San Diego State's wins at TCU (Oct. 6) and New Mexico (Oct. 9) marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 4-1 in five-set matches this season.

### THE RECORD BOOK

- ◆ A trio of Aztecs will make their marks in the SDSU career record listings before the end of the 2011 season.
- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels' 1,171 digs is fourth on the career Aztec top 10. Third place is currently held by Juliana Cezar (1993-96) with 1,369 career digs.
- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch has moved into the number-nine spot in career assists with 1,975. Former Aztec Melissa Stokes (1986-88) ranks ninth on the list with 2,239 assists.
- ◆ In addition, Andrea Hannasch needs four block assists to catch Rene Pankopf (1983-86) for the No. 10 spot on that list with 324 career BAs.

### AMONG THE MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- ◆ After the first seven weeks of the season, three Aztecs appear among the top 10 in the Mountain West in various statistical categories both overall and in Mountain West matches only. (Stats are per set except for hitting percentage).

### AZTEC YOUTH

- ◆ San Diego State fields one of the youngest teams in the nation according to a recent survey.
- ◆ The total of 14 freshmen and sophomores on the SDSU roster is the second-most in the country, behind only Air Force (15).
- ◆ As a percentage of the squad, the Aztecs are made up of 73.6% underclassmen, the seventh highest figure in NCAA Division I volleyball.

### HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch earned Mountain West Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It is the third weekly honor of her career.
- ◆ Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26. Her 23.5 points in the match were a career best.
- ◆ In the 3-2 win against Portland, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. The Aztecs beat Nevada, 3-0, in the nightcap with a team-high 12 kills and five blocks from Hannasch.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

### SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Against New Mexico on Sunday, Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.

### FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

### ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Pajje Pearson were named to the all-tourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.
- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

### ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Kyle Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- ◆ Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

### ATHLETIC RELATIVES

- ◆ Two members of the Aztecs have notable athletic connections in their family.
- ◆ Redshirt freshman Oni Lattin's grandfather, David Lattin, was a member of the 1966 Texas Western (now UTEP) basketball team under Don Haskins that upset Kentucky for the national title.
- ◆ Emily Harris' father, Al Harris, played defensive end and linebacker for the Chicago Bears from 1979-84 and 1986-88 before finishing his career with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1989-90.
- ◆ In addition, assistant coach Melanie Greene's dad, Ken Greene, played pro football with the San Diego Chargers and St. Louis Cardinals.

### PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- ◆ The Mountain West coaches and media poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish third in the eight-team league. It is SDSU's highest preseason conference ranking since joining the league in 1999.
- ◆ In the 12 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished second (2002), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003), fifth (2005), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final standings.
- ◆ Colorado State has been chosen to defend its Mountain West title from a year ago with New Mexico picked to finish second. The results of the preseason poll are as follows:

### AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ San Diego's win over Boise State last Saturday (Oct. 15) was its four straight victory. It marks the Aztecs' longest win streak since the 2007 season when they won six in a row.
- ◆ SDSU had a team hitting percentage of .352 over last week's two matches.
- ◆ The Aztecs nine service aces vs. Boise State were its second-highest total of the season and came in just three sets. The team high of 11 aces was set vs. Cal State Fullerton (Sept. 20) in five sets.
- ◆ As a team San Diego State stands first in the conference in kills, assists and service aces in all matches.
- ◆ San Diego State's .387 hitting percentage in the match vs. Wyoming on Sept. 29 was its highest of the season.
- ◆ Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels).
- ◆ Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match.
- ◆ Fouch and Kristi Jackels have appeared in every set in 2011.
- ◆ SDSU captured the titles at a pair of in-season tournament titles in 2011. The Aztecs won the Aztec Invitational with a 3-0 mark and were declared co-champions of the Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic at Tulane along with Southern Illinois when that tourney was cut short due to weather.
