San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. New Mexico

Team Notes

The Aztecs win their first game in the Mountain West Tournament since 2016.

- SDSU wins two games in the for the first time since 2013.
- The Aztecs are now 16-15 all-time in the Mountain West Tournament.
- San Diego State improves to 3-6 all-time against New Mexico in the Mountain West Tournament.
- SDSU improves to 13-2 when holding their opponents to less than 40 percent from the field.
- SDSU won their first game of the year when trailing with 5:00 remaining in regulation (1-16).

Game Notes

- The Aztecs set a season-high and MW Tournament record with 59 rebounds.
- The Aztecs were 9-for-20 from three-point territory, their third straight game shooting at least 40 percent from three.
- SDSU's nine three-pointers were a new MW Tournament record for the Aztecs.
- The Aztecs had 81 field goal attempts, a season-high and MW Tournament record.
- This was the Aztecs' first overtime game since losing to Nevada in the first round of the MW Tournament last year.
- New Mexico was just 3-for-29 from three (.103), the lowest percent SDSU has held an opponent this year.
- In the Aztecs last two meetings with New Mexico the Lobos are 6-for-55 from three (.109).

Player Notes

Najé Murray (22 points, 8-16 FG, 6-11 3-pt FG, 6 rebounds, 5 assists)

Set a new school record with 79 three-pointers in a season... The third most in a single-season in program history (record is 77)... Has 224 three-point attempts on the season, second most in school history... Scored 20+ points for the sixth time this season... Scored 16 of the Aztecs' 26 first half points... Hit season-high six three-pointers... Scored 10 or more points for the 24th time this season (40th in career)... Led the team with 40 minutes played.

Sophia Ramos (20 points, 3-6 3-pt FG, 6 rebounds 5 assists, 0 turnovers, 2-3 3-pt FG)

Hit game-tying shot with 2.6 seconds left... Scored 15 points in the fourth quarter... First game of the season with zero turnovers... Scored in double-digits for the 26^{th} time this season.

Mallory Adams (6 points, 16 rebounds)

Set new career-high with 16 rebounds... Had 10 or more rebounds for the 15^{th} time. Led the team in rebounding for the 22^{nd} time.

Baylee Vanderdoes (14 rebounds)

Set new career-high with 14 rebounds... Played season-high 26 minutes.

Téa Adams (18 points, 6-18 FG, 6-11 FT, 5 rebounds)

Scored 10 or more points for the 18th time this season... Set new career-high with 11 FT attempts.
