San Diego State Aztecs (3-7, 0-0 MWC) at Colorado State Rams (6-5, 0-0 MWC)

- ▶ **The Records:** The San Diego State women's basketball team begins Mountain West Conference play on the road for the third time in the league's seven-year history, as the Aztecs head to Fort Collins, Colo., for a meeting with Colorado State Thursday evening at Moby Arena. SDSU will be nearly a week removed from earning its third victory of the 2005-06 campaign, defeating UC Davis last Friday at home in the San Diego Surf 'N Slam tournament. The Rams are currently 6-5 on the year, having split their last four outings.
- ▶ **San Diego State Head Coach Beth Burns:** Burns (Ohio Wesleyan, 1979) is in the first year of her second stint as head coach at San Diego State. She coached the Aztecs from 1989 to 1997 and has a school record of 154-90 in nine seasons. Her 14-year head coaching record stands at 235-155.
- ▶ **Colorado State Head Coach Jen Warden:** Warden is in her first season at Colorado State. She boasts a school record of 6-5 overall and a four-year career head coaching record of 35-64.
- ▶ **Colorado State Series History:** SDSU leads 17-11 all-time and is 6-7 in games played in Fort Collins (Last: CSU def. SDSU in San Diego, 56-49).

Aztec Basketball Opens Conference Schedule At Colorado State Thursday

The San Diego State women's basketball team will kick off its seventh season of Mountain West Conference play in Fort Collins, Colo., when the Aztecs take on host Colorado State on Thursday at 7 p.m. (MST). This will be SDSU's third occasion to start an MWC campaign on the road, while the two sides will tangle in an MWC opener for the first time.

The Aztecs completed their non-conference tilt last Friday, defeating UC Davis to improve to 3-7 overall. SDSU has won three of their last five contests, while their opponent Colorado State, which was picked to finish fifth in the preseason league poll, is 6-5 overall and has dropped four of their last six games.

And Away We Go

San Diego State will look to build on its 2-12 record in conference play a year ago, beginning with Colorado State on Thursday. The Aztecs have won only 19 of their 84 league games (19-65) since MWC play began during the 1999-00 season, but lead the all-time series with the Rams, which currently stands at 17-11 in favor of SDSU.

In its six MWC season-openers, the Aztecs are 0-2 on the road and 2-2 at home. The two home wins came a year ago against preseason league favorite UNLV and versus BYU in 2001. The two losses away from San Diego were both at UNLV in 2002 and 2004.

San Diego State is 16-13 all time in conference openers, including a 5-4 mark in the Western Collegiate Conference (1976-85), a 2-3 record in the Big West (1985-90) and a 7-2 mark in the Western Athletic Conference (1990-99).

While the Aztecs are playing Colorado State in their MWC road opener for the second consecutive season, SDSU has not opened conference play against a school other than UNLV since 2000-01.

Aztecs Avenges Earlier Loss Against UC Davis

The San Diego State women's basketball team hit eight three-pointers and limited UC Davis to a season-low point total to defeat the visiting Aggies, 59-45, last Friday in the consolation game of the San Diego Surf 'N Slam at Cox Arena. With the victory, the Aztecs (3-7) avenged a 58-36 loss to the Aggies (5-7) earlier this season back on Dec. 3 in Davis, Calif.

SDSU had four-players in double-figures for the first time this season, as **Veronica Shaw (Phoenix, Ariz.)** had a team-high 14 points, while sophomore **Kate Eveland (Southlake, Texas)** came off the bench with her best performance of the year, contributing 13 points, six rebounds, five assists and no turnovers in 33 minutes of action. Senior **Michelle Strawberry (Corona, Calif.)** reached double-figures in scoring for the ninth time this year with 12 points, while sophomore **Shanna Demus (Palmdale, Calif.)** had 11 points.

The Aztec dominated the boards with a plus-10 margin (37-27), getting 10 rebounds from junior **Desiree Johnson (Kahuku, Hawaii)** and seven from Demus.

Other UC Davis Game Notes

SDSU has limited its opponent to 45 points in each of its last two non-conference season finales (also last year vs. Utah Valley State - W, 91-45) ... The Aztecs have split their two games in each of their last four home tournaments in 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2005...SDSU is 7-0 in its last seven non-conference season finales. The streak dates back to the 1998-99 campaign, when the Aztecs fell at UC Santa Barbara, 78-50... SDSU is 9-0 in its final non-conference home games of a season. The streak dates back to coach Beth Burns' first tenure on The Mesa in 1996-97, when the Aztecs fell to Arizona on Dec. 19, 1996... SDSU is 1-1 against UC Davis this season with each team winning on its home court... The Aztecs committed a season-low 10 fouls and 13 turnovers versus the Aggies.

All-Tournament

Two Aztec players earned all-tournament honors at the San Diego Surf 'N Slam, with seniors Michelle Strawberry and Veronica Shaw, both doing so for the first time in their careers. Strawberry averaged 12 points and 4.5 rebounds in the two contests, while Shaw put up comparable numbers at 11.0 ppg. and 6.5 rpg. The pair are the first Aztecs to earn all-tournament honors since 2003, when Ashlee Dunlap averaged a double-double in two games at the Lady Blazer Invitational in Birmingham, Ala. (Note: 2003 was the last time SDSU competed in a non-conference tournament).

Four Score

After scoring just 36 points versus UC Davis the first time around, San Diego State used a balanced attack to win the second meeting this season between the two schools. The Aztecs had a season-high four players reach double-figures in points including senior Veronica Shaw (14 points), sophomore Kate Eveland (13 points), senior Michelle Strawberry (12 points) and sophomore Shanna Demus (11 points). The 13 points were a season-best for Eveland (prev. 5 at Wichita State), while Demus' 11 points are a career-best.

SDSU has had three or more players reach double-figures in points in the same game five times, including in all three of its victories in 2005-06.

Three-Point Threat?

One of the biggest surprises in the win over UC Davis was the team's success from beyond the arc. The Aztecs made eight three-pointers, half of the team's previous season total, as SDSU entered the game just 16-for-92 (17.4 percent) from three-point land entering the night.

Sophomore Shanna Demus and Kate Eveland both had a career-high three treys, while senior Veronica Shaw was a perfect 2-for-2 after making only five in her previous 83 games in an Aztec uniform.

In 2004-05, San Diego State set school records for the second year in a record for most three-point field goals (140) and most three-point attempts (479).

Straw's Streak Goes On And On

With 12 points versus UC Davis, Aztec senior Michelle Strawberry has now scored in double-figures in each of the last six contests and in nine of the team's 10 games in 2005-06. Strawberry is fifth in the Mountain West Conference in scoring with her team-best 14.7 points per game, while her 29 points in the opener with Wichita State are still tied for the best in the MWC this season.

Dating back to last year, Strawberry has recorded 10 points or more in a game in 14 of her last 15 and in 18 of her last 21 contests.

On The Boards Again

After a two-game dryspell, SDSU won the battle on the boards with an opponent for the sixth time this season. The Aztecs outrebounded UC Davis by 10, owning a double-figure margin in that category in each of their last two victories (+12 versus Boise State). SDSU outrebounded an opponent just twice in the entire 2004-05 campaign.

California Girls

SDSU will head out of the state for just the second time this season when it travels to Fort Collins on Wednesday morning. The last time the Aztecs ventured out of the Golden State was for the opener with Wichita State back on Nov. 19. Since that game, SDSU has spent a combined 44 consecutive days in California.

Notes With A 'W'

An SDSU victory over the Colorado State will mean:

- ▶ SDSU has won each of its last two MWC openers and improves to 3-4 all-time. The Aztecs are 17-13 in all-time conference openers.
- ▶ SDSU earns its first victory in Fort Collins since the 2000 campaign, when the Aztecs won 58-51 on March 4 (span of six games).
- ▶ SDSU has forged at least a split in the two-game regular-season series with CSU for the third time in the last four years.
- ▶ SDSU head coach Beth Burns improves to 14-3 all-time versus the Rams.

Colorado State Tid-Bits

Colorado State has begun the Jen Warden era with a 6-5 overall record... The Rams have wins over Concordia, UC Irvine, Colorado, Portland, Northern Colorado and Texas San Antonio... CSU has played one ranked opponent in No. 2 Duke ... Senior Melissa Dennett, a preseason all-MWC pick, is the team's leading scorer and rebounder with 14.7 ppg. and 9.3 rpg. ... Three other players average in double-figure points, including Vanessa Espinoza (13.5 ppg.), Sara Hunter (11.3 ppg.) and Lindsay Thomas (11.0 ppg.) ... CSU

Utah, which tied for the 2004-05 regular season crown with New Mexico, was tabbed as the clear-cut preseason favorite, marking the third time the Utes have been picked to finish atop the conference. Utah received 23-of-26 first-place votes and 214 total points.

SDSU Head Coach Beth Burns

The winningest coach in SDSU women's basketball history, Beth Burns returned to Montezuma Mesa on April 8, 2005. In her first stint as head coach from 1989-97, Burns took the SDSU women's basketball program full circle, going from 7-23 her first year to 23-7 in her final campaign. During her eight seasons, she compiled a 151-83 record and a 64.5 winning percentage, the best in school history. The Aztecs went to the NCAA tournament on four occasions (1993, 1994, 1995, 1997), won a pair of tournament championships and three regular-season titles.

A three-time WAC coach of the year, Burns was the head coach at Ohio State for five seasons (1997-02) and has an overall record of 235-155 (.603). Her current SDSU record stands at 154-90 (.631).
