TRITON UPDATES

FIRST THINGS FIRST

The UC San Diego men's basketball team kicks off the regular season this weekend when it travels cross-town to face San Diego State in the first of four road games to open the 2008-09 campaign. The defending California Collegiate Athletic Association Tournament Champions will take on the Aztecs, who finished 20-13 overall a year ago, for the third consecutive season. Following Saturday's 1:00 p.m. clash with SDSU, UCSD will head north to square off with another Division I foe in Pacific on Wednesday, November 19.

TEST 'EM EARLY

Head coach Chris Carlson and the Tritons will have their work cut out for them right out of the gates this season, taking on a pair of Division I squads in their first two games of the year. UCSD faced three D-I squads in 2007-08, defeating UC Riverside 67-61 in an exhibition contest at their place on November 2. The Tritons lost an 81-63 decision to Drake University in Moraga, Calif. and fell to SDSU 76-60 at Cox Arena.

2007-08 AT A GLANCE

After losing its first two games of the 2007-08 season, UC San Diego ran off six straight victories before falling at Humboldt State, 80-69 on January 5. From there, the Tritons won nine of their next 12 in CCAA play, including six in a row from January 29 through February 15. The streak was snapped with a 61-46 home defeat to Cal State Dominguez Hills the next night, and UCSD went on to lose its next four on the road to limp into the CCAA Tournament at 15-11 overall and 11-9 in league play. The Tritons turned things around with a 63-59 overtime victory over 13th-ranked Cal State San Bernardino to advance to the CCAA Semifinals, where they knocked off San Francisco State, 72-65. UCSD met Cal Poly Pomona in the tournament final and outlasted the Broncos, 64-56 to claim the CCAA Tournament Championship and earn the league's automatic berth in the NCAA Tournament. The Tritons drew a No. 8 seed in the NCAA D-II Championships and traveled to Alaska to face top-seeded Alaska Anchorage, where they fell 80-60 to a quality Seawolves squad.

ENCORE!

In his first season on the sidelines, head coach Chris Carlson guided UC San Diego to new heights in 2007-08. Last season was UCSD's most successful campaign at the Division II level as the Tritons not only won their first CCAA Tournament title, but went on to make the program's first appearance in the D-II National Championships. The squad's overall record of 18-12 was UCSD's best mark since the 1998-99 campaign, the program's second-to-last season in the Division III ranks.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

The Tritons will benefit from a roster highlighted by seven seniors in 2008-09. Leading the charge will be guard Kelvin Kim, who had a breakout year last season averaging 9.4 points, 2.9 assists, and 1.1 steals per game. He also led the team with 56 threes. Forward Darryl Lawlor returns after posting averages of 6.4 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 1.3 assists in 29 games as a junior last season. Also coming back is forward Shane Poppen, who shot 51% from the floor and hauled in 4.4 boards per night, while guard Alan Husted is primed for a successful follow-up to his junior campaign in which he set the school record for free throw percentage, shooting at a 96% clip. Center A.J. Maulhardt returns after leading the team in field goal percentage at 62% a year ago, while Patrick Dreith begins his second season with the Tritons after transferring from the City College of San Francisco in 2007. Finally, Brett Stuckey returns after a redshirt season in 2007-08.

LAWLEY LEADS JUNIOR CHARGE

Highlighting the three juniors on UCSD's roster in 2008-09 is guard Jordan Lawley, the Tritons' top returning scorer. Lawley started 29 games for UCSD a year ago, posting averages of 11.4 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 1.4 assists per game. He scored 10 or more points 18 times during the season, including five of the team's last seven games, and averaged a team-high 8.3 field goal attempts per night. Andrew Browning returns after appearing in 28 games at the forward spot, while guard Tyler Acevedo is back for his third season after making seven appearances as a sophomore.

HEAD COACH CHRIS CARLSON

Chris Carlson enters his second year as the head coach at UC San Diego, having guided the Tritons to the program's most successful season at the Division II level in 2007-08.

Carlson was named the 11th head coach in program history in June of 2007 and made an immediate impact on the La Jolla campus, leading UCSD to an overall record of 18-12 last season -- the school's best mark since the 1998-1999 campaign. After finishing sixth in the ultra-competitive California Collegiate Athletic Association standings at 11-9, Carlson's Tritons caught fire in March, defeating Cal State San Bernardino, San Francisco State, and Cal Poly Pomona on the way to UCSD's first CCAA Tournament title. UCSD earned a No. 8 seed in its first NCAA Tournament appearance at the DII level, falling to the University of Alaska-Anchorage, 80-60.

In addition to multiple program firsts, Carlson's memorable inaugural season featured several upsets, including a victory over Division I foe UC Riverside and a pair of wins over nationally-ranked CSUSB. A new RIMAC Arena attendance record was set when 3,906 strong came out to watch UCSD take on SFSU on Spirit Night in late January. Lastly, two Tritons were recognized with All-CCAA honors in 2007-08 and five were named to the CCAA All-Academic Team.

Carlson joined the Triton family after spending the previous four seasons as the Director of Basketball Operations at UCLA under head coach Ben Howland. As the DOB, he was responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program and served as a liaison to the athletic administration and other school officials. Carlson also assisted in scheduling and recruiting and helped guide the Bruin program to back-to-back NCAA Final Four appearances in 2005-06 and 2006-07.

Before assuming his duties at UCLA, Carlson served in the same capacity for two years at the University of Pittsburgh, joining the Panther staff in the summer of 2001. Prior to that, he was a member of Howland's staff at Northern Arizona in 1998-99 where he coached a Lumberjack squad that led the country in both field goal percentage and three-point percentage for the first time in NCAA history. He remained on at NAU for two years after Howland's departure (1999-2001), where he worked with NAU's post players and oversaw recruiting and scheduling.

Prior to his stint at Northern Arizona, Carlson served as an assistant coach at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara, from 1994-98, where he oversaw development of the team's perimeter players. He also served as an assistant coach at nearby Dos Pueblos High School in Goleta, Calif. from 1991-93.

Carlson worked as a game management assistant at the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-Star game for 12 straight years from 1993-2004 and has worked four NCAA Tournament West Regionals. In addition, he was an intern in the Los Angeles/St. Louis Rams media relations department, a sports information assistant at UCSB in 1993-94, and a member of the 1994 FIFA World Cup media relations staff.

A San Diego native, Carlson is a 1993 graduate from UCSB, where he received his bachelors in History. Prior to his days as a Gaucho, Carlson attended Helix High School in La Mesa, Calif., where he earned All-League honors in basketball. He and his wife Karen, have two sons, Nicklas (6) and Charlie (3).

NEWS AND NOTES

SCOUTING THE AZTECS

San Diego State returns eight letterwinners and all five starters from last year's squad that went 20-13 overall and finished fourth in the Mountain West Conference at 9-7. The Aztecs advanced to the NIT but lost a 73-49 decision to two-time defending NCAA Champion Florida. Among the returnees are senior forward Lorenzo Wade, who led the team in scoring last season at 14.8 points per game, and Ryan Amoroso, who finished the year averaging 11.4 points and a team-high 6.5 rebounds per night. Saturday's contest will mark the 10th meeting between UCSD and SDSU, with the Aztecs winning the previous nine contests. Billy White led all scorers with 20 points as San Diego State recorded a 76-60 victory in last year's meeting. Henry Patterson scored 16 points and hauled in nine rebounds to lead the Tritons. The Aztecs have won 20 games each of the last three seasons.

YOUTH IS SERVED

For UCSD to be successful, head coach Chris Carlson will need to rely on his young players throughout the season. The Tritons' roster features eight underclassmen in 2008-09, including seven freshmen. While sophomore Casey Ryan and redshirt freshman Bryce Alviri have been with the program a year, UCSD welcomes six new faces this season, with many of them expected to get the opportunity to contribute right away.

KEY LOSSES

UCSD lost several key players from its CCAA Championship squad in 2007-08 and will look for other key guys to step up and fill the void. The Tritons will be without three of the team's top five scorers from a year ago, losing Henry Patterson, Clint Allard, and Andrew Hatch to graduation. An All-CCAA Second Team selection, Patterson was UCSD's leading scorer and rebounder in 2007-08, averaging 12.5 points and 4.8 boards, while Allard led the team dishing out 4.6 assists and ranked third in scoring at 9.8 points per night. Hatch (no relation to freshman center Christian) was fifth on the team in scoring at 6.6 ppg.

TURN THE CORNER

If the Tritons can knock off the Aztecs on Saturday, it will be the program's first victory in a season-opener in seven years. UCSD has gone 0-6 in its last six openers, with its last victory coming in 2001-02 when the Tritons defeated the University of Redlands 92-91. It would also be their first victory over SDSU.

ALLARD NAMED ASSISTANT COACH

Clint Allard, UCSD's all-time leading scorer at the Division II level, will stay on as an assistant coach in 2008-09. A four-year starter, Allard posted career averages of 10.3 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.7 assists, and 1.2 steals in 112 games with the Tritons. He was named to the All-CCAA Second Team as a senior last season after averaging career-bests in rebounds (3.9), assists (4.6), and steals (1.2) to go with 9.8 points per game.

TRITONS PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH IN CCAA COACHES POLL

For the second year in a row, UCSD was selected to finish seventh in the CCAA standings in the league's annual coaches poll. Cal State San Bernardino was picked to capture the 2008-09 CCAA regular season title after receiving eight first place votes and 99 total points. Cal State Dominguez Hills collected 77 points to finish second, one point ahead of Cal Poly Pomona, which earned one first place nod and 76 points. Humboldt State was picked fourth with 70 points, while Cal State L.A. collected one first place vote and 62 points to finish fifth. The Tritons received 52 points, just one behind sixth place San Francisco State. Following UCSD was Chico State, Sonoma State, Cal State Monterey Bay, and Cal State Stanislaus, respectively.
