WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEK IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- > Following Tuesday's 5-4 win over UCLA, San Diego State will resume Mountain West action when it hosts a three-game series vs. Nevada this weekend.
- > The opening game of that set is scheduled for Friday, April 7, at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > The Aztecs and Wolf Pack will also meet up for games on Saturday (April 8) and Sunday (April 9) at 2:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. PT respectively.

AZTECS ON THE AIR

- > All three games of the Nevada series will have live video streaming on The Mountain Digital Network and may also be heard on ESPN 1700 AM in San Diego.
- > In addition, live stats will also be available for all three contests this weekend. Links for the broadcasts as well as live stats will be on the SDSU web site (GoAztecs.com).
- > A total of 14 of SDSU's 31 home games this season will have live video streaming on the Mountain Digital Network.
- > In addition, nine contests will be broadcast live on ESPN 1700 in San Diego with the remaining 13 carried live on KCR.

SERIES RECORD

- > The Aztecs have a record of 15-24 against Nevada in a series that began in 1986.
- > SDSU captured two of three games against the Wolf Pack in early March in Reno, Nev. The Wolf Pack has won 15 of the last 19 games vs. San Diego State.
- > Last season SDSU went 0-8 against the Wolf Pack, a mark that includes six regular-season losses along with two at the Mountain West Tournament.
- > SDSU has a mark of 6-10 vs. Nevada in San Diego, 5-11 in Reno and 4-3 at neutral sites.

SCOUTING THE WOLF PACK

- > Nevada comes into the weekend with a record of 8-22 overall and 4-8 in Mountain West play. The Wolf Pack dropped a 6-1 decision to St. Mary's Wednesday in Reno.
- > Nevada is led offensively by third baseman Jordan Pearce (.343, 3 HR, 15 RBI), second baseman Keaton Smith (.314, 4 HR, 17 RBI) and left fielder Grant Fennell (.312, 6 2B, 11 RBI).
- > The Wolf Pack has a team batting average of .270 along with a 5.68 earned run average.

TREJO STREAK ENDS

- > Second baseman Alan Trejo had his 18-game hitting streak end in Sunday's (April 2) game vs. San Jose State.
- > During that streak he hit .311 (28-for-90) with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and 19 runs scored.
- > He hit safely in each of the next two games, going 3-for-8 with a double, two RBI and a run scored.
- > His double in the sixth inning vs. UCLA on Tuesday drove home the tying and winning runs in the Aztecs' 5-4 victory over the Bruins.
- > Trejo leads the team in runs scored (28), doubles (10) and stolen bases (7).
- > He has also made eight appearances on the mound this season and is 0-1 with one save and a 1.80 ERA.
- > He tossed a perfect eight innings in the victory over UCLA on Tuesday.
- > Trejo recorded his first career save on April 2 vs. San Jose State when he tossed the final two innings in the win over San Jose State.

BROWN STAYS CONSISTENT

- > Third baseman Andrew Brown continues to be one of the Aztecs' most consistent offensive players.
- > Over the past 13 games he is hitting .393 (22-for-56) with a double, triple, 12 RBI and 10 runs scored.
- > He is on an eight-game hitting streak, one game longer than the streak he had earlier in the season. During this streak he is 13-for-34 (.382) with a double, triple, nine RBI and four runs scored.
- > His seven-game hitting streak ended in the series finale vs. Cal Poly on March 5.
- > During that streak he batted .355 (11-for-31) with two doubles, a home run, six RBI and five runs scored.
- > Brown leads the squad with 47 hits. He is second on the team in RBI with 25 and third in doubles with seven.

ADKISON MAKES HIS MARK

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison has been named a second team Perfect Game/Rawlings Midseason All-American.
- > He was one of the hottest hitters in the nation over a 10-game span from March 11-26.
- > In those 10 contests, he batted .649 (24-for-37) with four doubles, a triple, six home runs, 23 RBI and 16 runs scored.
- > His slugging percentage over that span is 1.297 and he had a .723 on-base mark in those games.
- > Adkison set an SDSU record by reaching base 15 consecutive times (via either a hit or walk) from March 18 to March 25. In those four games, he had four singles, three doubles, a triple, 2 HR and five walks.
- > His 10 consecutive hits over that span was also a new SDSU record.
- > In the contest at Nevada on March 11, he hit two home runs. The last time an Aztec had two homers in a game prior to that was when Adkison hit a pair at Air Force on March 20, 2016.
- > Adkison has two four-hit games and two five-RBI contests this season. He is the lone Aztec with a four-hit game and one of two players (along with Dean Nevarez) to have five RBI in a game.

VERDON STREAK ENDS

- > First baseman Jordan Verdon has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of SDSU's last 17 contests.
- > He had a seven-game hitting streak end on March 21 in the game against Long Beach State. During that streak he hit .345 (10-for-29) with a home run, seven RBI and six runs scored.
- > Verdon had a personal season-best eight-game streak earlier in the year.
- > During that streak he went 13-for-37 (.351) with a double, two triples, five RBI and six runs scored.
- > He is tied for first on the team in multiple-RBI games with seven.
- > He hit his team-leading fourth triple of the season last Sunday (April 2) vs. San Jose State. He leads the Mountain West in that category.
- > He is the lone SDSU infielder without an error after 30 games (312 chances).

ERICKSON PROVIDES RELIEF

- > Junior left-hander Jacob Erickson has been impressive out of the bullpen this season.
- > In his last 15 appearances covering 22 innings, he has allowed one run on 17 hits with eight strikeouts.
- > In the process, he has lowered his earned run average to 1.35.
- > He picked up his fourth win of the year on Sunday (April 2) vs. San Jose State.
- > Three of his victories have come in relief with the other in a start at Long Beach State.
- > Erickson has been involved in three of the Aztecs' four shutout wins in 2017.

SHEEHAN HITS AWAY

- > After redshirting during the 2016 season, senior Danny Sheehan has returned for his final year and claimed the starting shortstop role he held in 2015.
- > He had a 13-game hitting streak end on Monday (April 3) vs. San Francisco. He singled in Tuesday's contest vs. UCLA and has now hit safely in 14 of the last 15 contests.
- > During his 13-game hitting streak, he went 18-for-46 (.391) with six doubles, nine RBI and 10 runs scored.
- > Sheehan has been hit by pitch 10 times this season to bring his career total to 23. That ranks ninth on the SDSU all-time top 20 in that category.

NEVAREZ GOES DEEP

- > Catcher Dean Nevarez is 10-or-28 (.357) over SDSU's last 10 games with a double, home run, two RBI sand two runs scored.
- > He saw a season best four-game hitting streak end in the series finale at Fresno State on March 26.
- > Over those four games he went 7-for-12 (.583) with two doubles, two a home run and four RBI.
- > Nevarez's first two home runs this season came in the series finale against UNLV in San Diego on March 19.
- > He is the second Aztec to homer twice in a game this season as Tyler Adkison accomplished the feat against Nevada in Reno on March 11.

CALABUIG HEATING UP

- > Outfielder Chase Calabuig is hitting .333 (13-for-39) over SDSU's last 12 contests with four doubles, two triples,a home run, eight RBI and nine runs scored.
- > He has a .615 slugging percentage over those 12 games.
- > In the first 14 contests of the season, he had totaled seven hits and posted a .171 batting average, which he has raised by over 90 points (.263) in the last 15 contests.

SAYLOR STANDS TALL ON THE MOUND

- > Senior right-hander CJ Saylor has recorded eight saves along with a win this season as the Aztecs' closer.
- > His latest save came on Tuesday when he pitched the final inning, striking out the side, in the 5-4 win over UCLA.
- > He had recorded a save the previous day (April 3) when he tossed a perfect ninth inning in SDSU's 4-2 win vs. San Francisco.
- > After surrendering his second and third earned runs of the year in the finale at Fresno State on Sunday (March 26), he bounced back in his last three appearances, tossing 3.1 total innings and allowing just a walk while striking out six.
- > Saylor's ERA now stands at 1.56 and opponents are hitting .197 against him.

PURPURA IMPRESSIVE

- > Senior left-hander Dominic Purpura recorded his fifth win of the year against no defeats in the 7-3 win over San Jose State on Saturday, April 1.
- > In that contest turned in SDSU's first complete game of the year as he allowed three runs (one earned) on nine hits with a walk and two strikeouts.
- > Purpura has made seven starts, and in both of his no-decisions in 2017, the Aztecs rallied to win the game.
- > His six strikeouts in his first appearance of the year vs. Pacific on Feb. 19 tied his SDSU career high.

BIBLE RETURNS

- > Last week, sophomore outfielder Chad Bible made just his second appearance since beginning chemotherapy treatment for Hodgkin's lymphoma that was diagnosed in January.
- > As a pinch hitter in the bottom of the eighth in the contest vs. Long Beach State March 21, he doubled down the right field line to drive home SDSU's final run in the victory over LBSU.
- > Bible started in left field in each of SDSU's first five contests this season, going 6-for-20 with a double and an RBI.
- > He also made a pinch-hitting appearance on March 7 vs. USC and is now batting .318 in the seven games he has played.

PITCHING DOMINATES

- > Over the past 11 games, the SDSU pitching staff has posted a 9-2 record with a 2.77 earned run average.
- > Opponents have hit .256 over those 11 contests.
- > Included in that run are a shutout victory and three one-run wins.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK I

- > Junior outfielder Tyler Adkison was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in SDSU's four games during the week of March 14-20.
- > In the contest at USD (March 14) and three-games vs. UNLV (March 17-19), he batted .688 (11-for-16) with three doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.438 slugging percentage and a .737 on-base average in the four games.
- > His homers came in three different contests and he struck out only once in 19 plate appearances.
- > Adkison was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the Week by CollegeSportsMadness.com.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK II

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison made it back-to-back Mountain West Player of the Week awards when he earned the honor for games played March 20-26.
- > Over last week's four games, Adkison (Culver City, Calif., Mater Dei HS) hit .538 with a triple, home run, seven walks and seven RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.048 slugging percentage and a .700 on-base mark.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- > Senior lefty Brett Seeburger earned his first conference Pitcher of the Week award for his performance in the second game of Saturday's (March 25) doubleheader at Fresno State.
- > In that contest, he tossed a one hit shutout over eight innings, allowing just an infield single and facing one batter over the minimum.
- > Seeburger retired the first 14 batters he faced before allowing a two-out infield single in the bottom of the fifth inning. He went on to retire the next 10 batters through the eighth inning.
- > Over his eight innings of work, he struck out a season-high seven batters and did not allow a walk.
- > For his effort Seeburger was also selected a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball* and the Madness Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

AZTECS AMONG THE NATIONAL LEADERS

STREAKS

- > Andrew Brown has the current longest hitting streak for the Aztecs at eight games. Dean Nevarez has a three-game streak in progress.
- > Jordan Verdon has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in the past 17 games with Brown at eight in a row.
- > Andrew Brown has recorded a team-leading 16 multiple-hit contests with Alan Trejo second at 10.
- > Tyler Adkison and Verdon lead the team with seven multiple-RBI games.

AZTEC NOTES

- > After opening the season with a 3-4 record, San Diego State is 18-5 in its last 23 contests.
- > SDSU enters the series vs. Nevada on its third five-game win streak of the season, it's longest of 2017.
- > Over the last 14 contests, the Aztecs are hitting .323 to .254 by opponent. They also have a team ERA of 2.97 while opponents' ERA is 6.48.
- > The Aztecs are 17-0 when leading after six innings, 19-1 when leading after seven and 21-0 when leading after eight.
- > SDSU has committed 23 errors in its first 30 contests for a .980 fielding percentage. The team record for fielding percentage in a season is .978 set during the 2013 campaign.
- > Logan Boyer has allowed no runs on just two hits with 11 strikeouts over his last eight relief appearances (10.1 innings). He tossed a perfect sixth innings picked up his first win in the victory against UCLA on Tuesday (April 4).
- > Junior Jorge Fernandez has made two starts and five relief appearances this season and has yet to allow a run.
- > Tyler Adkison is hitting .481 (13-for-27) with runners in scoring position while Andrew Brown's average in that situation is .459 (17-for-37).
- > Junior David Hensley's 16 career sacrifice bunts tie him for 20th on the SDSU career top 20 in that category.
- > Sophomore Jordan Verdon's 11 career sacrifice flies tie him for 12th on the SDSU career top 20 list.
- > Brett Seeburger's 2.60 earned run average leads the conference this week.
- > Julian Escobedo has reached safely in each of his last three plate appearances over two games. He was 1-for-1 and scored a run vs. San Francisco on Monday (April 3), then had a hit and walk with two runs scored against UCLA on Tuesday (April 4).
