### No. 17/21 Aztec Softball Travels to Tempe for Arizona State Tourney

The No. 17/21 San Diego State softball team looks to continue its best start in school history when it travels to Tempe, Ariz., this weekend for the Arizona State Tourney.

The Aztecs (17-5), who defeated Loyola-Chicago, 12-1, in five innings on Wednesday night, will play five games over the weekend, including two against Pacific and one against the host Sun Devils, who are ranked No. 1 in both the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and the USA Today/NFCA poll.

SDSU will play the Tigers (11 a.m.) and the Univ. of San Diego (1 p.m.) on Friday, UC Davis (9 a.m.) and Arizona State (3:30 p.m.) on Saturday, before meeting Pacific once again at 11 a.m. Sunday.

### Aztec Quick Hits

\* After a 5-1 weekend, SDSU is now ranked No. 17 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, up from No. 20 the previous week, and No. 21 in the USA Today/NFCA poll. Both are the highest rankings in the program's 32-year history. **See SDSU Movin' On Up, page 3.**

\* SDSU is off to an 17-5 start to begin the 2008 campaign, its start to a season in school history. The last time the Aztecs had 15 wins 22 games into the season was 2006, when they finished 34-15 with their best record in school history. **Bats Come Alive in No. 17/21 SDSU Softball's 12-1 Win Over Loyola-Chicago on Wednesday**

The No. 17/21 San Diego State softball team's bats came alive in a 12-1, five-inning victory over Loyola-Chicago Wednesday night at SDSU Softball Stadium. The 12 runs were a season high for the Aztecs (17-5), who continued their best start in school history, while the 11 hits tied their season-best offensive output.

After a scoreless first two innings, SDSU exploded for seven runs in the third and five more in the fourth.

Four Aztecs - sophomore Brittany Knudsen (San Diego, Calif./Escondido HS) (2-for-3, two runs), junior Tonye McCorkle (Santa Ana Heights, Calif.) (2-for-2, two runs, two RBI), junior Erin Floros (2-for-2, run, RBI) and junior Christine Kulick (2-for-2, run, two RBI) - had two hits apiece to lead the offense.

Sophomore Lindsey Marquez (Tustin, Calif.) tied her career high with three RBI, while redshirt junior Dani Sidoti (Tucson, Ariz.) scored twice and freshman Jessica Camello (Temecula, Calif.) hit a pinch-hit two-run double in the fourth.

Freshman Brooke Petty (4-0) pitched five effective innings for the Aztecs, allowing just one unearned run on three hits. She struck out two and walked three en route to picking up her fourth straight victory to start her collegiate career.

**Last Week With the Aztecs**

SDSU went 5-1 last week, including a 4-1 mark in the San Diego Classic I. Four of its five wins - vs. Eastern Michigan (3-0 and 4-3), Harvard (10-1 (5)) and Oregon (3-2) - came against 2007 NCAA tournament teams with the other coming against Saint Peter's (11-0 in six innings). The Aztecs' only loss came against No. 4/7 UCLA, a 2-1 defeat in nine innings.

Brittany Knudsen led the squad for the second straight week with a .500 average (8-for-16), .619 on-base percentage and seven runs. Erin Floros went 6-for-17 with 10 RBI and had two game-winning hits and a game-winning run. Christina Ross went 3-1 in the circle with a 0.89 ERA in 23 2/3 innings. She had 16 strikeouts against two walks. Brooke Petty also picked up a win and a save in nine innings of work.

**Movin' On Up...**

After winning five of its six games last weekend, including four against 2007 NCAA tournament teams, with the only loss coming to No. 4/7 UCLA by a 2-1 score in nine innings, the San Diego State softball team continues to move up the national polls.

SDSU is now ranked No. 17 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, up from No. 20 the previous week, and No. 21 in the USA Today/NFCA poll. Both are the highest rankings in the program's 32-year history. It is also the second straight week that the team has been ranked in both polls at the same time, a feat which has never happened in school history before last week.

In the ESPN.com poll, SDSU has 160 points, 54 points more than it had a week ago, and is just 12 points behind 16th-ranked Georgia. The Aztecs are also ahead of No. 18 Mississippi State (156 pts.), No. 19 DePaul (148 pts.), No. 21 Fresno State (112 pts.) and No. 24 Washington (35 pts.), all teams the Aztecs have played or will play this season.

As it stands right now, San Diego State has played or will play three of the top five teams, six of the top 10 squads and 13 of the top 25 schools.

In the USA Today/NFCA poll, the Aztecs stayed at No. 21 in the nation with 138 points, 28 more than it had a week ago. SDSU is ahead of No. 22 Washington (98 pts.), No. 23 Fresno State (80 pts.), No. 24 Virginia Tech (69 pts.) and No. 25 Maryland (55 pts.).

**Aztecs Off To Best Start in School History**

SDSU is off to a 17-5 start its best record after 22 games in school history.

San Diego State has had two other teams - 2005 and 2006 - start 15-7, while the 1997 Aztecs began the season with a 14-8 record. Only the 2006 squad, however, would go on to post a winning record. In fact, the 2006 team finished 34-15, its best record in school history.

What might be even more impressive about this year's team is that 10 of the Aztecs' 17 wins have come against 2007 NCAA tournament teams, including two against last year's WCWC schools. SDSU has also posted eight shutout victories in 2008.

**Aztecs Sweep Mountain West Conference Weekly Awards...Again**

San Diego State's Erin Floros (San Diego, Calif./Mt. Carmel HS) and Christina Ross (Santa Clarita, Calif./Univ. of Kansas) have been named the Mountain West Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, Commissioner Craig Thompson announced Tuesday. It is the second career award for Floros and the sixth career and third straight honor for Ross.

It is the second consecutive week the Aztecs swept the league's weekly awards after sophomore Brittany Knudsen (San Diego, Calif./Escondido HS) and Ross won the respective awards last Tuesday.

The weekly accolades come after SDSU went 5-1 last week with its only loss to No. 4/7 UCLA, 2-1, in nine innings. San Diego State also picked up wins against Saint Peter's (11-0, 6 innings), a pair versus 2007 NCAA tournament team Eastern Michigan (3-0 and 4-3), and victories against 2007 tourney squads Harvard (10-1, 5 innings) and Oregon (3-2).

A junior, Floros batted .353 with a team-high 10 RBI over the weekend. She started all six games and recorded a .450 on-base percentage. Floros recorded the game-winning singles in back-to-back games against Eastern Michigan (Saturday) and Oregon (Sunday), and scored the game-winning run versus Harvard on Friday.

A freshman All-American in 2006, Floros went 2-for-3 with a homer and two RBI in SDSU's 3-0 win over Eastern Michigan on Thursday. She followed that up with a two RBI performance against Saint Peter's College and one against Harvard on Friday. On Saturday, Floros was 2-for-3 and drove in three of the Aztecs' four runs in their 4-3 come-from-behind win over Eastern Michigan. She ended the weekend with a two-run single in the third in what proved to be the game-winner against Oregon on Sunday.

She excelled in the field as well, posting a perfect fielding percentage in a team-high 33 chances despite logging starts at both first base and catcher, after beginning the year as the starting third baseman.

Floros, the 2006 MWC Freshman of the Year, is batting .302 this season and leads the team with two home runs and 20 RBI in 21 games. With at least 30 games still to go, Floros is well on pace to break Kelcy Murphy's school-record 41 RBI during the 2002 season.

Ross, who was named the league's Pitcher of the Week the previous two weeks as well, posted a 3-1 record with a 0.89 ERA over the weekend despite battling the flu. She allowed 17 hits over 23 2/3 innings for a .205 opponent's batting average. Ross also had 16 strikeouts against two walks for an impressive 8-to-1 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Ross tossed six scoreless innings in SDSU's 3-0 win over Eastern Michigan on Thursday, while striking out five without a walk with just four hits. On Saturday, Ross held No. 4/7 UCLA to just five hits and one walk in nine innings of work. She struck out six and limited the Bruins to a .167 team batting average with just one extra-base hit. This stat is remarkable considering UCLA came into the game with a .362 average with 14 home runs and 126 runs in 19 games. In the nightcap on Saturday, Ross pitched 1 2/3 innings of perfect relief to pick up

the win in SDSU's come-from-behind 4-3 win over Eastern Michigan. Ross picked up her third win of the weekend on Sunday against Oregon, when she scattered two runs on eight hits and a walk in the 3-2 triumph. She added five strikeouts.

On the season, Ross ranks first in the league in ERA (0.64) and wins (10), and second in innings pitched (87.2) and appearances (16). She also has 78 strikeouts against 13 walks for a 6-to-1 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

**To Be the Best, You've Got to Beat the Best**

As professional wrestler Ric Flair says, "To be the best, you've got to beat the best." The Aztecs are certainly making their case of being the best.

Just 22 games into the season, SDSU is 17-5, including a 10-5 record against 2007 NCAA tournament teams and 2-1 mark against 2007 Women's College World Series squads. San Diego State has already beaten Cal Poly (3-0), California (7-0), UC Santa Barbara (4-1), Fresno State (3-2), Arizona (2-1), Northwestern (3-2), Eastern Michigan (3-0 and 4-3), Harvard (10-1 (5)) and Oregon (3-2).

It doesn't get any easier for the Aztecs, however, as on the season they are scheduled to play 22 teams who made last year's tournament, including seven of the eight WCWS teams.

As far as RPI goes, San Diego State will play seven of the top 10 RPI teams from last season, 12 of the top 25 and 23 of the top 50.

**Aztec Pitchers Back to Their Same Old Tricks**

One of the question marks going into the season was the stability of the SDSU pitching staff, with a proven player in two-time all-Mountain West Conference performer Christina Ross, and two unproven freshmen in Brooke Petty and Samantha Beasley. 15 games into the season, however, it looks like the pitching staff will no longer be a concern.

During the first weekend at the Cathedral City Classic, the trio of Ross, Petty and Beasley went a combined 4-1 with a 0.59 ERA over 35 2/3 innings. The staff struck out 27 against seven walks, while limiting their opponents to a .180 batting average, en route to three shutouts.

Three weekends ago at the Campbell/Cartier Classic, the staff went 5-0, including three shutouts, with a 0.40 team ERA over 35 innings. SDSU had 26 strikeouts against four walks, while limiting their opponents to bat .179.

Facing some of the toughest teams in the nation two weeks ago at the Palm Springs Classic, the staff didn't back down and was just as effective. Collectively, Ross, Petty and Beasley went 2-3 with a 1.53 ERA in 32 innings. The trio finished with 38 strikeouts and seven walks.

Last weekend at the San Diego Classic I, which featured four opponents and five games of teams who made the 2007 NCAA tournament, the staff went 5-1 with a 1.20 team ERA over 41 innings. The squad also struck out 34 and issued just six walks, while limiting its opponents to a .205 batting average.

The Aztecs are by far the best pitching team in the Mountain West Conference through four weekends of play. SDSU is first in ERA (0.93), wins (16), fewest walks allowed (24), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.21) and WHIP (walks + hits/innings pitched) (0.92). In addition, SDSU is second in innings pitched (143.2), strikeouts (125) and win percentage (.762).

Individually, as of March 3, Ross is first ERA (0.64) and wins (10), and is second in innings pitched (87.2) and appearances (16), and third in strikeouts (78), games started (11) and assists (T-3rd, 36). Petty is second in ERA (1.04) and tied for second in saves (1).

**Like a Rock**

Although the Aztecs have started 21 different batting lineups and 21 different fielding lineups through its 22 games, one thing has remained constant: the outfield. Head coach Van Wyk said in the beginning of the season that this is the best outfield she has ever had at San Diego State and the combination of senior Tamani Wells, junior Tonye McCorkle and sophomore Brittany Knudsen hasn't disappointed.

In 22 games, The trio has combined to bat .348 with 46 runs scored, 10 doubles, 34 RBI, 26 walks and 16 stolen bases. They have also combined for a .433 slugging percentage and a .424 on-base percentage.

They have been just as brilliant the field running down ball after ball. They have combined to post a .983 fielding percentage with just one error. In addition, each has at least one outfield assist.

No other Aztec has earned a start in the outfield and only junior Erin Floros has also started in all 22 contests. In fact, Wells has now started 102 consecutive games dating back to the 2006 season, the longest such streak on the team.

This season, Knudsen has started all 22 contests in right field, while McCorkle and Wells each have eight starts in center and eight in left.

At the plate, Wells has batted from the No. 2 hole in all 22 of her starts, while McCorkle has seen 13 of her starts as the leadoff, eight in the three spot and one in the five spot. Knudsen has nine starts in the No. 3 spot, nine at leadoff, and two each at No. 5 and No. 6.

**Put Me in Coach**

With the Aztecs hitting their stride 22 games into the season, head coach Kathy Van Wyk is faced with a major problem, how to find enough playing time for all the veterans and the contributing newcomers.

Junior transfer Tony McCorkle and a plethora of incoming freshmen have already left their stamp on the Aztec team, helping the squad to 17-5 record out of the gate, their best start in school history.

McCorkle, a 2006 Co-Big East Freshman of the Year and all-conference performer at Syracuse, leads the 2008 Aztecs in at-bats (72), runs (18), hits (25) and doubles (4), despite playing 13 of her 22 games at the leadoff spot. She is also second in batting average (.347), RBI (18), slugging percentage (.431) and on-base percentage (.420). McCorkle is also one of four Aztecs, along with Tamani Wells, Erin Floros and Brittany Knudsen, to earn the starting nod in every game this season.

Freshman Jen Wisneski has already shored up the infield at shortstop by exhibiting great range and a strong arm, and has improved at the plate. Through 22 games, Wisneski fifth on the team with eight runs and is tied for third with two sacrifice hits.

Samantha Beasley has appeared in 13 games with 10 starts and is hitting .333. Four of her eight hits have been doubles. In the circle, Beasley is 3-1 with a 1.56 ERA in 27 innings.

Brooke Petty is 4-0 with a 0.88 ERA in 32 innings, while Taylor Sutton (.421 OB%) and Jessica Camello (7 R, 3 RBI) each are 5-for-16 (.313).

## She's Baaaaack...

After missing most of the 2007 campaign with a torn ACL, junior Erin Floros has wasted little time in putting every other team on notice that she is back.

Through 22 games, Floros, a 2006 All-American, is batting .323 (fourth on the team) with a team-high 22 RBI and two home runs. In addition, she is second in slugging percentage (.431), and third in hits (13) and at-bats (65).

Floros also has started all 22 games, joining the outfield crew of Tamani Wells, Tonye McCorkle and Knudsen has the only players to earn the starting nod in all 22 contests.

Floros has performed well in the field as well, despite playing a bit of third base and first base for the first time in her collegiate career. Floros, who has also seen time at catcher and the designated player spot has committed just two errors in 82 fielding chances for a .976 fielding percentage.

With enough at-bats to now qualify for SDSU's career top-10 list, Floros is second in batting average (.344), and third in slugging percentage (.484) and on-base percentage (.414). In addition, she is tied for eighth with seven career home runs.

## Aztec Softball Featured on ESPN.com

The No. 25 San Diego State softball team was featured in the "College Sports" section of ESPN.com on Feb. 25. The article, written by Graham Hays, talks about SDSU's surprising victories over two-time defending NCAA champion Arizona and No. 3/2 Northwestern, and playing arguably the toughest schedule among all the 24 teams at the Palm Springs Classic.

The Aztecs defeated both Wildcat teams by one run, first defeating Arizona, 2-1, behind a season-high 11 strikeout performance by senior Christina Ross and then knocking off Northwestern, 3-2, on junior Erin Floros' walkoff single in the bottom of the seventh.

San Diego State would eventually fall in its next three contests, 1-0 to No. 6/8 Oklahoma, 7-6 to No. 18/19 Georgia and 7-5 to No. 13/10 Baylor, but was in each game until the very end.

## SDSU Wins Campbell/Cartier For First Time in 18-year History

The Aztecs went 5-0 from Feb. 15-17 to capture their first-ever Campbell/Cartier Classic title in the 18-year history of the event. The 5-0 weekend was a huge improvement from the year before where SDSU went 1-4 to finish sixth of six teams. San Diego State will look to be the first team to repeat in 2009 since Stanford won the Classic in 2000 and 2001.

Long Beach State's four championships are the most followed by UCLA with three. Cal State Northridge, Sacramento State and Stanford each have won two, while the Aztecs, California, Pacific and Washington have one apiece.

## Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

With its 3-0, nine-inning victory over Cal Poly on Feb. 8, San Diego State has now won eight consecutive season-opening games and 11 of 12 under head coach Kathy Van Wyk's tenure. Van Wyk's only setback in a lid-lifter is Feb. 5, 2000 against Illinois-Chicago by a 5-3 score. Over the 12 years, Van Wyk teams have outscored its opponents, 70-22, or 5.83-1.57 per game. Since records were first kept in 1980, SDSU is 20-9 (.690) in its opening games.

## SDSU Softball Picked Second in Preseason Mountain West Conference Poll

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to finish second in the 2008 Mountain West Conference in the preseason poll voted on by the league's coaches.

SDSU collected 19 points, including one first-place vote, to finish second behind Brigham Young's 25 points.

The Cougars, who had the other five first-place votes, were followed by the Aztecs, UNLV (15), Colorado State and New Mexico, which tied for fourth with 13 points, and Utah (5).

San Diego State, which only lost two starters from a year ago, returns nine players who started at least 25 games in 2007, including all-MWC performers senior Christina Ross (Santa Clarita, Calif./Univ. of Kansas), and sophomores Brittany Knudsen (San Diego/Escondido HS) and Lindsey Marquez (Tustin, Calif./Lutheran HS). Junior Erin Floros (San Diego/Mt. Carmel HS), a 2006 All-American, also returns for SDSU after missing most of 2007 with a knee injury.

## A Look at Pacific

Pacific is off to a 9-11 start after making the NCAA tournament a season ago. The Tigers are led offensively by Kellee Wilson (.345, 5 HR, 21 RBI) and Chelsea Engle (7-4, 1.87 ERA). SDSU leads the all-time series, 15-13, and won the last meeting, 7-5, on Feb. 18, 2000.

## Previewing USD

USD has struggled out of the gate with a 6-13 record. Lindsey Fleet (.327) is the only Torero with at least a .300 average, while Jennifer Ellenbeck (2-8, 4.27 ERA) leads the pitchers. SDSU had dominated the overall series with a 43-1 record, including two wins in 2007.

## A Glance at UC Davis

The Aggies are off to a 12-11 start in 2008. Julie Stauder (.367) leads the offense, while Jessica Hancock (7-6, 2.41 ERA) paces the pitching staff. The Aztecs are 2-0 all-time against UC Davis, including an 8-2 win earlier this season.

## Scouting No. 1/1 Arizona State

SDSU may face its biggest test of the season Saturday when it takes on No. 1/1 Arizona State (22-1). Mindy Cowles (.471, 5 HR) is one of five Sun Devils a batting average over .400, while Katie Burkhart (11-1, 0.39 ERA) leads the pitchers. SDSU is 8-26 against ASU.
