SDSU leads the MWC in red zone offense, scoring in 16 of its 17 opportunities (91.7 percent)... The Aztecs have converted on each of its last 15 trips to the red zone (11 TDs, 4 FGs)... SDSU also ranks 14th and leads the league in third-down conversions (48.8 percent)... SDSU has now won back-to-back games by 21 or more points for the first time since 1999... SDSU recorded its second consecutive game with more than 500 yards of total offense versus BYU... The last time SDSU had more than 500 yards of total offense in back-to-back games was in 2002, when it had 574 yards versus ASU and 585 yards against Idaho... SDSU has 400-plus yards of total offense in four of five outings, including the first two... The last time SDSU had over 400 yards of total offense in the first two games of a season was in 1996... SDSU has eight scoring drives of 10 or more plays and seven of 80 or more yards... The 90-yard scoring drive vs. BYU is the team's longest since 2002 against Hawai'i (94 yards)... SDSU had four rushing touchdowns against BYU, its most in a game since also tallying four versus Wyoming on Nov. 17, 2001 (38-16 SDSU win)... The Aztecs' 52 points against SJSU are their most points in a game since 1996... The 31-point margin of victory against the Spartans (52-21) is the Aztecs' best since 2003... SDSU's 90 offensive plays vs. SJSU are tied for 11th-most in NCAA Div. I in 2005... SDSU has run 80-plus offensive plays in three of its five games... SDSU's 28 first downs vs. SJSU are the team's most since 2001... The Aztecs' 80-yard touchdown at Ohio State is their first completion of at least 80 yards since an 87-yard toss in 2002 at Hawai'i... the 80-yard pass play is tied for sixth-longest in the nation in 2005... The Aztec offensive line did not allow a sack against Air Force, the first time the team has turned the trick since 2003, at UNLV...
