AZTECS VISIT BEEHIVE STATE FOR PAIR OF MWC MATCHES THIS WEEKEND

- ◆ San Diego State goes back on the road this week for a pair of Mountain West Conference matches.
- ◆ On Thursday, Nov. 4, the Aztecs will be in Salt Lake City to face Utah in a match scheduled for a 7:00 p.m. (MT) start at the Utes' Crimson Court.
- ◆ Two nights later (Saturday, Nov. 6), SDSU will visit Provo, Utah, for a match against Brigham Young at 7:00 p.m. (MT) at Smith Fieldhouse.
- ◆ Saturday's contest at BYU will be televised live on BYU TV and will be streamed live on the Internet at BYUTV.org.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ Brigham Young holds a 40-17 advantage over SDSU in the series that began in 1977. The Cougars have won 14 of the last 16 over San Diego State with the Aztecs winning two of the last seven. SDSU's last win over the Cougars in Provo came during the 2002 season. San Diego State has a record of 6-18 at home, 4-18 away and 7-4 at neutral sites vs. BYU.
- ◆ San Diego State's all-time record against Utah stands at 20-22 since the teams first met in 1982. The Utes have won 13 of the last 17 matches although the Aztecs have won two of the last three including a match in San Diego earlier this season. SDSU's has lost 12 straight in Salt Lake City with its last win on the Utes' home court coming in 1995. San Diego State is 13-6 vs. Utah at home, 7-14 in Salt Lake City and 0-2 at neutral venues.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Utah enters Thursday night's match with a record of 11-12 (6-3 MWC) after dropping a four-set decision to North Dakota State on Monday. Utah is led by Karolin Bartowiak (2.83 kills, 2.32 digs, 0.82 blocks per set) and Morgan Odale (3.25 kills, 2.26 digs per set). Freshman Erin Redd leads the MWC in hitting with a .375 attack percentage.
- ◆ Brigham Young's record stands at 9-14 (4-5 MWC) coming into Thursday's match against the Aztecs. The Cougars have won six of their last eight matches including a three-set win over SDSU in early October. Offensive leaders for BYU include Stephanie Snow (2.51 kills, 0.73 blocks per set) and Jennifer Hamson (2.76 kills, 1.00 digs. 0.89 blocks per set). Nicole Warner is first in the MWC in blocking in league matches at 1.56 per set.

COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her second season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history last year.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her record at SDSU is 26-27 (.491) and her career mark stands at 188-218 (.463).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ Collins-Parker was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She was one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

NASH ON THE ATTACK

- Freshman Summer Nash had back-to-back matches last week in which she set career highs in kills.
- ◆ Against UC Riverside on Oct. 26, she recorded 13 kills while hitting .417.
- ◆ Two days later (Oct. 28) she set her current career-high with 15 kills in the win over Wyoming. She also hit .429 in that contest
- ◆ In three matches last week she averaged 3.45 kills and 3.69 points per set while hitting .321.
- Prior to the match vs. UCR she had a pair of 12-kill effort in contests at Air Force and UNLV, her career-high at the time.
- Nash has hit double figures in kills in each of the past five matches and is averaging 3.44 kills per set over that span.
- ◆ Her kill average of 3.12 per set in conference matches would rank ninth in the league stats, but she has not played the minimum number of sets required to qualify for listing.
- ◆ Her .429 attack percentage in the contest against Wyoming (Oct. 28) marks the 10th time this season that she has hit better than .300 in a match.

SHELTON SHINES

- Freshman Raegan Shelton, who had missed four matches due to injury, came off the bench in the second set against Wyoming last Thursday (Oct. 28) to notch 14 kills, four blocks, two service aces and a .414 attack percentage in the win over the Cowgirls.
- ◆ The four blocks represented her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ In the win over host Arizona State on Sept. 3, she recorded a career-high 20 kills while hitting .500 for the match.
- ◆ Shelton had her second-best kill total of the season with 16 in the win over Utah in the previous match (Oct. 9).

- ◆ She hit .417 in that match and also set a career best with eight digs.
- ◆ She is third on the team in kill average at 2.81 per set.

HANNASCH ON THE BLOCK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch continues to be among the top blockers in the Mountain West Conference.
- ◆ Her overall average of 1.25 blocks per set ranks fourth in the MWC this week.
- ♦ Her mark of 1.29 blocks per set in league matches ranks fifth.
- Hannasch is currently 34th in the nation in blocking. Those rankings include athletes from 319 Division I teams.
- ◆ Her .542 hitting percentage at UNLV on Oct. 23 was her second-highest of the season.
- ◆ In addition, she is averaging 2.53 kills, 1.28 digs and 3.37 points per set.

MANASCO HEATS UP

- Senior outside hitter Kelsey Manasco set a new career high with a .550 hitting percentage in the win over UC Riverside last Tuesday (Oct. 26).
- Her 12 kills in that contest represented a season high as did her four block assists and 15.0 points.
- Against Wyoming (Oct. 28) she again recoded four block assists and added a season-high four assists which also tied her Aztec career best.
- ◆ In three matches last week she average 2.27 kills per set, a figure that is almost double her season average.

PEARSON PROVIDES SPARK

- ◆ Junior outside hitter Paije set a career high with seven blocks assists and seven total blocks in the win over Wyoming last week (Oct. 28).
- She had tied her previous career best of five block assists two days earlier vs. UC Riverside.
- She has recorded six total blocks in a match twice this season. That came in back-to-back matches vs. Utah and Seattle.
- ◆ Prior to the match against 14th-ranked Colorado State last Saturday (Oct. 30), Pearson had a .419 hitting percentage over the previous five matches (30k-4e-62ta).
- Her 10 digs vs. Wyoming was the third time she reached double figures in that category this season.

FOUCH SETTING IT UP

- Freshman setter Johnna Fouch's 53 assists in the win over UC Riverside (Oct. 26) was her second-highest total of the season and just two shy of her career high.
- ◆ She continues to lead the MWC in assists with an average of 10.56 per set.
- She recorded her eighth and ninth double-doubles of the fall with 11 digs vs. UCR and a 43-assists 10-dig effort against Wyoming (Oct. 28)
- ◆ Her assist average also ranks 55th in the nation (NCAA Division I) this week.
- Her 53 assists vs. Riverside was the fifth time this season that she has had more than 50 in a match.
- ◆ In the match vs. UC Irvine in Honolulu on Sept. 11, she set career bests with five total blocks and 32 digs.

SEXTON LEADS THE OFFENSE

- Kyley Sexton hit double figure in kills for the 14th time this season with 13 in the win over UC Riverside last week.
- She leads the Aztecs in kill average at 3.06 per set and is also first in points (3.46 per set).
- Her hitting percentage of .417 at UNLV (Oct. 23) was her second-best mark of the season, just behind the .419 she recorded against Northern Colorado in the second match of the season.
- ◆ Sexton recorded her fifth double-double of the season with 16 kills and 13 blocks in the win over TCU on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She set a career-high with 25 kills in the match vs. UCSB on Sept. 18. Her 27 points in that match was also a career best.
- ◆ In the match against UC Irvine on Sept. 11, she set a career high with 21 digs.

SALISBURY'S SIDELINED

- Senior middle blocker Lauren Salisbury suffered a wrist injury on Sept. 28 and is expected to miss the remainder of the 2010 season.
- She is a two-time all-conference selection and was named to the 2010 preseason all-MWC squad as well.
- With a total of 33 block assists this season, Salisbury will likely finish her Aztec career with as she has moved into the top 10 on the SDSU career list.
- Salisbury's total ranks tenth all-time and is eight behind Angelica Jackson's (1984-87) ninth-highest total of 341.

JACKELS DIGGING IT

- ◆ Sophomore libero Kristi Jackels ranks sixth in the conference in digs this week with an average of 3.48 per set.
- ◆ She had a season-high 28 digs in the contest vs. UC Santa Barbara (Sept. 18).
- ◆ Jackels had back-to-back 18-dig efforts earlier this season against Utah State and Arizona State.
- ◆ She has been in double figures in digs in 19 of SDSU's 24 matches.
- ◆ Her four aces against Northern Colorado on Aug. 28 are the most by an Aztec this year.
- ◆ She has recorded at least one assist in each of the last five matches and 13 of the last 14.

PEACOCK AT HER BEST

- Outside hitter Jessica Peacock recorded a career high hitting percentage (.562) for the second match in a row in the contest vs.
 Seattle on Oct. 15.
- ◆ She had established career highs in with 17 kills and a .517 hitting percentage in the win over Utah on Oct. 9.
- ♦ Her 18.5 points in the match vs. Utah was her best total as an Aztec as well.
- ◆ Her previous career highs included 10 kills and 12.5 points vs. TCU on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She set her season high in blocks with six against UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 18.

OROPEZA ON DEFENSE

- Freshman defensive specialist Kyla Oropeza has seen action in 23 of SDSU's 24 matches this season and started on three occasions.
- ◆ She recorded an assist and four digs in the win over UC Riverside last week.
- Oropeza is averaging 1.29 digs per set and has appeared in 79 of the teams 89 sets this fall
- ◆ In the win over Utah (Oct. 9), she had her second-highest dig total of the season with nine and tied her season best with two assists
- ◆ She was the server in the fifth set vs. the Utes on Oct. 9 when SDSU came from behind (7-13) to score eight straight points and win the match.

AZTECS IN THE MWC STATS

- ◆ Johnna Fouch leads the league's setters at 10.56 assists per set.
- ◆ Andrea Hannasch is fourth in blocking (1.25 per set).
- ◆ Kyley Sexton is ninth in the conference in kill average (3.06 per set).
- ◆ Kristi Jackels is sixth in digs at 3.48 per set.
- ◆ Lauren Salisbury is seventh in hitting percentage (.293).

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- ◆ In the win over UC Irvine on Sept. 18, the Aztecs recorded 108 digs as a team, their highest total in a match in over 10 years.
- In that contest, setter Johnna Fouch led SDSU with 32 digs, the most in a match by an Aztec since Aime Cordeiro had 33 against BYU on Nov. 2, 2007.
- ◆ The 32 digs were the 10th-most ever in a match by an SDSU player.

ALL TOURNAMENT AZTECS

- Aztec junior outside hitters Kyley Sexton and Paije Pearson were named to the alltournament team at the Aztec Invitational (Aug. 27-28) with Sexton picking up tournament MVP honors.
- ♦ Sexton average 3.90 kills, 2.40 digs and 0.50 blocks over SDSU's three matches.
- Pearson hit .300 with averages of 3.78 kills,
 3.00 digs and 0.44 blocks.
- Outside hitter Raegan Shelton was named to the all-tournament team at the ASU Sheraton Classic in Tempe, Ariz., during the weekend of Sept. 3-4.
- Shelton averaged 3.40 kills and 3.79 points per set while hitting .389 over SDSU's three matches.
- Kyley Sexton was named to the alltournament team at the USD/SDSU Challenge (Sept. 17-18), her second alltourney honor of the 2010 season.
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 3.42 kills and 1.28 digs per set.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week for her effort in the matches against New Mexico and TCU (Sept. 23 and 25).
- ◆ In a three-set sweep of New Mexico at home, Hannasch led all players with 12 kills and a career-best .688 hitting percentage. In the 3-2 home win over TCU, Hannasch tied a career-high with 16 kills.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.50 kills, 1.62 blocks and 4.50 points per set, while hitting .535 (28-5-43) over eight sets. She also had two assists, one service ace and six digs in the two matches.
- Hannasch shared the MWC Player of the Week award with Colorado State middle blocker Megan Plourde.



PEARSON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week on Aug. 30 for her efforts during the season's opening weekend Aztec Invitational.
- ◆ She began tourney play with a 14-kill, six dig effort in the win over CSU Northridge. The 14 kills tied her SDSU career high at the time.
- ◆ In the Aztecs' sweep of Northern Colorado, she collected six kills, three digs and one block, then followed with career highs in kills (15) and digs (18) in the tournament's championship match vs. Cincinnati.

FRESHMEN NUMBERS

- San Diego State is one of three teams in the nation that lists nine true freshmen on its 2010 roster.
- Defending national champion Penn State and South Carolina are the only other two Division I schools with that many first-year players.
- Both Auburn and Maryland-Baltimore
 County have nine freshmen on their rosters,
 but that number includes redshirt freshmen
 who were at the schools last season.
- Among Mountain West Conference schools, Air Force and UNLV both have seven true freshmen on their squads.

AZTEC NOTES

- As a team, the Aztecs have hit .300 or better in seven matches, their highest total since it reached that mark in nine matches during the 2005 campaign.
- The Aztecs are 2-3 in five-set matches this season.
- San Diego State has won five of its last seven matches.
- ◆ The loss to Colorado State last Saturday snapped a three-match win streak that had equaled the Aztecs' three straight victories to open the season.
- ◆ SDSU's team blocking total (13.0 blocks 4 solo, 18 assists) against Utah on Oct. 9 was its highest of the season. As a team SDSU has finished in double figures in blocking eight times.
- ♦ The Aztecs are 1-11 in matches in which they trail in kills and also 0-10 in contests in which they record fewer digs than their opponent. On the flip side, they are 11-1 when leading in kills and 12-2 when leading in digs. The match vs. Seattle on Oct. 15 was the only that SDSU won when it trailed in kills.
- Andrea Hannasch is the lone Aztec to have recorded at least one block in each of SDSU's matches this season.
- ◆ Johnna Fouch is the only Aztec to have started every match this season. Fouch and libero Kristi Jackels are the only players to have appeared in every set in 2010.
