# **INDOOR NOTES**

The San Diego State track and field team prepared for the outdoor season by competing in the brief, but equally important indoor campaign.

The indoor season was a successful one for the Aztecs as four records were set with one individual earning All-America honors.

Below are some of the highlights from the 2006 indoor campaign:

- ▶ Senior Erin Asay became San Diego State's first indoor All-American after finishing seventh at the NCAA Indoor Track and Field Championships in Fayetteville, Ark. Asay vaulted 13-5.25 to earn the national honor. Her effort was good enough to score two points for SDSU placing it 51st out of 63 teams
- ▶ San Diego State improved upon 2005's fifth-place finish at Mountain West Conference indoor meet by coming in fourth with 76 points.
- ▶ Asay became the MWC indoor pole vault champion after a vault of 13-4.50. It marked the second time in three years that she took home the individual crown.
- ▶ Freshman Dana Jensen earned all-conference honors after placing third in the pole vault when she cleared 12-08.75.
- ▶ Freshman Decontee Kaye became an all-MWC performer after she finished second in the triple jump with a leap of 41-10.50. It was her third straight meet in which she recorded an NCAA provisional qualifying mark.
- ▶ Freshman Kristin Olafsdottir was named all-league when she placed third in the pentathlon with 3,843 points. Her effort was good enough for an NCAA provisional qualifying mark and ranked her third in school history after first-place finishes in the 60-meter hurdles and the 800-meter run.
- ▶ The SDSU 4x400 relay team of Nicole Stone, Mandy Upuu, Kristin Olafsdottir and Brittani Dudley earned all-MWC accolades and in the process established a new school record when they clocked in with a time of 3:43.63.
- ▶ Junior Lisa Crampton etched her name in the school record book when she ran the fastest indoor mile (5:04.40) in program history.
- ▶ Asay found herself atop the all-time SDSU pole vault list when she vaulted 14-0.50 at the Albuquerque Invitational.
- ▶ Kaye broke the school record in the triple jump with an effort of 42-02.00 at the Mountain T's Invitational in Flagstaff, Ariz.

# **OUTDOOR NOTES**

The San Diego State track and field team completed another successful season in 2006, qualifying a school-record 15 student-athletes for the NCAA regional meet and sending two individuals and one relay team to the national meet.

Below are some of the highlights from the 2006 outdoor campaign:

- ▶ Freshman Decontee Kaye tied an 18-year old school record with her 41-9.75 leap in the triple jump at the Duke Invitational in Durham, N.C. Kaye tied Gaylen Ames' record, which was set in 1988.
- ▶ Freshman Kristin Olafsdottir became the Mountain West Conference's first female student-athlete to earn the league's High Point Award and be named Freshman of the Year in the same season at the conference meet.
- ▶ SDSU qualified a program-best 15 studentathletes for the NCAA regional meet. The previous high was 12 during the 2003 campaign.
- ▶ Senior Erin Asay became the fourth MWC pole vault champion in San Diego State history with a first-place clearance of 13-5.25. She joined two-time winner Shayla Balentine (2002, 2005) and Aimee Crabtree (2001).
- ▶ Freshman Shana Watson earned all-MWC honors in both the triple jump and long jump. Her second-place effort of 40-10.50 in the triple jump was a personal best as was her 19-7.50 performance in the long jump.
- ▶ Junior Lisa Crampton and freshmen Corri Campbell-Fell and Nicole Stone also garnered all-MWC accolades after finishing third in the steeplechase, 400 hurdles and 400 meters, respectively.
- ▶ The Aztecs sent Erin Asay (pole vault) and Nicole Stone (400 meters), along with their 4x400 relay team of Stone, Larnie Boyd, Sherraine Pencil and Brittani Dudley to the NCAA championships.
- ▶ San Diego State placed 17 individuals on 13 separate Aztec all-time outdoor top-10 lists in 2006
- ▶ Nicole Stone captured first place in the 400 meters at the prestigious Mt. SAC relays with a time 55 seconds. She also was awarded the 400-meter hurdles crown with an NCAA regional qualifying standard of 1:00.72.
- ▶ Freshman Leanne Taylor finished first in the discus throw at Mt. SAC with an NCAA regional qualifying mark of 159-9.

# CELESTE TYSON LEADS YOUNG AZTEC CROSS COUNTRY SQUAD IN 2006

With nearly 56 percent of San Diego State's cross country team made up of new-comers, including seven freshmen, the Aztecs relied heavily on senior captain Celeste Tyson and she did not disappoint in 2006.

Even with a relatively young squad, SDSU still managed six top-10 finishes in the team's nine meets. Its best finish came at the Fullerton Season Opener where San Diego State placed fourth of 19 schools. That day the Aztecs were led by junior college transfer Meryl Follosco, who finished with a time of 19 minutes, 3 seconds, en route to earning Mountain West Conference athlete of the week honors.

At the lone home meet of the season, the 62nd Aztec Invitational at Balboa Park, SDSU registered a fifth-place effort, with eight runners establishing season-bests. San Diego State was led by Tyson's 20th-place finish and was the first of six straight races in which she crossed the finish line before any other Aztec.

In Salem, Ore., at the Willamette Invitational, SDSU came in seventh and saw Tyson, Follosco, and freshmen Jessica Mason and Stephanie Armstrong register Aztec careerbests with three others, juniors Lisa Naucler and Lital Azulay and senior Jackie Duncan turning in season-low times. Tyson was San Diego State's top performer completing the race in 17:54.95, good for ninth place.

After claiming the 2005 Santa Clara Invitational title, the Aztecs fell short of making it two in a row when they finished in seventh place. Once again, SDSU was paced by Tyson, who recorded her fourth top-10 finish of her career, with an eighth-place effort of 17:52.00. The Austin, Texas, native's performance was the best 5K of her Aztec career, the fastest time of the season for San Diego State and it earned her MWC athlete of the week accolades.

SDSU carried its momentum from Santa Clara and took it into the MWC Championships in Salt Lake City, Utah, to wrap up its regular season. In the process, four Aztecs set season bests at the 6K meet. Tyson completed the race in 22:57.00, the team's fastest time of the season, with Azulay, Mason and Naucler each turning in season-low marks.

# FOUR AZTECS ESTABLISH SEASON BESTS AT MWC CHAMPIONSHIPS


Four Aztec runners set season-low times and two established lifetime bests at the 2006 Mountain West Conference Championships at Rose Park Golf Course on the campus of the University of Utah. San Diego State finished the 6K-meet in eighth after recording a total of 203 points.

Senior Celeste Tyson led the way as she ran the fastest 6K of any other Aztec this season with a time of 22 minutes, 57 seconds. She surpassed the team's previous top clocking of the campaign by 52 seconds. Earlier this season, Tyson ran a team-best 23:49.00 at the Roy Griak Invitational in Falcon Heights, Minn.

Besides Tyson, three other Aztecs ran their fastest 6K of the year. Lital Azulay shaved over a minute off her previous season-low time crossing the finish line in 24:12.30 with Jessica Mason following close behind with a season-best time of 24:18.00.

Lisa Naucler was the third SDSU runner in the aforementioned group as she recorded a season-low time of 24:33.60.
