#### WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEK IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ After a splitting a pair of contests with No. 6 Oregon State in Corvallis earlier in the week, San Diego State will resume league play this weekend when it visits Reno for a three-game series vs. Nevada.
- ◆ That set gets underway on Friday, April 1, with a contest scheduled to start at 1:00 p.m. (MT) at the Wolf Pack's Peccole Park.
- ◆ That game was originally scheduled to begin at 6:00 p.m., but the Nevada basketball team is playing in the CBI tournament final that evening on campus so the time of the baseball game was changed.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Wolf Pack will also hook up for games on Saturday (April 2) and Sunday (April 3) at 6:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.

#### ON THE AIR

- ◆ All three games vs. Nevada will have live audio broadcast provided by the Wolf PAck Radio Network. Links to those broadcasts are available at the SDSU web site (GoAztecs.com).
- ◆ In addition, there will be a Live Stats feed for all three games vs. the Wolf Pack at GoAztecs.com.

#### **SERIES RECORD**

- ◆ San Diego State's record against Nevada stands at 13-15 since the teams first met during the 1986 season.
- ◆ Last season the Wolf Pack swept a three-game series at Tony Gwynn Stadium in mid-April in the only meetings between the teams during the regular season.
- ◆ At the 2016 Mountain West Tournament in Reno, the Aztecs defeated Nevada, 9-7, in an elimination game.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 6-7 at home, 3-7 away and 4-1 on neutral fields in previous contests against Nevada.

#### **SCOUTING THE WOLF PACK**

- Nevada's record stands at 13-7 overall 4-4 in the Mountain West as the Wolf Pack comes into the weekend riding a four-game winning streak. Included in that run is a sweep of a three-game series at ULNV last weekend.
- ◆ The Nevada offense has been led by center fielder TJ Friedl (.398, 3 doubles, 4 triples, 10 RBI) and second baseman Miles Mastrobuoni (.372, 8 doubles, 14 RBI).
- ◆ The Wolf Pack's 976 fielding percentage leads the Mountain West.
- ◆ Nevada is hitting .277 as a team with a 4.60 earned run average.

#### **HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ**

- Mark Martinez is in his second season as head coach of the Aztecs and 11th season as a member of the San Diego State staff.
- ◆ Martinez is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- Last season he led the Aztecs to their third consecutive Mountain West Championship and berth in the NCAA regionals as SDSU compiled a 41-23 record.
- Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs prior to the 2006 season and served for nine years under Head Coach Tony Gwynn. During that time he was promoted to the position of Associate Head Coach.
- ◆ Prior to his arrival at SDSU, Martinez was an assistant coach at the University of New Mexico for 17 seasons. During his time as a hitting and infield coach he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the nation, ranking among the top 11 in the nation in hitting his final four seasons.
- ◆ Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College in Grand Junction, Colo., from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
- ◆ He graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

#### **AZTECS AT AIR FORCE**

- ◆ Due to snow, only one game of SDSU's three-game series at Air Force (March 18-20) was completed, that being the first game of a doubleheader on Sunday (March 20).
- ◆ The second game of that twin bill was suspended in the top of the eighth inning and will be completed when the Falcons come to San Diego in May.
- ◆ Stats for that second contest are not reflected in SDSU's current statistics.

#### TREJO COMES THROUGH

- Shortstop Alan Trejo hit a solo home run, his first of the season, in the top of the ninth inning against No. 6 Oregon State on Monday to give SDSU a 6-5 win over the Beavers.
- He had a 15-game hitting streak stopped in the game vs. New Mexico last Friday (March 25).
- ◆ During that streak he hit .409 (27-for-66) with two doubles, 11 RBI and 13 runs scored
- ◆ He leads the Aztecs with 35 hits on the season. Only one other player has as many as 27.
- ◆ He has recorded an RBI in each of SDSU's last four games.
- The only contests in which he did not record a hit this season were the UNM game last weekend and the one on Feb. 23 at UC Irvine.

#### **ADKISON HITS AWAY**

- Sophomore Tyler Adkison has hit a bases-loaded three-RBI double in two of the Aztecs' last three outings.
- Against New Mexico last Saturday (March 26), his three-run two-bagger in the bottom of the seventh extended SDSU's lead from 6-5 to 9-5 in what was eventually an 11-6 victory.
- On Tuesday at No. 6 Oregon State. His double in the first inning cleared the bases and gave the Aztecs an early 3-0 lead.
- ◆ Adkison hit a pair of home runs in the contest at Air Force on March 20 to take the team lead with three this season.
- ◆ In that contest he went 3-for-5 with three RBI and three runs scored.
- In SDSU's past three games he has gone 5-for-11 with three doubles and eight RBI.
- ◆ Adkison's .467 slugging percentage leads the team.

- send the Aztecs to the 6-5 win. With the win he evened his season record at 2-2 and lowered his earned run average to 3.52.

- ◆ Erickson did not walk a batter over his first nine relief appearances of the season covering 11.2 innings.
- ◆ He has now allowed three walks to go along with 13 strikeouts over 15.1 innings (12 appearances).

#### **PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

- Shortstop Alan Trejo earned the Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week award for games played through Sunday, March 13, 2016.
- ◆ It is the first MW weekly accolade for Trejo, a sophomore from Downey, Calif. (Warren HS).
- ◆ He led San Diego State to a 2-1 week in a home series against Northwestern.
- ◆ Over the three contests he posted a batting average of .600 (9-for-15) with six runs scored, five runs batted in and one stolen base.
- ◆ Trejo had at least two hits and two runs scored in all three games with a .625 onbase percentage and a .600 slugging percentage.
- ◆ Defensively, Trejo recorded seven putouts and 12 assists with no errors.
- He was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the week by College Sports Madness.

#### **PYATT CONSISTENT**

- Redshirt freshman Harrison Pyatt turned in his fourth impressive start of the season vs. New Mexico last Friday (March 25).
- ◆ He went 6.1 innings allowing two runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts, but took the loss as the Aztecs fell 4-2 to the Lobos.
- ◆ In his previous start vs. Northwestern (March 10), he tossed 6.2 innings allowing a run on a seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts.
- In his start vs. San Diego on March 1, he went six innings giving up no runs on one hit with three walks and seven strikeouts.
- ◆ Pyatt made his Aztec debut with the start at UC Irvine on Tuesday, Feb. 23.
- ◆ He pitched five innings allowing one run on just three hits while striking out four.
- ◆ In the four starts in which he has gone at least five innings, his earned run average is 1.50.

#### **NAVARRO'S FIRST HIT**

- ◆ After going hitless in his first six collegiate plate appearances, freshman Niko Navarro came through with an important single in the win over Fresno State on March 6.
- He was called upon to pitch hit in the bottom of the eighth inning with the bases loaded, one out and SDSU trailing, 4-2.
- Navarro proceeded to deliver a single to right field to drive home two runs and tie the game.
- ◆ SDSU added a third run one batter later and went on to win, 5-4.

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in the contest on Feb. 19.
- Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter vs. Oregon on Feb. 20.

#### **STREAKS**

- ◆ David Hensley has the team's longest current hitting streak at seven games.
- ◆ Trejo has the team's longest hitting streak of the season at 15 games.
- Hunter Stratton has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the Aztecs' last eight games.
- ◆ Trejo also leads the Aztecs with 11 multiple-hit contests while Adkison is the team leader with five multiple-RBI games.

#### **NEW COACHES**

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ♦ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

#### **VETERAN HONOREES**

- Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team all-Mountain West selection.

#### **RETURNING POSITION STARTERS**

- Among the returning starters are two members of the Aztec infield and two outfielders.
- ◆ The infielders include second baseman Alan Trejo (.266, 20 RBI) and first baseman Andrew Brown (.295, 17 doubles, 32 RBI).
- ◆ Brown is likely to begin the 2016 season as the Aztecs' third baseman.
- ♦ Also back are a pair of outfielders: Spencer Thornton (.317, 7 2B, 23 RBI) and Chase Calabuig (.305, 8 2B, 25 RBI).

#### **RETURNING ON THE MOUND**

- ◆ The Aztecs return eight full-time pitchers from last season's staff along with three others who could see time on the mound as well as at positions in the field.
- ◆ In addition to projected starters Marcus Reyes, Cody Thompson and Brett Seeburger, other top returnees includes relievers Jacob Erickson (2-1, 2.64; alltourney at the Mountain West Tournament) and Brian Heldman (3-1, 3.52. 1 save).
- Second baseman Alan Trejo, outfielder Chase Calabuig and catcher CJ Saylor could also see spot duty on the mound.

#### SAYLOR RETURNS BEHIND THE PLATE

- ◆ Junior CJ Saylor will resume duties at the catching position this season after serving at the Aztecs' closer a year ago.
- ◆ In 2015 he compiled a record of 3-3 with 11 saves and a 5.02 ERA.
- ◆ He began his SDSU as a catcher where he hit .212 in 14 games as a redshirt freshman in 2014.
- Saylor could see occasional action on the mound this season as well.

#### PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBI las season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball magazine.

#### **COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW**

- College Sports Madness also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

#### **DRAFTED AZTECS**

- Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

#### **AZTECS PICKED AS CO-FAVORITES**

- San Diego State has been picked as cofavorite along with New Mexico to win the Mountain West title in the conference's preseason baseball poll.
- ◆ In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received three firstplace votes and tallied 32 points as did the Lobos. Fresno State picked up the remaining first-place vote and tied for third in the poll with Air Force.

#### **AZTEC NOTES**

- Senior outfielder Spencer Thornton had his first three-hit game of the season in the contest at Air Force on March 20. In that game he had a pair of doubles, two RBI and three runs scored.
- David Hensley is on a seven-game hitting streak during which he is batting .379 (11-for-29) with three RBI and a run scored.
- Freshman right-hander Chris Collins has made eight relief appearances out of the bullpen and allowed one earned run over 7.2 innings pitched for a 1.17 earned run average.
- ◆ Catcher Hunter Stratton has gone 5-for-14 (.357) over the last five games in which he has appeared with one RBI and two runs scored
- Shortstop Alan Trejo is the only player to have started all 23 games this season at the same position.
- Only one other Aztec has started all 23 games, but not at the same position each time: Justin Wylie (2B-3B-DH).
- ◆ Niko Navarro (1-for-3), Dean Nevarez (1-for-2) and Jordan Verdon (1-for-2) are the only three Aztecs to have recorded a hit as a pinch hitter. Aztec pinch hitters are 3-for-17.
- ◆ Infielder Andrew Brown is 8-for-24 over SDSU's last six games with a double, home run, three RBI and three runs scored.

#### **UP NEXT**

- Following the Nevada series, San Diego State will return home for four home games next week.
- ◆ The week begins with a visit by Long Beach State for a contest on Tuesday, April 5, at 6:00 p.m. at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs will then host a three-game Mountain West series against UNLV that gets underway on Friday, April 8, with a game set to get underway at 6:00 p.m.
- ◆ The Rebels and SDSU will also meet for contests on Saturday (April 9) and Sunday (April 10) at 2:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
