Streaks Snapped

- San Diego State's three-game win streak against AP Top 25 teams was snapped (one short of the school record).
- San Diego State had won 16 straight games against teams from the state of California.
- San Diego State had won seven straight regular-season games against "power conference schools".
- San Diego State had won its last five regular-season neutral site games.
- San Diego State had won four consecutive games against teams from the Pac-12 Conference.
- San Diego State had won its last two games against USC

Big Notes

- San Diego State held USC to a season low 58 points (12 points less than its previous low), while also handing the Trojans season lows in field goals (24), three-point field goals (T-4) and free throws made (6).
- San Diego State's six turnovers are a season low.
- San Diego State was held to 43 points, its lowest scoring output since scoring 43 against Arkansas-Little Rock on Nov. 21, 2015.
- San Diego State set season lows for points (43), field goals (18) and free throws attempted (11).
- Despite that, the Aztecs cut the deficit to eight and had the ball in the final four minutes of the game.

Lamont Butler – 9 points, 3 rebounds

Named to the all-tournament team... All nine of his points came after intermission... Scored nine of San Diego State's 29 second half points... Has a three-point field goals in a career-high four consecutive games (7-of-14)... Played a career-high 34 minutes... Has nine or more points in four straight games for the first time in his 34-game career.

Trey Pulliam – 11 points, 3 rebounds

Reached double figures for the fourth time this season and the 12th time in his career (SDSU is 10-2 in those games)... Played 31 or more minutes in six consecutive games.

Nathan Mensah – 8 points, 7 rebounds, 3 blocked shots

Has 14 blocked shots in six games this season... Has 10 blocked shots in his last three contests (all multiple block games)... Shooting 60.0 percent from the field this season after going 4-for-6 from the field.
