Aztec Basketball Set to Battle No. 14/13 Oklahoma State for Surf 'N Slam Title

- **When & Where:** Sunday, Dec. 30, 2012, Viejas Arena (12,414), San Diego, Calif., 2 p.m. PT
- **Live Media:** A live audio webcast featuring Chris Ello, as well as live stats will be available on goaztecs.com.
- **SDSU Head Coach Beth Burns:** Burns (Ohio Wesleyan, 1979) is in the eighth year of her second stint as head coach at San Diego State. She led the Aztecs for eight seasons from 1989 to 1997, before returning in 2005. She has an overall head coaching record of 357-247 in 21 seasons, and she is 276-182 in her 16 campaigns at SDSU.
- **Oklahoma State Head Coach Jim Littell:** Littell (Southwestern College, 1977) is in his second season at the helm of the Cowgirl program and sports a 31-12 overall record. Last year, Littell guided OSU to the WNIT championship after serving a six-year stint as the team's associate head coach from 2005-11.
- **Series History:** Sunday's clash will be the first meeting ever between the Aztecs and Cowgirls.
- **Up Next:** SDSU will round out its 2012-13 non-conference slate with a home game against Savannah State on Wednesday, Jan. 2, in another afternoon contest starting at 2 p.m. PT.

NEWS & NOTABLES

- The Aztecs look to secure their fourth San Diego Surf 'N Slam title in the last five years on Sunday when they square off against No. 14/13 Oklahoma State at Viejas Arena. Tip-off is slated for 2 p.m. PT.
- SDSU is coming off an impressive 88-72 victory over SMU in the tournament opener on Friday, as senior point guard Chelsea Hopkins recorded just the fifth triple-double in Mountain West history after scoring a career-best 22 points to go along with 10 rebounds and 11 assists.
- The Aztecs shot a season-high 56.3 percent (36-64) from the field against the Mustangs to extend their winning streak to four games and raise their record to 8-3 overall.
- SDSU has turned on the afterburners over the last three games, averaging nearly 84 points per outing while shooting 53 percent from the floor (104-153).

SDSU IN REGULAR-SEASON HOME TOURNEYS

- This year marks the eighth straight season that SDSU has played host to a tournament. Prior to 2005, the last time the Aztecs conducted a home tourney was in November 2000, when SDSU went 1-1 at the Pacific Bell Classic.
- The Aztecs did not play host to a regular-season tournament in Beth Burns' first stint as head coach from 1989-97.
- SDSU women's hoops has played host to 22 home tournaments in its previous 36 years of existence.
- The Aztecs are 21-2 in the first game of a home tournament and has won the team title 12 times, including each of the first four.
- SDSU has split games in seven of its last 10 home tournaments. The team won the first game and lost the second in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2006 and 2010, and did the opposite in 2005 and 2007.
- The Aztecs are 8-1 in the last five Surf 'N Slams, winning the title over No. 4 Texas in 2008, vs. Auburn in 2009, and against Penn in 2011.

FAST FACTS: SURF 'N SLAM CLASSIC

- This season's Surf 'N Slam Classic returns to a four-team format with two games each day separated by an off day. Last year's tournament was comprised of three teams (SDSU, Penn, UNC Greensboro) with a single game on three consecutive days.
- Five different schools from five different conferences have won a tourney championship game in the Surf 'N Slam's seven seasons. SDSU is the only back-to-back winner in 2008 and 2009.
- Harvard, Oklahoma State and SMU are all making their first Surf 'N Slam appearances. The Crimson are the third Ivy League squad to play in the tourney, joining Brown (2006), and Penn (2011), while the Cowgirls are the third Big 12 school to compete in the event, following Texas (2008) and Texas A&M (2010), which bolted for the Southeastern Conference in time for the 2012-13 campaign. Similarly, SMU is the second Conference USA school in the field, joining UTEP, which made the trek west in 2008 as well. The Mustangs are also the fifth representative from the Lone Star State in the tournament's eight-year history.
- SDSU and SMU have tangled with one another in four previous encounters. However, the Aztecs have faced neither Harvard nor Oklahoma State in the program's 37-year existence.
- SDSU has an all-time Surf 'N Slam record of 11-4. The Aztecs have earned at least a split every season and advanced to the championship game five times (3-2), winning the title on three occasions.
- A total of five teams have been ranked in the AP top 25 when playing in the Surf 'N Slam, including No. 14 Oklahoma State this season, along with No. 7 Texas A&M (2010), No. 4 Texas (2008), No. 11 Georgia (2006) and No. 17 George Washington (2006).

THE LAST TIME OUT

Bolstered by Chelsea Hopkins' triple-double (22 pts., 10 rebounds, 11 assists), the Aztecs turned in an impressive 88-72 victory over SMU in the opening round of the eighth annual San Diego Surf 'N Slam Classic on Friday.

In addition to Hopkins' feat, SDSU received another strong effort from Courtney Clements, who finished with 21 points, including 16 in the second half, while Erimma Amarikwa tossed in 13 points of her own on 6-of-8 shooting to go with five boards.

As a team, the Aztecs posted a season-best 56.3 field-goal percentage, sinking 36 of their 64 attempts, while the Mustangs werelimited to a 39.0 percent clip (23-59) for the evening. Despite making 13 fewer free-throws (21-8), SDSU outscored the Mustangs, 42-28, in the paint and maintained a 25-17 edge on the defensive glass.

SMU's Keena Mays led all players with 26 points, but was held to just four in the second half after the Aztecs made some defensive adjustments at intermission. In addition, Akil Simpson contributed 20 points and eight rebounds for the visitors, while Alisha Filmore tallied 11 points and four assists in the loss.

SDSU raced to a 46-34 halftime lead, but the Mustangs pulled to within nine in the second half, 64-55, after Filmore completed an old-fashioned 3-point play at the 10:48 mark. However, the Aztecs soon vanquished the threat, crafting a 20-9 surge over the next six-plus minutes to give the host school its biggest lead of the game at 84-64 with 4:31 to go.

WELCOME BACK

SDSU also received an added boost from Ahjalee Harvey in their win over SMU on Friday. The sophomore guard returned to the lineup for the first time since suffering a hand injury earlier this month and scored nine points in 21 minutes, including a pair of 3-pointers. After the Mustangs cut the Aztec lead to single digits at 64-55 in the second half, Harvey stepped up on the ensuing possession and drained a triple to extinguish the SMU threat for good.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Over the last three games, senior Chelsea Hopkins has totaled 33 assists, including a career-high 13 vs. Fresno Pacific on Dec. 19. The 5-8 point guard also dished out 11 helpers against SMU to complete a rare triple-double after finishing with 22 points and 10 rebounds as well.

With her performances, Hopkins has taken over the Mountain West lead in assists with 6.7 per outing and has four more helpers (74-70) than the second-place player in Rmanii Haynes of UNLV despite playing in one less game (12-11).

Hopkins also topped the league in that category during the 2011-12 campaign, marking the fourth straight year an Aztec has led the MW in assists or assist average and five out of the last six years.

HEAD COACH BETH BURNS



The winningest coach in SDSU women's basketball history, Beth Burns is in her 21st season as a collegiate head coach and her 16th overall at the helm of the Aztecs.

Since returning for her second stint on Montezuma Mesa in 2005,

Burns has taken the program to new heights, including a trip to the NCAA Sweet Sixteen, three NCAA tournament appearances (2009, 2010, 2012) and two conference regular-season (2009, 2012) and tournament titles (2010, 2012).

Last season, she directed the Aztecs to both the outright Mountain West regular-season (12-2) and tournament titles. The team made its third trip to the NAAs in the past four years and its 25 total victories not only tied for second in program history, but also are SDSU's most in 18 years. As a result, Burns captured her second MW Coach-of-the-Year honor.

Burns picked up her 350th career victory on Nov. 14 against UC Irvine. She enters Sunday's game with a 357-247 (.591) overall record, including a 276-182 (.603) mark in her 16 years (1989-97, 2005-present) on The Mesa.

AZTECS AMONG MW LEADERS

Seniors Courtney Clements, Chelsea Hopkins and Malia Nahinu finds themselves among the Mountain West leaders following Friday's game. Clements tops the league in scoring (19.5 ppg), field goals (85) and 3-pointers (2.5/gm), while Hopkins occupies the top spot in assists (6.7/gm), ranks second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and is fourth in rebounding (7.3/gm). Not to be outdone, Nahinu is tied for the No. 1 slot in blocks (2.0/gm) and ranks second in field-goal percentage (.542).

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

The Aztecs are just one of two teams in the Mountain West to boast a positive turnover margin following Friday's game. SDSU is +2.1 in that statistic, good for second in the league behind Fresno State's +5.6 spread.

Against Fresno Pacific on Dec. 19, the Aztecs posted a season-low seven turnovers in an 90-41 win. During the 2011-12 campaign, SDSU didn't produce a single-digit turnover total until the 30th game when the Scarlet and Black finished with six miscues in their 73-55 semifinal victory over Wyoming at the MW tournament.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Despite Friday's frenetic pace, the Aztecs have limited the opposition to an average of 54.6 points per game and a .338 field-goal percentage, still tops in the MW.

Last year, SDSU gave up 54.4 points a game to lead the conference, while its .362 field-goal percentage defense ranked second.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Earlier this season, Courtney Clements became the 17th player to surpass 1,000 points in an Aztec uniform. Through 11 games this year, Clements has amassed 1,106 points during her career on The Mesa and has reached the 20-point plateau on 21 occasions, including six of her last nine outings. In 2011-12, she finished with 556 points, good for 11th place on the Aztecs' single-season charts.

BLOCK PARTY

As previously mentioned, Malia Nahinu is tied for the top spot in the MW with an average of 2.0 blocks per game. Against Fresno Pacific on, the SDSU senior posted with three rejections in the Aztecs' 73-56 win. With her performance, Nahinu has 94 blocks in her career on The Mesa, moving into ninth place on the school's all-time list.

AZTECS COLLECT MW WEEKLY HONORS

Just 11 games into the young season, San Diego State has already picked up three Mountain West Player of the Week awards after claiming six a year ago. Senior Courtney Clements was selected in consecutive weeks, Nov. 26 and Dec. 3, while Chelsea Hopkins received the distinction on Dec. 17.

Against USC, Clements scored a game-high 25

points, including a trio of 3-pointers. She also came away with six rebounds, two assists, one block and a steal, as the Aztecs rolled to an 80-46 victory.

The previous week, Clements earned all-tournament honors at the Omni Hotels Classic in Boulder, Colo., after averaging 22.5 points and 3.0 rebound in two games. Against Auburn, she drained a career-high six triples, finishing with a game-best 26 points to help SDSU cruise to an 78-57 win. Despite a loss to host Colorado the next night, Clements came away with game-high honors once again with 19 points on 9-of-17 shooting.

Hopkins, meanwhile, came within a whisker of a rare triple-double in the Aztecs' 73-56 road victory at Cal Poly after finishing with a season-high 17 points to go along with 10 rebounds and nine assists. She also tied her career best with eight field goals on 14 attempts and came away with two steals in 39 minutes.

With those performances, Clements now boasts five career weekly honors, while Hopkins has three to her credit.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Aztecs have emerged victorious in their first five home games this season and are a combined 48-13 (.787) on the Viejas Arena court since the 2008-09 campaign.

WOMEN'S HOOPS SIGNS QUARTET TO NLI's

Head coach Beth Burns announced the addition last month of four talented recruits who will join the Aztecs for the 2013-14 season. Those signing National Letters of Intent include Ariell Bostick (Oakland, Calif.), Chloe Johnson (Phoenix, Ariz.), Alyssa Lawrence (New Rochelle, N.Y.) and Briteesha Solomon (San Diego, Calif.).

AZTEC EXCELLENCE

San Diego State finds itself in elite company regarding the recent success of its football and men's and women's basketball programs. Since the fall of 2011, the three Aztec teams have posted a combined record of 86-29 (.748), which ranks sixth in the nation as of Dec. 25. Below are the top 10 schools with their combined records for FB, MBB and WBB during that span.

DECEMBERS TO REMEMBER

The Aztecs are a combined 31-9 during December since 2006. Four of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll in No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other five defeats were at Washington on Dec. 5, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opening round of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam.

Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 30 of those 40 December contests at home.

WITH A WIN...

An Aztec victory over Oklahoma State will mean:

- SDSU captures its fourth Surf 'N Slam title in the last five years.
- SDSU snaps the Cowgirls' 16-game victory streak, currently the longest in the nation.
- SDSU defeats a ranked opponent for the second year in a row after dispatching No. 18 DePaul at the Rainbow Wahine Classic in Hawaii on Nov. 18, 2011.
- SDSU extends its own winning streak to five games.
- SDSU improves to 6-0 at home this season.
- SDSU's 9-3 record matches its best start to a season since the 2008-09 squad also went 9-3.
- SDSU raises its record to 31-9 in December games since 2006.

OKLAHOMA STATE TIDBITS

The Cowgirls (10-0) own the nation's longest winning streak at 16 games dating back to last year after toppling Harvard, 92-62, in the other Surf 'N Slam matchup on Friday. With the victory, OSU also won its 21st consecutive outing in which four players scored in double figures. Junior Tiffany Bias led the OSU charge with 24 points, including 18 in the first half, followed by sophomore Liz Donohoe (18 pts.), while senior Toni Young (16 pts., 12 rebounds) and freshman Brittney Martin (12 pts., 11 rebounds) completed double-doubles.

Young is close to averaging a double-double for the season, leading the Cowgirls with 17.4 points and 9.5 rebounds per contest, while Donohoe (16.8 ppg) has

As a team, the Cowgirls are shooting just over 49 percent from the field, 36 percent from beyond the arc and 75 percent at the free-throw line.

OSU is outscoring its opponents by a whopping 38 points per game, including three victories by a margin of more than 50. In their closest game of the year, the Cowgirls survived a 74-71 scare at Missouri State back on Nov. 13.
