SDSU is second in the MWC in red zone offense, converting 27-of-31 opportunities (19 TDs, 8 FGs)... The Aztecs rank 21st nationally in fourth-down conversions, making 8-of-13 (61.5 percent)... SDSU is 3-1 this season when owning an advantage in total offense... SDSU has nine scoring drives of 10 or more plays and 13 of 80 or more yards... The Aztecs logged their second and third-longest offensive plays of the year at Utah on a 61-yard Kevin O'Connell run and a 60-yard pass from O'Connell to Jeff Webb... SDSU won back-to-back games against SJSU and BYU by 21 or more points for the first time since 1999... SDSU two straight games with more than 500 yards of total offense versus BYU, SJSU... The last time SDSU had more than 500 yards of total offense in back-to-back games was in 2002... SDSU had over 400 yards of total offense in the first two games of a season for the first time since 1996... The 90-yard scoring drive vs. BYU is the team's longest since 2002 against Hawai'i (94 yards)... SDSU had four rushing touchdowns against BYU, its most in a game since also tallying four versus Wyoming in 2001... The Aztecs' 52 points against SJSU are their most points in a game since 1996... The 31-point margin of victory against the Spartans (52-21) is the Aztecs' best since 2003... SDSU has run 80-plus offensive plays in three games... SDSU's 28 first downs vs. SJSU are the team's most since 2001... The Aztecs' 80-yard TD at Ohio State is their first completion of at least 80 yards since an 87-yard toss in 2002 at Hawaii... The Aztec offensive line did not allow a sack against CSU and Air Force, the first time the team has turned the trick since 2003, at UNLV... Jeff Webb has caught a pass in 31 straight games and has three receptions or more in 26 straight... Webb (2nd) and Robert Ortiz (10th) are both in the SDSU career top-10 for receptions.

San Diego State ranks first in the Mountain West and 35th nationally in pass defense, allowing an average of 197.7 yards per game... The Aztecs are 12th nationally in pass efficiency defense (104.98)... Senior linebacker Freddy Keiaho is tied for 26th nationally in tackles per game (9.8) and is tied for 28th in solo tackles (5.8/g)... Keiaho is tied for first in the MWC with 9.8 tackles per game, including a career best 18 at No. 9 Ohio State... 11 different Aztecs have made their first career start on defense in 2005... SDSU has 14 INT by nine different players... Five Aztecs have logged their first career INT in 2005 (Allen, B. Martin, J. Martin, Maze, McKay, Sturm)... At least one Aztec has recorded his first career INT in five of the last seven outings... SDSU opponents have thrown for over 200 yards in just four of 10 games this season... SDSU is 8-0 in its last 32 contests when keeping its opponent to 10 points or fewer... The Aztecs 10-3 since 2003 when owning an advantage in turnover margin... The Aztecs limited CSU to just 89 yards of total offense in the first half... The SDSU defense logged interceptions on each of the Rams' final three possessions in the fourth quarter... The three INTs in a game are the Aztecs most in one outing since last year at Michigan... At Utah, five Aztecs recorded 10 or more tackles in a game for the first time since a 1995 meeting in San Diego with Wyoming (Nov. 11)... SDSU held UNLV to just 88 yards passing, the fewest by an Aztec opponent since Air Force threw for just 95 yards on Nov. 22, 2003... SDSU held BYU to only 44 yards rushing, the fewest by an Aztec opponent since UNLV in 2003 (31 yards)... The defensive gave up only 12 first downs (fewest since 2003 vs. UNLV) vs. SJSU... SDSU has scored a pair of defensive touchdowns in 2005 with both coming on interception returns (86, 44 yards)... In 2004, The Dark Side had 80 tackles for loss, 29 sacks, 14 interceptions and forced 26 turnovers... In 2003, San Diego State allowed 17 offensive touchdowns, tied with co-national champion LSU for the best figure in the country... That same season, SDSU held four opponents to nine points or less marking the first time an Aztec squad had done that since 1977... In 2003, the Aztecs allowed 207 points, the fewest SDSU has allowed since 1977.
