Win Streaks Extended

- San Diego State wins its 15th straight road/neutral game. This is a school record and the longest active win streak.
- San Diego State wins the opening game of its 13th straight conference tournament, a school record. That is tied with Michigan for the fourth longest active streak nationally.
- San Diego State defeats Air Force for the third straight time and is 12-2 in its last 14 games against the Falcons.

Big Picture

- San Diego State improves to 29-1, the best 30-game record in school history, and is the only team in the nation with only one loss.
- San Diego State is 15-0 in road/neutral games this season. The Aztecs are the only team in the nation to win every road/neutral contest in 2019-20 and leads the nation with 15 road/neutral victories.
- The 29 victories are tied for the third most in school history. The 2015-16 squad, that advanced to the NIT national semifinals in New York City ended the campaign 28-10. The only two teams with more victories, the 2010-11 (34) and 2013-14 (31), both advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16.
- San Diego State is now 28 games above .500. Only once have the Aztecs completed a season more games above the .500 mark (2010-11, +31).
- San Diego State wins its 33rd game at Thomas & Mack Center since the start of the 2008-09 campaign. That is the most victories in a venue in which a team has not played a home game in the nation.

Series Notes

- San Diego State leads the all-time series, 59-24.
- The Aztecs are 5-1, with four straight wins, against the Falcons on neutral courts.
- San Diego State has won three straight, six of seven and 12 of the last 14 games between the teams.

Tournament Notes

- San Diego State improves 33-15 in Mountain West tournament history (68.8 percent). Regardless of other outcomes today, the Aztecs own the highest winning percentage and have the most victories of any team — current or past — in league history.
- The Aztecs are now 16-5 in quarterfinal games and are 12-4 in semifinal round Mountain West Conference history.
- The Aztecs are 23-7 in the Mountain West tourney since 2010.

Career Charts

- Malachi Flynn reached double figures for the 20th straight game. He becomes the sixth player in the Brian Dutcher/Steve Fisher era to reach double figures in at least 20 straight games (Brandon Heath (58), Jamaal Franklin (32), Marcus Slaughter (28), Mike Mackell (26) and Trey Kell (20)).
- Matt Mitchell played in his 72nd career victory. That moves him past Brandon Heath, the school's all-time leading scorer, into 19th place since the school started tracking the stat prior to the 1975-76 season.
- Mitchell started his 82nd career game moving him past Myron Epps into 18th place on the school's all-time chart (started 1978-79).

Game Notes

- San Diego State scored the first bucket of the game and is 20-1 this season when they score first.
- San Diego State had a 9-0 run over 2:05 in the first half to turn a 13-7 deficit into a 16-13 lead.
- San Diego State trailed at the half for the seventh time this season and with today's victory improved to 6-1 in those games.
- Air Force shot 60.0 percent in the first half which is the best shooting percentage for an SDSU opponent in a half this season. (UNLV 57.7 percent in
 the first half on Feb. 22).
- San Diego State used a 27-6 run to turn a 41-33 deficit with 18:45 to play in the second half in to a 60-47 lead with 7:02 to play.
- The Aztecs closed out the game on a 7-0 run after Air Force had pulled within six points with 1:57 remaining.
- Air Force scored 41 points in the first 21:15 of the game and was then limited to six points over the next 13:13.

Yanni Wetzell

Reached double figures for 19th time this year and 28th time in his career.

Malachi Flynn

Scored in double figures for the 29th time this season and 67th time in his career... Flynn scored just three of his 16 points in the first half.

Jordan Schakel

Reached double figures for the 20th time this season and 30th time for his career... Schakel hit multiple threes for the 21st time this year and his five triples equals his season and career-high... After missing the first 18 three-pointers in his Mountain West Championships career, Schakel then hit five of his next seven.
