SDSU Men's Golf Set for NCAA Albuquerque Regional

The San Diego State men's golf team embarks on its quest for postseason glory next week when it travels to the Land of Enchantment to compete in the NCAA Albuquerque Regional, May 16-18, in Albuquerque, N.M. The 22nd-ranked Aztecs, who are making their 18th consecutive regional appearance and 21st overall, will be among the field vying for a spot in the NCAA national championship series, scheduled for May 27-June 1 in Eugene, Ore.

SDŚU received the No. 4 seed out of 14 teams in the Albuquerque Regional, earning one of 50 at-large bids to the NCAA tournament after tying for fourth at the Mountain West Championship on April 24. A total of 81 NCAA Division I schools received invitations to play in one of six regional events that will be held concurrently this week in Marana, Ariz. (Arizona), Albuquerque, N.M. (New Mexico), Stillwater, Okla. (Oklahoma State), Kohler, Wis. (Marquette), Franklin, Tenn. (Vanderbilt) and Tuscaloosa, Ala. (Alabama).

Joining the Aztecs on the par-72, 7,555-yard UNM South Championship Course this week will be 13 other teams, including seven foes ranked in the Golfstat top 50, along with five individual competitors (75 golfers overall). The top five squads and low individual not on an advancing team will move on to nationals from each of the six regionals.

Teams will complete 18 holes (54 total) of stroke play each of the three days, following a practice round on Sunday, May 15. SDSU will be paired with Texas A&M and North Carolina State for Monday's first round, which is set to get underway from the No. 10 tee at 8:20 a.m. MT (7:20 a.m. PT), while starting times for Tuesday and Wednesday will be determined by team finishes.

Aztec Regional Lineup

For the just the second tournament this year, San Diego State head coach Ryan Donovan will utilize the starting lineup of Nahum Mendoza III (San Diego, Calif.), Riccardo Michelini (Carpi, Italy), Ryann Ree (Redondo Beach, Calif.), PJ Samiere (Kailua, Hawaii) and Gunn Yang (Pyeongchang, South Korea). The combination was employed last March at the Lamkin San Diego Classic, where the Aztecs placed third out of 15 teams.

Michelini will be making his fourth consecutive regional appearance, while Mendoza finds himself in the thick of fight for the third year in row, joining two-time participants Ree and Samiere. That leaves Yang, the 2014 U.S. Amateur champion, as the lone SDSU newcomer to postseason play.

At the New Haven Regional last year, Michelini (t-17th), Samiere (t-22nd) and Ree (t-25th) finished within two strokes of one another, helping the Aztecs to a second-place standing and advance to the national championships in Bradenton, Fla.

Mendoza, who owns a team-best 70.48 scoring average, enters the tournament ranked 14th nationally in the latest Golfstat individual ratings, while Ree checks in a No. 50, followed closely by Michelini at No. 54.

Aztecs At NCAA Regionals

Since the NCAA regional format was adopted in 1989, SDSU has received a bid on 21 occasions, including a current streak of 18 straight from 1999 to 2016. However, this year marks third consecutive season in which the Aztecs will participate in a regional event outside of the Pacific time zone after traveling to Columbia, Mo., and New Haven, Conn., in 2014 and 2015, respectively.

SDSU has advanced through regional competition into the national championship series on seven occasions, including last year when the Scarlet and Black finished second at The Course at Yale. The Aztecs captured the team title at OMNI Tucson National Golf Club in 2011, posting the program's lowest combined score in regional play with a 19-under 833 en route to a seven-stroke victory.

The following season at Stanford Golf Course in 2012, SDSU turned in a second-place finish, marking the last time the Aztecs qualified for the NCAA finals in consecutive years. Two-time All-American J.J. Spaun set three team regional records at Stanford, including lowest score (12-under 198), lowest round (7-under 63) and best individu-

al finish (2nd). The record for best single round by an SDSU golfer at a regional was previously held by Magnus Carlsson, who shot a 6-under 66 in 1999.

The Competition

The Aztecs are one of eight teams in the Albuquerque Regional ranked among the top 50 in the latest Golfstat rankings released May 11. Of those squads, five reside in the top 30, including No. 3 USC, followed by Arizona State (11), South Florida (15), SDSU (22) and Texas A&M (27).

The Aztecs own a 9-8 record in head-to-head results against eight of their regional foes during the 2015-16 campaign, including unblemished marks vs. Iowa (2-0), South Florida (1-0), Texas A&M (1-0) and TCU (1-0). SDSU has also maintained the upper hand this year against Arizona State (3-2), but has come up short against USC (1-2), Texas Tech (0-1) and New Mexico (0-3).

A Look At The Course

San Diego State is no stranger to the UNM South Championship Course, having competed in the William H. Tucker Intercollegiate in eight of the last 11 years and 13 times overall. Last September, the Aztecs posted a fifth-place team finish at the venue as Gunn Yang (-3) tied for sixth on the individual leaderboard. SDSU has played the course twice in regional competition, finishing 18th in 1995, followed by a 10th-place tie in 2002.

Opened in 1967, UNM South Championship Course maintains a course rating of 75.2 from the back tees with a slope of 134. In addition to this year's regional, the par-72, 7,555-yard layout has played host to the NCAA Men's Golf Championships in 1976, 1992 and 1998, as well as the NCAA Women's Golf Championships in 1987 and 2008. The course will also serve as a women's regional site in 2017.

In 2014, UNM South was ranked seventh on *Golfweek's* list of "Best Courses You Can Play State-by-State" and No. 21 among the publication's "Best Campus Courses." The Robert (Red) Lawrence design features blue and rye grass on the fairways and a mix of bent grass and Poa Annua on the greens.

Backspin: 2015 NCAA New Haven Regional

For the third time in five years, the San Diego State men's golf team secured a berth in the NCAA Championships after logging a runner-up finish at the NCAA New Haven Regional on May 16, 2015. The Aztecs, who completed round two in a tie for third, climbed one notch in the standings after posting a collective 7-under 273 over the final 18 holes for a three-round total of even-par 840.

With its performance, SDSU finished 14 shots in back of South Florida (-14), the No. 3 seed in the regional, while Oklahoma State (+2), Vanderbilt (+4) and LSU (+9) claimed the other three national qualifying spots on The Course at Yale's par-70, 6,803-yard layout.

Four of the Scarlet and Black's five starters finished with scores of par or better during the final round, including senior Xander Schauffele and junior Ryann Ree, who each carded a 67.

After making bogey at No. 1, Schauffele played spot-free golf the rest of the way, tying for team-high honors with four birdies, including three during a six-hole stretch on the front nine. With his effort, the Scripps Ranch High alumnus posted his highest finish in three regional events as a collegian, landing in a six-way logiam for fifth place with a combined 3-under 207. In addition, Schauffele completed his teambest eighth top-five placement this season and 13th round in the 60s.

Similarly, Ree drained four birdies of his own, including two straight conversions at the 11th and 12th greens as part of a bogey-free back

nine. Saving his best round for last, the Oregon transfer vaulted 11 places into a tie for 25th in his first-ever regional appearance.

SDSU had two additional players finish among the individual top 25, including Riccardo Michelini, who tied for the 17th position with a 1-over 211 after firing an even-par 70 on Saturday. The Aztec junior offset two bogeys with a pair of birdies, including an impressive make on the par-4, 365-yard No. 14, which ranked as the sixth-toughest hole of the final round.

Meanwhile, PJ Samiere logged his third-highest placement of the year after landing in the 22nd spot at 2-over 212. Despite backto-back bogeys on holes 9 and 10, the SDSU freshman still completed his 11th round in red figures this season, finishing with a 69, highlighted by a trio of birdies.

The SDSÚ contingent also included Nahum Mendoza III, who dropped into 49th at 10-over 220 after shooting a final-round 75. The Aztec sophomore started strong with four straight pars and a birdie-2 at No. 5; however, four bogeys and a double-bogey on the 13th green proved too much to overcome.

Mendoza Named MW Golfer of the Year

San Diego State junior Nahum Mendoza III was named 2016 Mountain West Men's Golfer of the Year in a vote of the conference's 11 head coaches as announced on April 28 by the league office.

With his award, Mendoza becomes the fifth Aztec player to capture MW Golfer of the Year honors, joining J.J. Spaun (2012), Aaron Goldberg (2008), Jon Lieber (2002) and Lars Johansson (2001).

In addition, Mendoza earned a spot on the 10-player all-conference team, along with SDSU seniors Riccardo Michelini and Ryann Ree. The selections give the Aztecs three all-MW honorees for the third year in a row.

Mendoza is currently ranked 13th in the nation according to Golfstat and is listed 14th in the latest Golfweek/Sagarin ratings. The Francis Parker High alum leads the league with a team-best 70.48 scoring average and tops the squad with 18 rounds below par, including 10 in the 60s. He has recorded seven top-10 placements on the year, including four in the top five.

Mendoza, who was named to the prestigious Arnold Palmer Cup on April 14, is coming off a stellar performance at the Mountain West Championship in Tucson, Ariz., where he tied for third on the individual leaderboard with a collective 6-under 210, highlighted by a final-round 67.

At the Southwestern Jones Invitational on March 1, he matched his best collegiate finish, tying for second place with a combined 7-under 209. Mendoza also fired a season-low 5-under 66 during the second round of the ASU Thunderbird Invitational on April 2 en route to fourth-place tie.

Not to be outdone, Mendoza, who collected his second straight all-conference certificate, was named one of 30 semifinalists for the 2016 Jack Nicklaus National Player of the Year Award on April 22

Ree also landed on the all-MW team for the second year in a row after posting seven top-10 finishes during the 2015-16 campaign, including five in the top-five. The Redondo Beach product owns a 71.00 scoring average in 11 tournaments and is ranked 50th nationally by Golfstat.

In SDSU's spring opener last February, The Prestige at PGA West, Ree recorded his highest placement as a collegian, finishing alone in the runner-up spot after shooting a 10-under 203. He was one of just two players in the elite field of 81 golfers to card all three rounds in the 60s (68-66-69) and topped 15 players ranked in the Golfstat top 100. For his efforts, Ree was named MW Men's Golfer of the Week for the first time in his career.

Ree also tied with Mendoza for fourth place at the ASU Thunderbird Invitational on April 3 and fired a personal-best 13-under 199 at the Alister MacKenzie Invitational last fall to finish in the fifth position.

Michelini, meanwhile, became the just the fourth Aztec player to garner all-Mountain West accolades on three occasions, joining Spaun (2010-12), Goldberg (2006-08) and Mark Warman (2002-04). The conference's freshman of the year in 2013, Michelini currently sports a 71.24 scoring average and is one of two SDSU golfers, along with Ree, to appear in all 11 events this season.

Michelini, who is ranked 54th by Golfstat, has logged six top-10 placements this year, highlighted by a fifth-place showing at the Aztecs' own Barona Collegiate Cup where he shot a 4-under 212 to help the Scarlet and Black capture the team title on March 22. He also contributed to SDSU's other tournament victory after tying for ninth at the season-opening Saint Mary's Invitational at Pebble Beach last September and shot a career-best 13-under 200 the following month at the Alister MacKenzie Invite.

Rewind: Mendoza Ties for Third at MW Championship Nahum Mendoza III finished in a tie for third place after firing a

5-under-par 67 to lead the Aztec men's golf team during the final round of the 2016 Mountain West Championship at OMNI Tucson National Golf Club on April 24

As a team, SDSU came up short in its bid for a second straight conference title, completing the 54-hole tournament in a tie fourth with Colorado State at 4-under 860.

Despite shaving four strokes off their second-round total with an even-par 288, the Aztecs were unable to make a move in the standings, finishing 14 shots behind champion UNLV (-18), while New Mexico (-15) landed in the runner-up spot ahead of third-place Fresno State (-5) on the par-72, 7,194-yard Catalina Course.

Individually, Mendoza vaulted 14 spots on the leaderboard after matching his lowest single-round card in three MW tournament appearances, highlighted by four birdies to go with an eagle on the par-5, 511-yard No. 10. With his effort, the SDSU junior finished just three shots of the pace, along with Sam Kim of New Mexico and UNLV's Zane Thomas, as Trevor Clayton of Fresno State (-9) took home medalist honors, while Nevada's 36-hole leader Corey Eddings (-7) slipped into second. In addition, Mendoza completed his fourth top-five placement of the spring and sixth of his career.

The Aztecs' Riccardo Michelini also saved his best for last, climbing six places into a four-way tie for 11th at 3-under 213 on the strength of a final-round 70. The SDSU senior captain offset four bogeys with a team-high six birdies, including an impressive conversion on the par-4, 470-yard 18th, which ranked as the toughest hole of the tournament. The 55-player field recorded just 11 birdies on the aforementioned green for the entire weekend.

PJ Samiere was the only other Aztec starter to complete the MW Championship in red figures, landing in a tie for 20th at 1-under 215 after firing a 74. Despite shooting 2-under over his final 11 holes, the SDSU sophomore was plagued by rough stretch on the front, suffering two bogeys as well as a triple on the par-3 No. 4 to tumble out of the eighth position.

Ryann Ree also lost ground on the leaderboard, slipping seven places into a tie for 43rd at 9-over 225 after logging a 77. The Aztec senior countered two bogeys with four birdies and eight pars; however, two doubles and an untimely triple on No. 18 precipitated his dron

Rounding out the Scarlet and Black delegation was Blake Abercrombie, who posted his second consecutive 80 to complete his first-ever conference championship in 52nd at 15-over 231. The SDSU sophomore shot 1-under after the turn, highlighted by a birdie on the par-5 10th; however, two double-bogeys and a triple on the front proved too much to overcome.

2015-16 Season Capsule

- San Diego State is enjoying another highly successful campaign, posting two tournament victories thus far to go with eight top-5 placements. The Scarlet and Black has displayed incredible depth this year with five different golfers leading the team in 11 regular-season events.
- The Aztecs took home the crown at the season-opening Saint Mary's Invitational on Sept. 16, as three players finished among the top 10 on the individual leaderboard at the famed Poppy Hills Golf Course in Pebble Beach, Calif. SDSU was led by Brian Song, who tied for fourth, while Ryann Ree and Riccardo Michelini both landed in the ninth position.
- After a fifth-place showing at the William H. Tucker Intercollegiate in Albuquerque, N.M., the Aztecs reeled off four consecutive thirdplace performances, beginning with the University of California's Alister MacKenzie Invitational in mid-October, where SDSU tied for the third-lowest 54-hole team score in school history with a 31-under 821. Ree (-14) and Michelini (-13), who finished fifth and sixth respectively, became the first set of Aztec teammates to complete three rounds below 70 in the same event since Colin Featherstone and Todd Baek in 2010.
- Ryann Ree captured Mountain West Men's Golfer of the Week honors on Feb. 24 after finishing a solo second at SDSU's spring opener, The Prestige at PGA West. Ree logged his highest placement as a collegian at the event with a 10-under 203, highlighted by 15 birdies overall, which ranked second in the field.
- Nahum Mendoza III recorded the first of four straight top 10 individual finishes after tying for the runner-up spot at the Southwestern Jones Invitational in early March. Mendoza carded a 7-under 209, while Ree was one stroke behind at 6-under to finish alone in fourth.
- After another third-place effort at the Lamkin San Diego Classic, which featured additional top-10 placements by Mendoza (T-3rd), Michelini (T-9th) and Ree (T-9th), SDSU claimed its second team title of the year at the Barona Collegiate Cup on March 22. The Aztecs (-26) won in convincing style, topping second-place Minnesota (+16) by a whopping 42 strokes. Brian Song was SDSU's

top golfer, finishing solo second at 6-under 210, while Ree (T-3rd), Michelini (T-5th), Gunn Yang (T-5th) and Mendoza (T-9th) all landed in the top 10.

- Mendoza leads the squad with 18 rounds below par, followed closely by Michelini and Ree, who have 15 to their credit. Ree has amassed a team-best 12 rounds in the 60s, while Mendoza has carded 10 sub-70 rounds.
- Three of SDSU's five starters in the Albuquerque have turned in a round of 65 during the regular season, which is tied for seventh on the Aztecs' all-time list for lowest 18-hole score. Ree and Michelini accomplished the feat in the second and third round, respectively, at the Alister MacKenzie Invitational, while Samiere logged his lowest second-lowest collegiate tally as an individual competitor in final round of the Barona Collegiate Cup.
- Pablo Matesanz also recorded his first victory in a Scarlet and Black uniform this season, emerging triumphant as an individual competitor at the Western Illinois Invitational on Feb. 16, held at Carleton Oaks Country Club in nearby Santee, Calif.

• Nahum Mendoza III has been named to the 2016 Arnold Palmer Cup as announced April 16 by the Golf Coaches Association of America. With his selection, the Aztec junior becomes the first SDSU player to compete in the prestigious tournament since former All-American Aaron Goldberg in 2008. Mendoza is one of 10 collegiate players who will represent the United States against their European counterparts in the 20th annual event, which features a Ryder Cup-style format. This year's Arnold Palmer Cup is scheduled for June 24-26 at Formby Golf Club in Formby, England.

Just A Chip Shot Away

The top five schools and two individuals (not on those qualifying teams) will advance out of the Albuquerque Regional to the NCAA championships, May 27-June 1, at Eugene Country Club in Eugene, Ore. The Aztecs have qualified for the national championships 28 times in school history, including seven occasions (1999, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2015) since the regional format made its debut.

A total of 30 teams and six individuals will play 54 holes of

stroke play over a three-day period to determine the individual national champion. The final three days will feature match play between the top eight squads for the national team title.

Head Coach Ryan Donovan

Ryan Donovan is in his 13th season at the helm of the SDSU men's golf program after serving as an assistant in 2003. Since taking the reins, he has directed the Aztecs to 28 tournament titles and five NCAA national championship appearances. In 2011, 2012 and 2015, he received Mountain West Coach of the Year honors and was named a finalist for the Dave Williams Award, which is handed out annually to the national coach of the year in Division I men's golf. Donovan was also was tabbed the Eaton Golf Pride West Region Division I Men's Coach of the Year by the GCAA following the 2010-11 campaign. A native of Yorba Linda, Calif., Donovan was a four-year member of the Aztec golf squad before graduating in 2001.
