One of the top players to ever put on a SDSU uniform ... Helped the Aztecs to backto-back NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Sweet 16 berth in 2011, two straight MWC Tournament championships and a share of the 2011 MWC regular season title... Guided the Aztecs to 59 victories over two seasons, including a program-best 34 wins in his final campaign (2010-11).

Won the award on Feb. 15 after averaging 19.5 points and 11.0 rebounds in wins over Wyoming and No. 23/25 UNLV ... MWC co-player of the week on Dec. 14 after averaging 18.0 points, 15.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists in wins over CS Fullerton and Arizona...
