THIS WEEKEND

San Diego State returns to the field this weekend as it heads to Cal Poly on Friday, Aug. 29, before returning to The Mesa to host Arizona State on Sunday (Aug. 31). The Aztecs will square off with the Mustangs at 7 p.m. PT at Alex G. Spanos Stadium. The home opener, meanwhile, will be an afternoon game with kickoff slated for 1 p.m. (PT) at SDSU Sports Deck.

SERIES HISTORY VS. CAL POLY

San Diego State leads in its all-time series with Cal Poly by a 3-2 count. The Aztecs pulled ahead with a 1-0 victory in San Diego last year. SDSU is 1-2 when playing in San Luis Obispo.

SCOUTING THE MUSTANGS

In its season opener, Cal Poly dropped a 2-1 decision to Brigham Young at Alex G. Spanos Stadium. Two days later, the Mustangs were shut out, 1-0, at Arizona. Junior goalkeeper Coral Hoover racked up nine saves on the weekend, while senior forward Ashley Vallis tallied Cal Poly's lone goal.

The Mustangs, who were picked to finish third in the Big West Conference preseason coaches' poll, return seven starters and two all-BWC selections from last year's squad that fell to Cal State Fullerton in a shootout in the conference tournament championship. Cal Poly also has five of its top six scorers from 2007, including all-BWC first-team selection Carrie Andrews. Hoover has stepped in as the starting goalkeeper after appearing in just one game last season.

SERIES HISTORY VS. ARIZONA STATE

Arizona State claimed the bragging rights between the two teams last year with a 3-0 victory in Tempe, Ariz. The all-time series is currently tied at 2-2-1, while the Aztecs are 1-0-1 against the Sun Devils in San Diego.

SCOUTING THE SUN DEVILS

Arizona State kicked off its season with a 4-2 victory over Northern Arizona last weekend. Sophomore forward Karin Volpe paced the Sun Devil attack with a pair of goals, while junior goalkeeper Katie Cochran anchored the defensive effort with six saves.

ASU returns seven starters from a 2007 squad that went 10-9-1 and tied for fifth in the Pac-10 Conference. Volpe led the Sun Devils in goals (5), points (12) and shots (35) and became the first freshman to lead the team in scoring since the 2002 campaign.

Arizona State also welcomes back sophomore midfielder and 2007 all-Pac-10 freshman team selection Alexandra Easton, as well as senior defender Kylla Sjoman, who led ASU with seven assists a year ago.

LAST TIME OUT

San Diego State opened the 2008 campaign with a tough 2-1 double overtime loss at Cal State Northridge on Friday, Aug. 22. Junior Heather Vandevanter scored her fifth career goal to get the Aztecs on the board, but it wasn't enough as the Matadors responded in the second half and tallied the game-winner in the 105th minute.

"We had several chances to win the game in both regulation and overtime, but didn't capitalize on those opportunities," said second-year Aztec head coach Mike Friesen. "It was a disappointing start to the season but we are still excited about this team."

Vandevanter got the Scarlet and Black out to a 1-0 lead at the break, scoring on an assist from sophomore Britney Bennett at the 41:57 mark. CSUN evened the game in the second half before Nalena Betancourt was able to slip the ball past Aztec goalkeeper Aubree Southwick off a corner kick for the game-winner in the second overtime period.

Vandevanter paced the Aztec offense with four shots, while senior Alicia Piz had three. Sophomore goalkeeper Aubree Southwick tallied four saves in the loss.

THE COACHES

After spending three years as an assistant on the San Diego State coaching staff, including two as associate head coach, Mike Friesen enters his second season as the Aztecs' head coach. In 2007, Friesen led SDSU to a 4-2-1 conference record, marking its most league wins since the 2000 campaign.

Nat Gonzalez, who spent three seasons as the associate head coach at Southern California and was the head men's soccer coach at UC Riverside prior to his stint at USC, is in his second year on The Mesa. Gonzalez was a four-year goalkeeper at UCLA from 1988-91 and was a member of the Bruins' 1990 national championship squad.

Jayme Hardwick enters her first season as a member of the SDSU women's soccer coaching staff. Hardwick was a four-year letterwinner as a midfielder at Purdue from 2002-05.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

San Diego State is looking forward to an eightgame home schedule. In 2007, five of the Aztecs' nine victories were won at SDSU Sports Deck. In its home opener on Sunday, Aug. 31, the Scarlet and Black will be looking to revenge last year's 3-0 loss to Arizona State. The Aztecs and Sun Devils will square off at 1 p.m.

2008 CAPTAINS

This season, the Aztec women's soccer team will have two captains in junior defender Millie Allen and redshirt sophomore midfielder Cat Walker.

Allen, a 2007 all-MWC second-team selection, appeared in every game last season. The Thornton, Colo., native scored her first career goal against Cal Poly (Sept. 14) and added the game-winner in the Aztecs' 1-0 upset over Arizona on Sept. 30. Allen has earned the starting nod in 46 career contests.

Walker was named a co-captain last year but suffered a season-ending injury in an exhibition game. As a freshman in 2006, the Folsom, Calif., native started 17 of the 19 contests she appeared in and tied for second on the team with three goals scored.

IN THE BOOKS

San Diego State returns its top goalkeeper from a year ago in sophomore Aubree Southwick. The Danville, Calif., native started 20 games in 2007, playing in all but 82 minutes during the season. Southwick wasted no time in etching her name in the SDSU record books, racking up a single-season leading 106 saves. On the career charts, she currently ranks second in goals against average (0.95) and is tied for fourth in shutouts (10). Also, with her four blocks last weekend, Southwick is just 23 stops away from breaking into the all-time top five saves leaders at SDSU.

BACK FOR MORE

The Aztecs return 17 letterwinners and seven starters from a 2007 squad that posted a 9-8-3 mark and finished second in the Mountain West Conference regular season standings. SDSU, which was picked to finish fourth in a conference preseason poll, also had its best league record (4-2-1) since the 2000 campaign when the Scarlet and Black went 4-2.

Returning starters from last season include seniors Alicia Piz and Jillian Riker, juniors Millie Allen, Allie Crowson, Ali Lokanc and Heather Vandevanter, and sophomore All-American Aubree Southwick.

FRESH FACES

Several freshmen are expected to make an immediate impact in their first year on The Mesa. Three newcomers, Gretel Amman (D), Megan McQueeny (D), and Tiffany Hurst (MF), earned the starting nod at Cal State Northridge (Aug. 22), while Taylor Canatsey (F) and Jamie Nelson (MF) also made their collegiate debuts in the season opener.

In all, the Aztecs welcome 10 newcomers in 2008. The remainder of the freshman class are Allie Brown (MF), Julia Flores (D), Megan Allaire (GK), Christina Palomino (GK) and Jackie Spinner (D).

Mike Friesen Head Coach Second Season/Fifth Overall at SDSU Sonoma State, 1996

After spending three years as an assistant on the San Diego State coaching staff, including two as associate head coach, Mike Friesen enters his second season as the Aztecs' head coach.

Friesen, the fourth head coach in Aztec history, has played a significant role in bringing excitement back to San Diego State soccer. An offensive standout in his playing days at Point Loma Nazarene (1988-89) and Sonoma State (1993-94), Friesen has helped the Aztecs become one of the most potent offenses in the West Coast.

As an associate head coach at SDSU, the Aztecs netted 28 goals in 2005, the most for the program since 2002. In 2004, SDSU reached the Mountain West Conference championship game for the first time since 1999. The team's 3-1-2 conference record was also its best since that same 1999 season.

Friesen teamed with former Aztec head coach Dr. Mike Giuliano to bring an up-tempo-in-your-face style of defense, which was successful, as evident by the team's nine shutouts in 2004, second most in school history. The Aztecs allowed just 18 goals in 21 games that season, the program's fewest since the 1990 squad gave up 12 goals in 13 games.

Prior to coming to San Diego State, Friesen spent five years working with the UC Santa Barbara women's program.

Upon arriving in Santa Barbara, Friesen helped turn the Gaucho program around, going from a 7-29-2 mark and scoring just 27 goals the two seasons prior to his arrival, to a 24-11-6 mark in 2002-03, tallying 105 scores.

Friesen has a great deal of experience coaching at a variety of levels. Before his time at UCSB, he guided the under-19 Santa Rosa United Aftershocks to the 1999 girls' California State Cup championship. In 1997, he directed Ursuline High School in Santa Rosa, Calif., to the CIF North Coast Section championship game.

2007 POSTSEASON HONORS

Goalkeeper Aubree Southwick racked up the awards last season, becoming the first player in Mountain West Conference history to earn two individual awards when she was tabbed the defensive player of the year and freshman of the year. The first-team all-MWC pick also garnered freshman All-America recognition.

Joining Southwick on the all-MWC first team was Jackie Ragudos, while Millie Allen and Jessica Girdner were both selected to the second team.

SDSU SPLITS PAIR OF EXHIBITION GAMES

San Diego State opened exhibition play with a 2-1 loss to Long Beach State at George Allen Field on Saturday, Aug. 16. The Aztecs held an early 1-0 lead after Cat Walker found the back of the net at the 12:58 mark of the first period, but the 49ers came storming back with a pair of second-half goals from Hayley Bolt.

SDSU returned to action two days later, playing host to UC San Diego. After a scoreless first half, the Aztecs came out of the break firing, with goals from Walker and freshman Taylor Canatsey. SDSU's defense was able to shut down UCSD the rest of the way, holding on for the 2-0 victory.

SDSU PICKED TO FINISH IN TIE FOR THIRD

San Diego State was picked to finish in a tie for third place with Utah in the Mountain West Conference regular season standings. The Aztecs and Utes each received 36 points in the 2008 preseason coaches' poll, while Brigham Young was tabbed as the favorite with 49 points.
