Gael Spotlight

• Already garnering national attention, Aidan Mahaney has been named to the Jerry West, John Wooden and Naismith Award Watchlists to open the season

• The Gaels opened the season ranked no. 23 in the AP Preseason top-25 poll. It is the first time since the 2019-20 season that the Gaels have appeared in the AP Preseason Top-25 poll, and the fourth time in the last eight years (2023-24, 2019-20, 2017-18, 2016-17).

• Saint Mary's Was selected to finish atop the WCC standings in the 2023-24 WCC Preseason Coaches Poll. This marks the first time since 2017-18 that the Gaels were selected as preseason conference favorites.

• Aidan Mahaney, Alex Ducas and Mitchell Saxen were all named to the preseason All-WCC team. The trio of returning starters for the Gaels look to be the focal point of this season's team. The Gaels and Gonzaga tied for the most preseason all-conference selections, each with three.

• The Gaels are coming off of back to back trips to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history. It was the fourth time in the current NCAA tournament format that the Gaels were able to reach the second round, having done so in 2010, 2017, 2022 and 2023.

About Saint Mary's

» SMC concludes the 2022-23 season with the second highest winning percentage (.744) and 3rd-most NCAA Tournament appearances (4) of any NCAA Division I men's basketball program in the state of California over the last decade.

» Saint Mary's has the ninth best win percentage of any Div. I team in the nation over the last 10 years.

» SMC has a 124-46 record (.729) winning percentage against non-conference opponents over the last 10 years.

» Over the past 10 years, SMC posted a 123-39 (.759) overall record in West Coast Conference play.

» Saint Mary's has participated in postseason (9 NCAA, 7 NIT) in each of the last 16 seasons, the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA behind Kansas, Michigan State, and Gonzaga.

» Saint Mary's has finished t-2nd or higher in the WCC in 16 of the last 20 seasons.

» SMC has won 25 or more games 13 times in the last 20 seasons.

» The Gaels went 30-6 in the regular season of 2017-18, marking the most single-season wins in program history.

» Former SMC standouts Patrick Mills, Jock Landale and Jordan Ford, began the season on active NBA rosters. Mills won the NBA title in 2014 with San Antonio and was traded from Brooklyn to Atlanta this summer. Landale signed with Houston this summer. Ford made his NBA debut with the Kings in their opener at Utah.

WHAT A START FOR WESSELS

Sophomore center Harry Wessels continues to be the most potent scoring option off the bench for Coach Bennett's squad. After scoring in double figures just once all of last season, the Aussie big man has scored in double-digits in each of the first three games of his sophomore season. Wessels has scored 11, 12, and 11 in his first three contests this season respectively, shooting an incredible 82.4% from the field (14-17). The center is also averaging 6.3 rebounds per contest and 1.7 blocks per game, truly showing his value off the bench.

MAHANEY SETS THE TONE VS UNM

In the Gaels wire-to-wire victory over UNM, Aidan Mahaney truly set the tone with a monster first half. The sophomore dropped 21 points on 8-16 shooting in the first frame, helping the Gaels to a 15 point halftime lead. The 21 points in a single half was the highest in Aidan's career, and the most by a Gael since Matthias Tass scored 22 in the second half against San Francisco in the 2021-22 season. Mahaney finished with 25 in the game, matching his career-high.

GAELS INK THREE ON NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

Head Coach Randy Bennett has announced the signing of three future Gaels to kick off college basketball's early signing period, as Joshua Dent, Mikey Lewis and Zion Sensley all signed their National Letters of Intent to play for the Gaels. This stellar recruiting class will be the first in Gaels history to feature multiple players in the ESPN100 rankings (Lewis and Sensley).

Dent is a sure-handed point guard, who can both score and distribute the ball. He

played alongside Rory Hawke and Jensen Bradtke at the Australian Centre of Excellence. Lewis is the 83rd ranked player in the ESPN100, and is a high volume scorer who can play the one or two coming out of Prolific Prep. Sensley is the 54th ranked player in the ESPN100, and is a well-sized wing at 6-8, who can score inside and out and is a physical rebounder, coming out of Rioradan HS.

RECORD BREAKING SEASON OPENER

The Gaels opened their season with a dominant display of excellence against Stanislaus State, using their size and physicality to stifle the scrappy Warriors in a 107-28 victory.

The 79 point margin of victory marked the largest in program history. The previous record belonged to the 2010-11 Gaels, who defeated Chicago State by a 121-52 tally. The 28 points allowed marked the fewest points allowed by the Gaels in a single game since the 2016-17 team held San Diego to 27 points.

HOOPS FOR A CAUSE

The Gaels opened their 2023-24 campaign with a charity exhibition in Hawai'i on October 20, as they took on the Warriors to raise money for those affected by the Maui Wildfires.

"It's always an excellent opportunity to take on a quality opponent like the University of Hawai'i in exhibition play, but this adds an extra bonus for our team to help those in need," Saint Mary's head coach Randy Bennett said. "The wildfires in Maui are a great tragedy and we are grateful for the opportunity to help those in need through this game."

already in the preseason tune up, picking up a 92-58 victory over the Rainbow Warriors. The backcourt duo of Augustas Marciulionis and Aidan Mahaney combined for 47 points on 62% shooting from the field, while Luke Barrett demonstrated his physicality on the glass with eight rebounds in 16 minutes of play.

The meeting also served as a reunion for two coaches with a close bond. Bennett gave Hawai'i Head Coach Eran Ganot his first collegiate coaching job 20 years ago as a volunteer assistant at Saint Mary's. Ganot eventually served as Bennett's associate head coach with the Gaels before he eventually took the helm at Hawai'i in 2015.

WELCOME TO MORAGA

Coach Bennett welcomed three incoming freshman to his 2023-24 roster, as Jordan Ross, Andrew McKeever and Jensen Bradtke will all be a part of this year's squad.

A heavily recruited point guard out of Pleasant Grove, Utah, Jordan Ross, comes to Saint Mary's as the 15th ranked PG in his class according to 24/7 Sports. Most recently, Ross led Arizona Compass Prep to the Geico High School National Championship game. A talented ball distributor, Ross led that AZ Compass team in assists.

Standing at a towering 7-1, Andrew McKeever makes his way to Moraga from nearby Livermore. A star at Granada High School, McKeever averaged 22 points, 12 rebounds, and five assists a season ago, leading his team to the CIF Division I State Championship game. McKeever was selected as both a first team All-East Bay Athletic League honoree and a second team All-State honoree.

Continuing the strong Australian tradition at Saint Mary's, Jensen Bradtke will be the 24th Aussie to join Coach Bennett's squad all-time, and the fourth active Gaels from Australia. Bradtke averaged 10 points and seven boards per contests at the Centre of Excellence last season, and 16 points and six rebounds per contest while playing for Team Victoria in the U20 Australian Championships. Coming from an athletic lineage, Jensen's father, Mark, is an Australian Basketball Hall of Famer.

THEY'RE BACK

Saint Mary's returns three of their starting five from a season ago, as Aidan Mahaney, Alex Ducas, and Mitchell Saxen will all be back in action for the Gaels. Last year, that trio averaged 38 points per contest,

making more than half of the Gaels 70.7 point per game average. Other key returners include Augustas Marciulionis, who appeared in every game a season ago, big man Harry Wessels, who adds depth behind Mitchell Saxen at the center position, and Luke Barrett, who showed great versatility as both a scorer and rebounder off the bench a year ago.

BIG DANCE RECAP

The fifth-seeded Gaels opened up the 2023 NCAA Tournament with a matchup against 12th-seeded VCU. Fueled by the first double-double of Logan Johnson's career, the Gaels shook of a slow start to handle the Rams 63-51. Alex Ducas and Mitchell Saxen both made huge contributions on both ends of the court, with both scoring 17 points, Ducas recording a career-high five steals, and Saxen recording a career-high four blocks.

Saint Mary's next drew fourth-seeded UConn, and continued their ferocious play through the first half against the Huskies. The Gaels led for a majority of the first half and took just a one point deficit into the lockerroom. The second half, however, belonged to UConn, who's defense held Saint Mary's to just 25 second half points en route to a 70-55 victory. Logan Johnson played all 40 minutes of what would prove to be his final collegiate contest, leading the Gaels with nine points, seven rebounds, four assists and four steals.

FORD DEBUTS WITH KINGS

In their season opener against the Utah Jazz in Salt Lake City, Gael great Jordan Ford made his NBA debut. Ford becomes the 11th Gael to play in the NBA, five of which were coached by Head Coach Randy Bennett.

POSTSEASON ACCOLADES

As a guard, Johnson doesn't put up block totals or rebounding numbers like some of the best big men in the country, but he locks down defenders as well as any player in the WCC. His overall defensive game has taken a huge step forward this season, which has helped lead the Gaels to the fourth-best scoring defense in the NCAA. Johnson has 48 steals on the year, which ranks sixth in the conference, but his 144 as a Gael are the fifth most in program history. He also has set a career-best in rebounding average at 4.9 per game.

Aidan Mahaney was named First Team All-WCC as a freshman, which also puts him on the All-Freshman team in the conference. This puts Mahaney in rare air, joining Patty Mills as the only other Gael to be named to the All-WCC team as a freshman. He is the

leading scorer for a freshman in the conference (14.6 points per game), a rank that is top-15 in the entire NCAA. He owns the second-most 20-point games by a Saint Mary's freshman, again behind Mills, and ends the regular season shooting 40.9% from beyond the arc.

Mitchell Saxen has seen a meteoric rise in his stock this season after joining the Gaels starting lineup, and he's made the most of it, finishing with first team honors. After making every start during the regular season, Saxen ranks amongst some of the best big men in the conference in points per game (11.8), rebounds per game (8.0, second-best in the conference), and blocks (37, leads in the conference). His first eight collegiate double-doubles came this year, and he's shooting 55% from the floor. Prior to this season, Saxen had never averaged more than 3.3 points per game and 2.3 rebounds per game.

Alex Ducas lands on the honorable mention list after another great season of sharp-shooting from beyond the arc. Ducas is averaging a career-best 12.3 points per game while also setting a new career-best with a 41.6% three-point percentage. His 79 made three-pointers are the seventh-most in a single season in Saint Mary's history, and are third most in the conference. He will finish his senior season as one of the best shooters in Saint Mary's history, ranking seventh actively in three-pointers made as a Gael, with a real chance to move into the top-five after postseason play.

For the second year in a row, Randy Bennett has been named the conference's Coach of the Year. He is the first coach not named Mark Few to win the award in consecutive seasons since Brad Holland of San Diego from 1999-2000. This is the fifth time that Bennett has won the award since his first win in 2008.

BALL DISTRIBUTION IS KEY

Over the past five seasons, Saint Mary's is 91-14 in games with 10 or more assists and 22-30 in games with nine or fewer.

DANCING HISTORY

Saint Mary's made their 13th appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2023. Previous years at the Big Dance include: 1959, 1989, 1997, 2005, 2008, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2017, 2019, 2020 (COVID-19), and 2022.

The team's most successful run was in 2010 when the Gaels defeated VCU then upset 2-seed Villanova in Providence, R.I. to advance to the Sweet 16.

Randy Bennett, Saint Mary's Head Coach

A five-time West Coast Conference Coach of the Year (2023, 2022, 2016, 2011, 2008) and 2010 Sporting News WCC Coach of the Year, Randy Bennett, took over as the head men's basketball coach prior to the 2001-02 season.

On Nov. 10, 2017, Saint Mary's and head coach Randy Bennett announced the signing of a new 10-year contract that will keep Bennett in charge of the program through the 2026-27 season. In 2022-23, Bennett led the Gaels to their 16th straight postseason appearance and a number-five seed in the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season.

Entering his 23rd season, he is the school's all-time wins leader, guided SMC to 16 post-season appearances (9 NCAA and 7 NIT), led the Gaels to their first post-season victory and had a player drafted (Patrick Mills, 2009) by the NBA for the first time since 1984. Two Gaels are currently playing in the NBA.

Bennett is second all-time among WCC coaches in career league wins and has a 507-208 (.709) record while compiling a 238-93 (.719) mark in WCC regular-season competition heading into the 2023-24 season. Bennett became the winningest coach at SMC when the Gaels defeated East Tennessee State in the semifinals of the Rainbow Classic on December 21, 2007, passing James Weaver (110-67), who held the record for 47 years.

He has led SMC to at least the semifinals of the WCC Tournament in 20 of his past 21 seasons, and 13 championship game appearances. His side captured WCC Tournament titles in 2010, 2012, and 2019.

In addition to team accomplishments, Bennett has had 48 players earn All-WCC recognition, with 39 first team and nine honorable mention selections. He coached Mickey McConnell, Matthew Dellavedova and Jock Landale to WCC Player of the Year honors. In 2011, he served as an assistant coach for the USA team that competed in the FIBA U19 World Championship. in Latvia.

BIG WINS OVER LAST FEW SEASONS

Bennett earned his 500th win at Saint Mary's on Feb. 2, 2023 in a home win over San Francisco. For reference, Bennett won his 400th career game as head coach, all with Saint Mary's, on Dec. 19, 2018 versus Bucknell.

Bennett has also been the head coach of the only two wins in SMC history over the No. 1 team in the country: the 2019 WCC Championship game over Gonzaga, and the home finale of the 2021-22 season, also over Gonzaga.

BENNETT HAS LASTING POWER

With a few high-profile coaches retiring this past summer, Randy Bennett is now the sixth-longest tenured head coach with one program amongst active coaches in the NCAA.

Greg Kampe leads the list, having led Oakland since the 1984-5 season. Mark Few is the only active WCC coach who has held a longer tenure with his current team (started in 1999-2000).
