Miscellaneous Statistics

2007 NOTES

▶ The Aztecs went 32-24, the eighth time in the last nine seasons they finished .500 or better.

▶ San Diego State defeated two top-10 teams - No. 6 Oregon State (1-0 on Feb. 8) and No. 10 Texas (3-0 on Feb. 18).

▶ SDSU went 4-6 against top-25 schools with three of the losses coming by one run.

▶ The Aztecs bettered their school record set a year ago with a .296 batting average. In addition, they set season-best marks with 238 runs and 593 total bases.

▶ San Diego State went 22-4 when it scored first and 12-3 when it scored in the first inning. In addition, the Aztecs were 21-1 when scoring five or more runs and 22-1 when leading after five innings.

▶ SDSU used 50 different batting lineups in its 56 games and 39 different fielding set-ups.

▶ Freshman Brittany Knudsen was named a second-team NFCA All-West selection and all-MWC pick after batting .386, the third-highest average in school history. In addition, she ranked among the school single-season leaders in on-base percentage (2nd, .464), runs (third, 39), slugging percentage (5th, .524), hits (T-5th, 64), total bases (T-5th, 87), walks (T-5th, 24) and home runs (T-7th, 4).

▶ Junior Christina Ross led the MWC and ranked among SDSU's all-time leaders in ERA (1.90), innings pitched (228.2), wins (23) and appearances (45). In addition, Ross, who garnered all-MWC honors for the second straight season, was second in the league in opposing batting average (.229), strikeouts (201), games started (33) and saves (2). The highlight of the season came on March 28 when she threw the first known perfect game in school history in SDSU's 8-0 win over Brown.

▶ Freshman Lindsey Marquez joined Knudsen and Ross on the all-MWC squad after batting a team-best .404 in league play to go along with 11 runs and nine RBI.

▶ Sophomore Melissa Owens was SDSU's final all-conference pick after ranking among the MWC leaders in both batting average (.341) and ERA (2.11).

▶ Junior Tamani Wells continued her improvement with a .333 average, while sophomore Monica Alnes led the squad with 25 RBI and tied for the team lead with four homers.
