### AZTECS HOSTS AIR FORCE & BOISE STATE FOR CONFERENCE MATCHES

- ◆ San Diego State returns home this week for a pair of Mountain West matches.
- ◆ The Aztecs will be in action on Thursday, Oct. 13, when they host Air Force at 7:00 p.m. (PT) on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ SDSU continues league play on Saturday, Oct. 15, with a contest against conference newcomer Boise State at 1:00 p.m.

### SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State holds a 27-2 mark in its previous 29 meetings with Air Force. The teams first met in 1996 while both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. Air Force's first win over SDSU came in Colorado Springs in 1999. The Falcons ended a 22-match losing streak at the hands of the Aztecs last season when they won a four-set decision in Colorado Springs. The Aztecs are 14-0 vs. the Falcons in San Diego, 12-2 in Colorado Springs and 1-0 at neutral sites.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Boise State have just once previously. That match occurred at the Red Raider Classic in Lubbock, Texas, during the 2005 season with SDSU taking a three-set win.

### SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Air Force enters the week with a record of 3-15 overall and 0-5 in the Mountain West. The Falcons have lost each of their last nine matches. Air Force is led by opposite hitter Cami Richan (2.93 kills, 1.92 digs per set) and middle blocker Ayesha Hein (2.75 kills, 0.63 blocks per set). The Falcons lead the conference in service aces with an average of 1.36 per set led by Josalyn Wise (0.27 per set).
- ◆ Boise State's record stands at 11-9 (2-3 MW) after it dropped a four-set decision at Utah Valley on Tuesday. The Broncos, in their first year in the Mountain West, are led by Liz Harden (2.68 kills, 0.54 digs per set) and Fiona Jones (2.47 kills, 2.53 digs per set). Middle blocker Darlene Nwagbuo is from San Diego where she attended Crawford High and San Diego City College.

### HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her two-year record at SDSU is 41-37.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 15-year career record stands at 202-227.
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.



### WIN NO. 200

- ◆ With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.
- ◆ She is in her 15th season as a collegiate head coach having previously held that position at UNLV and Colgate.

### NEW ASSISTANT COACH

- ◆ Former Aztec player Melanie Greene has been named the Aztecs' new assistant coach for the 2011 season. She replaces Andrea Leonard, who took the head coaching job at CSU San Marcos.
- ◆ A three-year starter as an outside hitter, she averaged 3.46 kills and 2.73 digs per set while leading the team in kills and finishing among the top three in digs each season.
- ◆ During her senior season as team co-captain and MVP, Greene ranked fourth in the Mountain West in kill average (3.68 per game), recorded 12 double-doubles (kills-digs) and concluded her career ranked 13th in that category.

- ◆ Greene graduated from San Diego State in 2007 with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration. She completed her master's degree in leadership and organizational studies at Azusa Pacific in 2010.

### SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011. It is the first weekly honor for Shelton, who shared the award with Wyoming outside hitter Jodi Purdy.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Against New Mexico on Sunday, Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.
- ◆ Her eight digs at New Mexico tied her career best.
- ◆ Her 14 kills and 16.5 points against Cal State Fullerton (Sept. 20) were season highs as well.
- ◆ She is averaging 3.56 kills per set through five Mountain West matches.

## HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She had new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points against the Horned Frogs.
- ◆ Hannasch tied her Aztec bets with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her 20 kills and 11 blocks at TCU were her third double-double of the season and sixth of her career.
- ◆ Her .486 hitting percentage against TCU was her second-highest mark in a match this season.
- ◆ She leads the San Diego State offense in blocks, service aces and points.
- ◆ She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories along with kills.
- ◆ Hannasch ranks 33rd in blocking in this week's NCAA Division I statistics.

## HARRIS HEATS UP

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris, a sophomore transfer from Western Michigan, has started each of the last 10 matches after not appearing in SDSU's first five contests of the year.
- ◆ She set career highs with eight blocks, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at new Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ She also tied her career highs with 15 kills vs. the Lobos in that match.
- ◆ Over the last three matches she has a .493 hitting percentage,
- ◆ Her previous best effort came at UC Riverside (Sept. 25) where she recorded season highs in kills (15) and blocks (7) along with a .481 hitting percentage.

## FOUCH ASSISTS

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch set a career high 65 assists in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.24 assists per set.
- ◆ That mark ranks 19th in NCAA Division I this week.
- ◆ Fouch set a career high with six total blocks in the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29. Her five blocks assists were her personal best as an Aztec as well.
- ◆ She has averaged just one block per set over the Aztecs last five matches (21 blocks in 21 sets).
- ◆ Her average of 2.51 digs per set is second only to libero Kristi Jackels. She averaged 3.20 digs per set in last week's matches at TCU and New Mexico.

- ◆ She has recorded seven double-doubles (assists-digs) in 2011, the latest being a 53 assist-14 dig effort at New Mexico last Sunday (Oct. 9).
- ◆ Fouch is hitting .362 (32k-7e-69att) from her setter position and has had only one attack error in SDSU's last four matches.

## JACKELS DIGGIN' IT

- ◆ Junior libero Kristi Jackels totaled 50 digs in last week's two road matches to average 5.00 per set in that pair of contests
- ◆ She has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,152 digs to rank fifth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ She ranks second in the conference this week with an average of 0.35 service aces per set in league matches.
- ◆ She is also second in digs in Mountain West play at 4.55 per set.
- ◆ Jackels has reached double figures in digs in every match with a high of 26 vs. Tulane on Sept. 2.

### PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- ◆ Senior Paije Pearson had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ She set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ In the match at UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- ◆ Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- ◆ In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

### TOUGH AS STEEL

- ◆ Freshman right side hitter Chaiymin Steel had a career-high 12 digs in the victory at TCU last week (Oct. 6).
- ◆ She also contributed four blocks in that contest.
- ◆ She is averaging 1.95 kills and 1.35 digs in SDSU's last six matches.
- ◆ She had the best match of her young Aztec career in the win at UC Riverside on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She finished with 10 kills while hitting .357, both highs for the first-year player from Reno, Nev.
- ◆ She also had a personal-best seven blocks and tied her season high with four digs.

### SEXTON RETURNS

- ◆ Senior outside hitter Kiley Sexton, who missed four matches after spraining her ankle in practice on Monday, Sept. 19, returned to the floor vs. Colorado State on Sunday (Oct. 2).
- ◆ She saw limited playing time in that contest (she did not start) and finished with seven kills, an assist and a dig.
- ◆ She recorded 13 kills in the win at TCU, her second-best total of the 2011 campaign.
- ◆ Sexton had a career-high four service aces in the three-set win over Nevada on Aug. 27.

### WORKING OVERTIME

- ◆ Last week's wins at TCU and New Mexico marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).

- ◆ SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 4-1 in five-set matches this season.

### THE RECORD BOOK

- ◆ A trio of Aztecs will make their marks in the SDSU career record listings before the end of the 2011 season.
- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels' 1,152 digs is fifth on the Aztec top 10. Fourth place is currently held by Ginger Ernest (1993-96) with 1,154 career digs.
- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch has moved into the No. nine spot in career assists with 1,902. Former Aztec Melissa Stokes (1986-88) ranks ninth on the list with 2,239 assists.
- ◆ In addition, Andrea Hannasch needs eight block assists to catch Rene Pankopf (1983-86) for the No. 10 spot on that list.

### AMONG THE MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- ◆ After the first six weeks of the season, three Aztecs appear among the top 10 in the Mountain West in various statistical categories both overall and in Mountain West matches only. (Stats are per set except for hitting percentage).

- ◆ San Diego State fields one of the youngest teams in the nation according to a recent survey.
- ◆ The total of 14 freshmen and sophomores on the SDSU roster is the second-most in the country, behind only Air Force (15).
- ◆ As a percentage of the squad, the Aztecs are made up of 73.6% underclassmen, the seventh highest figure in NCAA Division I volleyball.

### MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch earned Mountain West Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It is the third weekly honor of her career.
- ◆ Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26. Her 23.5 points in the match were a career best.
- ◆ In the 3-2 win against Portland, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. The Aztecs beat Nevada, 3-0, in the nightcap with a team-high 12 kills and five blocks from Hannasch.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

### FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

### ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Paije Pearson were named to the all-tourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.

- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

### ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Kyle Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- ◆ Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

### PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- ◆ The Mountain West coaches and media poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish third in the eight-team league. It is SDSU's highest preseason conference ranking since joining the league in 1999.
- ◆ In the 12 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished second (2002), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003), fifth (2005), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final standings.
- ◆ Colorado State has been chosen to defend its Mountain West title from a year ago with New Mexico picked to finish second. The results of the preseason poll are as follows:

### ATHLETIC RELATIVES

- ◆ Two members of the Aztecs have notable athletic connections in their family.
- ◆ Redshirt freshman Oni Lattin's grandfather, David Lattin, was a member of the 1966 Texas Western (now UTEP) basketball team under Don Haskins that upset Kentucky for the national title.
- ◆ Emily Harris' father, Al Harris, played defensive end and linebacker for the Chicago Bears from 1979-84 and 1986-88 before finishing his career with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1989-90.
- ◆ In addition, assistant coach Melanie Greene's dad, Ken Greene, played pro football with the San Diego Chargers and St. Louis Cardinals.

### AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ As a team San Diego State stands second in the conference in kills, assists and service aces in all matches.
- ◆ SDSU is averaging 14.38 kills per set over its last five matches.
- ◆ Summer Nash had only one kill on one attempt in the win at TCU (Oct. 6), but it was an important one as it was the match winner in the fifth and deciding set.
- ◆ Kyla Oropeza tied her career high with two service aces at TCU.
- ◆ San Diego State's .387 hitting percentage in that match vs. Wyoming on Sept. 29 was its highest of the season.
- ◆ The team's 11 service aces against Cal State Fullerton (Sept. 20) were a season high.
- ◆ Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels).
- ◆ Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match.
- ◆ Fouch and Kristi Jackels have appeared in every set in 2011.
- ◆ SDSU captured the titles at a pair of in-season tournament titles in 2011. The Aztecs won the Aztec Invitational with a 3-0 mark and were declared co-champions of the Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic at Tulane along with Southern Illinois when that tourney was cut short due to weather.
- ◆ The Aztec roster has three sophomore transfers from four-year schools: Andrea Terpstra (Pacific), Emily Harris (Western Michigan) and Courtney Vaccarello (Oregon).

### UP NEXT

- ◆ San Diego State will make the short trip across Mission Valley to face the 17th-ranked University of San Diego on Tuesday, Oct. 18, at 7:00 p.m. at USD's Jenny Craig Pavilion.
- ◆ The Aztecs will return home next Friday, Nov. 21, as they resume Mountain West action against UNLV at 6:00 p.m. on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ The contest against UNLV will be televised live on The MTN network.
