### WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEK IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ Following Tuesday night's 3-2 loss to UC Riverside in 10 innings, San Diego State will resume league play this weekend when it hosts a three-game series vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ That set gets underway on Thursday, March 24, with a contest scheduled to start at 6:00 p.m. (MT) at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Lobos will also hook up for games on Friday (March 25) and Saturday (March 26) at 6:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.
- ◆ The series is being played Thursday through Sunday due to Easter falling next Sunday.

### ON THE AIR

- ◆ All three games vs. New Mexico will have live video streaming on The Mountain Digital Network. Links to those broadcasts are available at the SDSU web site (GoAztecs.com).
- ◆ In addition, there will be a Live Stats feed for all three games vs. the Lobos at GoAztecs.com.

### SERIES RECORD

- ◆ San Diego State's record against New Mexico stands at 108-71. The Lobos are one of three teams against which SDSU has recorded 100 wins. The others are Air Force (100-22) and Utah (102-34).
- ◆ Last season each team won two of three regular-season games on its home field. The Aztecs also defeated the Lobos twice at the 2015 Mountain West Tournament including the championship contest.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 66-30 vs. UNM in San Diego, 33-37 in Albuquerque and 9-4 on neutral fields.

### SCOUTING THE LOBOS

- ◆ New Mexico's record stands at 13-7 overall after dropping a 14-10 decision at Texas Tech on Tuesday. The Lobos sit atop the Mountain West standings with a record of 5-1.
- ◆ The Lobo offense has been led by center fielder Chris DeVito (.400, 9 doubles, 5 HR, 27 RBI) and catcher Luis Gonzalez (.386, 5 doubles, 8 HR, 10 RBI).
- ◆ The Lobos are averaging eight runs per game and better than one home run per contest with 22 in 20 games.
- ◆ UNM is hitting .319 as a team with a 5.60 earned run average.

### TREJO STREAKING

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo is on a 14-game hitting streak during which he is batting .419 (26-for-62) with two doubles, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored.
- ◆ He has been in double figures in hits in eight of SDSU's last 10 contests.
- ◆ He leads the Aztecs with 30 hits on the season. Only one other player has as many as 21.
- ◆ The only contest in which he did not record a hit this season was on Feb. 23 at UC Irvine.

### VERDON HEATS UP

- ◆ Freshman Jordan Verdon is riding the team's second-longest current hitting streak at nine games.
- ◆ During the streak he is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with a double, triple, three RBI and five runs scored.
- ◆ Verdon leads the team in being hit by pitch this season with six.
- ◆ His .403 on-base percentage ranks second on the squad.
- ◆ Verdon is one of only two Aztecs to have recorded a double, triple and home run this season. (Dean Nevarez is the other.)

### WYLIE GOES DEEP

- ◆ Second baseman Justin Wylie hit a leadoff home run in the contest at Cal State Fullerton last Tuesday (March 15) to give SDSU an early 1-0 lead.
- ◆ On Tuesday vs. UC Riverside he recorded his team-high fourth double.
- ◆ Wylie leads the Aztecs with 15 RBI.
- ◆ He is currently on a seven-game hitting streak during which he is batting .321 (9-for-28) with two doubles, 10 RBI and eight runs scored.
- ◆ Wylie has hit safely in 10 of SDSU's last 11 games and has recorded at least one RBI in five of the last seven contests.

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo earned the Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week award for games played through Sunday, March 13, 2016.
- ◆ It is the first MW weekly accolade for Trejo, a sophomore from Downey, Calif. (Warren HS).
- ◆ He led San Diego State to a 2-1 week in a home series against Northwestern.
- ◆ Over the three contests he posted a batting average of .600 (9-for-15) with six runs scored, five runs batted in and one stolen base.
- ◆ Trejo had at least two hits and two runs scored in all three games with a .625 on-base percentage and a .600 slugging percentage.
- ◆ Defensively, Trejo recorded seven putouts and 12 assists with no errors.
- ◆ He was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the week by *College Sports Madness*.

## PYATT CONSISTENT

- ◆ Redshirt freshman Harrison Pyatt turned in his third straight impressive start of the season vs. Northwestern last Thursday (March 10) on March 1.
- ◆ In that contest he tossed 6.2 innings allowing a run on a seven hits with a walk and six strikeouts.
- ◆ In his previous start vs. San Diego, he went six innings giving up no runs on one hit with three walks and seven strikeouts.
- ◆ Pyatt made his Aztec debut with the start at UC Irvine on Tuesday, Feb. 23.
- ◆ He pitched five innings allowing one run on just three hits while striking out four.

## HELDMAN SAVES

- ◆ Senior Brian Heldman recorded his first (and SDSU's only) save of the 2016 season in the win at UC Irvine last week.
- ◆ He tossed the final two innings allowing one hit and hitting a batter to preserve the Aztecs' two-run lead.
- ◆ The save was the second of Heldman's two-year Aztec career.
- ◆ Last season he served primary as a late-inning set-up reliever.

## NAVARRO'S FIRST HIT

- ◆ After going hitless in his first six collegiate plate appearances, freshman Niko Navarro came through with an important single in the win over Fresno State on Sunday (March 6).
- ◆ He was called upon to pitch hit in the bottom of the eighth inning with the bases loaded, one out and SDSU trailing, 4-2.
- ◆ Navarro proceeded to deliver a single to right field to drive home two runs and tie the game.
- ◆ SDSU added a third run one batter later and went on to win, 5-4.

## GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. No. 14 Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in the contest on Feb. 19.
- ◆ Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter vs. Oregon on Feb. 20.

## STREAKS

- ◆ Alan Trejo has the team's longest current hitting streak at 14 games.
- ◆ The next best current streak of nine games belongs to Jordan Verdon while Justin Wylie has a seven-game streak in progress.
- ◆ Trejo has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in all 18 games this season while Verdon has done so in the past 10 contests.
- ◆ Trejo also leads the Aztecs with 10 multiple-hit contests and four multiple-RBI games.



### NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

### VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo was named to the all-tournament team at the 2015 NCAA Regional at Lake Elsinore, Calif.
- ◆ Pitcher Jacob Erickson, outfielder Spencer Thornton and designated hitter Justin Wylie earned all-tourney recognition at the 2015 Mountain West Conference Tournament.
- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and a second-team all-Mountain West selection.

### RETURNING POSITION STARTERS

- ◆ Among the returning starters are two members of the Aztec infield and two outfielders.
- ◆ The infielders include second baseman Alan Trejo (.266, 20 RBI) and first baseman Andrew Brown (.295, 17 doubles, 32 RBI).
- ◆ Brown is likely to begin the 2016 season as the Aztecs' third baseman.
- ◆ Also back are a pair of outfielders: Spencer Thornton (.317, 7 2B, 23 RBI) and Chase Calabuig (.305, 8 2B, 25 RBI).

### RETURNING ON THE MOUND

- ◆ The Aztecs return eight full-time pitchers from last season's staff along with three others who could see time on the mound as well as at positions in the field.
- ◆ In addition to projected starters Marcus Reyes, Cody Thompson and Brett Seeburger, other top returnees includes relievers Jacob Erickson (2-1, 2.64; all-tourney at the Mountain West Tournament) and Brian Heldman (3-1, 3.52, 1 save).
- ◆ Second baseman Alan Trejo, outfielder Chase Calabuig and catcher CJ Saylor could also see spot duty on the mound if needed.

### SAYLOR RETURNS BEHIND THE PLATE

- ◆ Junior CJ Saylor will resume duties at the catching position this season after serving at the Aztecs' closer a year ago.
- ◆ In 2015 he compiled a record of 3-3 with 11 saves and a 5.02 ERA.
- ◆ He began his SDSU as a catcher where he hit .212 in 14 games as a redshirt freshman in 2014.
- ◆ Saylor could see occasional action on the mound this season as well.

### PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

- ◆ Outfielder Chase Calabuig has been tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- ◆ Calabuig batted .305 with eight doubles and 25 RBI as season en route to second-team all-conference honors at the end of the 2015 campaign.
- ◆ He was also named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* magazine.

### COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS ALL-MW

- ◆ *College Sports Madness* also named Calabuig to its All-Mountain West first team while four other Aztecs earned second-team honors.
- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

### DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

### AZTECS PICKED AS CO-FAVORITES

- ◆ San Diego State has been picked as co-favorite along with New Mexico to win the Mountain West title in the conference's preseason baseball poll.
- ◆ In a vote of the seven MWC head coaches, the Aztecs received three first-place votes and tallied 32 points as did the Lobos. Fresno State picked up the remaining first-place vote and tied for third in the poll with Air Force.

### AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Junior relief pitcher Jacob Erickson has not issued a walk (while striking out 11) in his nine appearances covering 11.2 innings.
- ◆ Senior outfielder Spencer Thornton had his first three-hit game of the season in the contest at Air Force on Sunday (March 20). In that game he had a pair of doubles, two RBI and three runs scored.
- ◆ David Hensley went 5-for-10 over the three games vs. Northwestern (March 10-12) and scored a run in each of those contests.
- ◆ Freshman right-hander Chris Collins has made five relief appearances out of the bullpen and allowed one earned run over 6.1 innings pitched for a 1.42 earned run average.
- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo is the only two players to have started all 18 games this season at the same position.
- ◆ Two other Aztec have started all 18 games, but not at the same position each time: Chase Calabuig (CF-RF) and Justin Wylie (2B-3B-DH).
