AZTECS WRAP UP 2010 HOME SEASON VS. UNLV & AIR FORCE

- San Diego State will conclude its 2010 home season with a pair of Mountain West Conference matches this week.
- ♦ On Thursday, Nov. 18, the Aztecs will host UNLV at 7:00 p.m. in Titan Gym.
- On Saturday, Nov. 20, SDSU will face Air Force in a match scheduled to get underway at 1:00 p.m. in Peterson Gym.

SENIOR DAY

- Saturday's contest vs. Air Force has been designated Senior Day for a pair of Aztecs who will be playing their final home match for the Red and Black.
- Middle blocker Lauren Salisbury and outside hitter Kelsey Manasco will be honored prior to the contest against the Falcons.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ San Diego State holds a 26-2 mark in its previous 28 meetings with Air Force. The teams first met in 1996 while both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. Air Force's wins over SDSU came in Colorado Springs in 1999. The Falcons ended a 22-match losing streak at the hands of the Aztecs last month when they won a four-set decision in Colorado Springs. The Aztecs are 13-0 vs. the Falcons in San Diego, 12-2 in Colorado Springs and 1-0 at neutral sites.
- ◆ San Diego State's all-time record against UNLV stands at 19-12 since the teams first met in 1985. The Rebels have won nine of the last 14 against SDSU although the Aztecs have been victorious in the most recent three encounters. That SDSU run includes a sweep last year's two matches as well as a win the contest in Las Vegas on Oct. 23. San Diego State is 11-3 vs. UNLV at home, 8-8 in Las Vegas and 0-1 at neutral venues.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- ◆ UNLV's record stands at 9-19 (4-10 MWC) as it prepares to play the Aztecs on Saturday. The Rebels ended a three-match losing streak with a five-set win over Utah last Saturday at home. UNLV is led by Sara Nehf (3.43 kills, 1.47 digs per set) and Kelsey Keeler (2.11 kills, 1.70 digs per set). Of the 15 players on the Rebels roster, eight are freshmen.
- ♦ Air Force enters the week with an overall record of 4-23 and a mark of 1-13 in the Mountain West Conference. The Falcons have lost their last six matches and 13 of their last 14. Their only win during that run was a 3-1 victory over SDSU in Colorado Springs on Oct. 21. Air Force is led by Caroline Kurtz (3.58 kills, 2.53 digs per set) and Nichole Stillwell (2.33 kills, 0.67 blocks per set).

COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- San Diego State Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her second season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history last year.
- She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her record at SDSU is 28-29 (.491) and her career mark stands at 190-220 (.463).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- Collins-Parker was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She was one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

AZTECS ON THE BLOCK

- SDSU's team blocking total (15.0 blocks -1 solo, 28 assists) against Cal State Bakersfield on Nov. 13 was its highest of the season.
- The 28 assists was the team's highest total in a match since recording the same figure at Air Force on Nov. 13, 2009.
- As a team SDSU has finished in double figures in blocking in 11 matches this fall including the last three in a row.

CRACKING THE TOP 10

- In addition to Lauren Salisbury being among the top 10 in career hitting percentage (fifth), the SDSU record book will have a couple of other new top 10 entries by the end of the season.
- Andrea Hannasch is tied for ninth in career block assists with 341 (Shannon Matthew is No. 8 at 358).
- With 119 this fall, Hannasch is also seven block assists away from adding her name to the single-season top 10 in that category (Jennifer Hamilton and Megan Schauermann are tied for 10th with 126).
- Freshman setter Johnna Fouch enters the week with 1,094 assists and needs to average just 27 assists per match over SDSU's final four contests to crack the top 10. Andrea Clark currently ranks 10th with 1,211 assists in 1996.
- Salisbury has moved into the 10th spot in career block assists with 334 and needs seven move into the No. 9 position.
- With 380 digs, Kristi Jackels is only four away from entering the Aztec single season top 10 in that stat.

AZTECS IN THE OVERALL MWC STATS

- Johnna Fouch leads the league's setters at 10.52 assists per set.
- Andrea Hannasch is third in blocking (1.27 per set).
- Kristi Jackels is fifth in digs at 3.65 per set.
- Lauren Salisbury is sixth in hitting percentage (.300).

AZTECS IN THE LEAGUE-ONLY MWC STATS

- In league-only matches, Johnna Fouch ranks fifth in assists at 10.00 per set.
- Andrea Hannasch is fourth in blocks at 1.30 per set and 10th in points at 3.70 per set.
- Raegan Shelton stands 10th in kills at 2.98 per set.
- Kristi Jackels ranks sixth in digs at 3.60 per set.

SALISBURY'S RETURNS

- Senior middle blocker Lauren Salisbury made an unexpected return to the court last Saturday (Nov. 13) in the match against Cal State Bakersfield.
- She had suffered a wrist injury on Sept. 28 and was expected to miss the remainder of the 2010 season.
- In limited action in the second and third sets against the Roadrunners last weekend, she recorded three kills on three attempts and also contributed four blocks.
- Salisbury is a two-time all-conference selection and was named to the 2010 preseason all-MWC squad as well.
- ◆ With a total of 37 block assists this season, her career total of 334 ranks 10th all-time and is seven behind Angelica Jackson's (1984-87) ninth-highest total of 341.
- Salisbury's career hitting percentage of .327 ranks fifth on the Aztec top 10 list in that category.

JACKELS DIGS CAREER BEST

- Over SDSU's last four matches, sophomore libero Kristi Jackels has been in double figures in digs and averaged 4.67 per set during that span.
- She set her SDSU career high with 32 digs in the match against Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- ◆ Jackels becomes just the seventh Aztec to ever record 30 or more digs in a match, joining current teammate Johnna Fouch (who had 30 vs. UC Irvine in September) on that list.
- Her previous high in digs came at UC Santa Barbara in the final match of the 2009 season.
- She ranks fifth in the conference in digs this week with an average of 3.62 per set.
- Jackels had back-to-back 18-dig efforts earlier this season against Utah State and Arizona State.
- She has been in double figures in digs in 23 of SDSU's 28 matches.
- Her four aces against Northern Colorado on Aug. 28 are the most by an Aztec this year.
- She has recorded at least one assist in each of the last 12 matches and 20 of the last 21.

HANNASCH PROVIDES SPARK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch tied her career high in kills on Nov. 4 at Utah and then set a new career-best two days later at Brigham Young.
- At Utah on Nov. 4, she recorded 16 kills to equal her personal best as an Aztec which she had achieved on five occasions.
- In the match at Brigham Young on Nov.
 6, she set new career bests with 18 kills and 23 points.
- Hannasch continues to be among the top blockers in the Mountain West Conference as her overall average of 1.27 blocks per set ranks third in the MWC this week.
- Her mark of 1.30 blocks per set in league matches ranks fourth.
- She is currently 29th in the nation in blocking. Those rankings include athletes from 319 Division I teams.
- In addition, she is averaging 2.64 kills, 1.27 digs and 3.50 points per set.

NASH ON THE ATTACK

- Freshman Summer Nash played in only two sets last week (both vs. CSU Bakersfield) and averaged 3.5 kills and 1.00 blocks per set.
- She set her career high in kills for the fourth time in five matches with 16 against Utah on Nov. 4.
- Nash had a string of six straight doublefigures kill matches end with the contest at Brigham Young on Nov. 6. In those matches she averaged 3.55 kills per set.
- Her kill average of 3.00 per set in conference matches would rank ninth in the league stats, but she is one set short of the number required to qualify for listing in the MWC statistics.
- ◆ Her .333 attack percentage in the contest at Brigham Young (Nov. 6) marked the 11th time this season that she has hit better than .300 in a match.



SHELTON SHINES

- Freshman Raegan Shelton tied her career best with 20 kills in the win over Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- Her three blocks and six digs in that match were both one shy of her season bests.
- After missing four matches due to injury, Shelton came off the bench in the second set against Wyoming on Oct. 28 to notch 14 kills, four blocks, two service aces and a .414 attack percentage in the win over the Cowgirls.
- The four blocks represented her career high as an Aztec.
- In the win over host Arizona State on Sept. 3, she recorded a career-high 20 kills while hitting .500 for the match.
- She is second on the team in kill average at 2.87 per set.

PEACOCK AT HER BEST

- Outside hitter Jessica Peacock tied her SDSU career bests with six block assists and two service aces in the win over Cal state Bakersfield last Saturday (Nov. 13).
- She recorded 13 kills in the victory at BYU on Nov. 6 and also contributed four blocks.
- She previously had her season high in blocks with six against UC Santa Barbara on Sept. 18.
- She set a career high hitting percentage (.562) in the contest vs. Seattle on Oct. 15.
- She had established career best in with 17 kills in the win over Utah on Oct. 9.
- Her 18.5 points in that match against Utah was her best total as an Aztec as well.

FOUCH SETTING IT UP

- Freshman setter Johnna Fouch's 54 assists in the win at Brigham Young (Nov. 6) was her second-highest total of the season and just one short of her career high.
- Her 54 assists vs. BYU was the sixth time this season that she has had more than 50 in a match.
- She continues to lead the MWC in assists with an average of 10.52 per set.
- She recorded her 10th double-double of the fall with 47 assists and 13 digs at Utah last week (Nov. 4).
- Her assist average also ranks 60th in the nation (NCAA Division I) this week.
- In the match vs. UC Irvine in Honolulu on Sept. 11, she set career bests with five total blocks and 32 digs.

OROPEZA ON DEFENSE

- Freshman defensive specialist Kyla Oropeza has seen action in 27 of SDSU's 28 matches this season and started on three occasions.
- She recorded eight digs in SDSU's two matches last week for a mark of 1.25 per set, just under her season average.
- Oropeza is averaging 1.33 digs per set and has appeared in 93 of the teams 104 sets this fall.
- In the win over Utah (Oct. 9), she had her second-highest dig total of the season with nine and tied her season best with two assists.
- She was the server in the fifth set vs. the Utes on Oct. 9 when SDSU came from behind (7-13) to score eight straight points and win the match.

MANASCO HEATS UP

- Senior outside hitter Kelsey Manasco set a new career high with a .550 hitting percentage in the win over UC Riverside on Oct. 26.
- Her 12 kills in that contest represented a season high as did her four block assists and 15.0 points.
- ◆ Against Wyoming (Oct. 28) she again recoded four block assists and added a season-high four assists which also tied her Aztec career best.

PEARSON PROVIDES SPARK

- Junior outside hitter Paije Pearson totaled 10 blocks in the Aztecs' two matches last week for an average of 1.67 per set.
- Her six block assists at Cal State Fullerton was her second-highest total of the season.
- She had a solid match in last Saturday's win at Brigham Young, finishing with six kills, nine digs, five blocks and a service ace.
- Pearson set a career high with seven blocks assists and seven total blocks in the win over Wyoming on Oct. 28.
- She has recorded six total blocks in a match three times this season. In addition to the Fullerton match, she also did it in contests vs. Utah and Seattle.
- ◆ Her 10 digs vs. Wyoming (Oct. 28) was the third time she reached double figures in that category this season.

SEXTON LEADS THE OFFENSE

- Kyley Sexton hit double figure in kills for the 14th time this season with 13 in the win over UC Riverside on Oct. 26.
- She leads the Aztecs in kill average at 2.96 per set and is second in points (3.35 per set).
- Sexton recorded her fifth double-double of the season with 16 kills and 13 blocks in the win over TCU on Sept. 25.
- She set a career-high with 25 kills in the match vs. UCSB on Sept. 18. Her 27 points in that match was also a career best.
- In the match against UC Irvine on Sept.
 11, she set a career high with 21 digs.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- In the win over UC Irvine on Sept. 18, the Aztecs recorded 108 digs as a team, their highest total in a match in over 10 years.
- ◆ In that contest, setter Johnna Fouch led SDSU with 32 digs, the most in a match by an Aztec since Aime Cordeiro had 33 against BYU on Nov. 2, 2007.
- The 32 digs were the 10th-most ever in a match by an SDSU player.

ALL TOURNAMENT AZTECS

- Aztec junior outside hitters Kyley Sexton and Paije Pearson were named to the alltournament team at the Aztec Invitational (Aug. 27-28) with Sexton picking up tournament MVP honors.
- Sexton average 3.90 kills, 2.40 digs and 0.50 blocks over SDSU's three matches.
- Pearson hit .300 with averages of 3.78 kills, 3.00 digs and 0.44 blocks.
- Outside hitter Raegan Shelton was named to the all-tournament team at the ASU Sheraton Classic in Tempe, Ariz., during the weekend of Sept. 3-4.
- Shelton averaged 3.40 kills and 3.79 points per set while hitting .389 over SDSU's three matches.
- Kyley Sexton was named to the alltournament team at the USD/SDSU Challenge (Sept. 17-18), her second alltourney honor of the 2010 season.
- Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 3.42 kills and 1.28 digs per set.

HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week for her effort in the matches against New Mexico and TCU (Sept. 23 and 25).
- In a three-set sweep of New Mexico at home, Hannasch led all players with 12 kills and a career-best .688 hitting percentage. In the 3-2 home win over TCU, Hannasch tied a career-high with 16 kills.
- For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.50 kills, 1.62 blocks and 4.50 points per set, while hitting .535 (28-5-43) over eight sets. She also had two assists, one service ace and six digs in the two matches.
- Hannasch shared the MWC Player of the Week award with Colorado State middle blocker Megan Plourde.

PEARSON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Paije Pearson was named the Mountain West Conference Player of the Week on Aug. 30 for her efforts during the season's opening weekend Aztec Invitational.
- She began tourney play with a 14-kill, six dig effort in the win over CSU Northridge. The 14 kills tied her SDSU career high at the time.
- In the Aztecs' sweep of Northern Colorado, she collected six kills, three digs and one block, then followed with career highs in kills (15) and digs (18) in the tournament's championship match vs. Cincinnati.

FRESHMEN NUMBERS

- San Diego State is one of three teams in the nation that lists nine true freshmen on its 2010 roster.
- Defending national champion Penn State and South Carolina are the only other two Division I schools with that many first-year players.
- Both Auburn and Maryland-Baltimore County have nine freshmen on their rosters, but that number includes redshirt freshmen who were at the schools last season.
- Among Mountain West Conference schools, UNLV has eight true freshmen and Air Force six.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ With wins in their final two homes games this week, the Aztecs can ensure that they will finish at .500 or better this season. It would be the first time they have done so since the 2005 campaign when they ended the year at 16-14.
- Freshman defensive specialist Justine Ricigliano tied her season high with seven digs in the win at Brigham Young on Nov. 6.
- As a team, the Aztecs have hit .300 or better in seven matches, their highest total since it reached that mark in nine matches during the 2005 campaign.
- The Aztecs are 3-3 in five-set matches this season.
- The win over BYU was only the second one this season in which SDSU has trailed in kills and digs.
- Andrea Hannasch is the lone Aztec to have recorded at least one block in each of SDSU's matches this season.
- ◆ Johnna Fouch is the only Aztec to have started every match this season. Fouch and libero Kristi Jackels are the only players to have appeared in every set in 2010.
