Aztecs Continue Grueling Non-Conference Schedule at Mary Nutter

San Diego State continues its tough non-conference schedule this weekend when it travels to the Palm Springs area to play in the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, California.

The Aztecs (5-5), who are receiving votes in both major national polls, will play games against No. 11/13 Missouri at 5 p.m. PT Thursday, Nebraska (10 a.m. PT) and Bethune-Cookman (3 p.m. PT) on Friday, and No. 1/1 Oklahoma at 12:30 p.m. PT Saturday.

Out of SDSU's 10 games so far this season, eight of come against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament (San Diego State is 3-5 in those games) and five have come against nationally ranked squads (the Aztecs are 1-4). SDSU's upcoming opponents this weekend Missouri and Nebraska also made the 2023 NCAA tournament, while Oklahoma is the three-time defending national champion.

Micaela Macario leads the offense in many categories, including average (.318), runs (10), walks (7), stolen bases (8) and on-base percentage (.484). Mac Barbara, the Mountain West Preseason Player of the Year, is hitting .310 with two home runs and 13 RBIs, slugging .552 with a .429 on-base mark.

Allie Light, the defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year, leads a pitching staff that has combined to record a 2.10 ERA with 38 strikeouts in 70 innings. Light is 2-1 with a 1.01 ERA in 27 2/3 innings, striking out 17 with six walks and limiting the opposition to a .240 average.

All four of SDSU's games will be broadcast on FloSoftball and can be purchased via pay-per-view.

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 83-38 (.686) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic Information

The Aztecs continue their tough competition to start the season this weekend when the head to the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, California (Palm Springs area).

The Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, formerly the Cathedral City Classic, is one of the largest and most competitive Division I softball tournaments outside of the NCAA tournament. This year's tourney features 30 teams, including three of the eight Women's College World Series teams from last year. The entire tournament is held at Big League Dreams park across five fields.

The tournament is named after Mary Nutter, who started the National Sports Clinics (NSC) more than 25 years ago to provide softball coaches at all levels access to the highest quality instruction. Nutter passed away from a heart attack on July 24, 2012, and the tournament was renamed in her honor for the 2013 edition.

Tournament passes are available for \$105, while single-day tickets for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday are \$35 for adults, \$20 for seniors (65 or older) or students (U17), and \$12 for children between the age of 3-10. All single-game prices are \$2 more on the day of the event.

The Aztecs play games against No. 11/13 Missouri at 5 p.m. PT Thursday, Nebraska (10 a.m. PT) and Bethune-Cookman (3 p.m. PT) on Friday, and No. 1/1 Oklahoma at 12:30 p.m. PT Saturday.

All four games will be broadcast live on FloSoftball (shortened link - <https://flosports.link/3LYK8dW>) and available via pay-per-view, and all are expected to have live stats.

Notes on the Season so Far

* The Aztecs are off to a 5-5 start through 10 games with nine played at home (4-5) and one on the road (1-0)

* Out of SDSU's 10 games, eight have been against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament. San Diego State is 3-5 in those games.

* The Aztecs have already played five teams who are nationally ranked, going 1-4 in those games with a win over then No. 25 Kentucky, 2-1.

* The largest margin of defeat for SDSU this season is three runs in a 3-0 loss to No. 3/3 Stanford on opening day on Feb. 8.

* Out of San Diego State's five losses, one has been by one run, three have been by two runs and one was by three runs.

* The Aztecs are only hitting .234 as a team, but much of that can be attributed to who they have played. Three all-Mountain West performers from a year ago have yet to get on track in Bella Espinoza (.200 this season with one run and two stolen bases, .393 last season with 57 runs and 30 stolen bases), Makena Brocki (.172 this season with two RBIs and one extra-base hit, .297 last season with 33 RBIs and 19 extra-base hits) and Cali Decker (.115 this season with 0 RBIs and a .258 on-base percentage, .368 last season with 40 RBIs and a .462 on-base percentage).

* UCF transfer Micaela (Lala) Macario leads the Aztecs in average (.318), on-base percentage (.484), runs (10), walks (7) and stolen bases (8) despite missing a game.

* Mac Barbara (.310) has continued to provide pop with both of SDSU's home runs and 13 of its 30 RBIs, while slugging .552 with a .429 on-base mark. Barbara is the Mountain West preseason player of the year.

* San Diego State's pitching staff has continued to produce, combining for a 2.10 ERA and 38 strikeouts in 70 innings against just 12 walks.

* Defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year Allie Light leads the way with a 2-1 record to go along with a 1.01 ERA in 27 2/3 innings, striking out 17 with six walks and limiting the opposition to a .240 average.

Aztec Softball Receiving Votes in Both National Polls

The San Diego State softball team is still receiving votes in both national polls, which were released on Tuesday.

In the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll, the Aztecs have nine points, which are the 31st most in the poll. 25th-ranked Mississippi State has 113 points, while also receiving votes are Auburn (102), Virginia Tech (88), Baylor (61), Louisiana (31), Boston University (22), SDSU (9), Miami University (6), Penn State (3), Boise State (2), Grand Canyon (1) and Indiana (1). Back-to-back-to-back national champion Oklahoma is first in the poll once again with all 32 first-place votes and 800 votes total.

The USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll is voted on by 32 NCAA Division I head coaches with one representing each of the DI conferences.

San Diego State received 10 votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, down from 48 in the preseason poll. No. 25 is Oregon with 69 points. Those receiving votes are California (62), Utah (61), Louisiana (28), Northwestern (27), Indiana (11), San Diego State (10), Texas Tech (8), Boston U (7), McNeese (5), Louisville (4), Florida Atlantic (2), Miami-OH (2), UCF (2), Boise State (1) and Grand Canyon (1).

SDSU finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll. San Diego State, which was one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play.

SDSU Picked to Win MW; Mac Barbara, Allie Light Named Preseason Players of the Year

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West, while Mac Barbara (player) and Allie Light (pitcher) have been chosen as the league's preseason players of the year, the league announced Jan. 31.

Barbara and Light were joined on the 15-player preseason team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker and Bella Espinoza. This was the first time in MW history that preseason players of the year and a preseason all-conference team were announced.

The preseason poll, players of the year and all-conference team were voted on by the league's nine head coaches.

SDSU picked up 64 points, including eight of the nine first-place votes. Defending regular-season champion Boise State is second with 57 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (46), Fresno State (41), Nevada (37), UNLV (28), Utah State (19), New Mexico (17) and San Jose State (15) round out the voting.

Barbara made her second straight MW first team last season after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. Barbara batted .358 (57-for-159) a year ago with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, nine doubles, a triple and 33 walks, while slugging .673 with a .469 on-base mark. Barbara, a two-time first-team All-NFCA West Region (2022-23) player, was even better in league play, hitting .459 (28-for-61) with eight home runs, 24 RBIs and 18 runs in 24 games, drawing 14 walks with a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base percentage.

Light, meanwhile, was named the MW Pitcher of the Year in 2023, while also making her first all-conference team (first team) and first appearance on the all-NFCA West Region (second team). A four-time MW Pitcher of the Week, including three straight weeks from March 28-April 11, Light was 15-7 with a 1.90 ERA and a school-record seven saves in 132 2/3 innings. She started 17 games and played in 40 overall, playing a part in six Aztec shutouts, and striking out 106 with 20 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .218 average. Light was even better in MW play, going 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average.

Decker made the most of her first season on The Mesa in 2023, batting .368 (56-for-152) with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, four doubles and 26 walks, posting a .513 slugging percentage and an .462 on-base mark en route to becoming a second-team NFCA all-West Region pick and a second-team all-MW selection. Decker hit .386 (22-for-57) in MW play with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs and 12 walks, owning a .456 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base percentage. She was also named to the all-Mountain West Tournament team, batting a team-high .700 (7-for-10) with a home run, five RBIs and two runs. In nine postseason games overall (three in MW tournament, six in NCAA tournament), she hit .429 (12-for-28) with three homers, 13 RBIs and four runs, slugging .750 with a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second straight all-MW team a year ago (first team in 2022, second team in 2023), leading SDSU in batting average (.393), runs (57), hits (75), stolen bases (30) and at-bats (191). Espinoza's 70 singles were a SDSU single-season record, and she also ranked second in single-season history in stolen bases (30), third in runs (57), tied for third in hits (75) and eighth in batting average (.393). In MW play, Espinoza batted .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs and 13 stolen bases and later made the all-MW Tournament Team after hitting .545 (6-for-11) with five runs and two stolen bases in just three games.

Aztecs Unusually Fall in Opener

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980.

With a 3-0 loss to No. 3/3 Stanford on Feb. 8, the Aztecs fell to 33-12 (.733) in lid-lifters in recorded program history.

Even with the loss, SDSU has won 10 of its last 12 season openers, 21 of its last 24 and 24 of its last 28.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 27 season-openers came on Feb. 8 (lost to No. 3/3 Stanford, 3-0), in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 28 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 154-88, or 5.5-3.1 per game in lid-lifters.

SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over USD on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on an opening day since 2008.
