Aztecs Open Mountain West Play with Weekend Home Series vs. New Mexico

San Diego State kicks off its Mountain West play this weekend with a home series against New Mexico. The Aztecs (12-13) and Lobos (7-16) are set to play at SDSU Softball Stadium at 6 p.m. PT Friday, 6 p.m. PT Saturday and noon PT Sunday.

The first 250 fans to Sunday's game will receive a free tshirt

SDSU enters league play with a 12-13 record, most recently falling to UC Riverside, 6-0, at home on Wednesday night.

San Diego State, which is hitting .249 as a team, has three players batting over .300 in Maddi Ayers (.359, .432 OB%), Taylor Adams (.323, 8 R, 9 RBI) and Molly Sturdivant (.303, 5 2B). Kelsey Munoz (.293), meanwhile, paces the Aztecs in home runs (3) and RBIs (13), and Kiera Wright (.291) leads the team with 17 runs and 13 stolen bases (in 13 chances).

Returning Wednesday night to pitch an inning after missing the last eight games with an injury, Marissa Moreno leads the pitching staff by going 5-3 with a save and a 3.83 ERA in 56 2/3 innings. She has two shutouts, three complete games and 50 strikeouts, limiting the opposition to a .260 average. Despite missing the eight games, Moreno ranks in a tie for second in the MW in saves, third in strikeouts and innings pitched, and tied for eight in wins.

Alicia Garcia (4-5, 4.32 ERA, 45.1 IP) and MJ James (3-5, 5.35 ERA, 55.0 IP) have also logged important innings in the circle for SDSU.

The entire weekend series will be streamed on the Mountain West Network (shortened link - http://bit.ly/2SZxJJg) and live stats will be available on GoAztecs.com.

Following the home MW series, San Diego State travels to Boise State for a weekend series, beginning at 4 p.m. MT on March 22.



KATHY VAN WYK HEAD COACH | 23rd SEASON | CS FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1982 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 748 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her fifth Mountain West Coach of the Year award in 2014 after leading the Aztecs to a 16-8 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002, 2006, 2008 and 2013.
- Has led SDSU to 11 NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015)
- Guided San Diego State to its seventh MW regular season title in 2014 with a 16-8 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2012 and 2013.
- Coached her eighth All-American in 2017 when Jenavee Peres was named a second-team NFCA All-American. Peres became the Aztecs' first-ever second-team NFCA All-American (SDSU's three other NFCA All-Americans were on the third team).
- Has coached 78 all-conference selections, 40 NFCA all-West Region selections, nine MW Pitchers of the Year, nine MW Freshmen of the Year, four MW Players of the Year, one MW Defensive Player of the Year and 137 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

Scouting New Mexico

New Mexico comes into Mountain West play with a 7-16 record, including a 2-2 mark last weekend at the Loyola Marymount Tournament.

The Lobos are hitting .240 as a team through the 23 games, led by Bailey Klitzke (.390). Cameryn O'Grady (.364, 2 HR, 14 R, 13 RBI and Daryn Haslam (.303, 3 HR) are also hitting over .300 for UNM, while the trio of Maggie Buckholz (.240, 2 HR, 17 RBI), Monica Salas (.230, 3 HR, 11 RBI) and Lauren Wilmert (.215, 3 HR, 15 RBI) have combined for eight homers and 43 RBIs.

The New Mexico pitching staff has posted a 4.77 team ERA, thanks mainly to the efforts of Kennedy Ferguson (1-8, 3.35 ERA, 71.0 IP) and Kiana Spencer (4-6, 4.67 ERA, 51.0 IP).

The Aztecs lead the all-time series with the Lobos, 73-34, after winning two of three in Albuquerque last May. Below is a comparison between SDSU and UM so far.

Despite some of its top players battling injuries for various parts of the season, the Aztecs are in much better shape entering Mountain West play.

At 12-13 (.480), SDSU is 3 1/2 games better than last year when it started league action, mainly because of an offensive improvement and success in close games.

Aztecs Win the 29th Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic

For just the fourth time in the 29 years of the Campbell/Cartier Classic, San Diego State captured the tournament title.

The Aztecs secured the tourney title after going 3-1 with wins over Middle Tennessee (2-1), Northern Illinois (7-5) and UC Santa Barbara (1-0). SDSU's lone setback was against Grand Canyon on Feb. 16 (L, 0-8). NIU had a chance to secure the tournament title, but lost to MT, 2-1, in eight innings on Feb. 17.

Following the Aztecs (3-1) were Middle Tennessee and Northern Illinois at 3-2, Grand Canyon at 2-3 and UC Santa Barbara at 1-4. San Diego State's four Campbell/Cartier Classic titles are one short of Long Beach State for the most in the history of the tournament. Below is a look at the past winners.

The Comeback Kids

The Aztecs are off to a 12-13 start, thanks in part to three dramatic comebacks, and another walk-off win.

In SDSU's opener on Feb. 8, San Diego State scored six times in the bottom of the seventh inning to rally past Syracuse, 9-8. Down by an 8-3 score after the Orange tallied a pair of unearned runs in the top of the seventh, the Aztecs answered with six runs of their own, including five with two out, to pick up the win. In the inning, SDSU used three hits and took advantage of three SU errors.

After a 9-1 run-rule win over Charlotte after the Syracuse game, San Diego State rallied for another win against the 49ers in the first game on Saturday (Feb. 9). The Aztecs scored the final four runs of the game, including three times in the bottom of the seventh to record their second straight victory when trailing after six innings.

Not a comeback win, but still an impressive one was SDSU's 7-5 win over Northern Illinois on Feb. 15. The Aztecs entered the seventh inning with a 5-2 lead, but the Huskies tied it on a three-run homer by Sam Schmidt. SDSU responded in the bottom half when Kelsey Munoz took the first pitch she saw over the center-field fence for a two-run, walk-off homer.

On Feb. 28 at the San Diego Classic, San Diego State took advantage of a pair of Brigham Young errors in the bottom of the seventh inning to rally past the Cougars, 2-1. First, Kayla Sok scored from second on two errors by BYU third baseman Taylei Williams. Taylor Adams followed with a chopper to second base against a drawn-in infield, but the throw to the plate was late as Megan Smith raced home to give SDSU the 2-1 win.

This season, SDSU is 3-8 when trailing after six innings. Prior to this season, San Diego State was just 5-112 (.043) since 2012 when trailing after six innings of play and just 13-191 (.064) since 2006 when trailing after six innings.

Aztecs Excel in Lid-Lifters

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since Kathy Van Wyk took over the reigns of the program in 1997.

After a dramatic 9-8 win over Syracuse on Feb. 8, the Aztecs have now won six of seven season-opening games, 17 of their last 19 and 20 of 23 lid-lifters in Van Wyk's 23-year tenure.

SDSU's only blemishes in the past 23 season-openers under Van Wyk came in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech. 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC. 5-3).

Over the 23 years under Van Wyk, SDSU has outscored its opponent, 133-78, or 5.8-3.4 per game in lid-lifters.

Since records were first kept in 1980, San Diego State is 29-11 (.725) in their opening games.

Aztec Softball to Have 18-Plus Games Broadcast on Mountain West Network

The San Diego State softball team will have at least 18 games on the Mountain West Network this season.

The network, which is broadcast live on the Internet, started during the 2013 football season and gives all Mountain West sports the ability to broadcast all sports across all the 11 MW institutions. For videos and more information, visit the site at http://www.themw.com/#!/videos.

The Aztec softball games that are scheduled for the Mountain West Network this season are Feb. 28 vs. Brigham Young, March 1 vs. UIC, March 3 vs. UC Davis, March 5 vs. Florida Gulf Coast, the March 15-17 series with New Mexico, March 29 vs. UNLV, the April 12-14 series with San Jose State, April 23 vs. Cal Baptist, April 27 at Colorado State, May 4-5 against Fresno State and May 9-11 at Utah State.

Aztecs Picked Fifth in the Mountain West

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to finish fifth in the Mountain West in a preseason poll voted on by the league's nine head coaches, the conference announced Jan. 30. The Aztecs have won a league-record seven MW regular-season titles.

SDSU picked up 31 points in the preseason poll, just behind UNLV (35) and ahead of Nevada (19). Defending league champion Boise State was picked to win the league with 64 points, including eight first-place votes. Fresno State garnered the other first-place vote and had 57 points total, while San José State's 50 points were good enough for third. The bottom three of the preseason poll were Colorado State (26) in seventh, Utah State (21) in eighth and New Mexico (11) in ninth.

The Aztecs are coming off a 20-31 season in 2018, their first losing campaign since 2005. SDSU was 11-13 in MW play for sixth place, winning six of its final eight games, including two of the final three series.

SDSU Softball Announces 2018 Schedule

San Diego State softball head coach Kathy Van Wyk has announced a 54-game schedule for the 2019 season, highlighted by two home tournaments, including the 29th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic at SDSU Softball Stadium from Feb. 14-17.

The Aztecs, who have won a league-best seven Mountain West titles in the 19-year history of the league, are scheduled to play 14 contests against teams that made last year's NCAA tournament, including 12 contests vs. conference champions.

SDSU begins its season on the road for the 12th straight year, playing at Grand Canyon Univ.'s Kickoff Tournament in Phoenix from Friday, Feb. 8-Sunday, Feb. 10. San Diego State opens with Syracuse and Charlotte on Friday, Charlotte again and the host Lopes on Saturday and perennial national power Oklahoma on Sunday. The Sooners, who won the Big 12 last year and made it to the Women's College World Series, have won four NCAA championships, including three in the past six years (2013, 2016 and 2017).

The Aztecs open their home portion of its schedule with the 29th annual Campbell/Cartier Classic from Thursday, Feb. 14-Sunday, Feb. 17. SDSU will play Conference USA champion Middle Tennessee twice (Thursday and Friday), along with Northern Illinois (Friday), Grand Canvon (Saturday) and UC Santa Barbara (Sunday).

Following a mid-week clash at Big West champion Cal State Fullerton on Wednesday, Feb. 20, San Diego State heads to the always competitive Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, Calif. (near Palm Springs) from Thursday, Feb. 21-Sunday, Feb. 24. The Aztecs are scheduled to meet Army West Point on Thursday, NCAA tournament at-large selection Oklahoma State and Nebraska on Friday, Texas Tech on Saturday, and Cal Poly on Sunday.

After a Tuesday game at Loyola Marymount on Feb. 26, the Aztecs return to America's Finest City for the San Diego Classic from Thursday, Feb. 28-Sunday, March 3. On the docket for SDSU at the classic are West Coast champion Brigham Young on Thursday, Horizon champ UIC on Friday, Weber State on Saturday and UC Davis on Sunday.

San Diego State then welcomes Florida Gulf Coast on Tuesday, March 5, before making the short drive north to Long Beach State for a tournament from Thursday, March 7-Saturday, March 9. The Aztecs will meet Robert Morris on Thursday, followed by league champions Boston Univ. (Patriot) and Liberty (Big South) on Friday, and Mid-American champ Ohio and the host 49ers on Saturday. Last year, LBSU made the NCAA tourney and finished 20th in the USA Today/NFCA poll and 22nd in the ESPN/USA Softball poll.

SDSU returns to San Diego for a four-game homestand, beginning with a non-conference game against UC Riverside on Wednesday, March 13. San Diego State then kicks off Mountain West action at home with a weekend series with New Mexico from March 15-17.

The Aztecs head to defending MW champion Boise State the following weekend (March 22-24), before welcomes UNLV to close out March (March 29731).

SDSU hits the road for a weekend series at Nevada from April 5-7 and makes the crosstown drive to take on San Diego on Wednesday, April 10.

Next up for San Diego State is the 2017 MW champion San José State in a home series from April 12-14.

After a nine-day layoff, the Aztecs return to welcome Cal Baptist on Tuesday, April 23 in their final non-conference game of the sea-

SDSU then travels to Colorado State for a weekend series from April 26-28, before hosting Fresno State from May 3-5 in San Diego State's final home series of 2019.

The Aztecs end their regular season from Thursday, May 9-Saturday, May 11 at Utah State.

The NCAA Regional kicks off postseason play from May 10-13 at 16 campus sites.




