TEAM NOTES

- The Aztecs fell to 4-4 all-time against Boise State.
- SDSU is 2-2 all-time against Boise State in Boise.
- San Diego State fell to 3-2 all-time at Albertsons Stadium (2-2 vs. Boise State and 1-0 in the Idaho Potato Bowl (SDSU defeated Buffalo, 49-24, in 2013)).
- SDSU fell to 19-4 in all games played in September since the start of the 2016 campaign.
- San Diego State lost its conference opener for just the second time in the last 10 years.
- The Aztecs saw their road conference opener winning streak snapped at seven games.
- SDSU fell to 9-6 all-time against schools from Idaho (4-4 vs. Boise State, 3-2 vs. Idaho and 2-0 vs. Idaho State).
- Boise State had scored in 60 consecutive first halves at home prior to the Aztecs recording the first-half shutout tonight.
- SDSU shut out an opponent in the first half for the second straight game. The last time San Diego State had consecutive first-half shutouts was the 2015 Hawai'i Bowl against Cincinnati (W, 42-7) and the 2016 opener against New Hampshire (W, 31-0).
- The Aztecs have held their opponents scoreless in 10 of the 20 quarters this season.
- SDSU scored twice in the first quarter, which tied a season high (also vs. Idaho State).
- San Diego State had the first two scores of the game for the first time this season.

TRENDS

- SDSU did not start with the ball for just the 31st time in the last 137 games.
- San Diego State had its nine-game winning snapped when scoring first.
- The Aztecs had their 12-game winning streak snapped when leading at the half (2-1 this season) and are now 27-6 in the Brady Hoke era when leading at the half.

PLAYER NOTES

* Tyrell Shavers, Sr., WR (1 Blocked Punt, 1 PR TD)

Scored off a blocked punt for the first time this season and third time of his career ... He now has three overall touchdowns this year and eight for his career ... Blocked his first punt of the season and third of his career ... Is now tied for third all-time at SDSU in blocked punts (3).

- LB Caden McDonald started for the 36th consecutive game, the longest streak on the team (offense/defense).
- LB Caden McDonald played for the 53rd straight game, the longest streak on the team.
- LB Caden McDonald played in his 53rd game, the most on the team.
