#### #AztecWBB Prepares for City Showdown at USD

Fresh off a home victory over UC Santa Barbara on Sunday, San Diego State will make the short drive west down Interstate 8 on Tuesday to renew acquaintances with the University of San Diego in the annual city showdown, beginning at 6 p.m. PT inside Jenny Craig Pavilion. A live audio stream will be available on GoAztecs.com, with SDSU alumnus Chris Ello handling the play-by-play responsibilities.

The Aztecs-Toreros clash will mark the 38th installment of the intra-city showdown, which dates back to February 1978. The two sides have battled one another on a yearly basis since 2002 after the series went on hiatus from 1997-2001. SDSU owns a 28-9 advantage over its crosstown adversary and has emerged victorious in its last two visits to the Alcalá Park campus.

Defense has typified the series recently, with the two schools reaching the 70-point plateau just four times in the past 15 meetings. On each occasion, the team to score over 70 points came away with the win. Similarly, the losing side has failed to score more than 60 points in 10 of the last 13 encounters.

The aforementioned trend continued last season as USD claimed a 48-45 decision at Viejas Arena to spoil the Aztecs' 2013-14 home opener. The contest was just the fifth in the last 12 games to feature a winning margin of five points or less. The other seven have been decided by an average of over 17 points, with each team posting a victory of more than 25 points.

SDSU has been bolstered by the return of junior Erimma Amarikwa, who missed the final 23 games of the 2013-14 campaign after undergoing hip surgery. Through seven games this year, the Vacaville, Calif., native leads the Aztecs with 10.4 points and 6.4 rebounds per outing, along with a .571 field-goal percentage. Against UCSB on Sunday, Amarikwa scored all 15 of her points in the first half to tie senior Khristina Hunter for team-high honors. Amarikwa and Hunter also grabbed six rebounds apiece and combined for 11 of 16 field goals on the afternoon to lift SDSU to a 64-58 victory. Hunter has been the Aztecs' top free-throw shooter this season, draining 13 of 17 attempts (.765), while leading the squad with 10 steals and seven blocks. SDSU's fortunes have also been sparked by junior Ahjalee Harvey, who has connected on 11 of 21 shots from three-point range (.524).

As a team, SDSU enters the week leading the Mountain West with a .426 field-goal percentage, while its plus-3 rebounding margin ranks third.

## Scouting the Toreros

USD, which was picked to finish third in the West Coast Conference preseason poll, claimed a pair of victories last week to move to 6-1 on the season. The Toreros dispatched previously unbeaten Dartmouth by a 78-53 count at home on Dec. 1, before posting a 59-50 road victory at Weber State on Dec. 6. USD's lone blemish of the year came against Mountain West member Fresno State in a 93-88 slugfest at Jenny Craig Pavilion on Nov. 28.

Individually, the Toreros boast four players with double-digit scoring averages, led by Maya Hood (16.8 ppg) and her twin sister Malina Hood (15.8 ppg), while Sophia Ederaine (15.1 ppg) and Katherine Hamilton (10.6 ppg) follow close behind.

Entering the week, Ederaine finds herself among the nation's leaders in several categories, including blocks (5th - 3.71/gm), offensive rebounds 15th - 5.0/gm) and total rebounds (21st - 11.3/gm). In addition, she has recorded five double-doubles already this season, which ranks seventh in the country.

A preseason all-WCC selection, Malina Hood is USD's top three-point threat so far this year, connecting on 21 of the team's 34 triples, while Hamilton and Cori Woodward have knocked down five apiece.

Collectively, the Toreros top the nation with an average of 23.0 offensive rebounds per game while occupying the eighth spot in both rebounding margin (+14.0) and blocked shots (6.4/gm). As a team, USD is shooting 37.6 percent from the field, including a 32.7 percent clip from three-point range, and 66.2 percent from the free-throw line.

Now in her 10th season, head coach Cindy Fisher has compiled a 178-111 record at the helm of the Torero program and has amassed a 231-192 mark in 14 years overall. Prior to taking over the reins at USD, Fisher served as head coach at Wyoming from 1998-2003, followed by a two-year stint as an assistant at Nebraska.

The Aztecs are 76-62 against current members of the West Coast Conference. However, 29 of those defeats occurred at the hands of former Western Athletic Conference and Mountain West rival Brigham Young.

### With a Victory...

An SDSU win over USD on Tuesday will mean:

- The Aztecs raise their all-time record to 29-9 against the Toreros, including a 10-4 mark on the road.
- SDSU wins its third straight at Jenny Craig Pavilion.
- The Aztecs improve to 35-13 in December games since 2006.
- SDSU moves to 77-62 all-time against current WCC schools.

### Flashback: Aztecs-Toreros - 2013 Edition

San Diego State was saddled with its third straight hard-luck defeat to open the 2013-14 campaign after falling to the University of San Diego, 48-45, at Viejas Arena.

With the Aztecs clinging to a slim 45-43 lead in the defensive struggle, the Toreros' Amy Kame drained a three-point basket from the top of the key to put the visitors up for good at 46-45 with 1:32 left on the clock. SDSU (0-3) had a chance to force overtime on its last possession after USD (3-0) sank two of four free throws in the closing minute. However, Ahjalee Harvey's three-point attempt from the right corner was off the mark, spoiling the Aztecs' home opener.

SDSU posted a higher field-goal percentage than its opponent for the third consecutive game, with the Aztecs shooting 36.7 percent (18-49) from the perimeter, compared to USD's 31.8 percent clip (21-66). However, the Scarlet and Black was outrebounded by a 42-37 margin, including a 23-9 spread on the offensive glass. The Toreros capitalized on those opportunities, outscoring SDSU 21-8 in second-chance points.

In addition, the Aztecs lost the turnover battle as USD parlayed 22 miscues by the host school into 18 points, while SDSU was only able to muster nine points off 14 Torero blunders.

Individually, the Aztecs were led by junior Erimma Amarikwa, who totaled 13 points on 5-of-5 shooting and a 3-for-3 effort at the free-throw line to go with a team-high tying six rebounds. Elsewhere, Harvey contributed eight points, including two triples, while junior Desi Culberson knocked down a pair of threes as well to finish with six points of her own.

The Aztecs led 7-6 at the 14:19 mark of the first half following one of Harvey's aforementioned treys, before USD fashioned a 9-0 run over the ensuing 4:49, capped by two consecutive Brooke Jelniker jumpers. SDSU missed eight straight shots during that span until Amarikwa sank back-to-back layups to help the Aztecs answer right back with a 9-0 blitz of their own. After Culberson buried a three-pointer with four minutes left before intermission, SDSU trailed by just one at 17-16.

However, USD was able to maintain the upper hand in the closing minutes as Kame and Malina Hood converted baskets sandwiched around a jumper by sophomore Deidra Smith to increase the lead back to four at 22-18 with 2:04 to go. After the two sides exchanged turnovers and missed field goals, Culberson dialed up from beyond the arc once again with 44 seconds on the clock to give the contest its 22-21 score at the break.

USD built a pair of five-point leads early in the second half, including a 28-23 spread following a Kame jumper with nearly three minutes elapsed in the period. Moments later, Amarikwa finished off an old-fashioned three-point play; senior Danesha Long sank a free throw, while freshman Ariell Bostick hit a layup to give the hosts a 29-28 advantage with 14:56 to go.

The two sides fought for strategic control of the game over the next 9:14, with USD maintaining a 41-38 lead following a jumper by Hood at the 5:42 mark. However, Amarikwa scored the next four points on a layup and two foul shots to put SDSU back in front 42-41 with four minutes remaining. On the Toreros' next possession, Smith blocked three straight shots; however, the Aztecs were unable to secure the rebound on each occasion as Kame soon made the hosts pay by nailing a jumper from the right baseline with the shot clock running down.

Smith answered with a basket on SDSU's next foray up the court, while sophomore Deajanae Scurry hit one of two free throws shortly thereafter to up the Aztec lead to 45-43 with 2:22 left on the clock, setting the stage for Kame's clutch shot.

Kame, who tallied the Toreros' lone three-point make of the night, finished with 16 points to lead USD, while Jelniker chipped in 12 points of her own in the victory.

### Last Time Out: Aztecs-UCSB

Kristina Hunter and Erimma Amarikwa totaled 15 points and six rebounds apiece to lift the Aztecs to a 64-58 victory over UC Santa Barbara on Sunday at Viejas Arena.

Amarikwa connected on 7 of 11 field-goal attempts, scoring all of her points in the first half, while Hunter went 7-for-8 at the free-throw line, sinking three in the final minute to help preserve SDSU's third straight triumph over the Gauchos. With the victory, the Aztecs raise their record to 3-4 overall, while UCSB remains winless on the year at 0-8.

Neither side shot the ball well, with the Gauchos converting 41 percent of their field-goal attempts (24-58), compared to SDSU's 39 percent clip (21-54). However, the Aztecs sank 18 of 27 free throws, including their first 13 attempts, while UCSB went to the charity stripe just 10 times, draining eight tries for the game. In addition, SDSU registered a season-low 13 turnovers and connected

on 4 of 8 three-pointers, while the Gauchos were just 2 for 13 from beyond the arc.

The contest was a see-saw affair throughout the first half, featuring three ties and 11 lead changes. However, Ahjalee Harvey nailed a triple from the right wing with 3:42 remaining to ignite a decisive 11-0 run that put the Aztecs up for good at 34-24 by intermission. Conversely, UCSB shot itself in the foot during that span, misfiring on its final five field-goal attempts of the period while committing five turnovers.

Following the break, the Gauchos managed to trim the deficit to 43-40 with 9:47 left on the clock on a jumper by Kendra Morrison, before SDSU fashioned a timely 14-5 run over the next 5:25 to give itself a seemingly comfortable 57-45 advantage. However, UCSB would not go quietly, eventually narrowing the gap to 59-55 with 42 seconds remaining on a layup by Jasmine Ware. With time running out, the Gauchos were forced to foul, but the Aztecs stood their ground, sinking five free throws down the stretch to seal the win.

In addition to the heroics of Hunter and Amarikwa, SDSU received a solid contribution from Desi Culberson, who recorded nine points and three steals off the bench, while Harvey tallied with eight points and three assists. Elsewhere, Aleiah Brandon was a perfect 2-for-2 from both the field and the foul line to finish with six points, while freshman Lexy Thorderson notched her first collegiate three-pointer at the 7:34 mark of the second half.

On the flip side, Ware led all scorers with 20 points on 9-of-15 shooting for UCSB, while teammate Chaya Durr recorded 11 points before fouling out.

### Noting the UCSB Game

■ San Diego State enjoyed its first halftime lead of the season (34-24).

■ For the first time this year, the Aztecs committed fewer turnovers than the opposition (13-17).

■ SDSU improved to 65-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game.

■ With her eight points, Ahjalee Harvey reached 300 points for her career.

### Decembers to Remember

The Aztecs are a combined 34-13 during the month of December since 2006. Seven of those losses came to teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national poll, including a defeat to No. 23 Texas A&M and a setback to North Carolina State (rv) last year in the final of the San Diego Surf 'N Slam. The Aztecs have also come up short in previous years against No. 2 UConn, No. 7 Texas A&M, No. 14 Oklahoma State, No. 17 George Washington and USC (rv). The other six defeats were against UCLA in 2013, at Washington in 2012, at Washington State and against USD in 2011, vs. Pepperdine in overtime in 2009 and against Quinnipiac in the opener of the 2007 Surf 'N Slam. Of course, it should be noted that SDSU has played 35 of those 47 December contests at home.

### Fort Named Top MW Preseason Freshman; Aztecs Picked Seventh

San Diego State point guard McKynzie Fort was tabbed as the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year last month in a combined vote of the league's 11 head coaches and select media members.

Fort is the fifth consecutive Aztec player to garner top MW pre-season freshman accolades, following in the respective paths of Chloe Johnson, Deajanae Scurry and Desi Culberson, as well as Melissa Sweat, who received such distinction prior to the 2010-11 campaign.

Fort, who led the powerful Etiwanda High School program to the Southern Regional finals of the CIF playoffs as a senior last season, was a first-team all-state selection and Baseline League most valuable player honoree before earning all-area recognition by the *Los Angeles Times*.

As a team, SDSU was predicted to finish seventh in the pre-season poll released by the conference office. SDSU earned 134 points from the panel, trailing UNLV (143 pts.) by just nine points for sixth place.

Defending regular-season champion Colorado State was picked to repeat after receiving 21 of 28 first-place votes and 276 points, comfortably ahead of Boise State, which received four first-place votes and 241 points, while Wyoming was slotted

for the third position with three first-place votes and 235 points.

This year marks the first time since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign that SDSU has not been selected to finish among the top three places in the MW preseason rankings.

### Noting the Newcomers

In addition to McKynzie Fort, the Aztecs' highly touted freshman class includes two other former prep stars in Cheyenne Greenhouse (Riverside, Calif.) and Lexy Thorderson (Castle Rock, Colo.), both of whom could play significant roles in SDSU's fortunes this season. Greenhouse was a first-team all-CIF selection after leading Canyon Springs High to the Division I state championship as a senior in 2013-14. She also collected the Inland Empire League's most valuable player award and received first-team all-conference recognition for the fourth straight year.

Thorderson, meanwhile, garnered numerous postseason accolades at Rock Canyon High, where she finished her prep career as the school's all-time leading scorer. A nominee for the McDonald's All-America team, Thorderson led the state of Colorado in 3-point field goals made as a senior, earning second-team class 5A all-state distinction.

SDSU also solidified its depth for the 2015-16 season after junior Kym Ellison (Georgia Tech) and sophomore Geena Gomez (St. Joseph's) transferred to The Mesa in the summer of 2014. The two players will not be eligible to compete this season due to NCAA rules, but will serve as valuable assets to the team in practice.

### 2013-14 Rewind

After winning a program-record 27 games and capturing its second straight Mountain West regular-season championship, San Diego State faced a year of transition during the 2013-14 campaign. Not only did the Aztecs have to adjust to a brand new coaching staff, but they were also forced to overcome the loss of four senior starters who accounted for 64 percent of the team's scoring from the previous year. With five newcomers on board, growing pains were certainly inevitable. However, SDSU flashed its resiliency throughout the season, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and tying for sixth in the MW standings with a 9-9 mark. Below are some additional obstacles the Aztecs endured last year:

- SDSU had to replace two starters, Erimma Amarikwa and Ahjalee Harvey, who were lost for the year after suffering injuries during the non-conference schedule. As a result, the Aztecs employed 10 different starting lineups last season compared to just three in 2012-13.
- In addition, SDSU was faced with a difficult schedule featuring nine games against teams that advanced to postseason competition, including four squads that finished among the AP Top 25: South Carolina, Texas A&M, North Carolina State and USC.

SDSU dropped four very close games during the non-conference slate by an average of three points in losses to Sacramento State, USC, San Diego and UCLA.

Despite these tribulations, the gritty Aztecs found success on the court during the 2013-14 campaign. Below are a few of the accomplishments of last year's squad:

- SDSU led the Mountain West as team in rebounding margin (+7.6) and rebounding defense (33.1/game).
- The Aztecs also ranked second in the conference in field-goal percentage (.419) and offensive rebounds (15.3/game).
- SDSU averaged over 40 rebounds per contest (40.6) for the third straight season, representing its longest stretch since a six-year span from 1984-89.
- The Aztecs handed two-time defending MW tournament champion Fresno State its only home loss in conference play with a 70-69 upset on a late basket by Danesha Long. Coupled with a win at Fresno in 2013, SDSU is the only MW team to defeat the Bulldogs twice on the road in the past two years.
- The Aztecs topped the 80-point barrier in back-to-back conference games for the first time since joining the Mountain West after scoring 88 points in consecutive home victories over San José State and Utah State.

• Elsewhere, Stacie Terry tied for the second-highest victory total (13) ever by a first-year SDSU head coach in program history.

### 2014-15 By the Numbers

With a new season already underway, below are a few trends to watch in 2014-15:

- SDSU has claimed 37 of its last 48 home games and has gone 69-23 (.747) on the Viejas Arena floor since the start of the 2008-09 campaign.
- The Aztecs have recorded 65 Mountain West victories in the last six seasons after posting 31 wins in the league's first nine years.
- SDSU is 65-1 over the last three-plus seasons when leading with five minutes to go in the game, including its victory over UC Santa Barbara on Dec. 7. The Aztecs' lone blemish during that stretch was a heartbreaking 59-58 defeat at Washington in December 2012.
- SDSU is 34-13 in December games dating back to the 2006-07 campaign, with seven of those losses coming against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.
- The Aztecs have advanced to finals of the MW Championship in five of the last seven years after not winning a single game in the tournament's first eight years of existence.
- For the second straight season, SDSU will play 18 conference games. The Aztecs will complete a home-and-away slate with eight squads, while facing San José State (home) and Utah State (away) just once.

### SDSU Holds Groundbreaking Ceremony for Jeff Jacobs JAM Center

San Diego State held a ceremonial groundbreaking for the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center, the men's and women's basketball performance center, on Aug. 27. The JAM Center is scheduled to be completed by August 2015 and in time for the start of the 2015-16 campaign.

SDSU President Dr. Elliot Hirshman, men's hoops head coach Steve Fisher and Jeff Jacobs spoke before a selected group of invited guests, which included Steve and Lisa Altman, and Jim and Susan Morris, as well as members of both the Aztec men's and women's basketball programs. The master of ceremonies for the event was the voice of San Diego State men's basketball, Ted Leitner.

Preliminary site work started in July where the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center will be located, just south of the Fowler Athletics Center and east of the football practice fields. The facility, which will support the continued growth and development of the SDSU men's and women's basketball teams, includes two full-length courts, eight baskets, locker rooms, film rooms, team lounges, athletic training room and coaches locker rooms.

Hundreds of supporters contributed to the effort to make the Jeff Jacobs JAM Center a reality. In addition to the naming gift from Jeff Jacobs, Hal and Debby Jacobs, Steve and Lisa Altman and Jim Morris, creating the name "JAM" Center, sizeable donations were made from the Manna Charitable Foundation and the Walter and Betty Zable Foundation. The total cost of the project is \$14.5 million, of which \$12.5 million in private funding has been raised. No state funds will be used to construct this building.

The project was designed by JCJ Architecture and is being built by The Hunt Construction Group.

# STACIE TERRY

## Head Coach Second Season UT Arlington (1998)

San Diego native Stacie Terry was named the eighth head coach in the history of the San Diego State women's basketball program on May 15, 2013.

During her first season on Montezuma Mesa, Terry was saddled with the unenviable task of replacing four senior starters who accounted for nearly 64 percent of the team's scoring offense from the previous year, as well as overcoming the loss of two key players - forward Erimma Amarikwa, a preseason all-Mountain West selection, and starting point guard Ahjalee Harvey - to injuries prior to conference play.

Despite those obstacles and a demanding schedule featuring nine games with teams that eventually advanced to postseason competition, Terry's squad flashed its resiliency during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-9 mark in the MW.

Under Terry's guidance, the Aztecs led the league in rebounding margin and rebounding defense, while ranking second in field-goal percentage.

Individually, Terry also oversaw the progress of senior center Cierra Warren, who became the fifth SDSU player in the last six years to receive first-team all-MW recognition.

Prior to her arrival on The Mesa, Terry gained a wealth of experience as an assistant coach at the Division I level for 14 years, including five under head coach Nikki Caldwell, who transformed UCLA into a powerhouse before restoring LSU to national prominence.

During Terry's two seasons at LSU, the Lady Tigers compiled a 45-23 overall record and earned two NCAA tournament bids, including a Sweet 16 appearance during the 2012-13 campaign. During that season, the Lady Tigers also posted six victories against ranked opponents and finished with their second-highest scoring average (69.0) in the last seven years. Under Terry's guidance, forward LaShondra Barrett garnered first-team all-Southeastern Conference accolades and received honorable mention All-America distinction in 2012 before becoming a first-round draft choice of the WNBA's Washington Mystics.

Prior to her appointment at LSU, Terry served as an assistant under Caldwell at UCLA from 2008-11, helping the Bruins gain national acclaim with a pair of NCAA tournament appearances. During Terry's tenure, UCLA posted 72 overall victories, as the 2010-11 squad finished with a 28-5 record, setting a school record for fewest losses in a single season to go with a No. 7 national ranking. In addition, the Bruins signed the fourth-ranked recruiting class that season, according to ESPN HoopGurlz, while Terry helped mentor first-team all-Pac-10 performers in Doreena Campbell, Darxia Morris and Jasmine Dixon, a 2012 honorable mention AP All-America selection, as well as all-conference freshman honorees Atonye Nyingifa and Markel Walker.

Terry spent the 2007-08 campaign at Southern Mississippi, as the Golden Eagles posted a 21-14 record and

earned a postseason berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). While at Southern Miss, Terry spearheaded the development and coordination of the Lady Eagle recruiting campaign. Her responsibilities also included working with the perimeter players, scouting opponents and film breakdown, as well as coordinating all of the team's community service events.

Terry also coached for three seasons from 2004-07 as an assistant under Hall of Fame head coach Theresa Greutz at Illinois, where the Fighting Illini had three straight recruiting classes ranked among the top 25 in the nation, according to Blue Star Basketball, and made three consecutive trips to the WNIT. Her primary duties included defensive instruction and working with the perimeter players.

In addition, Terry coached at Dayton during the 2003-04 season following a three-year stint at Louisville from 2000-03. With the Cardinals, Terry's responsibilities encompassed recruiting, scouting, player development, summer camps and serving as a liaison for the program's community service outreach. Louisville captured the Conference USA regular-season title and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament in 2001 before making a WNIT appearance in 2002. She also assisted in signing the nation's 21st-ranked recruiting class in 2002-03, according to All-Star Girls Report. Terry recruited and coached all-Conference USA honoree Lori Nero, a draft choice of the WNBA's Houston Comets, as well as Sara Nord, who finished her collegiate career as the Cardinals' all-time assist leader and ranks among the top 15 scorers in school history.

Terry enjoyed a successful collegiate playing career at the University of Texas at Arlington, winning four varsity letters from 1994-98 under head coach Mike Dean. She earned first-team all-Southland Conference honors after leading the Mavericks in scoring with 17.4 points per game as a senior in 1997-98. Terry scored 1,169 points during her career at UTA and still ranks among the school's top 10 in three-point field goals made (third), assists (sixth), steals (seventh) and free-throw percentage (10th). She is just one of 17 players in Maverick history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, while her .335 career three-point field-goal percentage is also a school and Southland Conference career record.

Terry played one season of professional basketball in Warsaw, Poland, averaging 12.0 points and 6.0 assists with the Polonia Phoenix, before returning to UT Arlington to begin her coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1999.

Terry prepped at El Capitan High and held the Vaqueros' career scoring record for three years following her graduation. She was inducted into the school's athletic hall of fame in 2008.
