### AZTECS TO CONCLUDE CONFERENCE HOME SLATE WITH PAIR OF MATCHES THIS WEEK

- ◆ San Diego State returns home this week to complete the home portion of its 2011 Mountain West schedule with a pair of matches.
- ◆ The Aztecs will be in action on Thursday, Nov. 3, when they host New Mexico at 7:00 p.m. (PT) on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ SDSU will then square off against TCU on Saturday, Nov. 5, at 12:00 p.m. on its home floor.

### SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ The Aztecs' all-time record vs. New Mexico stands at 29-18 since the teams first met during the 1991 season. The Lobos have had the upper hand in recent years, winning seven of the last nine matches against SDSU since 2007. The Aztecs were successful on the Lobos' home court earlier this season as they posted a five-set victory. The series goes back to 1976 and schools have met annually since 1990 when both were members of the Western Athletic Conference. SDSU has a 10-10 mark against the Lobos in Albuquerque, 14-8 in San Diego and 5-0 on neutral courts.
- ◆ San Diego State and TCU have met 15 times in the past with SDSU holding an 8-7 advantage in the series. The Horned Frogs have captured three of the last five meetings between the teams and six of the last nine since 2007 although the Aztecs captured a five-set match in Fort Worth earlier this season. The Aztecs are 4-4 vs. TCU in Fort Worth and 4-3 in Peterson Gym. The Horned Frogs have won three of the last four matches against San Diego State in Peterson Gym.

### SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ New Mexico enters the week with an overall record of 13-10 and 5-5 in the Mountain West. The Lobos are led by Ashley Rhoades (3.86 kills, 0.92 blocks per set) and Kelly Williamson (3.42 kills, 1.69 digs per set). Rhoades' 4.53 points per set ranks second in the Mountain West. Libero Allison Buck leads the conference with an average of 4.88 digs per set in league matches (second in all matches sat 4.91 per set).
- ◆ TCU's record stands at 20-4 (7-3 Mountain West) with the Horned Frogs scheduled to visit UNLV Thursday night before facing San Diego State on Saturday. TCU's top players include Kristen Hester .360, (3.34 kills, 0.80 digs per set) and Jordan Raines (3.23 kills, 2.88 digs per set). As a team, the Frogs lead the Mountain West in kills, assists and digs.

### HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her third season with the Aztecs after being named prior to the 2009 campaign. Her two-year record at SDSU is 44-40.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 15-year career record stands at 205-230.
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

### WIN NO. 200

- ◆ With the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29, Head Coach Deitre Collins-Parker recorded her 200th career victory.
- ◆ She is in her 15th season as a collegiate head coach having previously held that position at UNLV and Colgate.

### HANNASCH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Junior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch led SDSU with 14 kills in its last match (at Wyoming, Oct. 29).
- ◆ She hit .345 in that contest while adding six blocks and a pair of digs.
- ◆ She had a streak of seven straight matches in double figures in kills ended in the contest at San Diego on Oct. 18.
- ◆ She then recorded 14 kills, five blocks and a .385 hitting percentage vs. UNLV three days later.
- ◆ Over the past six matches she is hitting .341 while averaging 3.20 kills per set.
- ◆ Her .765 hitting percentage in the win over Boise State (Oct. 15) was a career high as she had no errors in the match on 17 attacks.
- ◆ Hannasch set or tied five personal career highs in the win at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She set new career bests of 20 kills and 30 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She also tied her Aztec bests with three assists, three solo blocks and 11 total blocks.
- ◆ Her 20 kills and 11 blocks at TCU were her third double-double of the season and sixth of her career.
- ◆ She leads the San Diego State offense in kills, blocks, points and hitting percentage.
- ◆ She ranks among the top 10 in the Mountain West in each of those categories as well as kills.

### FOUCH ASSISTS

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch recorded a season-high 31 digs at Wyoming last Saturday (Oct. 29).
- ◆ It was the most digs in a match by an Aztec this season and one shy of her SDSU career high.
- ◆ Her average of 2.60 digs per set is second only to libero Kristi Jackels.
- ◆ Fouch leads the conference in all games with an average of 11.02 assists per set while her league-match average of 11.63 is also the best in the Mountain West.
- ◆ Her overall assist average ranks 27th in NCAA Division I this week.
- ◆ She set a career high with 65 assists in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Fouch set a career high with six blocks in the win over Wyoming on Sept. 29.
- ◆ She has recorded nine double-double performances (assists-digs) in 2011, the latest being a 54 assist-31 dig effort at Wyoming on Oct. 29.

### NASH CONTRIBUTES

- ◆ Summer Nash made a start at Wyoming on Oct. 29 after having appeared off the bench in the previous nine matches.
- ◆ She responded with eight kills, three digs and block in the three sets in which she played.
- ◆ She appeared in two sets off the bench against UNLV on Oct. 21 and recorded nine kills, five digs and a block in helping SDSU win the third and fourth sets.
- ◆ Nash's 13 kills and 10 digs vs. Cal State Fullerton on Sept. 20 was her first double-double as an Aztec.
- ◆ Her season high of 16 kills came vs. Valparaiso on Sept. 17.

## HARRIS AROUND THE BLOCK

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris, a sophomore transfer from Western Michigan, has started each of the last 16 matches after not appearing in SDSU's first five contests of the year due to injury.
- ◆ In SDSU's two matches last week she recorded a total of seven blocks while hitting .333.
- ◆ Her overall average of 0.98 blocks per set ranks sixth in the Mountain West while her mark of 1.00 in league matches is ninth in the conference stats.
- ◆ Harris set career highs with eight blocks, 19.0 points and a .522 hitting percentage in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ She also tied her career highs with 15 kills vs. the Lobos in that match.

## SHELTON SOLID UP FRONT

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton recorded her ninth double-figure kill effort of the season with 13 at Wyoming last Saturday (Oct. 29).
- ◆ She also added five digs, two service aces and an assist in that contest.
- ◆ Against UNLV on Oct. 21, she tied her career highs of 21 kills and four blocks while setting a new personal best with 23.5 points.
- ◆ She had recorded a career-highs in those categories with 21 kills and 21.5 points at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ Her eight digs at New Mexico on Oct. 9 tied her career best.
- ◆ Shelton is averaging 3.28 kills per set through 10 Mountain West matches to rank sixth in the league.

## SEXTON SERVES IT UP

- ◆ Senior outside hitter Kyley Sexton is averaging 0.28 aces per set, a mark which would rank seventh in the conference (all matches) if she had not missed several matches with an ankle injury in late September.
- ◆ She had a career-high four service aces in the victory over Nevada on Aug. 27.
- ◆ Her three blocks assists against Boise State on Oct. 15 tied her season high.
- ◆ Her season-high 19 kills vs. Portland on Aug. 27 is the second-highest total for an Aztec this fall.
- ◆ She recorded 13 kills in the win at TCU on Oct. 6, her second-best total of the 2011 campaign.

## JACKELS DIGGIN' IT

- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels saw a streak of double-figure dig efforts end in the win over Boise State on Oct. 15.
- ◆ She had finished in double figures in digs in every match this season with a high of 26 vs. Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ Going back to last season, that streak had extended to 19 consecutive matches.
- ◆ Jackels has joined the 1,000 dig club for her two-plus year career as an Aztec and enters the week with 1,226 digs to rank fourth on the SDSU all-time list.
- ◆ She ranks fourth in the conference this week in digs in Mountain West play at 4.13 per set.
- ◆ She is also ninth in service aces at 0.27 service aces per set in league matches.
- ◆ Jackels has notched at least one service ace in each of the Aztecs' last six matches.



### PEARSON SETS PERSONAL BESTS

- ◆ Senior Pajje Pearson averaged 2.00 kills and 2.00 digs per set in SDSU's two matches last weekend.
- ◆ In the win vs. Boise State on Oct. 15 she did a little of everything, finishing with six kills, two assists, two service aces and four digs along with a .500 hitting percentage.
- ◆ She had season highs of 12 digs and one solo block in the win at New Mexico on Oct. 9.
- ◆ Pearson set a personal career high with 17 kills and 20.0 points in the match at Tulane on Sept. 2.
- ◆ In the match at UC Riverside on Sept. 25, she set a career best with four service aces and tied her SDSU career high with four assists.
- ◆ Pearson had 15 kills and hit .423 (her highest attack percentage of 2011) in the four-set loss to Kansas on Sept. 16.
- ◆ In the season opener against UC Irvine she tied her Aztec career high with eight blocks in the win over the Anteaters.

### TOUGH AS STEEL

- ◆ Freshman right side hitter Chaiymin Steel tied her Aztec career best with 10 kills in the win over UNLV on Oct. 21.
- ◆ She hit .318 in that contest and also had four blocks, three digs and an assist.
- ◆ She had a career-high 12 digs in the victory at TCU on Oct. 6.
- ◆ She also contributed four blocks in that contest.
- ◆ Steel had the best match of her young Aztec career in the win at UC Riverside on Sept. 25.
- ◆ She finished with 10 kills while hitting .357, both highs for the first-year player from Reno, Nev.

### GOING LONG

- ◆ San Diego State's wins at TCU (Oct. 6) and New Mexico (Oct. 9) marked only the second time that the Aztecs have won back-to-back five-set matches on the road. The other occasion came during the 1988 season when they won at Fresno State and Pepperdine on consecutive days (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ SDSU has only had three consecutive five-set matches once in school history. That came in 1986 when they defeated San Jose State, UCLA (away) and Cal State Fullerton from Sept. 29 to Oct. 3.
- ◆ San Diego State has a record of 4-3 in five-set matches this season.

### THE RECORD BOOK

- ◆ A trio of Aztecs will make their marks in the SDSU career record listings before the end of the 2011 season.
- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels' 1,226 digs is fourth on the career Aztec top 10. Third place is currently held by Juliana Cezar (1993-96) with 1,369 career digs.
- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch has moved into the number-nine spot in career assists with 2,143. Former Aztec Melissa Stokes (1986-88) ranks eighth on the list with 2,239 assists.
- ◆ In addition, Andrea Hannasch is now 10th on the career blocks assists chart with 333. Ninth place is occupied by Angelica Jackson (1984-87) with 341.

### AMONG THE MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- ◆ After the first seven weeks of the season, three Aztecs appear among the top 10 in the Mountain West in various statistical categories both overall and in Mountain West matches only. (Stats are per set except for hitting percentage).

#### **AZTEC YOUTH**

- ◆ San Diego State fields one of the youngest teams in the nation according to a recent survey.
- ◆ The total of 14 freshmen and sophomores on the SDSU roster is the second-most in the country, behind only Air Force (15).
- ◆ As a percentage of the squad, the Aztecs are made up of 73.6% underclassmen, the seventh highest figure in NCAA Division I volleyball.

#### **SHELTON EARNS CONFERENCE AWARD**

- ◆ Sophomore Raegan Shelton earned Mountain West Volleyball Co-Player of the Week honors for matches played from Oct. 3-9, 2011.
- ◆ She had a career-high 21 kills and 58 attempts on .241 hitting against the Horned Frogs, the most kills by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ Against New Mexico on Sunday, Shelton had 19 kills on .267 hitting and tied her career-high with eight digs.
- ◆ For the week, Shelton averaged 4.00 kills, 0.40 blocks and 1.50 digs per set, while hitting .252. She averaged 4.20 points per set over 10 total sets.

#### **HANNASCH PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

- ◆ Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch earned Mountain West Volleyball Player of the Week honors for matches played during the opening weekend of the 2011 season (Aug. 26-27). It is the third weekly honor of her career.
- ◆ Hannasch led SDSU to a 3-0 record and the Aztec Invitational tournament title. She was named Most Valuable Player of the tournament for her performances against UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ She posted a double-double with 17 kills and 10 blocks in the 3-1 win over UC Irvine on Friday, Aug. 26. Her 23.5 points in the match were a career best.
- ◆ In the 3-2 win against Portland, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, six blocks, five digs and two service aces. The Aztecs beat Nevada, 3-0, in the nightcap with a team-high 12 kills and five blocks from Hannasch.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks, 1.17 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .398. She also accounted for 4.88 points per set.

#### **FOUCH ALL-TOURNEY HONOREE**

- ◆ Sophomore setter Johnna Fouch was named to the all-tournament team at the DePaul Invitational (Sept. 16-17).
- ◆ Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 12.30 assists per set and 2.60 digs per set.
- ◆ It was the second straight tournament in which Fouch was an all-tourney honoree as she received the same accolade at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic in New Orleans Sept. 2-3.

#### **ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS PART II**

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch and outside hitter Pajje Pearson were named to the all-tourney team at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic Sept. 2-3.
- ◆ Over the matches against Tulane and William and Mary on Sept. 2, Pearson averaged 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 3.12 points per set. She also recorded 0.50 blocks per set.
- ◆ Fouch, meanwhile, was the tournament's top setter with an average of 10.00 assists per set. She also finished with marks of 0.62 kills and accounted for 0.88 points per set from her setter position.

#### **ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS PART III**

- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Kyle Sexton were named to the all-tournament team at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 26-27).
- ◆ Hannasch averaged 3.58 kills, 1.75 blocks and 1.17 digs in wins over UC Irvine, Portland and Nevada.
- ◆ Sexton averaged 3.00 kills per set over the three matches and had six service aces and a .281 hitting percentage.

#### **ATHLETIC RELATIVES**

- ◆ Two members of the Aztecs have notable athletic connections in their family.
- ◆ Redshirt freshman Oni Lattin's grandfather, David Lattin, was a member of the 1966 Texas Western (now UTEP) basketball team under Don Haskins that upset Kentucky for the national title.
- ◆ Emily Harris' father, Al Harris, played defensive end and linebacker for the Chicago Bears from 1979-84 and 1986-88 before finishing his career with the Philadelphia Eagles from 1989-90.
- ◆ In addition, assistant coach Melanie Greene's dad, Ken Greene, played pro football with the San Diego Chargers and St. Louis Cardinals.

#### **PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS**

- ◆ The Mountain West coaches and media poll has predicted the Aztecs to finish third in the eight-team league. It is SDSU's highest preseason conference ranking since joining the league in 1999.
- ◆ In the 12 years of the MW's existence, SDSU has finished second (2002), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003), fifth (2005), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final standings.
- ◆ Colorado State has been chosen to defend its Mountain West title from a year ago with New Mexico picked to finish second. The results of the preseason poll are as follows:

- ◆ San Diego State's losses at Colorado State and Wyoming last week marked the first time that the Aztec had lost two matches in a row this season.
- ◆ Kyla Oropeza's 13 digs at Wyoming on Oct. 29 tied her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ Defensive specialist Courtney Vaccarello had her first kill of the season at Wyoming last weekend.
- ◆ San Diego's win over Boise State on Oct. 15 was its fourth straight victory. It marked the Aztecs' longest win streak since the 2007 season when they won six in a row.
- ◆ As a team, San Diego State stands first in kills and assists in league matches.
- ◆ San Diego State's .387 hitting percentage in the match vs. Wyoming on Sept. 29 was its highest of the season.
- ◆ Eleven different players have started matches for the Aztecs this season (not including libero Kristi Jackels).
- ◆ Only Johnna Fouch and Andrea Hannasch have started every match.
- ◆ SDSU captured the titles at a pair of in-season tournament titles in 2011. The Aztecs won the Aztec Invitational with a 3-0 mark and were declared co-champions of the Sugar Bowl Collegiate Classic at Tulane along with Southern Illinois when that tourney was cut short due to weather.
