WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEK IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ After its mid-week contest at Long Beach State, the Aztecs will hit the road for a three-game conference series at Air Force in Colorado Springs, Colo., that gets underway on Friday (April 12) at 3:00 p.m. (MT) at Falcon Field.
- ◆ The teams will also meet for contests on Saturday (April 13) and Sunday (April 14) at 1:00 p.m. and 12:00 p.m. (MT) respectively.

SERIES RECORD

- ◆ San Diego State's all-time record against Air Force stands at 86-19 since the teams first met in 1961.
- ◆ The Aztecs have won the last 36 of the last 40 meetings between the teams and have dropped only five games to the Falcons during Tony Gwynn's reign as head coach. Among those five losses is a pair of setbacks in Colorado Springs during the 2012 season.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 46-7 vs. the Falcons in San Diego and 35-12 at Air Force's home field. The Aztecs have won all five meetings at neutral sites.

SCOUTING THE FALCONS

- ◆ Air Force begins the week with a mark of 9-21 overall and 3-7 in the Mountain West. The Falcons had games at Nebraska-Omaha scheduled for Tuesday and at Creighton on Wednesday rained out.
- ◆ Air Force's top hitters include Garrett Custons (.364, 13 doubles, 18 RBI), Peter Johnson (.362, 8 doubles, 21 RBI) and Seth Kline (.345, 8 doubles, 20 RBI).
- ◆ Air Force has a .279 team batting average with a 5.28 ERA.

HEAD COACH TONY GWYNN

- ◆ Tony Gwynn is in his 11th season as San Diego State's head coach after being named to the position in Sept. 2001. He became just the fourth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
- ◆ In 2002, he served as a volunteer coach for the Aztecs under Jim Dietz, who retired at the end of that season.
- ◆ In 2004, Gwynn led his squad to the Mountain West Conference regular-season championship and was named the MWC coach of the year.
- ◆ A former Aztec who played baseball at San Diego State (1979-81), Gwynn concluded a 20-year major league career with the San Diego Padres in 2001. With a career batting average of .338, he won eight National League batting titles, five Gold Gloves, and made 15 appearances in the annual All-Star Game.
- ◆ Tony Gwynn was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on July 29, 2007.
- ◆ His overall record entering the week stands at 307-327 (.484). His mark in Mountain West Conference contests is 155-111 (.583).

GWYNN GETS 300TH WIN

- ◆ SDSU Head Coach Tony Gwynn picked up his 300th victory in charge of the SDSU baseball program during the Aztecs' 12-2 win over Long Beach State on Tuesday.
- ◆ Here are some other Gwynn coaching milestone victories:

MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Senior catcher Romanski was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his efforts in the Aztecs' five games last week (April 1-7).
- ◆ For the week he hit .474 (9-of-19) with a double, home run, three runs scored and five RBI. He also walked once and had one sacrifice bunt.
- ◆ Defensively from behind the plate, Romanski was errorless with 45 putouts and eight assists.
- ◆ In Sunday's 8-1 win, Romanski had a pair of hits with the second being a solo home run, his first of the season and his first as an Aztec.

MW PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Sophomore right-hander Michael Cederroth earned conference Pitcher of the Week honors after tossing eight shutout innings in SDSU's 2-0 win over Nevada last Friday.
- ◆ In that contest, he struck out a career-high 14 batters through eight innings.
- ◆ He recorded at least one strikeout in each inning, including three in the eighth.
- ◆ Cederroth scattered four hits and only walked one hitter.
- ◆ In addition, College Sports Madness has named San Diego State Pitcher Michael Cederroth the Madness Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week for his exceptional performance during last week's action.

SDSU PITCHING ROTATION

- ◆ SDSU's pitching rotation for the weekend includes Michael Cederroth on Friday along with Philip Walby and Ryan Doran on Saturday and Sunday respectively.
- ◆ In Cederroth's last outing (vs. Nevada on April 5) he tossed eight shutout innings with a walk and a career-high 14 strikeouts in the 2-0 win over the Wolf Pack.
- ◆ Walby went six innings in a no-decision vs. Nevada last Saturday (April 6). He surrendered four runs (two earned) on seven hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in a game won by SDSU in the final inning.
- ◆ Doran improved to 5-2 with a win over Nevada on Sunday (April 7) in which he went 7.2 innings along one run on five hits with four walks and seven strikeouts.

MUNO GOES DEEP

- ◆ First baseman Ryan Muno connected for his first home run of the season on Monday, April 1, vs. UC Riverside, a three-run shot deep over the left field fence at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ Muno made his return to the lineup vs. UNLV on March 22 after missing five weeks with a broken hand suffered during practice on Feb. 19.
- ◆ Since his return, he is hitting .381 (16-for-42) with seven doubles, a home run, 11 runs scored and 13 RBI.

ROMANSKI GETS ON

- ◆ Catcher Jake Romanski had a streak of reaching base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in 14 straight games come to an end against Nevada last Friday when he went 0-for-3.
- ◆ His five-hit effort at Fresno State on March 16 was a career high and the only five-hit game by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ He also tied his Aztec best with three runs scored in that contest.
- ◆ He had an 11-game hitting streak ended in the game at Arkansas on March 9.
- ◆ In those contests he went 16-for-38 (.421) with three double and five runs scored.
- ◆ Romanski's 11-game streak is the longest by an Aztec this season.

DERBY SAVES

- ◆ Freshman closer Bubba Derby made two appearances last weekend against Nevada picking up a save and a win in the first two games of that series.
- ◆ On Friday (April 5) he tossed the final inning of the Aztecs' 2-0 win over the Wolf Pack to notch his seventh save of the year.
- ◆ On Saturday (April 6) he got the final out in the top of the ninth and was credited with the victory when SDSU scored the winning run in the bottom of the same frame.
- ◆ Derby has made a total of 15 relief appearances this season covering 17.2 innings and has struck out 22 batters and surrendered only three walks.
- ◆ His seven saves is tied for the most in the Mountain West this week.

ALLEN STREAKING

- ◆ Greg Allen is on a six-game hitting streak during which he has gone 8-for-24 (.333) with five runs scored and four RBI.
- ◆ Allen has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the last 14 games.
- ◆ He is third on the squad in multiple-hit games with nine.
- ◆ He turned in his second four-hit effort of the season on Feb. 27 in the 7-4 win at Santa Clara.
- ◆ He also had four RBI in that contest with a pair of bases-loaded singles.
- ◆ He leads the team in runs (27) and steals (11).
- ◆ He leads the conference lead in steals heading into this weekend's action at Air Force.

ROBARDS GETS SECOND WIN

- ◆ Sophomore lefty Mike RoBards recorded his second win of the year on April 1 against UC Riverside.
- ◆ In that contest he went seven innings allowing one run on five hits with a walk and a season-high six strikeouts.

- ◆ He recorded his first win of the season as the starting pitcher against Long Beach State on March 19.
- ◆ He went 5.2 innings allowing two runs (one earned) on eight hits with three strikeouts.
- ◆ RoBards made four relief appearances prior to his three starts and has moved into the role of SDSU's mid-week starting pitcher.

FRANCE PLAYS LONG BALL

- ◆ Freshman third baseman Ty France hit his third home run of the year last Saturday (April 6) against Nevada, a shot that tied the contest in the eighth inning of a game won by SDSU in its final at bat.
- ◆ His three home runs lead the team this season as no other Aztec has more than one.
- ◆ France saw an eight-game hitting streak end on March 29 at New Mexico.
- ◆ During that streak he went 10-for-29 (.345) with 9 RBI.
- ◆ France had a season-high four RBI in the game at Fresno State on March 16.
- ◆ He had a single and two RBI vs. Long Beach State on Tuesday (March 19).
- ◆ He singled in the winning runs in the bottom of the eighth inning in the 5-3 win over UNLV on March 22.
- ◆ His eight-game hitting streak was the third-longest on the team this season.

ZIER STREAKING

- ◆ Second baseman Tim Zier has a nine-game hitting streak in progress during which he has gone 14-for-33 (.424) with two doubles, eight runs scored and six RBI.
- ◆ He had a career-high four hits in the win over Long Beach State on March 19.
- ◆ He also had two RBI and two runs scored in that contest.

SHEEHAN SHINES

- ◆ Freshman Danny Sheehan went 3-for-8 over the final two games against Nevada last weekend (April 6-7).
- ◆ On Saturday he had a pair of hits including an RBI single that drove in the run that got the Aztecs to within a run at 4-3.
- ◆ On Sunday he delivered a two-run single on a hit-and-run play during SDSU's four-run sixth inning.
- ◆ As the right fielder, he also threw out a runner attempting to go from first to third on a base hit.

MILLER TOUGH ON THE MOUND

- ◆ Senior Ethan Miller returned to form in his lone relief stint last weekend against Nevada on Sunday (April 7). In that game he went 1.1 innings allowing a hit with no walks and a pair of strikeouts.
- ◆ He had a streak of 20 consecutive innings without allowing a run come to an end New Mexico on March 29 when he surrendered four runs to the Lobos in the contest on Friday, March 29.
- ◆ Miller made his lone start of the year in the series finale at Arkansas on March 9.
- ◆ In that game he tossed 6.0 innings allowing no runs on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts.
- ◆ He left the contest after six innings with the scored tied 0-0 and was not involved in the decision.

NATIONAL LEADERS

- ◆ As a team, San Diego state ranks among the top 50 in the nation in two categories. There are currently a total of 295 teams playing Division I baseball.
- ◆ That list included strikeouts per nine innings (7.8 - 44th)) and fielding percentage (.974 - 48th).
- ◆ Individually, Bubba Derby ranks 20th in the nation in saves with seven and Michael Cederoth is 22nd in strikeouts per nine innings (10.24).
- ◆ Other Aztecs in the top 50 include Evan Potter and Time Zier in sacrifice bunts (8 - 33rd) and Jake Romanski among toughest to strike out (1K per 14 ABs - 48th).

POWER SHORTAGE

- ◆ Jake Romanski's home run on Sunday, April 7, vs. Nevada was just the team's sixth of the season.
- ◆ Freshman third baseman Tyler France hit his third homer of the year the previous day vs. the Wolf Pack.
- ◆ Sophomore outfielder Matt Muñoz and senior first baseman Ryan Muno are the only other Aztecs to have homered this season.
- ◆ San Diego State has hit a total of six home runs through the first 32 games of the season.
- ◆ Conversely, foes have hit 10 home runs.

AZTECS PICKED SECOND

- ◆ San Diego State has been picked to finish second in the regular-season Mountain West Conference baseball standings.
- ◆ In a vote of MW head coaches, the Aztecs received one first-place vote and 26 points to finish behind favorite New Mexico (35 points).

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Tim Zier was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in the series at USD Feb. 15-17.
- ◆ Zier hit .429 (6-of-14) for the weekend with two doubles and seven RBI as the Aztecs swept No. 12 San Diego in a three-game series to open the season.
- ◆ He recorded SDSU's first RBI in each game as the Aztecs never trailed during the series.
- ◆ In the season opener (Feb. 15), he hit an RBI double in his first at-bat and ended up 3-for-5 from the plate with three RBI, a double and a run scored.
- ◆ During Saturday's (Feb. 16) 4-2 victory, Zier had an RBI single and double.

- ◆ The fourth previous draftee is freshman catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers).

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ The 2-0 win over Nevada last Friday (April 5) was the first time in 16 contests this season that SDSU has won when scoring three or fewer runs.
- ◆ Freshman right-hander Tyler Sapp made his first collegiate start a good one as he went seven innings allowing one run on three hits with two walk and seven strikeouts over seven innings in a no-decision at UC Riverside on April 2.
- ◆ First baseman Mitch Bluman had a season-high two hits and three RBI in the series finale at New Mexico on March 30.
- ◆ Tim Zier leads the team with seven multiple-RBI games followed by Ty France with five.
- ◆ Zier is batting .415 (17-for-41) with runners in scoring position.
- ◆ Zier's 10 multiple-hit contests trails only Jake Romanski, who has 12 this season.
- ◆ Zier, France and Greg Allen are the only three players to have started all 33 games for the Aztecs this season.
- ◆ Matt Muñoz had a personal season-high three hits and two runs scored in the victory over Long Beach State on March 19.
- ◆ Michael Cederoth's .208 opponent batting average ranks second in the conference this week while Philip Walby's mark of .217 is sixth.
