Posted season highs of 18 minutes and four rebounds in a home win over USC (11-30-12) ... Scored a season-best 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting, including a pair of three-pointers, helping the Aztecs secure a road victory at Cal Poly (12-16-12) ... Tallied five points in consecutive appearances at Boise State (2-6-13) and vs. UNLV (2-17-13) ... Also saw action in two MW tournament games against Nevada (3-14-13) and New Mexico (3-15-13), as well as SDSU's first-round victory over UC Santa Barbara in the WNIT (3-20-13).

► **At Midland College**

Spent two seasons at Midland College in Midland, Texas, where she played under head coach Ron Jones ... Garnered WJCAC all-conference honors and was also named to the All-Region V team in her sophomore campaign after leading the Lady Chaparrals to a 23-8 record ... Averaged 11.3 points and 5.4 rebounds per game as a sophomore ... As a freshman, she led Midland to a 27-6 record and trip to the Region V Tournament championship game ... That season, she averaged 11.5 points and 6.1 rebounds per game for Midland en route to earning WJCAC MVP accolades as well as NJCAA Honorable Mention All-America and all-region honors.

Was one of five Aztecs to receive all-Mountain West honors after earning third-team distinction ... Topped the league with a 53.2 field-goal percentage in MW games and ranked third with a 50.2-percent clip overall ... Averaged 9.6 points and 6.3 rebounds, with the latter ranking 11th in the league for all games ... Tied for third in the MW with 3.1 offensive boards in conference games ... Finished second on the team behind Chelsea Hopkins with four

double-doubles and tied Kristina Hunter for third with 20 blocks ... Was one of five SDSU players to shoot over 70 percent from the free-throw line, draining 64-of-91 attempts (.703) ... Posted double-digit scoring performances on 17 occasions, including five times in a six-game stretch from Jan. 19-Feb. 9 ... Poured in 16 points and set a personal best with 12 rebounds to help the Aztecs knock off UC Irvine (11-14-12) ... Logged a career-high 35 minutes in a victory vs. Auburn at the Omni Hotels Classic (11-23-12) ... Tossed up her first collegiate three-point try with the shot clock winding down at

Colorado (11-24-12) ... Was also 7-for-8 from the charity stripe against the Buffaloes ... Led all scorers with 16 points on 7-of-10 shooting in a win over Fresno Pacific (12-19-12) ... Registered a career-high 14 field-goal attempts, finishing with 15 points in a comeback victory against Nevada (1-23-13) ... ► **Coach Terry Says:**

"Desi is a great athlete who can do a lot of different things to help us win. She can defend, rebound, pass and score. She brings tremendous enthusiasm both on and off the court and does all the little things that will make us better."

► **As A Sophomore (2012-13)**

Provided valuable minutes as a key reserve in 32 of the team's 34 games, averaging 2.9 points and 2.8 rebounds per contest ... Led the Aztec sophomore class with an average of 14.9 minutes per game ... Finished Mountain West competition tied for 10th in the league in blocked shots (0.8/g) ... Totaled eight points on 3-of-3 shooting, including a pair of three-pointers vs. No. 14 Oklahoma State at the San Diego Surf 'N Slam (12-30-12) ... Tied her collegiate best with three blocks and added two assists at UNLV (1-16-13) ... Came away with a season-high three steals at home vs. Air Force (2-2-13)

... Went 4-for-4 from the charity stripe and dished out a pair of assists at Nevada (2-23-13) ... Finished with seven points, sinking all three of her field-goal attempts, while adding five rebounds and a block vs. Colorado State (2-13-13) ... Played a season-long 28 minutes at Air Force, recording her first collegiate double-double with career-highs of 15 points and 13 rebounds to help SDSU clinch its second straight Mountain West regular-season title (3-6-13) ... Tallied four points and eight rebounds vs. Boise State (3-9-13) ... Averaged 5.0 points, 2.3 rebounds and 18.3 minutes in three games at the MW tournament ... Blocked two shots in the Aztecs' win over UC Santa Barbara in the first round of the WNIT (3-20-13).

► **As A Freshman (2011-12)**

Preseason Mountain West Freshman of the Year ... Only true freshman to log a start for the Aztecs in 2011-12 ... Played in all 32 games, earning a starting spot in the opening eight contests ... Finished the season tied with Courtney Clements as the team's second-leading rebounder with 5.3 per game and was tops among MW freshmen ... Had 83 offensive boards, which is 28 more than any other SDSU player ... Also chipped in just under five points a contest (4.6) and had 25 steals and 15 blocked shots ...
