Aztecs End Fall Campaign At Las Vegas Showdown

The San Diego State women's golf team completes its 2011 fall campaign starting Monday morning with the three-day, 54-hole Las Vegas Collegiate Showdown at the par-72, 6,329-yard Boulder Creek Golf Club in Boulder City, Nev., Oct. 24-26.

The Aztecs are one of 16 schools in the field for the 10th annual event. Other participating squads include fellow Mountain West members host UNLV and Colorado State, as well as BYU, East Carolina, Fresno State, Idaho, Long Beach State, Louisville, Miami, Missouri, Nevada, Oklahoma, Pepperdine, UC Davis and UC Irvine.

SDSU is currently ranked 33rd nationally by *Golfweek*/Sagarin and 37th by *golfstat.com*, and is one of five teams in this week's tournament rated in the top 50. The Aztecs are participating in the Las Vegas Collegiate Showdown for the second consecutive season and the third time since 2004.

The field will play 18 holes of golf each day, starting with tee times on Monday and Tuesday as early as 7:30 a.m. PT from both the No. 1 and No. 10 holes. Wednesday's action will feature a shotgun start with all squads beginning at 8 a.m. Live results for all three days will be available on the schedule page on goaztecs.com, as well as on golfstat.com.

First-year head coach Leslie Spalding will bring the same starting five golfers to the Las Vegas area for the third consecutive tournament.

Senior **Malin Enarsson (Gothenburg, Sweden)**, juniors **Gina Clark (Murrieta, Calif.)** and **Christine Wong (Richmond, B.C.)**, sophomore **Tessa The (Los Altos, Calif.)** and freshman **Amy Alston (Mission Viejo, Calif.)** are all slated to make the trip. The Aztecs will not have a sixth student-athlete competing as an individual for the first time since the opener.

A year ago, Enarsson and Clark both played in the Las Vegas Collegiate Showdown. Wong, meanwhile, missed the only tournament of her career, as she was representing her native Canada at the Women's World Amateur Team Championships in Argentina.

Flashback: 2010 LV Collegiate Showdown

The San Diego State women's golf team settled for a 13th-place performance in its final 2010 fall event, the UNLV Las Vegas Collegiate Showdown in Boulder City, Nev. The Aztecs posted a three-day, 54-hole total of 41-over 905 at the par-72, 6,329-yard Boulder Creek Golf Club.

Then sophomore **Alessia Knight (Bologna, Italy)** was SDSU's top finisher, taking 39th overall with a 9-over 225, including a 79 in the final 18 holes. Three Aztecs, Stephanie Arcala, Gina Clark and Malin Enarsson, all tied for 54th place at 12-over 228.

Rounding out the San Diego State contingent was senior Samantha Roberts, who carded a 10-over 82, to finish 80th

with a 238 in her first action of the 2010-11 campaign.

Last Time Out: Aztecs 12th at Stanford

The San Diego State women's golf team fell just one stroke short of finishing in the top 10, as the Aztecs ended the 54-hole Stanford Intercollegiate with a 14-over 298 to place 12th out of 16 teams on Oct. 16. SDSU's three-day total of 23-over 875 was only one stroke behind No. 9 Texas and No. 50 Stanford, who tied for 10th place with an 874, at the par-71, 6,148-yard Stanford Golf Course.

Junior Christine Wong finished as SDSU's top golfer in a tie for 25th place with a 2-over 215, including two consecutive even-par rounds to start the tournament. Senior Malin Enarsson was the only other Aztec in the top 50, as tied for 47th place at 6-over 219.

Freshman Amy Alston tied for 53rd at 7-over 220, and junior Gina Clark carded her best 18 holes in the final round with a 74 to finish 75th with a 230.

After starting the tournament with a promising 1-over 72, sophomore Tessa The logged back-to-back rounds in the 80s to tie her for 79th with a 20-over 233. Junior Alessia Knight, who was competing as an individual, ended up in 86th place at 39-over 252.

Spalding Named SDSU's Women's Golf Coach

San Diego State athletic director Jim Sterk announced the hiring Aug. 1, of Leslie Spalding as head women's golf coach. Spalding played on the LPGA Tour for 10 years, and most recently was the head coach at Montana State for the last four seasons.

The Billings, Mont., native played on the LPGA Tour from 1996 to 2005, competing in 215 events with seven top-10 finishes and more than \$600,000 in prize money. After completing her playing career, she served as the head women's golf coach at Montana State from 2007-11.

As a collegian, Spalding attended the University of Alabama on a golf scholarship from 1987 to 1991 and earned her bachelor's degree in telecommunication/film with a minor in marketing in 1992.

Rewind: Aztecs Earn Second Consecutive NCAA bid

The 2010-11 season produced a mixed bag of results for the San Diego State women's golf team.

On one hand, the Aztecs earned their second consecutive NCAA regional berth, marking the first time they accomplished that feat as a team in back-to-back seasons in program history. On the other hand, SDSU came in 17th out of 24 teams at that event and were fifth at the conference championships.

The Aztecs did win one tournament, the 12-team Gold Rush in Yorba Linda, Calif., in mid-February, and placed in the top five in three other events.

As a testament to its strength of schedule, San Diego State boasted the second-highest ranking among MWC schools and were rated 45th nationally at the end of the season by *Golfweek* and 46th by *golfstat.com*.
