What's On Tap

Fifth-seeded San Diego State will face fourth-seeded New Mexico in the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Conference Championships in Salt Lake City, Utah on Wednesday. The Aztecs and Lobos have met twice before in MWC Tournament play with SDSU owning the series lead, 2-0. The winner of the match will advance to the semifinals to play No. 13 Utah on Thursday.

Last Year's MWC Championships

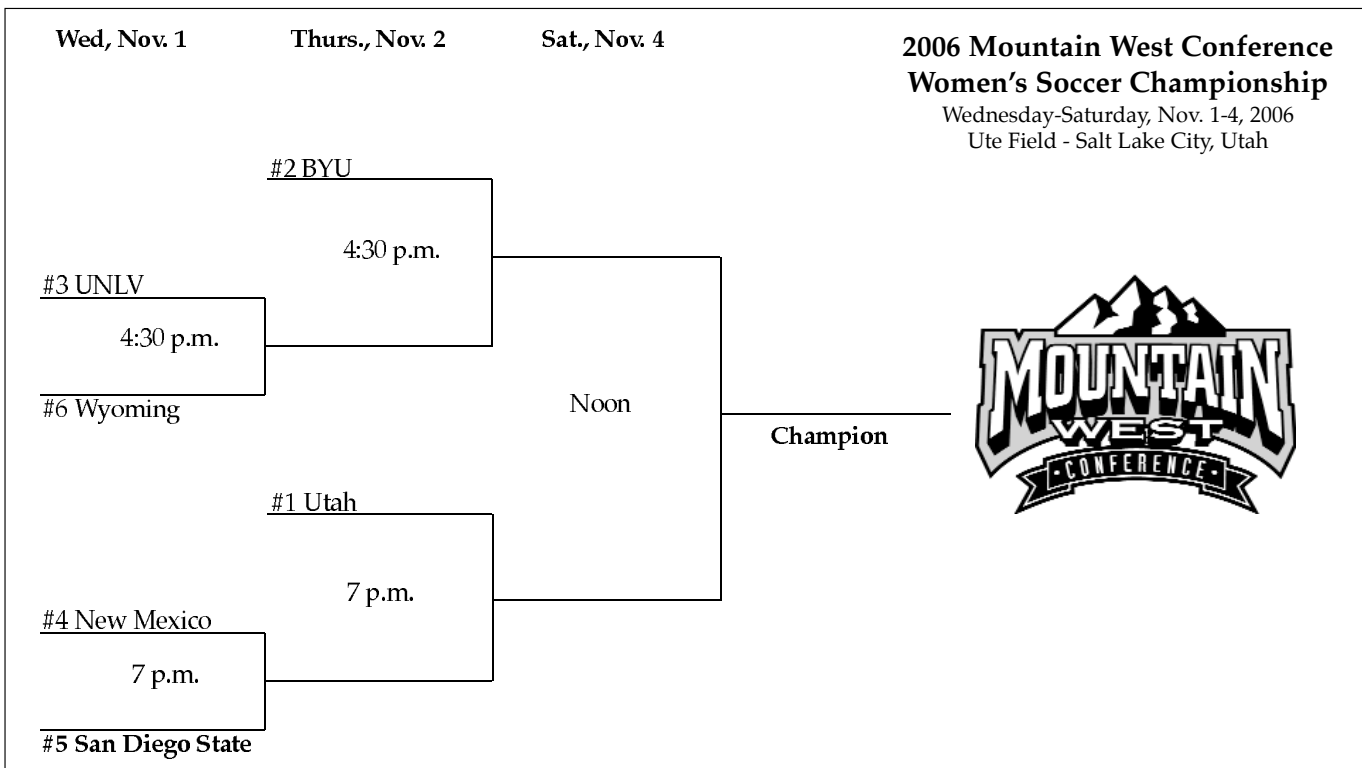
► In last year's conference tournament, the Aztecs pulled off an upset in the first round over third-seeded BYU. Freshman Erika Sutton (Arvada, Colo.) scored the game winning goal for SDSU and assisted on sophomore Lisa Nielsen's first goal of the season to help the Aztecs defeat No. 17 Brigham Young, 2-0. In the semifinals, SDSU held a 1-0 lead over No. 2 seed UNLV courtesy of Jen Mello's team-leading eighth goal of 2005. The Aztecs looked as if they were going to win the game, but in the 88th minute the Rebels' Tanya Roberts used her head to send the game into overtime. Shortly after the overtime period began, UNLV would strike once more to defeat the Aztecs, 2-1.

A Look at New Mexico

► SDSU and the Lobos met almost two weeks ago in New Mexico and the Lobos handed the Aztecs their first conference loss of 2006. Since then, SDSU has been unable to find the win column, while New Mexico has gone 1-0-1 with a tie vs. BYU at home and a 3-0 win over Air Force in Colorado Springs. The Lobos allow 0.73 goals/game and jump on their opponents early, outscoring them, 11-4, in the first half. In goal, Shannon Adranga posts an 8-6-4 record with six shutouts and a 0.74 GAA. Her six shutouts rank second in the Mountain West. Offensively, Bridgette Sanchez leads New Mexico with five goals and 14 points. She is also tied for the team lead in assists with four.

What to Watch For

► SDSU's offense. The Aztec offense has shown flashes of its power this season (they have scored at least two goals in every game they have won) and is 6-0-2 when scoring a goal.



The Mello and Sutton Connection

They're back... A year after leading the team in scoring as freshmen and accounting for 44.6 percent of the team's points, sophomores Jen Mello and Erika Sutton have had an even better season in 2006.

Over the course of the last two seasons, the Aztecs are 12-2-1 (3-0-1 in 2006) when Sutton records at least one point, 11-2-1 (5-0-1 in 2006) when Mello does the same and 7-1 (2-0 in 2006) when each contributes at least one point.

The sophomore duo has 53.3 (8-of-15) of the squad's assists, 52.6 (30-of-57) percent of its points, and 52.4 (11-of-21) percent of the team's goals.

Earlier this season, Sutton became the fourth Aztec to be named to the *Soccer Buzz* Elite Team of the Week and also earned MWC Offensive Player of the Week honors. Mello became the third Aztec in 2006 to garner MWC Player of the Week honors, winning the award for her three-goal, one-assist performance versus No. 15 BYU and Wyoming.

Last season, Sutton earned *Soccer Buzz* Freshman All-Far West Region accolades and was named second-team all-MWC.

Aztec Notes

- ▶ 19 of 21 goals this year for SDSU have come from underclassmen.
- ▶ The Aztecs have started eight underclassmen in 16 of 19 games this season.
- ▶ 26 Aztecs have seen playing time this year.
- ▶ The Aztecs have used 15 different starting lineups in 19 games in 2006.

Not Mello-ing Out

In her sophomore year, Jen Mello is continuing to be an integral part of the Aztec offense. She currently leads the team in goals (8), points (19) and shots on goal (22). Mello has three multi-goal games in 2006 (Sept. 8 at UC Irvine, Oct. 8 vs UNLV and Oct. 15 at Wyoming). The Pleasanton, Calif., native is second in the Mountain West in goals (8), goals per game (0.44), points (19) and points per game (1.06). Mello's performance three weeks ago earned her the Mountain West Conference Co-Offensive Player of the Week for Oct. 9-15. During the week, Mello scored three goals and tallied one assist (two goals versus Wyoming; one goal, one assist at No. 15 BYU). Mello also was named to the *Soccer Buzz* Elite Team of the Week for her performance versus BYU and Wyoming. It was the first such honor for the sophomore forward.

Sutton On Point

Despite playing defender for the last few matches, sophomore Erika Sutton has tallied 11 points through 19 contests this season, which has her tied for seventh in the Mountain West. Her five assists place her second in the MWC behind Utah's Amanda Feigt. The Arvada, Colo., native was named a Breitbard Star of the Month for August by the San Diego Hall of Champions for her two-goal, two-assist performance at the Purdue Boilermaker Cup, which also earned her the MWC Offensive Player of the Week award.

Strength of Schedule

The coaching staff certainly didn't make things easy for a young squad with a schedule that features 10 opponents that advanced to the 2005 NCAA soccer tournament. Here is a look at how far those teams advanced:

Fountain of Youth

About 90 percent (19-of-21) of SDSU's goals this season have come from underclassmen. If you break it down by class the sophomores have 12 of the 21 (57.1 percent) and the freshmen have accounted for 7 of the 21 (33.3 percent) of the Aztec goals in 2006.

Save By Burson!

With her 91 saves this season, junior goalkeeper Cat Burson has moved up to fourth on the SDSU all-time saves list (156). The 91 saves sets a career high for the junior goalkeeper and is the most by an Aztec in one season since 2001 when Linnea Quinones had 90 saves. The all-time leader for saves in one season is Elizabeth Judkins, who had 99 during the 1994 season.
