AZTECS SET TO WRAP UP 2013 HOME SEASON

- ◆ San Diego State returns to Aztec Court this week for its final two home matches of the 2013 season.
- ◆ On Thursday, Nov. 21, the Aztecs will take on league foe Boise State at 7:00 p.m. (PT).
- ◆ Two days later (Saturday, Nov. 23), SDSU will face Utah State at 1:00 p.m. on Aztec Court.
- ◆ The Boise State match will have live video streaming in the Mountain Digital Network while the Utah State contest will be streamed live at Go Aztecs.com.
- ◆ Both games will feature free admission for all fans in attendance.

PARKING ADVISORY

- ◆ Due to the Pearl Jam concert at Viejas Arena on Thursday, November 21, SDSU will be charging \$15 per vehicle for parking in Parking Structures 4 and 5.
- ◆ Fans attending Thursday night's Volleyball game are encouraged to park in the lots east of College Ave. (\$1 per hour rate) including Parking Structures 3 and 6.

SENIOR DAY

- ◆ Saturday's match has been designated Senior Day during which eight members of the 2013 team will be honored as they play their final home match on Aztec Court.
- ◆ That group includes Johnna Fouch, Emily Harris, Summer Nash, Kyla Oropeza, Justine Ricigliano, Christie Ring, Raegan Shelton and Courtney Vaccarello.

SERIES RECORDS

- ◆ The Aztecs and Boise State have met just six times previously with SDSU winning on five of those six occasions. SDSU defeated the Broncos in three sets in Boise earlier this season. Last season the teams split matches with the Broncos winning in Boise and SDSU winning in San Diego. The first meeting between the teams occurred at the Red Raider Classic in Lubbock, Texas, during the 2005 season with SDSU taking a three-set win. The Aztecs won both meetings vs. the Broncos in 2011.
- ◆ San Diego State holds a 7-4 lead in its series with Utah State since the teams first met in 1978. This season the Aggies handed SDSU a three-set defeat on October 24 in Logan. In the previous two meetings, the Aztecs fell to the Aggies on a neutral court in 2010 and defeated them at home last season. The Aztecs are 4-0 vs. Utah State in San Diego, 1-1 in Logan and 2-3 on neutral courts.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- ◆ San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her fifth season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her four-year record at SDSU is 84-62 (.575).
- ◆ She was named the 2012 Mountain West Coach of the Year after leading the Aztecs to a 23-8 overall record and their first conference title since 1995.
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her 17-plus year career record stands at 246-253 (.493).
- ◆ A three-time All-American at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- ◆ She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- ◆ She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

- ◆ Boise State enters the week with a record of 12-15 overall and 6-11 in the Mountain West. The Broncos have lost three of their last four matches after defeating San Jose State in three sets a week ago. BSU is led by Alyssa Gammel (2.89 kills per set, 2.49 digs per set) and Sarah Horton (2.55 kps, 1.94 dps). Libero Hannah Hubbard, from San Diego (Santa Fe Christian HS), is averaging 3.69 digs per set.
- ◆ Utah State's record stands at 18-9 (11-5 MW) with the Aggies slated to face UNLV Thursday evening prior to meeting SDSU on Saturday. USU is led by Rachel Orr (3.36 kps, .46 dps) and Elle Brainard (2.95 kps, 0.8 bps). Libero Ashlan Rogers-Court leas the Mountain West in service aces in league matches (0.37/set) and ranks third in digs at 4.20 per set).

SHELTON HEATS UP

- ◆ Senior outside hitter Raegan Shelton has been in double figures in kills in six of the past seven matches and is averaging 3.63 kills per set over that span.
- ◆ Last week she had 16 kills at Nevada (Thursday, Nov. 14) after leading all players with 16 kills in Monday's (Nov. 11) three-set win over UNLV.
- ◆ For the week she averaged 4.00 kills per set.
- ◆ Shelton made her return from a spell on the sidelines due to injury when she appeared in the final set against Wyoming on Oct. 17, registering a kill and three digs.
- ◆ She made her full return as a starter in the ensuing contest vs. Colorado State (Oct. 19). In that match she led the Aztecs with 11 kills and also had a block and three digs.
- ◆ A preseason all-conference selection, Shelton had been out since suffering a broken finger during the NAU Fiesta Bowl Tournament (Sept. 6-7).

HARRIS ON THE ATTACK

- ◆ Middle blocker Emily Harris tops the team in hitting percentage with a mark of .358.
- ◆ Her .336 career hitting percentage ranks fourth on the SDSU career list and 10th in the Mountain West record book heading into this week's match.
- ◆ She is leads the team in blocking with a mark of 1.11 blocks per set after averaging 1.39 bps in last week's two matches.
- ◆ She recorded a season-high .667 attack percentage in the win over Air Force on Oct. 31 while leading all players with 11 kills in that match.
- ◆ She is 16 block assists shy of entering the SDSU career top 10 in that category despite being in only her third season as an Aztec.
- ◆ Harris' eight block assists in the win over Fresno State (Oct. 3) was her season high.

FOUCH SETTING IT UP

- ◆ Senior setter Johnna Fouch's 47 assists at Nevada last Thursday (Nov. 14) was her highest total in a match since she recorded 45 at UNLV in mid-September.
- ◆ She registered a season-high four block assists in that contest at Nevada as well and also tied her season high with three service aces.
- ◆ Her 15 digs in the three-set win over UNLV on Nov. 11 was her second-highest mark of the season.
- ◆ She recorded a double-double in the win over UNLV on Nov. 11 (28 assist-15 digs), to give her 10 on the season.
- ◆ During the NAU Fiesta Bowl Classic the weekend of Sept. 6-7, her 54 assists vs. Idaho established a tournament record for assists in a three-set match.

- ◆ The senior from Riverside, Calif., recorded a career high eight kills on 12 attempts with no errors for a .667 hitting percentage in the match vs. Texas-San Antonio (Aug. 31).

SANDBERG COMING ON

- ◆ Kaja Sandberg has registered six kills in each of SDSU's past four matches.
- ◆ She had a .600 hitting percentage in the contest at Fresno State (Nov. 9) with six kills and no errors on 10 attacks.
- ◆ She had eight total blocks (2 solo, 6 assists) in the win over Air Force on Oct. 31, the third time this season she has tied her personal best in that category.
- ◆ She recorded a career-high eight block assists for the second time in three matches when she did so vs. Colorado State on Oct. 19.
- ◆ Sandberg is second on the team in blocking this season with a mark of 1.04 bps.
- ◆ She had a number of career-bests during on Oct. 12 at Air Force.
- ◆ Those highs included kills (9), attempts (20), service aces (2), block assists (8) and total blocks (8) and points (15.0).

NASH LEADS THE OFFENSE

- ◆ Senior Summer Nash led the Aztecs with 18 kills in the match at Nevada last Thursday (Nov. 14).
- ◆ She is averaging 3.75 kills per set over her last four contests.
- ◆ She matched her career high with 21 kills in the match at San Jose State on Nov. 7.
- ◆ She also had 21 kills this season in contests vs. Texas-San Antonio (Aug. 31) and Northeastern (Sept. 14).
- ◆ Nash set a career-high with a .706 hitting percentage in the win at Boise State (Oct. 26) with 12 kills and no errors on 17 attempts.
- ◆ She leads the team in kills at 3.52 per set and in points at 3.96 per set.
- ◆ She has recorded three double doubles this season (kills-digs).
- ◆ Her 16 digs vs. Texas-San Antonio on Aug. 31 was her career high as an Aztec.

RING DEBUTS AT LIBERO

- ◆ Senior Christie Ring has been SDSU's libero over the past five matches.
- ◆ During that span she is averaging 3.68 digs per set.
- ◆ In her second start at the libero position she turned in a career-high 21 kills in the match at San Jose State on Nov. 7.
- ◆ She also set a career best with six assists in the win over UNLV last Monday (Nov. 11)
- ◆ She had made her first start at the libero position on Nov. 2 vs. New Mexico and responded with 12 digs.

LITTLE SEES MORE TIME

- ◆ Freshman Baylee Little set her SDSU personal high with a .500 hitting percentage in the win over New Mexico on Nov. 2 as she notched seven kills on 12 attempts with one error.
- ◆ She also tied her personal best with three digs in that contest.
- ◆ She set personal highs in every other category during the Aztecs' road trip to New Mexico and Air Force (Oct. 10-12).
- ◆ At New Mexico she set career bests in kills (16) attempts (26), assists (2) and points (16.5).
- ◆ She also tied her highs in service aces (1), digs (3) and solo blocks (1).
- ◆ At Air Force she had career highs in block assists (5) and total blocks (5).

RICIGLIANO DIGS IT

- ◆ Justin Ricigliano has averaged 2.00 digs per set during the Aztecs' past five matches.
- ◆ Her 14 digs at Utah State on Oct. 24 was her sixth double figure effort in that category this season.
- ◆ Making her first start at the libero position, she recorded a career-high 24 digs in the four-set win at Air Force on Oct. 12.
- ◆ Her previous personal best of 13 digs was set earlier this season in a five-set match at Louisiana State on Aug. 31.
- ◆ Ricigliano also turned in a career-high four assists in the win at Air Force.

WABER SOLID UP FRONT

- ◆ Michelle Waber had seen limited action in the previous matches prior to recording 12 kills in the three-set victory over UNLV on Monday (Nov. 11).
- ◆ She had 10 kills over the three sets at Utah State (Oct. 24), reaching double figures in that category for the third time in four matches.
- ◆ In the absence of Summer Nash due to injury (Oct. 10-12), Waber led the Aztecs with 16 kills in each match that week (at New Mexico and at Air Force).
- ◆ She also had a season-high eight digs at UNM and added eight more at Air Force for a weekly average of 1.67 per set, almost double her season mark.

FOUCH MOVING UP THE CHARTS

- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch's three-plus year mark of 4,426 assists places her third on the SDSU career list.
- ◆ The top spot is held Andrea Clark (1994-97) with 4,916.
- ◆ Fouch ranks seventh on the Mountain West career assist list and needs 43 assists to move into the No. 6 spot.
- ◆ Her 43 career double-doubles is the most among active players in the Mountain West and is fourth on the all-time conference list.

- ◆ Michelle Waber is ninth in kill average at 3.07 per set.
- ◆ Raegan Shelton ranks seventh in kills (3.27 per set) and 10th in points at 3.47 per set.

- ◆ Five Aztecs also rank among the MW top 10 stats in conference matches.
- ◆ Summer Nash is seventh in kills (3.30 per set) and ninth in points (3.62 per set).
- ◆ Kaja Sandberg ranks eighth in hitting percentage (.332) and ninth in blocks (1.10 per set).
- ◆ Emily Harris stands fifth in blocking at 1.25 per set and ninth in hitting percentage (.330).
- ◆ Courtney Vaccarello is eighth in digs (3.33 per set).
- ◆ Johnna Fouch ranks ninth in assists at 8.14 per set.

DEFENSIVE FOURSOME

- ◆ Four of San Diego State's defensive specialists recorded career highs in digs during SDSU's season-opening tournament at LSU (Aug. 30-31).
- ◆ Senior Courtney Vaccarello had 25 digs in the contest against LSU on Aug. 31.
- ◆ Defensive specialists Justine Ricigliano and Kyla Oropeza each notched personal bests in that same with 13 digs. It marked the second time that Oropeza had 13 digs in a match during her time as an Aztec.
- ◆ Ricigliano also marked a career best with four service aces vs. the Tigers.
- ◆ Christie Ring established her career high with 13 digs in the opener vs. UC Davis and also set a personal best of four assists against Texas-San Antonio.

ALL-TOURNEY AZTECS

- ◆ Summer Nash, Emily Harris and Michelle Waber earned all-tournament honors at the Holiday Inn Mission Valley Aztec Invitational (Sept. 13-14).
- ◆ Nash, who was also named the tourney MVP, averaged 3.83 kills and 1.67 digs per set over SDSU's three matches. Her kill average and mark of 4.33 points per set led all players.
- ◆ Harris, meanwhile, led all tourney players with an average of 1.42 blocks per set and also recorded 2.83 digs per set while hitting at a .429 clip.
- ◆ Waber had marks 3.42 kills and .50 blocks per set along with a .316 hitting percentage.

VACCARELLO ALL-TOURNEY AT NAU

- ◆ Libero Courtney Vaccarello was named to the all-tournament team at last weekend's Fiesta Bowl Tournament at Northern Arizona.
- ◆ The senior from San Jose, Calif., averaged 4.36 digs per set and also contributed eight assists and a service ace over the Aztecs' three matches.

ALL-TOURNEY AT LSU

- ◆ Three Aztecs were named to the all-tournament team at Tiger Classic at LSU during the weekend of Aug. 30-31. That trio included setter Johnna Fouch along with outside hitters Summer Nash and Raegan Shelton.
- ◆ Fouch averaged 11.21 assists and 2.64 digs per set over her team's three matches and also hit .409 with 11 kills.
- ◆ Nash ended the weekend with marks of 3.83 kills and 2.00 digs per set and led the Aztecs with five service aces while Shelton averaged 3.23 kills per set.

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ The Aztecs have been involved in seven five-set matches this season and have a mark of 1-6 in those contests including losing the last six in a row. Last year they went 7-3 in five-set contests.
- ◆ San Diego State is second in the Mountain West overall stats in assists at 13.32 overall and in kills at 14.14 per set.
- ◆ As a team, SDSU ranks 21st in the nation in assists and 24th in kills.
- ◆ The Aztecs' longest win streak this season has been three matches (twice) while the longest losing streak has also been three contests (on two occasions).
- ◆ SDSU is 22-3 on its home court over the past two seasons.

UP NEXT

- ◆ San Diego State will conclude its 2013 season with a pair of matches on the road next week.
- ◆ On Wednesday, Nov. 27, the Aztecs will be in Fort Collins, Colo., for a contest against ninth-ranked Colorado State at 7:30 p.m. (MT).
- ◆ Two days later (Friday, Nov. 29), SDSU will face Wyoming in Laramie at 7:00 p.m. (MT).
