SAN DIEGO STATE SELECTED MOUNTAIN WEST MEN'S BASKETBALL PRESEASON FAVORITE

The 2023 NCAA tournament runner-up San Diego State has been predicted to win the 2023-24 Mountain West regular-season title as voted on by select media and announced Thursday morning ahead of the Conference's media day.

The Aztecs received 25 first-place votes and earned 333 points in the 2023-24 MW Men's Basketball Predicted Order of Finish. SDSU returns four letterwinners from last year's squad, including two starters Lamont Butler and Darrion Trammell. Joining head coach Brian Dutcher and the Aztecs in 2023-24 are seven newcomers, headlined by MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year Reese Waters.

Boise State was picked second in the preseason poll with 299 points and four first-place votes, New Mexico was selected third with 278 points and a first-place vote. Nevada was picked fourth with 240 points and the remaining first-place vote.

Colorado State was chosen to finish fifth with 218 points, UNLV sixth with 199 points, San José State seventh with 124 points and Fresno State eighth with 115 points. Utah State is ninth with 105 points, Wyoming 10th with 74 points and Air Force is 11th with 61 points.

MOUNTAIN WEST NOTEBOOK

- The Mountain West is celebrating its 25th season of men's basketball during the 2023-24 campaign.
- In the current NET rankings, the Mountain West has six programs ranked among the top 45: San Diego State (18), New Mexico (26), Colorado State (27), Utah State (29), Boise State (32) and Nevada (42). These six teams are a combined 125-41 on the season, including a 69-10 mark in nonconference action.
- The Mountain West is 104-38 (.732) in nonconference action in 2023-24, the fourth-best nonconference record among the 32 conferences. The MW has had a nonconference winning percentage of .600 or better in each of the last four seasons.
- Best in the WEST. The Mountain West is 24-7 against the Pac-12 (6-1) and West Coast Conference (18-6) in 2023-24.
- The Mountain West is one of three conferences (Big 12, SEC) that has five or more teams with an overall winning percentage of .700 or better.
- The Mountain West is the only conference to have all its teams finish the nonconference slate with a winning percentage above .500.
- San Diego State is currently ranked 19th in the *Associated Press* poll and 20th in the *USA Today* Coaches poll, while Utah State is No. 22 in the *AP* poll and No. 23 in the coaches poll.
- Boise State, Colorado State, Nevada and New Mexico are receiving votes in the national polls.
- Four MW guards rank among the top 30 in the nation in total assists. Colorado State's **Isaiah Stevens** is second in the nation with 207 assists, while Utah State's **Darius Brown II** is 17th with 171 assists and Fresno State's **Isaiah Hill** ranks 20th with 165 assists. San José State's **Alvaro Cardenas** ranks 30th with 150 assists.
- CSU's Stevens and SDSU's **Jaedon LeDee** have been named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 and the Lute Olson watch lists. Additionally, Utah State's **Great Osobor** was named to the Lute Olson watch list.
- The Mountain West is one of five conferences (ACC, Big 12, Big East, SEC) with three or more student-athletes on the Lute Olson watch list.
- SDSU's LeDee and USU's Osobor are finalists for the Karl Malone Award, while CSU's Stevens is a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award.
