San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. San Francisco

Team Notes

- San Diego State recorded 15 or more strikeouts for the third consecutive game, marking the first time in the Mountain West era (since 2000). The Aztecs recorded 47 strikeouts in just 27 innings this weekend, good for a 15.67 strikeouts per nine innings ratio.
- San Diego State saw its 86-game winning streak when leading after eight innings come to a close after the 9-8 loss in game 1. The Aztecs also had a 18-game winning streak when leading after six innings and a 22-game winning streak when leading after seven.
- SDSU finishes the series with a 15-6 record in opening-weekend series games since the start of the 2013 season. The Aztecs have now won five of their last six season-opening series.
- Preseason all-American closer Casey Schmitt saw his run of 25.1 consecutive scoreless innings come to a close.
- For the weekend, SDSU outhit USF .320 - .232 and outscored the Dons 22-15.

Julian Escobedo

Logged his second multi-RBI game of the season and seventh of his career... Extended his on-base streak to a career-best 27 games... Led SDSU in batting average (.500), runs (4), hits (6), home runs (1), RBIs (8), total bases (10), slugging percentage (.833), and on-base percentage (.571) for the series.
