Defensive Tidbits

• Zach Arnett is serving as the team's defensive coordinator for the second season at SDSU, but head coach Rocky Long will still call the game. Since Long took over as the defensive coordinator in 2009, San Diego State's defense ranks 9th nationally in rush avg. (3.6), 16th in yards per touch (6.3) and 17th in total defense (343.6).

• The Aztecs have had five of the best defensive seasons nationally and are off to another good start this year. Below are total ranks of the last five-plus seasons:

• The Aztecs have allowed just 14 points in 2019, the fourth-fewest allowed through two games in their Division I era (since 1969).

• In two games this year, SDSU is allowing just 7.0 points and 207.5 yards per game. In the opponents' other games, they are averaging 27.5 points and 337.5 yards per game.

• SDSU has forced 3 and outs (or better) in 11 of the 25 drives (44.0 pct.) when its opponent tried to score this year (excludes kneel downs to end half/game).

• SDSU ranks eighth in FBS play this year in rushing yards allowed per game (48.5) and ninth in defensive rush average (1.9). Over the last two years, San Diego State ranks third in def. RYPC (96.4) and fourth in def. RYPC (2.9).

• The Aztecs went the first five games of the season last year without allowing a rush longer than 17 yards. San Diego State allowed only three rushes (out of 453, 0.66 pct.) for 20 or longer last year. This year, the longest carry SDSU has allowed is 12 yards, which is tied for the fifth-shortest long run of the 130 FBS seasons.

• SDSU's opponents have converted just 11 of its last 43 attempts (25.6) on fourth down against the Aztecs.

• The Aztecs have held an opponent to single digits 13 times since the beginning of the 2015 season (56 games).

• Since the beginning of 2015 (56 games), San Diego State's defense ranks in a tie for first in interceptions (74) and fifth in interception TDs (10).

Offensive Tidbits

- Since Jeff Horton took over as offensive coordinator prior to the 2015 campaign, San Diego State is 15th nationally in rushing yards per game (223.9), 25th in rushing yards per carry (5.0) and 32nd in rushing touchdowns (116).
- San Diego State is 41-2 the last 43 times it has rushed for at least 200 yards.
- SDSU has a 100-yard rusher has at least one in 27 of its last 42 games since 2016 (37, 100-yard rushers total) and 36 of the 56 games since Jeff Horton took over as the offensive coordinator in 2015 (47, 100-yard rushers total).
- San Diego State had two 100-yard rushers vs. No. 23/25 Arizona State last season (Juwon Washington - 138 and Chase Jasmin - 112) for the 29th time in program history (the Aztecs are 28-1 in those occasions, including a 15-0 mark in the Rocky Long era).
- San Diego State has the fewest interceptions thrown since the 2015 season (20, min. 35 GP), three less than No. 2 (LSU, 23).
- The Aztecs are 34-4 the last 38 times they have scored at least 30 points and 46-9 in the Rocky Long era when scoring 30-plus points.
- Since Oct. 3, 2015, San Diego State is 36-7 when scoring at least 20 points. The Aztecs are 68-18 in the Rocky Long era when scoring just 20 points.
- Since the beginning of 2014, SDSU is 39-8 when committing one turnover or less and 9-13 when having two or more turnovers in the game. San Diego State has one turnover or less in 40 of the 56 games since the start of the 2015 campaign.
- SDSU is 33-5 in the last 37 games when owning an edge in time of possession.
- San Diego State threw for 293 yards Saturday at UCLA, its most in the Jeff Horton Offensive Coordinator era (since 2015).
