Running Back • 5-9 • 170 • Albuquerque, N.M. • Manzano HS

• **At San Diego State:** Speedster with an incredible first step ... Impressed in 2018 fall camp as a true freshman and was on the travel squad for the whole season ... Saw more time as the 2018 season wore on ... Was a regular contributor in the backfield during the 2019 season and again in 2020 ... Was the co-starting 'T' and 'F' running back as a senior ... Also started at kick returner and punt returner ... Ranked second in program history in kick return average (25.3), a tie for second in kick return touchdowns (3), third in kick returns (80), kick return yards (2,020) and punt returns (67), seventh in all-purpose yards (4,037) and eighth in punt return yards (445) ... Also ranked 24th with 1,353 rushing yards.

• **2022 (^Senior): Earned honorable mention All-America accolades by Phil Steele Magazine as a kick returner ... Was named a first-team all-Mountain West selection at both kick returner and punt returner by the league's head coaches and media, the first Aztec to ever be named first team at both positions ...** Also was named the College Football Network Specialist of the Year ... Also received first-team all-league honors at special teams by College Football Network, return specialist by Pro Football Focus, at kick returner by Phil Steele Magazine, while garnering second-team accolades by Phil Steele Magazine (PR) and College Football Network (KR and PR) ... Racked up numerous preseason accolades, including being named to the Paul Hornung Award Watch List for the most versatile player for a third straight season ... Also was named the Mountain West Special Teams Player of the Year by the league's media ... Also was named a preseason first-team all-MW pick at both kick returner and punt returner by the league media ... Also was named a preseason all-league selection as an all-purpose player by Lindy's Sports, and at both kick returner and punt returner by both Phil Steele Magazine and Athlon Sports ... Labeled as a "special teams demon" by Lindy's Sports and "SDSU's No. 9 player" by Athlon Sports ... Started 10 times on offense ... Rushed 102 times for a team-high 390 yards (3.8 avg.) with three touchdowns and a long of 53 yards ... Also had 10 catches for 60 yards (6.0 avg.) with a touchdown ... Returned 23 kickoffs for 571 yards (24.8 avg.) with a 95-yard touchdown ... Also returned 18 punts for 118 yards (6.6 avg.) and a 66-yard touchdown ... Became the first FBS player with at least one rushing touchdown, receiving touchdown, kick return touchdown and punt return touchdown in the same season since Temple's Isaiah Wright in 2018 and just the second Aztec since at least 1996 (Rashaad Penny in 2017). No other Mountain West player has accomplished the feat (league started in 1999) ... Led the Mountain West in kick return yards (571, T-16th in FBS) and punt return average (6.56, 35th in FBS), and tied for first in kick return touchdowns (1, T-2nd in FBS), second in combined kick/punt return yards (689, 7th in FBS), total punt returns (18, T-25th in FBS) and total kick returns (23, T-13th in FBS), tied for second in punt return touchdowns (1, T-6th in FBS), third in kick return average (24.83, T-20th in FBS) and fourth in punt return yards (118, 53rd in FBS) ... Rushed three times for 22 yards (7.3 avg.) with a long run of 10 yards across 16 snaps ... Also returned three kickoffs for 64 yards (21.3 avg.) with a long of 29 yards and a punt for 22 yards ... Had a quality game against Idaho State on Sept. 10, starting at running back for the first time of the season ... Recorded his first career punt return for a touchdown in the first quarter with a career-long 66-yard return ... It was his first overall touchdown of the season ... Later added a 53-yard rushing touchdown ... Finished with 169 all-purpose yards, including 58 on the ground on four carries (14.5 avg.), 75 on three punt returns and a 36-yard kick return ... Had another good all-around game off the bench at No. 14/15 Utah on Sept. 17, running six times for 29 yards (4.8 avg.) with a long run of 18 yards ... Also returned a kick for 23 yards and a punt for seven yards ... Rushed 16 times for 115 yards (7.2 avg.) with two touchdowns, including a long of 42 yards, in a start against Toledo on Sept. 24 ... Broke 100 yards rushing for the third time of his career and first time since the 2019 New Mexico Bowl (Dec. 21) against Central Michigan when he had a career-high 139 yards ... Scored his second and third rushing touchdowns of the season (11th and 12th of his career) ... It was his second multi-touchdown game of the season and third career multi-touchdown game ... Also returned two kicks for 45 yards (22.5 avg.) and a punt for three yards ... Finished with 163 all-purpose yards ... Was named to the Hornung Award Honor Roll ... Was named the team's offensive player of the game ... Started for the second straight game and third time of his career at Boise State on Sept. 30, running 13 times for 61 yards (4.7 avg.) and adding a 7-yard catch ... Also returned a kick for 20 yards and a punt (for a minus-yard) ... Earned the start at running back vs. Hawai'i on Oct. 8, carrying 10 times for 22 yards (2.2 avg.) and caught a 15-yard touchdown pass ... It was his first career receiving touchdown ... Also returned a punt for 10 yards and recorded two tackles on special teams ... Started again at Nevada on Oct. 22, rushing 10 times for 30 yards (3.0 avg.) with a long run of nine yards ... Also returned two kickoffs for 56 yards (28.0 avg.) with a long return of 33 yards ... Earned another start at Fresno State on Oct. 29, where he rushed six times for eight yards (1.3 avg.), while adding two receptions for seven yards (3.5 avg.) ... Played 13 offensive

snaps overall ... Also returned three kickoffs for 43 yards (14.3 avg.) and two punts for negative 2 yards (-1.0 avg.) ... Started for a seventh time of the season vs. UNLV on Nov. 5, rushing five times for 18 yards (3.6 avg.) in 19 snaps ... Also returned three punts for six yards (2.0 avg.) with a long of nine yards ... Returned a pair of kicks for 112 yards, including a 95-yard touchdown against San José State on Nov. 12 ... Had his first kickoff return touchdown of the season and third of his career ... The three career kickoff return touchdowns are tied for the second most in program history (Jwan Washington and Colin Lockett), only trailing Rashaad Penny's seven ... Now has six overall touchdowns this season (3 rush, 1 receiving, 1 KR, 1 PR) and 17 for his career (12 rush, 1 receiving, 3 KR, 1 PR) ... Also carried three times for one yard and caught a pair of passes for 22 yards (11.0 avg.) with a long of 16 yards ... Was named the team's special teams player of the game ... Earned the start at running back at New Mexico on Nov. 18, rushing nine times for 12 yards (1.3 avg.) in 21 snaps ... Also returned a kickoff 27 yards and two punts for six yards (3.0 avg.) with a long of eight yards ... Got the start at running back on Senior Night against Air Force on Nov. 26, rushing six times for 16 yards (2.2 avg.) with a long of eight yards ... Also had a pair of catches for two yards (1.0 avg.) ... Played 24 offensive snaps overall ... Returned three kickoffs for 61 yards (20.3 avg.) with a long of 37 yards ... Also returned two punts for negative-11 yards ... Started the final game of his career against Middle Tennessee in the Hawai'i Bowl on Dec. 24, rushing four times for one yard (0.3 avg.) and adding two catches for seven yards (3.5 avg.) in 42 snaps ... In the return game, had four kick returns for 84 yards (21.0 avg.) with a long of 25 yards and also a 3-yard punt return.

• **2021 (Senior): Was named a first-team all-Mountain West kick returner selection by the league's coaches and media ...** Joined Rashaad Penny (2015-17) as the only Aztecs to make an all-MW first team in league history ... Also was named to the Pro Football Focus Mountain West Team of the Year as a kick returner (first team) and a punt returner (honorable mention) ... Was named to the Paul Hornung Award Watch List for the most versatile player for a second straight season ... Also was a preseason second-team all-Mountain West selection as a kick returner by both Phil Steele Magazine and Athlon Sports ... Also was an honorable-mention selection by Pro Football Focus ... Started all 14 games at kick returner and punt returner, and twice at running back ... Rushed 37 times for 246 yards (6.6 avg.) with three touchdowns and a long of 55 yards, while making 13 catches for 76 yards (5.8 avg.) with a long of 20 yards ... Also returned 27 punts for 193 yards (7.1 avg.), while returning 22 kickoffs for 601 yards (27.3 avg.) with a 100-yard kick return touchdown ... Led the Mountain West in total punt returns (27, 4th in FBS), combined kick return yards (794, 6th in FBS), kick return average (27.3, 15th in FBS), punt return yards (193, 18th in FBS) and punt return average (7.1, 30th in FBS), tied for first in kick return touchdowns (1, T-13th in FBS), and third in kick return yards (601, 18th in FBS) and total kick returns (22, T-24th in FBS) ... Started the opener vs. New Mexico State on Sept. 4 along with Greg Bell at running back ... Only carried the ball three times, but took his first snap 43 yards for a touchdown for SDSU's final points of the game ... It was his first rushing touchdown of the season and seventh of his career ... Also had an 18-yard catch and two punt returns for nine yards (4.5 avg.) ... Played eight snaps on offense ... Came off the bench at Arizona on Sept. 11, carrying twice for 19 yards (9.5 avg.) with a long of 17 yards ... Also had two catches for five yards (2.5 avg.) and returned five punts for 26 yards (6.5 avg.) ... Ended up playing nine snaps on offense ... Had two kick returns for 126 yards (63.0 avg.), including a 100-yard touchdown against Utah on Sept. 18 ... Became the fifth Aztec in program history with a 100-yard kickoff return (has happened eight times overall) and first since Rashaad Penny against Nevada on Nov. 18, 2017 ... His 63.0 kick return average was the ninth highest in a FBS game in 2021 (min. 2 KR) and the fourth highest by an Aztec since at least 1996 (min. 2 KR) ... Now has two of the four-highest kick return averages in a game by an Aztec since at least 1996 (74.0 vs. Colorado State on Dec. 5, 2020 (No. 1) and 63.0 vs. Utah on Sept. 18, 2021 (No. 4)) ... Was one of only 19 FBS players with a 100-yard kick return for a touchdown in 2021 ... It was his second career kickoff return touchdown ... Also returned three punts for 11 yards (3.7 avg.) and caught a 4-yard pass ... Played four offensive snaps ... Was named the team's special teams player of the game ... Had a solid game against Towson on Sept. 25, rushing seven times for 75 yards (10.7 avg.) with two touchdowns, while returning three punts for a career-high 31 yards (10.3 avg.) ... Had his most rushing yards in a game since having 139 against Central Michigan in the 2019 New Mexico Bowl ... Had two rushing touchdowns for the second time of his career (also Sept. 14, 2019 at New Mexico State) ... The two touchdowns also matched a career high (same NMSU game) ... Now has three rushing touchdowns this season and nine for his career ... Also has four overall touchdowns on the season and 11 for his career ... Played 14 snaps off the bench against New Mexico on Oct. 9, rushing three times for two yards (0.7 avg.) and adding two receptions for two yards (1.0 avg.) ... Was more effective in the kicking game with two kick returns for 49 yards (24.5 avg.) with a long of 33 yards, and two punt returns for three yards (1.5 avg.) ... Was on the

offensive side of the ball for just 11 snaps at San José State on Oct. 15, rushing three times for 12 yards (4.0 avg.) with a long of 12 yards ... Also returned three kickoffs for 69 yards (23.0 avg.) with a long of 26 yards, and two punts for four yards (2.0 avg.) ... Made the most of his 12 offensive snaps at Air Force on Oct. 23, rushing six times for 32 yards (5.3 avg.) with a long of eight yards ... Also had a 20-yard catch, the longest of the game for San Diego State ... Returned two kickoffs for 46 yards (23.0 avg.) ... Was named one of SDSU's offensive players of the week ... Ran two times for six yards (3.0) in 10 offensive snaps against Fresno State on Oct. 30, while adding a 7-yard catch ... Also excelled in the kick return game with two returns for 74 yards (37.0 avg.) with a long of 40 yards ... Played 10 snaps off the bench at Hawai'i on Nov. 6, rushing four times for three yards (0.8 avg.) with a long of seven yards ... Also returned three kickoffs for 76 yards (25.3 avg.) with a 50-yarder to open the game ... Had a 2-yard catch in four offensive snaps against Nevada on Nov. 13, while excelling in the return game ... Had three punt returns for 34 yards (11.3 avg.) with a career long of 19, while adding two kick returns for 45 yards (22.5 avg.) and a long of 23 ... Was named one of SDSU's special teams players of the week ... Carried four times for 47 yards (11.8 avg.) with a long run of 47 yards at UNLV on Nov. 19 in just six offensive snaps ... Also caught an 8-yard pass and returned a punt for 10 yards ... Played eight offensive snaps against Boise State on Nov. 26, rushing once for two yards and catching an 11-yard pass ... Also returned three punts for 38 yards (12.7 avg.) and a 14-yard kick return ... The 38 punt return yards were a career high ... Was chosen as one of SDSU's special teams players of the game ... Earned the start (SDSU played two running backs) against Utah State in the Mountain West Championship on Dec. 4, where he had 1-yard rush and a 2-yard catch in five offensive snaps ... Also returned three punts for 26 yards (8.7 avg.) with a long of 14 yards and three kickoffs for 59 yards (19.7 avg.) with a long of 27 yards ... Had one rushing attempt and one catch in five snaps in the Tropical Smoothie Frisco Bowl vs. No. 24/25 UTSA on Dec. 21, both for negative yards ... Also returned two kickoffs for 43 yards (21.5 avg.) with a long of 24 yards, while returning one punt for one yard.

- **2020 (Junior):** Earned second-team all-Mountain West honors as a kick returner by the league's coaches and media ... Was also on the Hornung Award Watch List for the most versatile player ... Was a preseason third-team all-Mountain West selection at kick returner by Athlon Sports and Phil Steele Magazine ... Started three games at running back, all eight at kick returner and three at punt returner ... Rushed for 225 yards on 35 carries (6.4 avg.) with two touchdowns ... Also had seven catches for 12 yards (1.7 avg.) ... In the return game, returned 12 kicks for 383 yards (31.9 avg.) with a 93-yard touchdown and seven punts for 34 yards (4.9 avg.) ... Led the Mountain West in kick return average (31.92, 7th in FBS), and tied for second in kickoff return touchdowns (1, T-5th in FBS) and ranked third in combined kick return yards (417, 22nd in FBS) ... Started the opener against UNLV on Oct. 24 at running back, kick returner and punt returner ... Ran for 40 yards on just three carries (13.3 avg.) with a long of 32 yards, while adding two catches for 13 yards (6.5 avg.) ... Also excelled in the return game with two kick returns for 51 yards (25.5 avg.) and four punt returns for 27 yards (6.8 avg.) ... Ran for a 73-yard touchdown in a start at Utah State on Oct. 31 ... The 73-yard rush was a career long and longest by an Aztec since Rashaad Penny's 81-yard touchdown run against Army West Point in the 2017 Armed Forces Bowl (Dec. 23) ... Also returned two punts for seven yards (3.5 avg.) ... Ran twice for three yards (1.5 avg.) and caught a 2-yard pass off the bench vs. San José State on Nov. 6 ... Also returned three kickoffs for 68 yards (22.7 avg.) and a punt for zero yards ... Ran seven times for 61 yards (8.7 avg.) off the bench against Hawai'i on Nov. 14, including a 51-yard touchdown ... Also had a 21-yard kick return and added a catch ... The touchdown was his second of the season and sixth of his career ... Ran six times for six yards (1.0 avg.) in a reserve role at Nevada on Nov. 21 with a long of four yards ... Also returned two kickoffs for 50 yards (25.0 avg.) with a long of 34 yards ... Earned the start at Colorado on Nov. 28, rushing four times for six yards (1.5 avg.) and adding a 1-yard catch ... Also had a 22-yard kick return ... Was named the Mountain West Special Teams Player of the Week on Dec. 7 for his play at Colorado State on Dec. 5 when he returned two kickoffs for a career-high 148 yards (74.0 avg.), including a 93-yard touchdown ... It was SDSU's first kickoff return TD since Kaegun Williams had one at San José State on Oct. 19, 2019 ... The 74.0 kickoff return average was the highest by an Aztec in a game since at least 1996 (min. 2 returns), the second highest in Mountain West history and the second highest in a FBS game this season ... Additionally, the 148 kickoff return yards were the most by an Aztec since Davion Mauldin totaled 151 yards on Nov. 7, 2009 vs. TCU and the ninth most in program history ... Along with a 90-yard punt return TD by BJ Busbee in the second quarter, San Diego State became the first team with a kickoff return and punt return in the same quarter since Tennessee on Oct. 31, 2015 (third quarter at Kentucky) ... Also rushed 10 times in the game for 33 yards and made a catch ... Ran twice for three yards at No. 14/16 Brigham Young on Dec. 12 and had a 23-yard kick return.

- **2019 (Sophomore):** Played in 12 of the team's 13 games on the season, starting six times at running back, five times at punt returner and nine times as the kick returner ... Rushed 78 times for 355 yards (4.6 avg.) with three touchdowns and a long of 56 yards ... Also had 16 catches for 64 yards (4.0 avg.) with a long grab of 20 yards ... Has also returned 12 punts for 93 yards (7.8 avg.) with a long of 17 yards and 15 kickoffs for 319 yards (21.3 avg.) with a long of 34 yards ... Ranked fifth in the Mountain West in total kick/punt return yards (412, 60th in FBS) ... Led SDSU in all-purpose yards (831), all-purpose yards per game (69.2), punt return yards (93), punt return average (7.8) and kick return yards (319) ... Had a good opener with Weber State, rushing for 50 yards on just five carries (10.0 avg.) with a long of 23 yards, and returning four punts for 25 yards (6.3 avg.) ... The four punt returns, 25 punt return yards and long return of eight yards were each career highs ... Started at running back for the first time of his career at UCLA, rushing a career-high 10 times for 19 yards (1.9 avg.) with a long of six yards, while adding at career-high four receptions for a career-best 32 yards and a career long of 20 yards ... Also logged a career-long 17-yard punt return ... Had a career day at New Mexico State, rushing 22 times for 118 yards (5.4 avg.) and two touchdowns ... Became the 78th different 100-yard rusher in program history ... Was named to the Pro Football Focus Mountain West Team of the Week for the first time of his career ... Set career highs in attempts (22), yards (118) and touchdowns (two) ... His first touchdown was a 1-yard run that put SDSU up, 14-0, in the second quarter while his second from seven yards out gave the Aztecs a 24-0 lead in the third quarter ... Ran for 118 yards after entering the game with 206 yards for his career and doubled his previous touchdown total (1) ... Also added three receptions for six yards and a 4-yard punt return ... Started for a third straight game vs. Utah State, but was hampered by an early ankle injury ... Still made the most of 17 offensive snaps, rushing 10 times for 20 yards (2.0 avg.), while returning three kicks for 50 yards (16.7 avg.) with a long of 22 yards ... Earned the start at Colorado State, carrying nine times for zero yards in 18 snaps ... Returned a kickoff for a career-long 33 yards and returned two punts for 15 yards (7.5 avg.) with a long of 12 yards ... Also had a catch that went for a 5-yard loss. ... Only played six offensive snaps vs. Wyoming, rushing once for zero yards ... Still returned three kicks for 63 yards (21.0 avg.) with a long of 22 yards and three punts for 21 yards (7.0 avg.) with a long of nine yards ... Only got four snaps at San José State after suffering a hamstring injury, carrying twice for six yards (3.0 avg.) and adding a 6-yard catch ... Also saw some time on special teams before the injury, returning a kickoff 26 yards and a punt 11 yards ... Did not play at UNLV because of the hamstring injury ... Was only on the field for one offensive snap against Nevada, making a 2-yard catch ... Also returned two kickoffs for 50 yards (25.0 avg.) with a long of 28 yards ... Had a 2-yard rush in a pair of offensive snaps vs. Fresno State, while returning two kickoffs for 26 yards (13.0 avg.) with a long of 20 yards ... Earned the start at Hawai'i, carrying the ball once for one yard and adding a catch for zero yards in seven snaps ... Had three catches for 10 yards (3.3 avg.) with a long of six in five offensive snaps against Brigham Young, while returning one kick for 18 yards ... Had a monster game in front of his hometown against Central Michigan in the New Mexico Bowl, rushing for a career-high 139 yards on 17 carries (8.2 avg.) and a touchdown, while adding two catches for 13 yards (6.5 avg.) and two kick returns for 53 yards (26.5 avg.) ... Finished with a career-high 205 all-purpose yards, averaging 9.8 yards per touch en route to earning Co-Offensive Most Valuable Player honors with Jesse Matthews ... Recorded his second 100-yard game of the season and his career ... Had 139 rushing yards after entering the game with only 29 yards over his previous eight games played ... Also had a season-long 56-yard rush and a career-long 34-yard kick return ... Now has 267 rushing yards in the state of New Mexico (his home state) in three games (89.0 rypg) after recording 225 in his 20 other games played (11.3 ypg).
- **2018 (True Freshman):** Shared the team's outstanding freshman award (with CB Darren Hall) ... Played in 11 games on the season, rushing 23 times for 137 yards (6.0 avg.) with a 72-yard touchdown ... Also had a 7-yard catch, and returned eight kicks for 146 yards (18.2 avg.) with a long of 26 and returned three punts for seven yards (2.3 avg.) ... Did not play in the opener at No. 13/13 Stanford or against Sacramento State ... Came in for one snap against No. 23/25 Arizona State, rushing for 11 yards ... Was on the field for one snap vs. Eastern Michigan, but did not record a stat ... Had a breakout game at rv/No. 24 Boise State, rushing for 76 yards and a touchdown on three attempts (25.3 avg.) ... Recorded his first career touchdown on his fourth career attempt ... The 72-yard run was the longest of the season for the Aztecs ... Carried the ball a career-high six times against Air Force, but finished with a net zero yards with a long of two yards ... Also returned two kickoffs for 32 yards (16.0 avg.) with a long of 23 and returned a punt for three yards ... Ran three times for nine yards (3.0 avg.) in seven snaps vs. San José State ... Had a 1-yard run in six snaps at Nevada, while returning three kickoffs for 49 yards (16.3 avg.) with a long of 20, and returning two punts for four yards with a long of 5 ... Set career bests in kickoff returns (3), kick return yards (49), punt returns (2), punt return yards (4) and long punt return (5) ... Carried four times for 10 yards

(2.5 avg.) in front of his home crowd at New Mexico ... Carried once for nine yards for a first down against UNLV and added three kickoff returns for a career-high 65 yards (21.7 avg.), including a career long of 26 yards ... Played two snaps of statless ball at Fresno State ... In nine snaps vs. Hawai'i, rushed three times for 18 yards (6.0 avg.) with a long of 16 yards, while adding his first career catch for seven yards ... Had a 3-yard rush in three snaps vs. Ohio in the DXL Frisco Bowl.

- **High School:** Was a three-year letter winner at Manzano High School in Albuquerque, N.M. ... Led the Monarchs to a state championship in 2017 and a perfect 13-0 record ... Manzano High School improved its record each of Byrd's three years, going from 7-5 in 2015, to 10-3 in 2016 to 13-0 in 2017 ... Played quarterback, running back and wide receiver at MHS, and also returned kicks and punts ... Over his three years (according to MaxPreps), was 112-for-177 (63.3 pct.) for 1,522 yards and 16 touchdowns against four interceptions, while rushing 344 times for 2,750 yards (8.0 avg.) and 37 touchdowns, and adding 41 catches for 669 yards (16.3 avg.) and four touchdowns ... Best season statistically was 2017, where he was 72-for-107 (67.4 pct.) for 1,011 yards and 10 touchdowns in the air, 1,235 yards and 21 touchdowns on the ground on 158 carries (7.8 avg.), and adding 25 catches for 381 yards (15.2 avg.) and three touchdowns ... Earned all-state and all-metro honors, and was the league MVP ... Was a three-time team MVP ... As an athlete, earned three stars from 247sports and two stars from Rivals ... Rated as the top recruit in New Mexico by 247sports ... Also competed on the track and field team, where he won four straight 100-meter state titles, three 200 championships.
- **Personal:** Jordan Lamont Byrd was born April 7, 2000, in Albuquerque, N.M. ... Son of Lamont Byrd and Nicole Bedford ... According to Rivals, also had scholarship offers from TCU, Arizona, Utah, Texas Tech, Utah State and New Mexico ... Is majoring in interdisciplinary studies.
