OPENING TIPS

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...

UC Irvine is on their third of three straight road trips where they will collide with national runner-up, No. 25/RV San Diego State. In the last two weeks, the Anteaters have made stops in Las Vegas (Nevada), Pittsburgh (Pennsylvania), and Logan (Utah).

FIVE

After eight games played, there are five players averaging double figure scoring. Redshirt senior Justin Hohn leads the effort with 13.7 points per game and is followed by freshman Derin Saran (11.1), redshirt junior Devin Tillis (10.7), senior Andre Henry (10.1), and junior Bent Leuchten (10.0).

UCI VS. RANKED OPPONENTS IN THE 2020'S

Just three years into the 2020's decade, UC Irvine has already recorded their best record against ranked opponents (2-2, 0.500). Their next best was in the 1980's where they were 7-15 (0.467). The Anteaters have earned their two ranked wins by double figures and their two losses were only by single digits (at USC in 2021, 66-61 and at SDSU in 2022, 72-69). UCI looks to pick up their third ranked in of the 2020's at No. 25/RV San Diego State on Saturday.

OLD CONFERENCE FOE'S

UCI and No. 25 San Diego State used to compete against each other in the PCAA (before it was renamed the Big West) from 1975-1978 before the Aztecs left the conference. SDSU holds the 2-0 record over the Anteaters in league play.

KEEPING IT FRESH

The Anteaters and the Aztecs have met just twice in the last three seasons. The previous meeting between the last two squads was in 1997.

LAST TIME VS. SDSU

Former Anteater DJ Davis had a career high 28-point showing that led the Anteaters in the 72-69 loss to No. 24/24 San Diego State where he shot 9-17 from the field and 4-6 from behind the arc. Justin Hohn led the team in assists, recording a season best four. Forward Dean Keeler added eight points along with a block. The

'Eaters had their best game at the charity stripe, making 12 on 14 attempts (0.857).

RECAP VS. UTAH STATE

UC Irvine and Utah State were locked in an impressive shooting affair until the Aggies pulled way in the second half for a 79-69 victory at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum on Saturday evening. UC Irvine shot 58.6 percent (17-29) from the floor in the first half but went 10-28 (35.7%) in second half. The Aggies shot 50.8 percent for the game (30-59), improving from 50 percent in the first 20 minutes (16-32) to 51.9 percent in the second (14-27). UCI was led by guard Justin Hohn with a game high 21 points while forward Dean Keeler posted a career best 15 points on the night.

KENPOM LEADERS

Out of 2289 eligible players, Pierre Crockrell II is 10th in assist rate (41.4) and Devin Tillis is 46th in two-point percentage (0.719). Out of 363 teams, UC Irvine ranks 11th in bench minutes (43.2), 34th in adjusted defensive efficiency (96.6), and 46th in three-point percentage offense (37.7).

LEADING THE BIG WEST

Several Anteaters sit in the top ten of the Big West individual statistical rankings: rebounds per game (10th, 6.0--Tillis), field goal percentage (7th, 0.479--Hohn), assists per game (1st, 5.6--Crockrell II), assist-turnover ratio (3rd, 2.4-- Crockrell II), blocks per game (6th, 1.2--Keeler), and steals per game (10th, 1.6-- Henry).

NATIONAL STATISTICS THROUGH 12.07.23

UC Irvine is ranked top-50 nationally in the following categories: assists per game (35th, 17.1) and field goal percentage (38th, 0.490).

NET WORTH

The first NET ranking of the season was released on Monday Dec. 4. The 'Eaters are the highest ranked and only Big West team within the top-100 sitting at 67 with Hawai'i locking in the second position at 134.

- > No. 25/RV San Diego State holds a 7-2 record entering the contest, picking up wins against Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State, Sain Mary's, Washington, California, Point Loma Nazarene, and UC San Diego
- > The Aztecs last played on Tuesday where they fell to Grand Canyon in Phoenix, 79-73
- > SDSU defeated both their opponents in the Continental Tires Main Event to win the championship title
- > The Aztecs are 2-0 against the Pac-12 this season and have won both of those contests in overtime
- > San Diego State went 32-7 overall in 2022-23 and 15-3 in Mountain West play
- > The Aztecs won both the Mountain West regular season and championship titles
- > SDSU finished last year's campaign as the NCAA Run-ner-Up, falling to UCONN in the finale
- > San Diego State won the program's first Sweet 16 game while appearing and winning a game in the Elite Eight and Final Four, the first Mountain West team to do so
- > In the final 2022-23 AP Poll, SDSU ranked second in the nation, the highest in program history
- > Jaedon LeDee leads all Aztecs in scoring and rebounds averaging a double double with 205 total points (22.8 ppg) and 93 rehounds (10.3 rng)







In their trip to Henderson, UC Irvine walked away with three wins against quality opponents in Pepperdine, Toledo, and Rice. The Anteaters were one of three teams who went undefeated in the MTE (Indiana State and New Mexico).

KEEPING IT 100!

In Friday (Nov. 17) night's win over Occidental, four different Anteaters shot perfect whether it was from the field (1) or at the line (2). Pierre Crockrell II (2-2), Andre Henry (1-1), and Dean Keeler (3-3) made all of their shots from the line. Hayden Welling (9-9) did not miss any from range.

GAINING NATIONAL ATTENTION

After their win on Tuesday night (Nov. 14) at No. 16/20 USC, UC Irvine saw themselves trending in the United States on X (formerly Twitter) and received recognition from prominent accounts in Dick Vitale, Jon Rothstein, John Fanta, Field of 68, NCAA March Madness, SportsCenter, College Insider, College Basketball Report, Mid Major Madness, and CBS Sports College Basketball.

1K CLUB

Dylan Thoerner recorded a career milestone of 1,000-points scored during their career during the win over No. 16/20 USC. Thoerner notched the milestone on his first triple of the night.

UC IRVINE SHOCKS NO. 16/20 USC

Redshirt senior Justin Hohn wreaked havoc on the nationally ranked Trojans defense in his career night to lead UC Irvine to victory over No. 16/20 USC, 70-60. Hohn poured in 25 points on 10-16 shooting from the floor and 3-6 from three-point distance. The Anteaters earned their first ranked win over USC in program history and first overall win against the Trojans since the 61-54 effort on Dec. 20, 2012 in Los Angeles. Center Bent Leuchten posted 19 points in the victory while forward Devin Tillis recorded his second consecutive double figure rebounding game with 10 grabs off the glass.

SLAYING GIANTS IN NOVEMBER

In back-to-back seasons, UC Irvine has knocked off two Pac-12 opponents on the road by double figures in the month of November. Last year, the Anteaters traveled up to then No. 21/21 Oregon and defeated the Ducks inside Matthew Knight Arena, 69-56. UCI battled against the odds to pull off a similar upset in Los Angeles this season with their 10-point victory over No. 16/20 USC.

CAREER HIGH COINCIDENCES

In three consecutive years of playing New Mexico State, redshirt senior Justin Hohn has posted a new career best number in a different statistical category in each contest against the Aggies. In 2021, Hohn grabbed a best of seven rebounds and made three-pointers in the 2022 neutral site meeting. In this year's meeting, Hohn tied his career high three steals. In addition, Bent Leuchten tied his career best in steals (3) exactly one year apart from when he first set it (Nov. 11, 2022 and Nov. 11, 2023).

WELCOME TO THE FLOOR

Graduate student Dylan Thoerner and freshman Derin Saran made their Anteater debut on Tuesday (11/7) night against the Spartans. Thoerner only had on rebound in the contest, but was a vital part of the UCI offense on their scoring runs. Saran poured in eight points along with a rebound and a steal.

GAP YEAR

Sophomore Eli Chol and freshmen Jurian Dixon and Ben Egbo were announced on Tuesday Nov. 7 as the 2023-24 season redshirt class. All three players will return to the floor or make their debut in 2024-25.

SHARING THE BALL

For the upcoming 2023-24 season, the Eaters return every player from the 2022-23 roster who recorded a positive assist-turnover ratio.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICS

UC Irvine is ranked 24th in both KenPom's Mid-Major Top-25 and Field of 68's Mid-Major Preseason Polls. UCI comes in at the 94 slot in the KenPom rankings, the highest ranked team in the Big West and the highest preseason ranking under Coach Turner's reign. Additionally, the Anteaters are receiving votes in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll.

NOT THE ROOKIES, BUT THE VETS

For the first time in three seasons, UCI will graduate more than one player from the program while also returning academic seniors who have up to two years of eligibility left. Graduate student Dylan Thoerner along with fifth years in Pierre Crockrell II and Dean Keeler will complete their athletic eligibility this season.

HITTING THE ROAD

UC Irvine plays nine of their 12 non-conference games on the road, including their three games played in Henderson, Nevada at a neutral site MTE. This is the most UCI has been on the road since the 2019-2020 season where 10 games were not at home with four played at neutral sites.

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

The UC Irvine Anteaters are coming off a championship campaign in the 2022-23 season where they earned the Big West regular season crown behind their 15-5 league record. UCI already has a championship under their belt prior to the start of the 2023-24 campaign as they went an undefeated 8-0 at the 42nd annual Jones Cup in Taiwan.

COACHING ACHIEVEMENT

Alum and assistant coach Michael Wilder enters his tenth season as a coach for the Anteaters. In his ten years as a coach, Wilder has helped lead UCI to two conference tournament titles, five regular season championships, and the programs first NCAA March Madness win. As a player, Wilder finished up his career fourth in program history in three-pointers made, 17th in rebounds, and was one of 32 1,000-point scorers.

WENT INTERNATIONAL

UCI had the opportunity to get some extra practice and games in over the summer by participating in the 42nd annual Jones Cup held in Taipei City. The 'Eaters were presented the grueling task of competing in eight games over a nine-day span while facing national and professional teams from various countries. In a tournament where they never trailed in the second half, UC Irvine's 8-0 record earned them the first United States medal since 2012 when the University of Pittsburgh Greensburg won the bronze and first American gold since 2006 (Athletes in Action). Additionally, UCI was the first collegiate United States team to win the gold medal in 30 years when Hawai'i did it in 1993. Pierre Crockrell II was named the tournament's MVP along with All-Tournament team recognition.

CONFERENCE DOMINATION

According to CBK Report, UCI has one of the best conference winning percentages (72-21, 0.774) over the last five years. In the last five years in the Big West, UC Irvine has won three regular season titles, made an appearance in the NIT, won the conference tournament to earn the league's automatic qualifier to March Madness, and recorded the programs first NCAA tournament win.

DEFEND THE BREN

In the Turner era of Anteater basketball, UC Irvine holds a 144-46 (0.758) record inside the Bren Events Center. In similar fashion to their overall conference domination over the last five years, the 'Eaters have gone 72-14 (0.837) in Big West play on their home court.

CHAMPIONSHIP MENTALITY

In a ten-year span, UC Irvine has won eight Big West championships whether it was a regular season or championship title. The Anteaters have won the Big West outright in 2013-14, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2022-23 seasons while earning Big West championship titles in 2014-15 and 2018-19. UCI has made seven post-season appearances under the helm of Russell Turner, advancing to the NIT First Round last season.

WINNING CULTURE

The Anteaters are coming off a 23-12 season (.657), marking their tenth-straight winning season under Head Coach Russell Turner. UCI finished 15-5 in the Big West, ending the 2022-23 season tied for first place in the Big West.

HEAD COACH WRITING HISTORY

Coach Turner currently sits fourth all-time in the Big West victory leaders and fourth in career wins. Turner sits fifth in all-time conference wins with 145, just 10 games behind Long Beach State's head coach Dan Monson who holds the fourth spot.

ALL ABOUT THE NET

While mentioned every season, this year's non-conference schedule is arguably the most challenging one the program has seen. The Anteaters will face last year's NCAA runner-up, two preseason AP Poll Top-25 ranked teams, and eight other teams that made appearances in the postseason. UCI's opponents are housed in the American Athletic Conference, Atlantic 10, Conference USA, Mid-American Conference, Mountain West, Pac-12, Summit League, and West Coast Conference.

DEPTH OF THE BENCH

Another constant to the Anteater program is the impressive depth held on the bench as UCI continues to return players in every position as well as having guys behind them who are also very good.

Hohn, a redshirt senior, looks to enter back into the starting lineup this season after playing a sixth man role last year. The guard showed his flashes of excellence over the summer with his offensive volatility.

Henry stepped up on the Anteaters foreign tour and started in every game he played in. The senior's offensive style complimented those around him to help propel UCI to their victories.

Tillis will continue to be threat at as the fourman providing a high level of defensive intensity while sneaking by as a scoring threat at the post and along the perimeter. The redshirt junior was named to the Blue Ribbon Yearbook's Big West's Preseason Team.

NEW ADDITIONS

Similar to last year, UCI add five newcomers to their roster. Dylan Thoerner, Derin Saran, Jurian Dixon, Ben Egbo, and Carter Welling are the new Anteaters on the squad.

Thoerner, an Irvine native, returns to his hometown for his final season after competing at Tufts University for four years. The guard is an NABC Division III All-American and two-time All-Conference se lection. Thoerner is a scoring weapon and poses a threat from deep.

Saran hails from Istanbul, Turkey and comes to Irvine by way of The Asheville School in North Carolina. The freshman is a three-time conference champion, Western North Carolina Player of the Year, and a 2023 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year nominee.

Dixon brings in additional talent to the squad after helping lead his high school team to a No. 5 ranking his senior year while finishing as a top-10 scorer in San Diego high school history.

Another state championship player enters the UC Irvine program through Egbo. The guard was named as the conference Defensive Player of the Year last season while also landing a spot on the All-CUSD First Team.

RUSSELL TURNER

HEAD COACH (14TH SEASON) 271-173 OVERALL RECORD

Russell Turner, the winningest coach in UCI history, concluded his 13th season at the helm in 2022-23. Turner has guided the Anteaters to 265 wins, averaging over 20 wins a season.

Turner who enters his 14th season as head coach at UC Irvine in 2023-24, has led the 'Eaters to seven postseason appearances (2013 CIT, 2014 NIT, 2015 NCAA, 2016 CIT, 2017 NIT, 2019 NCAA, and 2023 NIT).

Turner became the only coach in UCI history to amass 200 wins. He has been named the Big West Coach of the Year four times in his career and has led the 'Eaters to Big West regular season titles in six of the last nine seasons.

On the national stage, Turner has been named a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year award in 2017 & 2020, and the Hugh Durham Award in 2019 & 2020. Bracketbusters.com also named him one of the Top-10 Big West Coaches of the Century.

In 2022-23, Turner guided the Anteaters back to the top of the Big West standings for his sixth regular season title and an automatic birth to his seventh postseason appearance at UCI. He earned his first regular season ranked win at No. 21 Oregon, 69-56, before claiming the Las Vegas Holiday Classic Invitational Crown at the end of November. Turner earned his 250th career win to place him fourth all-time on the Big West career wins list

UCI's 2020-21 team was the second youngest in the country, and Turner led the Anteaters to a Big West Tournament final for the fourth-consecutive season. He is one of only seven coaches in Big West history to reach over 200 wins.

In 2019-20, Turner led the Anteaters to their second-straight Big West regular season outright title, marking the first time in UCI history the 'Eaters won back-to-back outright titles. UCI entered the Big West Tournament as the No. 1 seed before its cancelation.

He led UCI to a record-breaking 2018-19 season as the Anteaters broke school records in overall wins (31), longest winning streak (17 games) and tied a program best 15-1 mark in Big West play. Turner guided the Anteaters to their second Big West Conference Tournament title and second NCAA Tournament appearance. UCI won its first-ever NCAA Tournament game defeating fourth-seeded Kansas State 70-64. He also helped Jonathan Galloway become the Big West's first-ever three time Defensive Player of the Year recipient. Turner was named the Big West Coach of the Year.

In 2017-18, he guided the Anteaters to their sixth-straight winning season with an 18-17 overall record and second-straight Big West Tournament final. He upped his career win total to 157 becoming the third coach in UC Irvine history to eclipse 150 wins in a career.

He was named Big West Conference Coach of the Year in 2017 after leading the Anteaters to their third regular-season league title in the last four years.

In 2016, Turner led UCI to a 28-10 record, which at the time, set school records for overall victories, non-conference wins (15), and road victories (13).

In 2015, he led UCI to the program's first NCAA Division I Tournament berth as the Anteaters won the Big West Conference Tournament for the first time in school history. UCI took three-time national champion Louisville to the wire in the NCAA Second round, falling 57-55.

Turner was named 2014 Big West Conference Coach of the Year and NABC District 9 Coach of the Year after leading the Anteaters to their first league regular-season title in 12 years and a second consecutive 20-win season.

He quided the 'Eaters to a 23-12 overall record in 2013-14 and a 13-3 mark in Big West play. Five of his players received Big West postseason recognition.

Turner was named UC Irvine's head coach April 9, 2010, after serving the previous six seasons as an assistant coach for the Golden State Warriors of the National Basketball Association following positions at Stanford University and Wake Forest University.

Turner also served as a coach for the Warriors' summer-league entry in Las Vegas for five seasons. He has been an active participant in the NBA's international outreach camps, including Basketball without Borders, representing the league in Turkey, China and Lithuania. BWB is a program that uses basketball to create positive social change in education, health and wellness.

Turner was a member of Mike Montgomery's Stanford University staff from 2000-04 when the Cardinal had a combined overall record of 105-24 (.814), including 59-13 (.819) in Pac-10 play. Stanford won Pac-10 regular-season titles in 2001 and 2004, was ranked No. 1 in the polls both seasons, and advanced to the NCAA tournament each of Turner's four years, including the West Regional final in 2001.

The list of players he worked with at Stanford includes All-Americans Josh Childress, Casey Jacobsen, Jarron Collins and Jason Collins.

Prior to Stanford, Turned worked under Dave Odom as an assistant at Wake Forest University from 1994-2000. The Demon Deacons won 161 games in those six seasons, advancing to the NCAA tournament three times, including the Midwest Regional final in 1996. Tim Duncan was a three-time All-American during Turner's tenure at Wake Forest.

Turner's first coaching position was as an assistant at his alma mater, Hampden-Sydney (Va.) College in 1993-94. As a player at Hampden-Sydney, Turner was a two-time All-American (1991 & 1992) and set the school's career scoring record of 2,272 points. He was a member of Hampden-Sydney's first two NCAA tournament teams and was inducted into Hampden-Sydney's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2002.

He graduated magna cum laude in 1992 with a B.A. in English and economics, and earned numerous academic honors including election into Phi Beta Kappa. Turner is a native of Roanoke, Va. He and his wife, Elizabeth, a physician, have two children, Devlin and Darius.






