Aztecs Host Utah Wednesday; Travel to LBSU/CSF Tournament

San Diego State returns to America's Finest City Wednesday morning for the first time since Feb. 18 when it hosts Utah before staying in Southern California this weekend in the Louisville Slugger Invitational.

The Aztecs (9-10), who are receiving votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, welcome the Utes (13-6) at 11 a.m. PT Wednesday in a game moved up to beat the rain, then play Grand Canyon (16-4) and Long Beach State (3-17) at 4:30 p.m. PT and 7 p.m. PT Friday in Long Beach, and North Dakota (5-17) and Cal State Fullerton (11-9) at 3 p.m. PT and 5:30 p.m. PT Saturday in Fullerton.

Out of SDSU's 19 games so far this season, 14 have come against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament (San Diego State is 5-9 in those games) and nine have been against nationally ranked squads (the Aztecs are 2-7).

Utah made the Women's College World Series last year, eliminating SDSU in a best-of-three series in the NCAA Super Regional, while Grand Canyon and Cal State Fullerton also made the NCAA tournament (San Diego State beat Grand Canyon in the NCAA Los Angeles Regional).

Macey Keester tops the Aztecs offense with a .33 average, while Lala Macario leads SDSU in on-base percentage (.410), runs (15), walks (9, tied) and stolen bases (11). Mac Barbara, the Mountain West Preseason Player of the Year, is hitting .279 with five home runs and 20 RBIs, slugging .651.

Freshman sensation Cece Cellura (2-1, 2.37 ERA, 41.1 IP) and the defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year Allie Light (4-5, 2.47 ERA, 45.1 IP) lead a pitching staff that has combined to record a 2.68 ERA with 75 strikeouts in 128 innings. Cellura was named the MW Freshman of the Week on Monday, while Light was selected as the MW Pitcher of the Week the previous Monday (Feb. 26).

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 87-43 (.669) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

Notes on the Season so Far

- * SDSU finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll.
- * San Diego State, which was one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play.
- * The Aztecs are off to an 9-10 start through 19 games with nine played at home (4-5), six neutral (4-3) and three on the road (1-2).
- * Out of SDSU's 19 games, 14 have been against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament. San Diego State is 5-9 in those games.
- * The Aztecs have played two of the eight teams who made the 2023 Women's College World Series (No. 1/1 Oklahoma and No. 3/3 Stanford) and meets their third (Utah) on Wednesday.
- * SDSU has already played nine teams who are nationally ranked, going 2-7 in those games with wins over then No. 25/rv Kentucky, 2-1, on Feb. 10 and then No. 11/13 Missouri, 3-2, on Feb. 22.
- * According to initial NCAA RPI, which came out Monday (San Diego State is 41), the Aztecs have played the ninth-toughest strength of schedule in the country this year with their opponents as the 19th-toughest strength of schedule.
- * SDSU's average adjusted RPI loss this season is 30.
- * San Diego State has already played seven games against the top-25 RPI schools in No. 1 LSU (L, 9-1, and L, 3-1), No. 3 Stanford (L, 3-0), No. 4 Missouri (W, 3-2), No. 5 Oklahoma (L, 7-0) and No. 23 Texas A&M (L, 7-5, and L, 1-0).
- * Cal State Fullerton (No. 40) and Grand Canyon (No. 50) will be the 11th and 12th opponent for the Aztecs this season that is in the top 50 in the initial RPI.
- * Out of SDSU's 10 losses, two have been by one run, five have been by two runs, one was by three runs, one was by seven runs and one by eight.
- * The Aztecs are only hitting .233 as a team, but much of that can be attributed to the teams they have played. Three all-Mountain West performers from a year ago have yet to get on track in Bella Espinoza (.220 this season with four runs and four stolen bases, .393 last season with 57 runs and 30 stolen bases), Makena Brocki (.125 this season with three RBIs and one extra-base hit, .297 last season with 33 RBIs and 19 extra-base hits) and Cali Decker (.167 this season with 1 RBI and a .286 on-base percentage, .368 last season with 40 RBIs and a .462 on-base percentage).

* UCF transfer Lala Macario is hitting .300, and leads SDSU in on-base percentage (.410), runs (15), walks (9, tied) and stolen bases (11) despite missing a game.

* Mac Barbara (.279) has continued to provide pop with five of SDSU's seven home runs and 20 of its 53 RBIs, despite missing two games two weekends ago, while slugging .651 with a .389 on-base mark. Barbara is the Mountain West preseason player of the year.

* San Diego State's pitching staff has continued to produce, combining for a 2.68 ERA and 75 strikeouts in 128 innings against just 21 walks.

* Defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year Allie Light leads the way with a 4-5 record to go along with a 2.47 ERA in 45 1/3 innings, striking out 27 with 10 walks.

* Cece Cellura has come on strong in her first season on The Mesa, posting a 2-1 record with a team-low 2.37 ERA in 41 1/3 innings, striking out 18 against four walks.

* Cellura was named the MW Freshman of the Week on Monday.

Cece Cellura Named Mountain West Freshman of the Week

San Diego State softball pitcher Cece Cellura (Glendale, Calif.) has been named the Mountain West Freshman of the Week, the league announced Monday. It is the first conference weekly award for the right-hander.

Cellura pitched in three games for the Aztecs (9-10) over the weekend at the Purple & Gold Challenge, going 1-0 with a 1.45 ERA in 14 1/3 innings, starting all three appearances. Cellura struck out 11 without a walk, limiting the opposition to just 12 hits and a .211 batting average.

Cellura started against McNeese on Friday, giving up two runs on four hits and no walks over 4 1/3 innings, striking out a career-high six batters. She earned the start against host No. 4/5 LSU on Saturday night and gave up one run on four hits and no walks over five innings, striking out two before exiting with the game tied at 1-1. Cellura picked up the win in SDSU's 3-0 shutout over Illinois on Sunday, tossing five scoreless innings with four hits allowed (all singles) and no walks, while striking out three.

On the season, Cellura is 2-1 with a team-low 2.37 ERA in 11 appearances (eight starts) over 41 1/3 innings. She has struck out 18 against four walks, while holding the opposition to a .267 average.

SDSU Picked to Win MW; Mac Barbara, Allie Light Named Preseason Players of the Year

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West, while Mac Barbara (player) and Allie Light (pitcher) have been chosen as the league's preseason players of the year, the league announced Jan. 31.

Barbara and Light were joined on the 15-player preseason team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker and Bella Espinoza. This was the first time in MW history that preseason players of the year and a preseason all-conference team were announced.

The preseason poll, players of the year and all-conference team were voted on by the league's nine head coaches.

SDSU picked up 64 points, including eight of the nine first-place votes. Defending regular-season champion Boise State is second with 57 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (46), Fresno State (41), Nevada (37), UNLV (28), Utah State (19), New Mexico (17) and San Jose State (15) round out the voting.

Barbara made her second straight MW first team last season after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. Barbara batted .358 (57-for-159) a year ago with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, nine doubles, a triple and 33 walks, while slugging .673 with a .469 on-base mark. Barbara, a two-time first-team All-NFCA West Region (2022-23) player, was even better in league play, hitting .459 (28-for-61) with eight home runs, 24 RBIs and 18 runs in 24 games, drawing 14 walks with a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base percentage.

Light, meanwhile, was named the MW Pitcher of the Year in 2023, while also making her first all-conference team (first team) and first appearance on the all-NFCA West Region (second team). A four-time MW Pitcher of the Week, including three straight weeks from March 28-April 11, Light was 15-7 with a 1.90 ERA and a school-record seven saves in 132 2/3 innings. She started 17 games and played in 40 overall, playing a part in six Aztec shutouts, and striking out 106 with 20 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .218 average. Light was even better in MW play, going 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average.

Decker made the most of her first season on The Mesa in 2023, batting .368 (56-for-152) with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, four doubles and 26 walks, posting a .513 slugging percentage and an .462 on-base mark en route to becoming a second-team NFCA all-West Region pick and a second-team all-MW selection. Decker hit .386 (22-for-57) in MW play with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs and 12 walks, owning a .456 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base percentage. She was also named to the all-Mountain West Tournament team, batting a team-high .700 (7-for-10) with a home run, five RBIs and two runs. In nine postseason games overall (three in MW tournament, six in NCAA tournament), she hit .429 (12-for-28) with three homers, 13 RBIs and four runs, slugging .750 with a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second straight all-MW team a year ago (first team in 2022, second team in 2023), leading SDSU in batting average (.393), runs (57), hits (75), stolen bases (30) and at-bats (191). Espinoza's 70 singles were a SDSU single-season record, and she also ranked second in single-season history in stolen bases (30), third in runs (57), tied for third in hits (75) and eighth in batting average (.393). In MW play, Espinoza batted .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs and 13 stolen bases and later made the all-MW Tournament Team after hitting .545 (6-for-11) with five runs and two stolen bases in just three games.
