NEWS AND NOTES

- San Diego State heads to Tempe to face Arizona State in the back-end game of a home-and-home series. The Tuesday night affair will air live on Pac-12 Networks with Ted Robinson and Don MacLean calling the action. Ted Leitner will have radio duties on 101.5 KGB, XTRA 1360 and FOX Sports IE 1350.
- SDSU is in search of its second win in as many tries after defeating San Diego Christian, 91-52, on Friday night at Viejas Arena. The Aztecs have not opened a campaign with a 2-0 record since the 2014-15 season.
- The Aztecs won their 12th straight season-opener in what was head coach Brian Dutcher's first game at the helm of the program. It marked the first time someone other than the recently retired Steve Fisher was San Diego State's head coach since Feb. 27, 1999.
- San Diego State is 1-0 after using a balanced attack to dismiss San Diego Christian. Eight different Aztecs scored at least six points and no player logged more than 24 minutes. As a team, SDSU shot 56.1 percent from the field and 71.0 percent from the charity stripe, while holding the Hawks to 32.8-percent shooting and only four free-throw attempts. The Aztecs have won 59 straight games when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- Leading the way in the opener for SDSU was senior Malik Pope. The forward, who averaged 13.1 points and 7.1 rebounds over the final 14 games of 2016-17, connected on nine of his 11 attempts from the floor to finish with a game-high 20 points to go with six rebounds. It was Pope's fourth-career 20-point effort and he was two points shy of matching his career high.
- Returning starter Jeremy Hemsley came off the bench and was a steady force, scoring 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting and dishing six assists against one turnover. He also shared game-high honors in steals (3) with junior newcomer Devin Watson.
- San Diego State's starters set the tone for the game after scoring the first 14 points of the game, despite 60 percent of the starting group having never played an official game for the Aztecs. Outside of Pope and Trey Kell, who owns the most starting experience of anyone on the roster (86 career starts). Dutcher called on Watson, an all-WCC first-team transfer from San Francisco, araduate transfer Kameron Rooks (California) and true freshman Matt Mitchell to round out his first-ever starting five.
- The Aztecs had six new players overall take the floor for them on opening night. In addition to Watson (8 points), Rooks (4 points, 3 rebounds) and Mitchell (6 points, game-high 8 rebounds, 2 steals), SDSU had redshirt freshman Jalen McDaniels contribute five rebounds and a game-high two blocked shots, true freshman Jordan Schakel score seven points and walk-on Michael Sohikish add four points in three minutes.
- As much as the Aztecs received from their newcomers, the returners' efforts should not go unnoticed. Kell, in just 18 minutes, made all three of his attempts, including both three-pointers, junior Max Montang connected on all four of his free-throw tosses and Nolan Narain shot 100 percent (4-for-4) from the floor and added a career-high seven rebounds. Each member of the trio scored nine points. Junior Montaque Gill-Caesar, meanwhile, scored three points in nine minutes in his first game action of any kind (close scrimmage and exhibition) since going through the school's concussion protocol.
- San Diego State, with its blend of veterans and rookies, head to the desert looking to avenge last season's home loss to the Sun Devils. The Aztecs led by seven points at halftime and saw the cushion evaporate in a matter of 129 seconds after ASU opened with a 9-2 run that featured a trio of treys. At the final horn, the scoreboard read: Arizona State 74, San Diego State 63.

San Diego State is 16-7 in its last 23 vs. current members of the Pac-12 Conference and 17-8 since the start of the 2009-10 season.

- San Diego State has gone 12-8 vs. teams in the Pac-12 Conference at game time since the start of the 2009-10 campaign.
- Last season, SDSU split two games vs. the league, defeating California in Sacramento, 77-65, before falling to Arizona State.

The Aztecs will face the same two Pac-12 teams this season, playing at ASU and welcoming the Golden Bears to Viejas Arena on Dec.

9. SDSU could also see Washington State in the Wooden Legacy during the Thanksgiving holiday.

NEW TO YOU, BUT NOT TO SDSU

Although new to head coaching at SDSU, Brian Dutcher is no stranger to the university or the program. The 19th-year Aztec coach experienced 386 victories and 10 Mountain West titles while atop Montezuma Mesa in the 18 seasons with Steve Fisher at the wheel.
 In those 18 years, Dutcher also helped the Aztecs to 13 postseason tournaments, including eight NCAA appearances and a pair of Sweet 16 berths (2011, 2014).

ALL-AROUND PERFORMANCE

Jeremy Hemsley turned in 10 points, six assists and three steals, while committing just one turnover in 22 minutes vs. San Diego Christian. He is the 11th Aztec to have at least that stat line in a game since at least 1996-97, and the first to do so since Chase Tapley vs. Bryant on Nov. 11, 2011.

• He is the second Aztec to accomplish the feat while playing less than 30 minutes, joining Chad Nelson, who did it on Jan. 25, 1997, in 25 minutes vs. Hawai'i.

STAR-STUDDED COMPANY

Matt Mitchell received the starting nod for Brian Dutcher, making him the first true freshman since Jeremy Hemsley to start in their debut. Hemsley was later named Mountain West Freshman of the Year and is a two-time all-conference selection. Prior to Hemsley, Trey Kell earned the nod in his first game at SDSU and has become a two-time all-MW performer.

Mitchell is just the 15th freshman to start a season-opening game with Dutcher on the bench, dating back to the 1988-89 campaign, and the 10th while Dutcher has been at SDSU. The others are Juwan Howard, Jalen Rose, Chris Webber, Jerod Ward, Albert White, Bradley Jackson, Steve Sir, Brandon Heath, Richie Williams, D.J. Gay, Tim Shelton, Kawhi Leonard, Kell and Hemsley.

BACKCOURT DUO CLOSING IN ON A GRAND

Jeremy Hemsley is quickly closing in on 1,000 points for his career. In 70 career games, the junior has scored 865 points. Once he hits the milestone, he will be the 32nd member of the Aztecs' 1,000-point club and the first since Trey Kell accomplished the feat on Feb. 12, 2017.

• Devin Watson is just ahead of Hemsley in the race for 1,000 career points. The guard has 877 points after totaling 869 in 61 games at San Francisco.

HIGH-END EXPERIENCE

The Aztecs welcome six new players to the roster, but two come loaded with high-level experience in Devin Watson and Kameron Rooks. The childhood friends from North San Diego County are eligible after transferring from a pair of Bay Area schools (Watson - San Francisco; Rooks - California).

Watson brought 61 career games, including 47 starts, with him to the table, while Rooks saw action in 83 games (20 starts) and played in the NCAA tournament (2016) and the NIT (2017).

KEEPIN' IT (ALMOST) 100

San Diego State scored 98 points in the exhibition vs. UC San Diego. The Aztecs scored more than that just once last season (100 vs. Savannah State on Nov. 28). Outside of that, SDSU scored more than 80 points just three other times (San Diego Christian, vs. Tulsa, vs. Boise State) in 2016-17.

- In the opener vs. San Diego Christian, the Aztecs closed in on 100, but fell nine points short.
- The last three seasons, the Aztecs have averaged 61.8 points per game in 2014-15, 68.6 in 2015-16, and 68.5 in 2016-17.

The school record for points per game for an entire season is 86.9, which occurred in SDSU's first season as a Division I member (1970-71).

AZTEC STAPLE: DEFENSE

The Aztecs have been one of the elite defensive teams in the nation over the last few seasons and this year they return six letterwinners

off a team that finished eighth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense and 15th in scoring defense. Both were tops in the MW. According to KenPom.com, SDSU last season ranked eighth nationally in effective field-goal percentaged defense, ninth in two-point field-goal percentage defense and 20th in blocked shot percentage.

- 2013-14 ranks: 2nd in scoring defense, 6th in scoring margin, 8th in field-goal percentage defense.
- 2014-15 ranks: 2nd in scoring defense, 7th in field-goal percentage defense, 24th in blocked shots.
- 2015-16 ranks: 1st in field-goal percentage defense, 3rd in scoring defense, 10th in blocked shots.
- 2016-17 ranks: 8th in field-goal percentage defense, 15th in scoring defense, 34th in blocked shots.

TOUGH AWAY FROM HOME

SDSU is 90-47 (65.7 percent) in road/neutral games since March 6, 2010, which is the eighth-best winning percentage nationally.

STREAKING THROUGH CALIFORNIA

SDSU had won 47 straight games vs. teams from the state of California, a streak that dated to Dec. 2, 2009, before falling at Fresno State, 59-57, on Jan. 3, 2015.

The Aztecs are now 63-6 in their last 69 vs. California schools and 51-1 in their last 51 vs. non-league California teams (51-0 in last 51 in games played indoors).

San Diego State has also beaten seven Pac-12 schools during this remarkable run.

The 47-game winning streak vs. California schools was the longest active streak in the country ahead of second-place BYU (22 straight vs. Colorado teams) and Pittsburgh (22 straight vs. Pennsylvania teams).

NICE RUN

San Diego State is a member of the California State University system and it had won 22 straight home games against CSU schools dating to the 2000-01 campaign. The streak ended on Feb. 22, 2017, when Fresno State earned a 63-55 victory. Prior to the defeat, the Aztecs' last loss to a Cal State school at home happened back on Jan. 5, 2000, against Cal State Fullerton.

SDSU has also won 21 consecutive non-conference games vs. its fellow CSU institutions. The Aztecs have not suffered a loss since Nov. 27, 2000, at Fresno State (WAC).

PRETTY GOOD WHEN LOW ON TIME

The Aztecs have been good at preparing when short on time. When there is less than 24 hours to prepare, SDSU is 17-2 in its last 19 regular-season tries.

ATOP THE MOUNTAIN

Since the beginning of the Mountain West in 1999-00, San Diego State has the most men's basketball championships than any other current member of the league, which is a remarkable feat considering the Aztecs went 0-14 in league play the first season (1999-2000) and 4-10 the second year (2000-01). Here is the list of current Mountain West schools with their regular-season championships (includes ties) and tournament championships: 1. San Diego State 10, 2. New Mexico 8, t-3. UNLV 3, t-3. AZTECS PICKED SECOND IN MW PRESEASON POLL

SDSU was picked to finish second in the Mountain West media poll. It marked the 13th consecutive year in which San Diego State was picked to finish in the top four of the MW preseason poll and the fourth year in a row that it has been selected either first or second.
 SDSU earned 229 points and two first-place votes and trailed only Nevada (257 points; 19 first-place votes). The Aztecs, however, were ahead of third-place Boise State (211; 2), fourth-place Fresno State (188) and fifth-place Colorado State (154). The remaining first-place tally went to UNLV, which was predicted to finish in sixth (138). The rest of the poll: Wyoming (7th; 133), Utah State (8th; 102), New Mexico (9th; 93), San José State (10th; 41), Air Force (11th; 38).

KELL NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MW

Trey Kell was named a preseason all-Mountain West selection at the conference's media summit in Las Vegas in October. With the recognition, he became just the third Aztec to be named to the preseason team multiple times in MW history, joining Brandon Heath (2005-06, 2006-07) and Winston Shepard (2014-15, 2015-16).

Brian Dutcher, a long-time San Diego State men's basketball assistant coach, is entering his first season as head coach following Steve Fisher's retirement announcement on April 11, 2017. Dutcher, who was on Montezuma Mesa for all of Fisher's 18 seasons, held the title of associate head coach/head coach in waiting the previous six years and is the program's 15th head coach.

Over the course of his time at San Diego State, Dutcher helped the Aztecs reach the postseason 13 times, including eight trips to the NCAA tournament, win a conference-best 10 Mountain West titles and record 12 seasons of at least 20 victories.

Since 2008-09, Dutcher and SDSU twice advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2011, 2014) and NIT semifinal round (2009, 2016), won at least 25 games seven times and captured seven MW championships (five regular season, two tournament).

Dutcher arrived at SDSU shortly after Fisher was hired on March 26, 1999. In his first year in "America's Finest City," the Aztecs won only five games, but improved upon their win total from the season before. After that, San Diego State posted a 14-14 record in 2000-01, before winning the 2002 MW Championship, earning an NCAA tournament bid and finishing with a 21-12 record. The 2002-03 campaign saw SDSU receive an NIT invitation, which culminated in the program's first Division I postseason victory.

After helping attract the first McDonald's All-American to the 2002-03 squad, Dutcher assisted in securing the signatures of future starters and all-league performers Brandon Heath and Marcus Slaughter. The duo started their first two seasons on The Mesa, leading to the 2005-06 season that produced the school's first Mountain West regular-season and tournament title sweep.

The Aztecs advanced to the NCAA tournament and ultimately won a then-school-record 24 games. That appearance led to a string of 10 consecutive postseason berths.

From the 2006-07 campaign through 2008-09, San Diego State registered 20 or more wins and went to three straight NITs. In 2009, the Aztecs advanced to the NIT semifinals and broke the previous school record with 26 victories.

The run to the NIT semifinals was a springboard to the most successful run in SDSU basketball history. Led by future NBA first-round draft pick and NBA champion Kawhi Leonard, the 2009-10 Aztecs won the MW Championship, advanced to the NCAA tournament and fell four points shy of moving on to the second round before finishing with a 25-9 record.

The NCAA experience from the 2009-10 squad proved fruitful in 2010-11 when it returned all five starters, including Leonard, and a freshman named Jamaal Franklin, who would turn out to be a future MW Player of the Year and NBA draft selection. With Dutcher on staff, SDSU won its first 20 games of the year, shared the MW regular-season title and captured the MW tournament crown. The Aztecs moved on to the NCAA tournament as a No. 2 seed and won the program's first Division I NCAA tournament game. San Diego State, which was ranked as high as No. 4 and received first-place votes at one point in the season, advanced to the Sweet 16 and fell to the eventual national champion, finishing with a school-record 34 wins, a mark that still stands today. The Aztecs' also found themselves in the final top-25 polls, ranking sixth in the AP and 11th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Five months after SDSÚ's record-setting 2010-11 campaign, the University elevated Dutcher from associate head coach to associate head coach/head coach in waiting.

In his first season with his new title, Dutcher and the Aztecs advanced to the 2011-12 NCAA tournament as an at-large team and recorded 26 wins. The next season, SDSU was again an at-large selection to the 2013 NCAA tournament, moved on to the round of 32 for the second time in three years and finished with 23 victories.

Another NCAA Sweet 16 run was in the cards in Dutcher's third season as the head coach in waiting. The Aztecs opened the season by winning 21 of their first 22 games, including 20 in a row at one point, and were led by seniors Xavier Thames, who would become an NBA draft pick, and Josh Davis. SDSU won the program's second outright Mountain West regular-season title and later swept through two games in Spokane, Washington, to secure its second Sweet 16 appearance in four seasons. San Diego State compiled 31 wins and finished the season ranked 13th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches after rising to as high as fifth nationally in both polls.

The 2014-15 campaign saw the Aztecs spend their fifth straight season in the top 25. In the process of winning 27 games, San Diego State grabbed its second straight MW regular-season crown and earned an atlarge invitation to the NCAA tournament where they defeated St. John's in the round of 64. One season later, the Aztecs found themselves in the NIT after winning the MW by three games with a 16-2 record. Nevertheless, San Diego State won three games and qualified for the NIT national semifinals, eventually logging 28 victories.

More recently, San Diego State completed the 2016-17 slate with a 19-14 record despite experiencing a rash of injuries. The 2016 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic champions will enter 2017-18 as one of 12 teams to have won at least 19 games in 12 consecutive seasons.

Before Dutcher arrived at San Diego State, he served as assistant coach and later associate head coach at Michigan under Fisher. He spent 10 seasons on the Wolverine staff, establishing himself as one of the nation's top assistant coaches. His first year in Ann Arbor was 1989 and resulted in a national title for Michigan as he assisted then-interim head coach Fisher on the bench. The Bloomington, Minn., native led UM's recruiting efforts in 1990-91 when the Wolverines inked Juwan Howard, Ray Jackson, Jimmy King, Jalen Rose and Chris Webber. The "Fab Five" is considered perhaps the best recruiting class in NCAA history. Dutcher helped lead that group to nearly 100 wins, two berths in the NCAA championship game and a regional final over a four-year period. He was also on the Michigan staff for an NIT championship (1997).

Dutcher's recruiting prowess, however, was demonstrated by more than just the "Fab Five" haul. Michigan had the nation's top-ranked recruiting class in 1993-94 and in 1994-95, with a group that included Maurice Taylor and Jerod Ward. The accomplishment marked the first time that a university had the nation's top class in consecutive years, according to recruiting analyst Bob Gibbons.

Dutcher was born Oct. 30, 1959, in Alpena, Mich. He attended Jefferson High School in Bloomington, Minn., and went on to earn a bachelor's degree in physical education from Minnesota in 1982. While an undergraduate, he worked for his father, then-Gopher head coach Jim Dutcher. He then spent one season in the prep ranks at Apple Valley (Minn.) High School before becoming a graduate assistant at Illinois, where he earned his master's degree in physical education and athletic administration.

While in Champaign, Dutcher helped Lou Henson lead the Illini to a Big Ten championship, two appearances in the Sweet 16 and one regional final.

Dutcher's first full-time coaching job came at South Dakota State, where he spent three seasons helping turn around the Division II program before departing in 1988 for Michigan.

His final season in Ann Arbor ended with the Wolverines claiming the first-ever Big Ten Tournament championship.





San Diego State 91 San Diego Christian 52 Nov. 10, 2017 + San Diego, Calif. Viejas Arena + Att.: 11,285

SAN DIEGO - San Diego State opened the Brian Dutcher Era with a 91-52 victory over San Diego Christian at Viejas Arena. The game marked the first of Dutcher's head coaching career after serving as an assistant under Steve Fisher for 18 seasons.

The Dutcher-led Aztecs opened the night by scoring 14 unanswered points and were never threatened the rest of the night. SDSU kept the Hawks from reaching double digits for almost 10 minutes. A basket by Derrick Novsek gave San Diego Christian its ninth and 10th points with 10:43 left in the first half to make it a 27-10 game.

The Aztecs led at halftime, 46-24, thanks to 56.7-percent shooting. On two-point attempts alone, SDSU was connecting at a 76.2-percent clip (16-21).

The second half was more of the same from San Diego State as it made 55.6 percent from the floor and made 11 of 13 attempts from the charity stripe. Defensively, SDSU did not allow the Hawks to get to the free-throw line. For the game, San Diego Christian was 3-for-4 from the charity stripe.

SDSU had two players reach double figures in scoring, but had six others score at least six points. Malik Pope made nine of his 11 shot attempts for a game-high 20 points. Jeremy Hemsley chipped in 10 points to go with a game-high six assists.

Pope received the starting assignment and was joined by three players who had never suited up for the Aztecs in graduate transfer Kameron Rooks, junior transfer Devin Watson and true freshman Matt Mitchell. Senior Trey Kell filled out the group.
