Aztecs Begin Mountain West Play with Home Series vs. Utah State

San Diego State kicks off Mountain West play with a home series against Utah State this weekend at SDSU Softball Stadium. The Aztecs (13-11, 0-0 MW) are the defending Mountain West Tournament champion (first one held since 2006) and have won a league-record eight regular-season titles.

SDSU, which is receiving votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, welcome the Aggies (15-9, 0-0 MW) at 6 p.m. PT Friday, 4 p.m. PT Saturday and noon PT Sunday.

Out of San Diego State's 24 games so far this season, 17 have come against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament (San Diego State is 7-10 in those games), including three against Women's College World Series programs, and nine have been against nationally ranked squads (the Aztecs are 2-7).

Macey Keester leads SDSU with a .370 average, while Mac Barbara (.310) has continued to provide pop with six of San Diego State's eight home runs and 25 RBIs, slugging .638 with a .440 on-base mark. Barbara is the Mountain West preseason player of the year. UCF transfer Lala Macario is hitting .308, and leads the Aztecs in on-base percentage (.418), runs (19), walks (12) and stolen bases (11).

The SDSU pitching staff has continued to produce, combining for a 2.71 ERA and 91 strikeouts in 163 innings against just 26 walks. Freshman Cece Cellura has come on strong in her first season on The Mesa, posting a 3-1 record with a team-low 2.39 ERA in 52 2/3 innings, striking out 23 against four walks. Defending MW Pitcher of the Year and the preseason pitcher of the year Allie Light is 6-6 with a 2.47 ERA in 45 1/3 innings, striking out 34 with 14 walks. Dee Dee Hernandez (3-2, 1 SV, 2.46 ERA, 31.1 IP) and Cassidy West (1-2, 2 SV, 3.00 ERA, 21.0 IP) have also logged innings for San Diego State.

All three games this weekend will be broadcast on the Mountain West Network.

STACEY NUVEMAN DENIZ
HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON (16TH OVERALL) | UCLA, 2002

- Was named San Diego State's fifth head coach in program history on June 8, 2021, taking over for SDSU's all-time winningest head coach Kathy Van Wyk.
- Helped lead SDSU to seven straight NCAA tournaments from 2009-15 and a combined 398-264 (.601) record in her 14 seasons on The Mesa as an assistant coach, associate head coach and head coach in waiting.
- In her first season as SDSU's head coach in 2022, San Diego State went 39-16 (.712) for the second-best winning percentage in school history, winning the Mountain West regular-season title for the first time since 2014.
- Was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2022 in her first season as head coach.
- Is 91-44 (.674) as head coach at San Diego State, leading the Aztecs to a Mountain West Tournament title in 2023.
- Was the head coach of the National Pro Fastpitch's Chicago Bandits for the 2018 season, leading the Bandits to the NPF Championship series in her first year.
- Also has served as an assistant coach for the Women's National Team and USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) Selection Camps.
- As a player, was a three-time U.S. Olympian, winning gold medals in 2000 and 2004, and a silver medal in 2008. Also helped the United States National Team to a World Cup championship (2006), two World Championships (2002 and 2006) and two Pan American gold medals (1999 and 2003).
- Was a standout player at UCLA, finishing her four-year career with four NCAA records - 90 home runs, .945 slugging percentage, 240 walks and 81 intentional walks. She was a four-time first-team NFCA All-American (1997, 1999, 2001-02) and a three-time Pac-10 Player of the Year (1999, 2001-02).
- In 1999, Nuveman Deniz led the Bruins to a national championship, batting .446 during the season with 31 home runs and 91 RBIs.

Notes on the Season so Far

- * SDSU finished the 2023 campaign with a 39-17 record, advancing to the program's first super regional after capturing the NCAA Los Angeles Regional, and being ranked No. 18 in the final ESPN/USA Softball poll and 19th in the final USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll.
- * San Diego State, which was one win away from making the Women's College World Series, won the Mountain West tournament, the first held since 2006, with a perfect 3-0 record after finishing second in regular-season play.
- * The Aztecs are off to a 13-11 start through 24 games with 10 played at home (4-6), eight neutral (6-3) and five on the road (3-2).
- * Out of SDSU's 24 games, 17 have been against teams that made the 2023 NCAA tournament. San Diego State is 7-10 in those games.
- * The Aztecs have played three of the eight teams who made the 2023 Women's College World Series (No. 1/1 Oklahoma, No. 3/3 Stanford and Utah).
- * SDSU has already played nine teams who are nationally ranked, going 2-7 in those games with wins over then No. 25/rv Kentucky, 2-1, on Feb. 10 and then No. 11/13 Missouri, 3-2, on Feb. 22.
- * According to NCAA RPI (as of March 14), the Aztecs have played the 17th-toughest strength of schedule in the country this year with their opponents playing the seventh-toughest strength of schedule.
- * SDSU's average adjusted RPI loss this season is 24.
- * San Diego State has already played seven games against the top-25 RPI schools in No. 1 LSU (L, 9-1, and L, 3-1), No. 3 Stanford (L, 3-0), No. 6 Missouri (W, 3-2), No. 9 Oklahoma (L, 7-0) and No. 12 Texas A&M (L, 7-5, and L, 1-0).
- * Thirteen of the Aztecs' 24 games so far have come against top-50 RBI schools (SDSU is 3-10).
- * Out of San Diego State's 11 losses, three have been by one run, five have been by two runs, one was by three runs, one was by seven runs and one by eight.
- * The Aztecs are hitting .256 as a team, but much of that can be attributed to the teams they have played. Three all-Mountain West performers from a year ago have yet to get on track in Bella Espinoza (.258 this season with eight runs and four stolen bases, .393 last season with 57 runs and 30 stolen bases), Makena Brocki (.161 this season with six RBIs and one extra-base hit, .297 last season with 33 RBIs and 19 extra-base hits) and Cali Decker (.241 this season with six RBIs and a .328 on-base percentage, .368 last season with 40 RBIs and a .462 on-base percentage).
- * Macey Keester leads the Aztecs with a .370 average (20-for-54).

Utah State enters Mountain West play with a 15-9 record in the midst of a seven-game winning streak. The Aggies are hitting .294 as a team, led by Ariel Fafita and her .397 average. Grace Matej is batting .395 with two homers and 14 RBIs, former Aztec Alex Bunton is hitting .365 with four home runs and 18 RBIs, and Tatum Silva is at .333 with six stolen bases. The USU pitching staff has combined for a 2.38 ERA with two shutouts. Denay Smith is the team's top pitcher with a 6-2 record and 1.15 ERA in 48 2/3 innings, while Jessica Stewart (3-2, 4 SV, 1.66 ERA, 33.2 IP) and Katie Zuniga (4-2, 1.48 ERA, 31.0 IP) also have ERAs under 2.00. San Diego State leads the all-time series with Utah State, 27-12, winning two of three last year in Logan, Utah.

SDSU Picked to Win MW; Mac Barbara, Allie Light Named Preseason Players of the Year

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the Mountain West, while Mac Barbara (player) and Allie Light (pitcher) have been chosen as the league's preseason players of the year, the league announced Jan. 31.

Barbara and Light were joined on the 15-player preseason team by fellow Aztecs Cali Decker and Bella Espinoza. This was the first time in MW history that preseason players of the year and a preseason all-conference team were announced.

The preseason poll, players of the year and all-conference team were voted on by the league's nine head coaches.

SDSU picked up 64 points, including eight of the nine first-place votes. Defending regular-season champion Boise State is second with 57 points and the other first-place vote, while Colorado State (46), Fresno State (41), Nevada (37), UNLV (28), Utah State (19), New Mexico (17) and San Jose State (15) round out the voting.

Barbara made her second straight MW first team last season after being named the MW Player of the Year in 2022. Barbara batted .358 (57-for-159) a year ago with 13 home runs, 45 RBIs, 34 runs, nine doubles, a triple and 33 walks, while slugging .673 with a .469 on-base mark. Barbara, a two-time first-team All-NFCA West Region (2022-23) player, was even better in league play, hitting .459 (28-for-61) with eight home runs, 24 RBIs and 18 runs in 24 games, drawing 14 walks with a .902 slugging percentage and a .564 on-base percentage.

Light, meanwhile, was named the MW Pitcher of the Year in 2023, while also making her first all-conference team (first team) and first appearance on the all-NFCA West Region (second team). A four-time MW Pitcher of the Week, including three straight weeks from March 28-April 11, Light was 15-7 with a 1.90 ERA and a school-record seven saves in 132 2/3 innings. She started 17 games and played in 40 overall, playing a part in six Aztec shutouts, and striking out 106 with 20 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .218 average. Light was even better in MW play, going 7-1 with two saves and a 1.37 ERA across 61 1/3 innings, striking out 36 against 12 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .213 average.

Decker made the most of her first season on The Mesa in 2023, batting .368 (56-for-152) with six home runs, 40 RBIs, 29 runs, four doubles and 26 walks, posting a .513 slugging percentage and an .462 on-base mark en route to becoming a second-team NFCA all-West Region pick and a second-team all-MW selection. Decker hit .386 (22-for-57) in MW play with a home run, 14 RBIs, 15 runs and 12 walks, owning a .456 slugging percentage and a .493 on-base percentage. She was also named to the all-Mountain West Tournament team, batting a team-high .700 (7-for-10) with a home run, five RBIs and two runs. In nine postseason games overall (three in MW tournament, six in NCAA tournament), she hit .429 (12-for-28) with three homers, 13 RBIs and four runs, slugging .750 with a .467 on-base mark.

Espinoza made her second straight all-MW team a year ago (first team in 2022, second team in 2023), leading SDSU in batting average (.393), runs (57), hits (75), stolen bases (30) and at-bats (191). Espinoza's 70 singles were a SDSU single-season record, and she also ranked second in single-season history in stolen bases (30), third in runs (57), tied for third in hits (75) and eighth in batting average (.393). In MW play, Espinoza batted .352 (25-for-71) with 25 runs and 13 stolen bases and later made the all-MW Tournament Team after hitting .545 (6-for-11) with five runs and two stolen bases in just three games.

Aztecs Unusually Fall in Opener

San Diego State has excelled in season-opening games since records were first kept in 1980. With a 3-0 loss to No. 3/3 Stanford on Feb. 8, the Aztecs fell to 33-12 (.733) in lid-lifters in recorded program history. Even with the loss, SDSU has won 10 of its last 12 season openers, 21 of its last 24 and 24 of its last 28.

San Diego State's only blemishes in the past 27 season-openers came on Feb. 8 (lost to No. 3/3 Stanford, 3-0), in 2018 (lost to No. 25/25 Georgia, 23-2), 2012 (lost to Texas Tech, 5-4) and in 2000 (lost to UIC, 5-3).

Over the last 28 openers, the Aztecs have outscored their opponent, 154-88, or 5.5-3.1 per game in lid-lifters. SDSU ended up recording back-to-back shutouts over USD on 2021 opening day, the first time it had consecutive shutouts on an opening day since 2008.
