several roads at the park will be closed this weekend.

**Directions** From The North

Take I-5 South to I-805 South to CA-163 South.

Take Exit 2C toward University Ave.

Bear right onto 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Finish line, registration and packet pick up will be on right just past Quince Dr.

From The East

Take the 8 West and exit 14A for CA-125 North toward CA-94 South.

Keep left at the fork, follow signs for CA-125 South.

Take exit 15 on the left to merge onto 94 West.

Take exit 1A onto 5 North. Take exit 16B for 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Turn right at 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Finish line, registration and packet pick up will be on right just past Quince Dr.

From The Airport

Head East on N Harbor Dr. toward Rent a Car.

Turn left at W Laurel St.

Turn left at 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Finish line, registration and packet pick up will be on right just past Quince Dr.

- Colleges, clubs and elite individual Entry deadline is **Wednesday**, **September 18**<sup>th</sup>. Entries received after the deadline will not necessarily be accepted.
- Up to 10 runners per team. Top 5 will score with the next 2 runners displacing. Multiple teams per institution/club permitted.
- Computerized race results will be posted on-line and will also be available for each team following the completion of each race.
- Please be honest when placing your team in the open or invitational race. All NCAA DI teams will be placed in the Invitational race unless coaches request otherwise.

#### **Entry Fees**

\$125 - Per each 7 athlete team for USTFCCA members. \$10 each additional athlete.

\$175 - Per each 7 athlete team for non-USTFCCA members. \$10 each add'l athlete.

\$25 – Unattached and Community race entrants.

\$30 – Day of meet individual entry fee.

Unattached Elite Men 8K < 26:00 Entry Guidance: Women 5K <18:30

Online payment option for the Open and Invitational Sections is under development by DirectAthletics. All Dirt Dog Community Race entries are on-line through Active.com, except Race Day Registration. Elite Open/Invitational runners pay by check Race Day.

Trophies will be awarded to the top three college teams in invitational races. Top 5 individual invitational winners will also receive awards.




