Series Notes

- The all-time series is now tied at 37 games apiece.
- San Diego State is still 31-11 in the last 42 meetings against UNLV (regardless of location), after once trailing 26-6 in the series.
- San Diego State has still won 12 of the last 15 games against UNLV in Viejas Arena.

Game Notes

- SDSU was down by as many as 14 points in the second half and trailed by 11 at the final media timeout (3:59 remaining), before getting to withing
 one point at 64-63 with 14 seconds left.
- SDSU falls to 16-1 this season (48-9 in Brian Dutcher era) when outrebounding its opponent.
- The Aztecs 25 first-half points matches its lowest output of the season (vs. Tennessee State on 11-25-19).
- San Diego State's 63 points are the fourth fewest in a game this season.

Player Notes

Malachi Flynn (24 points, 9 rebounds, 6 assists, 1 steal)

Reached double figures for the 26th time this season (the other game he had nine points) and 64th time in his career... Recorded his 20th career game with at least 20 points (eighth time this season)... Led the team in scoring for the 17th time this season and 31st time of his career... His nine rebounds were his most

this season and tied for the most of his career (also nine vs. Montana State on Nov. 11, 2016 while at Washington State)... Became just the second Aztec since the 1996-97 season to record at least 24 points, 9 rebounds and 6 assists in the same game (also Jamaal Franklin at Air Force on Feb. 2, 2013).

Matt Mitchell (13 points, 4 rebounds, 1 assist, 1 steal)

Reached double figures for the 17th time this season and 54th of his career... SDSU fell to 16-1 this season and 40-14 over his career when he scores in double figures.

Jordan Schakel (10 points, 9 rebounds, 2 steals)

Reached double figures for the 18th time this season and 28th time in his career... SDSU fell to 17-1 this season and 25-3 over his career when he scores in double figures... Matched his career and season high with nine rebounds (also had nine at New Mexico on Jan. 29)... Led the team in rebounding (tied with Malachi Flynn) for the fourth time this season and eighth time of his career... His two steals tied a season high... Made a 3-pointer for the ninth straight game, which is tied for the longest streak of his career... Had multiple 3-pointers for the 18th time this season and 39th time of his career.
