WHAT'S ON TAP THIS WEEKEND IN AZTEC BASEBALL

- ◆ After its 7-2 win over No.17 Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday (May 3), San Diego State now hits the road for a three-game Mountain West series at Fresno State this weekend.
- ◆ The Aztecs and Bulldogs will open that three-game set on Friday, May 6, at the Bulldogs' Beiden Field at 6:00 p.m. (PT)
- ◆ San Diego State and Fresno State will also hook up for games on Saturday (May 7) and Sunday (May 8) at 6:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. (PT) respectively.

ON THE AIR

- ◆ All three contests at Fresno State will have live video streaming on the Mountain Digital Network with links at www.GoAztecs.com.
- ◆ In addition, live stats will be available for all of the games this weekend with the links available at GoAztecs.com.

SERIES RECORD

- ◆ SDSU's record against Fresno State stands at 92-92 with the Bulldogs being the team that the Aztecs have faced the most in the sport of baseball over the years.
- ◆ Earlier this season the Bulldogs captured two of the three games between the teams at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- ◆ The Aztecs are 44-45 at home, 43-45 in Fresno and 5-2 on neutral fields against Fresno State.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- ◆ Fresno State enter the weekend with a record of 30-16 overall and 17-7 in the Mountain West. It currently sits in second place, two games behind league leader New Mexico.
- ◆ The Bulldogs top hitters include outfielders Brody Russell (.415, 15 2B, 4 HR, 35 RBI) and first baseman Aaron Arruda (.331, 12 2B, 8 HR, 33 RBI).
- ◆ Relievers Tim Borst and Dylan Lee have recorded eight and six saves respectively.
- ◆ Fresno State is hitting .288 as a team with a 3.34 earned run average.

ADKISON HITS AWAY

- ◆ Sophomore Tyler Adkison has hit in eight of SDSU's last nine contests after having a six-game hitting streak end on April 30 vs. Nevada.
- ◆ In the series finale vs. the Wolf Pack last Sunday (May 1), he had a pair of hits, a walk, RBI and two runs scored.
- ◆ He had a personal season-best nine-game hitting streak come to an end in the game at USD on April 12.
- ◆ During that streak he went 12-for-35 (.343) with three doubles, a triple, home run, 11 RBI and four runs scored.
- ◆ In the win over No. 20 Long Beach State on April 5, he led off with a triple in the 12th inning after which he scored the game-winning run in SDSU's 6-5 win.

- ◆ He hit a pair of home runs in the contest at Air Force on March 20.

TREJO KEEPS HITTING

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo leads SDSU in hitting among the regular starters with a .322 average.
- ◆ He had a pair of sacrifice flies in the win over CSU Fullerton on Tuesday.
- ◆ He hit his second homer of the season in the win over New Mexico on April 24.
- ◆ Trejo went 5-for-11 with a triple during the three-game series at No.10 Texas Tech (April 15-17).
- ◆ He had a team season-high 15-game hitting streak end on March 25 vs. New Mexico.

- ◆ During that streak he batted .419 (27-for-66) with two doubles, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored.
- ◆ He has drawn a walk in each of the last seven games.

NEVAREZ IN A PINCH

- ◆ Freshman Dean Nevarez made his fifth pinch hitting appearance of the year at New Mexico on April 23.
- ◆ He responded with a two-run double.
- ◆ He has gone 2-for-4 as a pinch hitter this season with a walk.
- ◆ Nevarez is the only Aztec pinch hitter with more than one hit.
- ◆ He had a two-RBI double in the series finale vs. Nevada on Sunday (May 1) as the DH in that contest.

WYLIE CONSISTENT

- ◆ Second baseman Justin Wylie has gone 10-for-26 (.385) in the Aztecs last seven contests.
- ◆ He hit his third homer of the year at USD on April 12, a solo shot in the top of the seventh inning.
- ◆ He tied his season high with three hits in the game on April 9 vs. UNLV.
- ◆ He hit a leadoff home run in the contest at Cal State Fullerton on March 15 to give SDSU an early 1-0 lead. His first home of the year had come in the previous contest vs. Northwestern.
- ◆ He is second on the team with 14 multiple-hit games this season.
- ◆ Wylie leads the squad in stolen bases with seven.

LOPTIEN GETS FIRST SAVE

- ◆ Sophomore right-hander Tyler Loptien recorded his first career save as an Aztec when he got the final out in the Aztecs' 10-9 win at New Mexico April 24.
- ◆ He has made six appearances this season covering 4.1 innings during which he has allowed no runs on three hits with five walks and four strikeouts.
- ◆ Opponents are hitting just .188 against him.

VERDON ON SUNDAY

- ◆ Freshman Jordan Verdon had two hits including a double with two RBI and a run scored in the series finale vs. Nevada last Sunday (May 1).
- ◆ He had a pair of hits and drove in three runs the previous Sunday in the win at New Mexico (April 24).
- ◆ His RBI single in the ninth drove in SDSU's final important run in what ended up as a 10-9 win.
- ◆ In Sunday games this season he is hitting .364 (12-for-33).
- ◆ He connected for his second home run of the season at USD on April 19, a three-run shot that extended SDSU's two-run lead to five runs in the eighth inning.
- ◆ He went 4-for-10 in the three-game series vs. UNLV (April 8-10) with a double and four RBI.
- ◆ His three RBI vs. the Rebels on April 8 was a season high.
- ◆ He had an 11-game hitting streak come to an end on March 26 vs. New Mexico.
- ◆ It was the third-longest hitting streak by an Aztec this season.
- ◆ During that streak he hit .361 (13-for-36) with a double, triple, three RBI and five runs scored.

HENSLEY STREAK ENDS

- ◆ David Hensley had a double and sacrifice bunt against Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday (May 3).
- ◆ He leads the team in sacrifice bunts with 10, a number that ties for 11th on the SDSU single-season list.
- ◆ After going hitless in the first two games vs. Nevada last weekend, he had a pair of hits including a double with two RBI and a run scored in the series final on Sunday (May 1).
- ◆ He hit his first career home run in the second inning of the April 12 contest at University of San Diego, giving SDSU a 1-0 lead in a game it went on to win, 7-3.
- ◆ He had a 12-game hitting streak, second longest on the squad this season, come to an end in the series finale vs. UNLV on April 10.
- ◆ During that streak he hit .365 (19-for-52) with a two doubles, four RBI and eight runs scored.

CONFERENCE HITTING

- ◆ Five of SDSU's regular starters are hitting above the .300 mark in Mountain West Conference games.
- ◆ That list includes Justin Wylie (.372), Alan Trejo (.320), Spencer Thornton (.316), Chase Calabuig (.305) and Jordan Verdon (.303).
- ◆ As a team the Aztecs are hitting .293 in league games.



STREAKS.

- ◆ Four Aztecs currently have two-game hitting streaks in progress after the team suffered a one-hitter at the hands of Nevada last Saturday (April 30).
- ◆ The team's longest hitting streak this season is 15 games by Alan Trejo.
- ◆ Justin Wylie has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of the last 10 games while Alan Trejo has done so in the last eight.
- ◆ The longest such streak by an SDSU hitter this season is 22 by Spencer Thornton.
- ◆ Trejo leads the Aztecs with 18 multiple-hit contests as well as a team-high seven multiple-RBI games each.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Shortstop Alan Trejo earned the Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week award for games played through Sunday, March 13, 2016.
- ◆ It is the first MW weekly accolade for Trejo, a sophomore from Downey, Calif. (Warren HS).
- ◆ He led San Diego State to a 2-1 week in a home series against Northwestern.
- ◆ Over the three contests he posted a batting average of .600 (9-for-15) with six runs scored, five runs batted in and one stolen base.
- ◆ Trejo had at least two hits and two runs scored in all three games with a .625 on-base and a .600 slugging percentage.
- ◆ Defensively, Trejo recorded seven putouts and 12 assists with no errors.
- ◆ He was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the week by *College Sports Madness*.

GOOD START

- ◆ Two Aztec newcomers recorded hits in their first collegiate at bat during the season-opening series vs. Oregon.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon singled to right center field in his first plate appearance in the contest on Feb. 19.
- ◆ Dean Nevarez delivered a single to center in his first plate appearance as a pinch hitter vs. Oregon on Feb. 20.

NAVARRO'S FIRST HIT

- ◆ After going hitless in his first six collegiate plate appearances, freshman Niko Navarro came through with an important single in the win over Fresno State on Sunday (March 6).
- ◆ He was called upon to pinch hit in the bottom of the eighth with the bases loaded, one out and SDSU trailing, 4-2.
- ◆ Navarro proceeded to deliver a single to right field to drive home two runs and tie the game.
- ◆ SDSU added a third run one batter later and went on to win, 5-4.

NEW COACHES

- ◆ The Aztecs have added a pair of new coaches to their staff for the 2016 season: Pitching Coach Sam Peraza and Volunteer Assistant Joey Centanni.
- ◆ Peraza arrives at SDSU after two seasons at Florida International. He also had previous experience at Cal State Northridge, Cal State Los Angeles and Eastern Oklahoma State.
- ◆ He is a 2002 graduate of San Diego State, where he pitched during the 2002 season.
- ◆ Centanni played four seasons as a pitcher and first baseman at Pacific, graduating in 2009. After college, he spent one season in the Baltimore Orioles organization before an injury ended his playing career.
- ◆ He later served as an associate scout for the Orioles in the San Diego area and coach locally at Francis Parker High School.

VETERAN HONOREES

- ◆ Five players who earned individual honors a year ago return for the 2016 season.

- ◆ That quartet included outfielder Spencer Thornton and third baseman Andrew Brown along with pitchers Marcus Reyes and Cody Thompson.

DRAFTED AZTECS

- ◆ Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- ◆ That trio includes junior catcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with sophomore outfielder Denz'l Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and freshman first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

AZTEC NOTES

- ◆ Left fielder Chase Calabuig ended a four-game hitless streak by going 2-for-3 with a triple, RBI and run scored vs. Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday (May 3).
- ◆ Junior left-hander Marcus Reyes picked up his first win of the season after tossing three shutout innings against No. 17 Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday.
- ◆ Jordan Verdon is one of six Aztecs to have recorded a double, triple and home run this season. The others include Alan Trejo, Tyler Adkison, Andrew Brown, Dean Nevarez and Chase Calabuig.
