### SDSU TO WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON AT HOME ON TUESDAY

- ◆ After a pair of wins last week, one at home and one on the road, San Diego State will conclude its 2012 regular season at home this week.
- ◆ SDSU will host Mountain West foe Nevada on Tuesday, Nov. 20, at 7:00 p.m. on Aztec Court in Peterson Gym.
- ◆ A win against the Wolf Pack will give the Aztecs a share of the conference championship for the first time since entering the Mountain West in 1999.

### **MW TITLE, NCAA TOURNEY**

- ◆ SDSU enters the week tied with Colorado State atop the league standings with a record of 12-3 in the Mountain West.
- ◆ The Rams host New Mexico on Friday in their regular-season finale.
- ◆ Should the Aztecs and Rams tie, Colorado State would win the tiebreaker between the teams and receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.
- ◆ The tiebreaker, after head-to-head record, is each team's set record in conference play.
- ◆ The selection show for the 2012 NCAA women's volleyball tournament is on Sunday, Nov. 25, at 1:00 p.m. (PT) on ESPNU.

### **STREAKING**

- ◆ San Diego State has won its last 11 straight matches and 13 of its last 14.
- ◆ SDSU's last loss came at Boise State on Oct. 11.
- ◆ The 11-match winning streak is the Aztecs' longest since the 1995 campaign when they won 12 in a row.
- ◆ That year SDSU finished with a record of 27-5 overall and 13-1 in the Western Athletic Conference.
- ◆ The last season in which San Diego State won as many as 20 matches was 2002 when it finished with a record of 22-12. They enter the week with a record of 22-7.
- ◆ The last time the Aztecs won as many as 23 matches in a season was in1995 when it recorded 27 victories.

### SERIES RECORDS

◆ San Diego State all-time record vs. Nevada is 1-1. Earlier this season the Wolf Pack defeated the Aztecs in five sets in Reno to record their lone Mountain West win of the year. The Aztecs' victory in the series came in three sets during the 2011 Aztec Invitational in San Diego.

### **SCOUTING THE WOLF PACK**

- Nevada enters the week with a record of 4-24 overall and 1-14 in the Mountain West. Since opening league play with a win over the Aztecs, the Wolf Pack has lost its last 14 consecutive contests.
- ◆ Nevada is led by Tessa Lea'ea (3.13 kills, 1.34 blocks preset) and Janelle Batista (2.52 kills, 0.66 digs per set). Lea'ea ranks fourth in the league in blocks and eighth in kills.

### **HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER**

- San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker enters her fourth season with the Aztecs after being named the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at SDSU is 70-48 (.593).
- ◆ She previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her career record stands at 230-239 (.490).
- ◆ A three-time All-American as a player at the University of Hawai'i, she led the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was named the national player of the year twice.
- She was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- She is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.

### **WABER ON THE OFFENSIVE**

- Over SDSU's last eight matches, Michelle Waber has averaged 3.52 kills and 4.10 points per set.
- ◆ In the matches against Air Force and Boise State (Nov. 8 and 10) she hit a combined .362.
- ♦ Her .588 hitting percentage vs. Air Force (Nov. 8) marked her high as an Aztec.
- Her 18 kills against Wyoming (Oct. 27) was her second-highest output of the season.
- She totaled 21.0 points and had three service aces in that match to equal her personal season bests in each category.

### HANNASCH LEADS OFFENSE

- Andrea Hannasch has averaged 4.00 kills, 1.69 digs and 4.46 points per set while hitting .362 over the Aztecs' last four matches.
- ◆ She has reached double figures in kills in eight of SDSU's last nine contests and 14 of the last 16.
- ◆ Hannasch notched her first doubledouble of the season with 11 kills and 10 assists in the Aztecs' win at Fresno State on Nov. 3.
- ◆ Her season average of 3.92 points per set leads the Aztecs.
- ◆ She tied her season high with 19 kills in the win over New Mexico on Oct. 1.
- Hannasch is one of two Aztecs (along with Emily Harris) to have recorded at least one block in every match this season.

### HARRIS ON THE BLOCK

- Emily Harris has emerged as the team's leading blocker averaging 1.34 per set.
- ◆ Over SDSU's last four matches she is averaging 1.77 blocks per set.
- ◆ With 146 blocks in 2012 assists she ranks fourth on the SDSU top 10 list for block assists in a season.
- ◆ She notched a career-high 10 block assists at Air Force on Oct. 13.
- ◆ Harris turned in a personal season high 12 kills in the Aztecs' victory at Fresno State on Nov. 3
- ◆ Harris leads the squad in hitting percentage at .321.

### FOUCH'S BEST EFFORTS

- Setter Johnna Fouch recorded her ninth and 10th double-doubles of the season in last week's two Aztec victories.
- ◆ She recorded 44 assists and 10 digs against No. 18 San Diego followed by 39 assists and 10 digs at New Mexico.
- ◆ She has notched double-doubles in six of SDSU's last seven matches.
- ◆ Over the past seven matches Fouch is averaging 3.04 digs per set.
- ◆ She had a season-high 61 assists in the win at Fresno State on Nov. 3.
- ◆ Fouch set career-highs with six kills and 8.5 points in the three-set victory at UC Irvine on Oct. 16.
- Her three blocks vs. New Mexico two days later Oct. 18 tied her 2012 season best.
- She is hitting .429 from her setter position with only three attack errors in 63 attempts.

### JACKELS DIGGIN' IT

- ◆ Libero Kristi Jackels has averaged 4.59 digs per set over SDSU's last six matches.
- ◆ She has recorded 20 or more digs in a match on seven occasions during the 2012 season.
- She set her season high with 28 digs in the four-set win over Colorado State on Oct. 25.
- ◆ Her 461 digs this season ranks sixth in the SDSU single-season list.
- She is the only player to appear four times on that list as her season dig total each of her four years as an Aztec rank among the all-time SDSU top 10.

### SHELTON ON THE OFFENSIVE

- ◆ Raegan Shelton tuned in a personal season-best .412 hitting percentage while leading the Aztecs with 17 kills in the win over No. 18 San Diego on Nov. 14.
- ◆ Over the Aztecs' last four matches she is averaging 3.46 kills per set while hitting
- ◆ In league matches she ranks eighth in kills at 3.24 kills per set and is also ninth with a mark of 3.69 points per set.
- ♦ Her 20 kills against Air Force on Oct. 13 matched her season high that she previously recorded vs. UNLV on Oct. 7.
- Shelton had a career-high 24.0 points in that win vs. the Falcons.
- Her five blocks in the contest vs. Wyoming (Oct. 27) was her career best in that category.

### **WORKING OVERTIME**

- ◆ San Diego State has played nine five-set matches this season and has a record of 7-2 in those contests.
- ◆ The Aztecs' mark for most five-set contests in a season is 11 during the 1989 campaign.
- ◆ The last time SDSU had as many as nine five-set matches in a season was in 1988 and this is the seventh time in program history that they have reached that figure.
- ◆ The Aztecs have now gone 10 contests without having to play a five-set match, their longest such streak of the season.

### **AMONG THE MW LEADERS**

- ◆ Several Aztecs ranks among the top 10 in various categories in the Mountain West statistics.
- Emily Harris is fifth in hitting percentage (.321) and third in blocks (1.34/set).
- ◆ Andrea Hannasch is eighth in blocks (1.03/set), seventh in hitting percentage (.297) and eighth in points (3.69/set).
- ◆ Johnna Fouch is fifth is assists (9.10/set).
- ◆ Kristi Jackels is seventh in digs (4.02/set).
- ◆ Raegan Shelton is ninth in kills (3.08/set).
- ◆ Summer Nash is 10th in kills (3.01/set).
- As a team, SDSU ranks first in the Mountain West in kills (14.09/set) and is second in hitting percentage (.233), assists (13.02/set) and digs (15.24/.set).

### **MOVING UP THE CHARTS**

- ◆ Three current Aztecs moved into the top 10 on the SDSU career lists in various categories last season and continue to move up the charts.
- ◆ Andrea Hannasch's three-year total of 467 block assists moves her into the number-two spot on the SDSU all-time list. The all-time leader is Jennifer Miller (1989-92) with 480 block assists.
- ◆ Kristi Jackels has compiled 1,826 digs during her time as an Aztec to rank second in that category. Aime Cordeiro (2004-07) is the all-time leader with 1,974 career digs.
- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch's mark of 3,422 career assists place her third. The second spot is held by Melissa Wright (2000-02) with 3.865 assists.

### **ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTEC**

- ◆ Junior outside hitter Raegan Shelton was named to the all-tournament team at the Fullerton Classic (Sept. 14-15).
- ◆ Shelton average 2.88 kills while hitting at a .272 clip.
- ◆ She also had 1.69 digs per set and 0.56 blocks per set to earn the honor.
- ♦ Her 15 kills against Oregon State was her season high and she also set a career best with 12 digs.
- ◆ She recorded her first double-double of the season in that contest against OSU.

### ALL-TOURNEY PART II

- Andrea Hannasch and Michelle Waber earned all-tournament honors at the season-opening Aztec Invitational (Aug. 24-25).
- Over SDSU's two matches that weekend, Hannasch average 3.75 kills, 1.38 digs, 1.12 blocks and 4.62 points per set while hitting .545.
- Waber, meanwhile, averaged 4.50 kills, 4.94 points and 1.13 digs per set en route to being named tourney MVP.

### **ALL-TOURNEY PART III**

- Sophomore outside hitter Michelle Waber and junior middle blocker Emily Harris were named to the all-tournament team at the Aztec Challenge (Aug. 31-Sept. 1).
- Waber averaged 3.22 kills, 2.00 digs and .056 blocks per set while hitting .309 over the Aztecs three matches.
- ♦ Harris recorded a .417 hitting percentage and averaged 1.80 kills and 1.50 blocks.

### **ALL-TOURNEY PART IV**

- Senior libero Kristi Jackels was named to the all-tournament team at the Verizon Volleyball Challenge in Honolulu (Sept. 7-9).
- Over SDSU's three matches she averaged 3.58 digs per set and turned in a seasonhigh 23 in the contest against Hawai'i.
- Jackels also had 12 assists (1.00 per set) and a service ace during the weekend competition.

### NASH NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ◆ Summer Nash was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Nov. 5. She came off the bench the previous week while helping the Aztecs to a pair of 3-1 road wins over UNLV and Fresno State as San Diego State moved into first place in the Conference.
- ◆ At UNLV on Nov. 1, she entered the match in the fourth set and recorded a kill that ended the Rebels' 5-0 run to start the contest. With the score tied at 13-13, she added a kill that began a three-point SDSU run and gave the Aztecs the lead for good en route to the set and match win. Nash finished the set with three kills and one error in seven attempts.
- ◆ At Fresno State on Nov. 3, she came off the bench in the second set and played in each of the final three sets, leading the Aztecs in the match with 16 kills. Her .600 hitting percentage and two solo blocks against the Bulldogs were both career highs.
- For the week, Nash averaged 4.75 kills, 0.75 blocks and 0.25 digs per set, while hitting at a .531 clip. She averaged 5.38 points per set over four total sets.

### HANNASCH EARNS POW HONOR

- Senior middle blocker Andrea Hannasch was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for her performance at the Aztec Invitational during the weekend of Aug. 31-Sept. 1.
- ◆ Against Delaware, she recorded a .643 attack percentage on 11 kills to go along with four digs and six block assists.
- ♦ Her 19 kills in the win over Cal was one shy of her career high as an Aztec.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.75 kills, 1.38 digs and 1.12 blocks per set, while hitting .545. She averaged 4.62 points per set over eight total sets.

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK AGAIN

- Middle blocker Andrea Hannasch earned Mountain West Women's Volleyball Player of the Week honors on Oct. 8 after leading the Aztecs to victories over Fresno State and UNLV.
- ◆ In the win over Fresno State, Hannasch recorded 14 kills, nine digs and five blocks while amassing a .370 hitting percentage. She also tied her season- and career-high of three assists and served up two aces, including one on match point in the fifth set that gave SDSU the win.
- Her 19 kills in the victory over UNLV were a season-best and one shy of her career-high. She also tallied eight digs and five blocks in the match while posting a .385 hitting percentage.
- ◆ For the week, Hannasch averaged 3.30 kills, 1.70 digs and 1.00 blocks per set, while hitting .379. She averaged 4.00 points per set over 10 total sets.

### **AZTEC NOTES**

- ◆ The Aztecs have lost back-to-back matches only once this season.
- ◆ The team's .396 hitting percentage in the victory over Air Force on Nov. 8 was its second-highest of the 2012 campaign.
- ◆ The Aztecs are hitting .303 as a team and holding opponents to a .169 hitting percentage over their last five matches.
- Chaiymin Steel averaged 1.00 blocks per set in SDSU's wins over No. 18 San Diego and New Mexico last week.
- ◆ Setter Johnna Fouch (assists-digs) has recorded 10 double-doubles this season to lead the team. Outside hitter Michelle Waber (kills-digs) has three and Chloe Mathis (assists-digs) has two while Raegan Shelton and Andrea Hannasch have one (kills-digs).
- ◆ Andrea Hannasch and Emily Harris are the only two Aztecs to have started every match this season. Senior Kristi Jackels has also been the starting libero for every match in 2012. They are the only three Aztecs to appear in all 115 sets in 2012.
