Oregon State By The Numbers

0 - Oregon State is one of nine teams nationally to have zero turnovers entering this week's games.

3 - OSU's opponents have been held to under 20 points in three consecutive games, the longest streak since three straight midway through the 2006 season.

5 - Consecutive wins at home, tied for the 11th-longest in the nation.

6 - Oregon State's overall win streak, its longest since the 2013 Beavers also won six straight. OSU is tied for eighth nationally actively.

8.5 - Tackles for loss by OSU over the first two games, ranking 15th nationally and third in the Pac-12.

14 - Scoring drives for the Beavers over the first two games, in 20 that didn't end by the first or second half.

38 - Points for OSU in the first half against UC Davis. It's the 10th-most in a half by an FBS program this season.

103 - Total rush yards allowed by the Beaver defense this season. The 51.5 per game average ranks seventh nationally and No. 1 in the Pac-12.

Against San Diego State

▲ The Beavers and Aztecs are meeting for the sixth time, and first since 2014. OSU won that meeting, 28-7, at Reser Stadium.

▲ SDSU won the first two meetings between the teams, in 1972 and 1975, but Oregon State went on to win in 2000, 2013 and 2014. OSU is 2-0 in games played in Corvallis.

▲ SDSU head coach Brady Hoke coached Oregon State's defensive line and inside linebackers in 1989 and 1991-94.

▲ Aztecs' defensive line coach, Bojay Filimoeatu, served as a defensive quality control coach for the Beavers in 2016.

Recapping UC Davis

▲ Oregon State limited UC Davis to 169 offensive yards. It's the 22nd time since 1996 an OSU opponent has tallied less than 200, and the third with Jonathan Smith as the Beavers' head coach.

▲ Damien Martinez' 64-yard rush to open the Beavers' offensive night was his longest run at the collegiate level.

▲ Martinez ended the game with 104 rush yards to surpass 100 for the eighth time in his career.

▲ Silas Bolden became one of just six players nationally with a punt return for touchdown this season. He then scored on a 22-yard reception later in the second quarter.

▲ DJ Uiagalelei has back-to-back multiple touchdown pass games to open his OSU career. He also improved to 24-6 as a starting quarterback at the collegiate level.

▲ Rweha Munyagai Jr. and Riley Sharp each caught their first career touchdowns. Munyagai Jr. also made his first start and the touchdown was his first career reception. Sharp, a converted linebacker, made his first career catch last week versus San Jose State.

▲ Aidan Chiles ran for his first collegiate score and passed for his first touchdown.

▲ The 55 points scored by the Beavers marked a single-game high at Reser Stadium during Jonathan Smith's tenure as head coach.

Win Streak

▲ Oregon State has won six consecutive games, the team's longest streak since the 2013 Beavers won six straight.

▲ OSU's streak is tied for the eighth-longest nationally, and is second in the Pac-12, trailing only Washington's nine.

▲ Oregon State is looking to win seven straight for the first time since the 2000 season.

▲ The Beavers have won five straight at home, tied for the 11th-longest streak nationally. That is the fourth-longest streak in the Pac-12, trailing Utah (15), USC (10) and Washington (9).

Make That 8

▲ Damien Martinez carried the ball just seven times in the 55-7 win over UC Davis, but picked up his eighth career 100-yard ef-

fort, totaling 104.

▲ The Lewisville, Texas native pushed his career total to 1,231 yards, which ranks 33rd for a career at OSU. He is just 23 yards shy of 32nd and just over 100 out of 29th.

▲ The sophomore has averaged 6.6 yards per carry over 186 career attempts. He is just 14 attempts shy of qualifying for the Oregon State record books, where he would better the program record of 5.8 set by J.J. Young (1991-94), Ryan Nall (2015-16) and Artavis Pierce (2016-19).

More On Martinez

▲ Damien Martinez has averaged 9.96 yards per rush over the first two games this year, a mark that ranks seventh nationally but second among running backs with at least 20 carries.

▲ His 249 total yards are good for a tie for 11th.

Three Straight Under 20

▲ With the win Saturday, Oregon State has held its last three opponents - Florida (3), San Jose State (17) and UC Davis (7) - to under 20 points.

▲ The Beavers last held an opponent to under 20 in three straight games in 2006, losing to Washington State 13-6 before defeating Washington 27-17 and Arizona 17-10.

▲ OSU is looking to make it four straight for the first time since doing so for five consecutive in 2001-2002: a 45-10 win over Northern Arizona and 17-14 loss to Oregon in 2021, 49-10 over Eastern Kentucky to open 2022 followed by a 35-3 win over Temple and 47-17 victory against UNLV.

In The Rankings

▲ Oregon State remained steady in the Associated Press Top 25 rankings while moving up one spot to 17 in the US LBM Coaches Poll.

▲ Oregon State's rankings this season.

▲ Oregon State was in the AP Top 25 for six weeks during the 2022 season, which included a final ranking at No. 17 after the win over Florida. The Beavers also finished 17th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Bolden Making His Mark

▲ Silas Bolden scored his first career special teams touchdown on a 65-yard punt return Saturday, then scored on a 22-yard touchdown reception.

▲ He became one of just six players in the nation with a punt return for score this season. Bolden did so while returning the first two punts of his collegiate career. He's also returned 23 kickoffs, averaging 26.8 yards per.

▲ OSU has won three straight when sporting a 2-0 mark.

Hodgins Into The Backfield

▲ Isaac Hodgins got into the backfield in a big way Saturday, recording three tackles for loss, totaling 16 yards. That included an 8-yard sack.

▲ Hodgins is the first Oregon State defensive lineman to record at least three in the same game since Scott Crichton on Dec. 24, 2013 against Boise State in the Hawai'i Bowl.

How's That For Game One?

▲ All DJ Uiagalelei did in his first game at Oregon State was make OSU history. The transfer from Clemson started and passed for 239 yards and three touchdowns. He also ran for a pair of 1-yard scores, and became the first OSU QB, since at least 1996, to throw for three touchdowns and run for two in the same game.

▲ It's also just the 18th time a Pac-12 quarterback has done that since '96.

▲ DJU was named the Manning Award Star of the Week for his performance against San Jose State and he was also selected to the Great 8 for the Davey O'Brien Award.

▲ Uiagalelei completed 20-of-25 passes, an 80-percent completion percentage. That's the fifth-best mark by an OSU QB dating back to 1996. A look below at the company he has joined.

▲ As a team, the Beavers completed 22-of-28 passes, a 78.6 completion percentage, and the seventh-best single-game mark since 1996.

▲ Uiagalelei is now 24-6 as a starting quarterback at the collegiate level.

Limiting Yards

▲ Oregon State has allowed just 227 yards per game to start the year after limiting UC Davis to 169 on Saturday. Those 227 yards are 5 yards better than California as Oregon State leads the Pac-12.

▲ Trent Bray took over as Oregon State's

defensive coordinator for the last four games of the 2021 season. Since then, over a stretch of 19 games, the Beavers have held opponents to 324 yards per game, 20th nationally, and best in the Pac-12. Teams have surpassed 400 yards against OSU just three times in those 19 games.

▲ OSU has also held opponents to 109.8 rush yards per game over that stretch, 13th nationally and second in the Pac-12, trailing only Utah (100.3 ryppg).

Points, Too

▲ Oregon State's defense held the Aggies to seven points, the 11th time over that 19-game stretch where the Beavers have limited an opponent to less than 20.

▲ Opponents have averaged 19.5 points per game over that stretch, 13th nationally and No. 1 in the Pac-12.

A Look At Some Drives

▲ Oregon State has scored on 14 of its drives this season. Overall, Oregon State has had 22 drives this season, but two were finished by the first half or the end of the game.

▲ Looking a little closer: 11 of Oregon State's scoring drives have gone at least two minutes in length. Five of the 14 drives have eaten up 70 or more yards, and only three have been for 10 or more plays.

Reigning Pac-12 Co-COTY

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith was named the Co-Coach of the Year in the Pac-12 last season, joining Washington's Kalen DeBoer. Smith was the first OSU coach to be honored since Mike Riley in 2008.

▲ Smith was also named the Region 5 Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). He was the first Beaver coach to earn that honor since Riley in 2012.

Under Jonathan Smith

▲ Oregon State is 22-6 when leading at halftime. The Beavers are also 21-3 when taking a lead into the fourth quarter.

▲ The Beavers are 19-12 when controlling time of possession.

▲ Oregon State is 18-13 at home.

▲ The Beavers have scored 30 or more points in 30 of his 59 games, going 23-7.

▲ Oregon State is 19-7 when outgaining its opponent.

▲ OSU is 23-11 when scoring first.

▲ The Beavers are 11-2 when holding an opponent to 21 points or less.

All-Americans Returned

▲ Anthony Gould and Taliese Fuaga both returned after being named All-Americans in 2022. Jack Colletto is the only All-American lost from the 2022 squad.

▲ Oregon State also returned Damien Martinez and Jack Velling, who were each selected as Freshman All-Americans.

On Fourth

▲ Oregon State has converted on 77 fourth-down conversions under head coach Jonathan Smith since 2018, the most in the Pac-12. UCLA has the second-most at 70.

▲ OSU is tied for 15th nationally.

▲ OSU has converted on 61.1 percent of its 126 attempts over that stretch, second-best in the Pac-12. OSU is ranked 12th nationally.

Home Sweet Home

▲ Oregon State has been one of the best home teams in the country the past two seasons, amassing an 12-1 record at Reser Stadium. The lone loss was a 17-14 setback to USC last season.

▲ The Beavers are averaging 407.5 yards of offense and just under 35.6 points per game during that stretch.

▲ Conversely, OSU has allowed 310.2 yards and just over 16.2 points per game the last two-plus seasons.

All-Conference

▲ Oregon State set a single-season record with 18 players recognized as all-conference by the Pac-12's coaches in 2022.

▲ Nine of those 18 returned in 2023, including first-team selections Anthony Gould and Damien Martinez.

▲ Second-team selections returning include Silas Bolden, Taliese Fuaga and Joshua Gray. Those who earned honorable mention and are return are Ryan Cooper Jr., Sione Lolohea, Kitan Oladapo and James Rawls.

▲ The Beavers also became the first team in the Pac-12 era to sweep selections for first and second team returners (Gould and Bolden).

Gray At 35

▲ Offensive lineman Joshua Gray has started 35 career games, the longest stretch on the team.

▲ Gray's 35 games have all come consecutively, with defensive lineman Isaac Hodgins No. 2 with 33. Defensive back Kitan Oladapo has 26 straight starts.

▲ Twenty-three Beavers all-time have started 40 or more games in their careers, with offensive lineman Brandon Kipper (45 games) and defensive back Jaydon Grant (40 games) reaching the plateau last season.

▲ Gray is aiming to become just the eighth Beaver to start 40 or more straight. Kipper was the last to reach that mark with 45 straight to end the 2022 season.

That's Rare

▲ Damien Martinez and Deshaun Fenwick have combined for 12 career 100-yard efforts. Martinez has seven and Fenwick has five, including three since transferring to Oregon State.

▲ The Beavers have had two or more rushers with 100 yards in the same game 19 times, including twice under head coach Jonathan Smith. It happened most recently in 2021 when B.J. Baylor ran for 145 yards and Fenwick went for 127 yards and two touchdowns.

Fewest Departures

▲ Per Max Olson of The Athletic, the Beavers had the fewest departures to the Transfer Portal from 2022 to 2023. Just seven scholarship Oregon State players entered the portal after the team's 10-3 season.

▲ The Beavers are one of two teams nationally in single digits, joining Ohio State (nine).

▲ UCLA, with 10, is the only other Pac-12 Conference Team to rank in the top 15 for the fewest entries.

The Defense In '22

▲ The Oregon State defense, in its first full season under coordinator Trent Bray, made its mark. The Beavers finished first in the Pac-12 in total defense (332.8 yards per game allowed), scoring defense (20 points allowed per game) and rushing defense (108.2 yards per game).

▲ The Beavers also finished third in passing defense, at 224.5 yards per game, just 15 more than No. 1 Stanford.

▲ OSU held opponents to less than 400 yards of total offense in all but two games. From 2015-2021, the defense had held opponents to 400 yards or less just 22 times in an 80-game stretch.

Completed Reser Stadium

▲ Oregon State played its first game in the Completed Reser Stadium Sept. 9 when hosting UC Davis.

▲ The \$161 million project has made Reser into a national best-in-class facility.

▲ An anonymous donor made a historic \$50 million lead gift to transform Oregon State University's Reser Stadium into a national best-in-class football facility with year-round programs and facilities for all OSU students, faculty and staff.

▲ The project received approval by the OSU Board of Trustees Finance and Administration Committee on Jan. 28, 2021. The west side of the stadium was imploded nearly a year later in January 2022.

▲ The project involved the complete demolition and rebuilding of the west side of Reser Stadium and the construction of year-round university facilities, including a new state-of-the-art interactive welcome center for new students considering attending OSU; new health center facilities for Corvallis campus students; health care facilities for OSU faculty and staff; and additional meeting space for university students, faculty and staff.

▲ Reser Stadium will now feature a 360-degree stadium concourse and includes expanded concessions and restroom facilities, enhanced sightlines, accessibility improvements and other fan amenities comparable to the east side of Reser, which was renovated prior to the 2005 season.

On This Date

▲ Oregon State has played on Sept. 16 just seven times previously, going 1-6. The Beavers' lone win on the date came in 1960 over No. 6 USC, 14-0.

▲ Oregon State last played on the date in 2017, losing to Washington State, 52-23.

The HC

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith is in his sixth year leading the program.

▲ Smith quarterbacked the Beavers to the 2001 Fiesta Bowl (2000 season), and was a two-time team captain for Oregon State. The Beavers went 28-18 from 1998-2001, and the QB helped OSU to the 1999 Oahu Bowl in addition to the 2001 Fiesta Bowl.

2023 Opponents

▲ Oregon State's opponents combined to go 80-70 (.533) during the 2022 season. That includes three 10-game winners: Washington (11), Oregon (10) and Utah (10).

▲ OSU's six home opponents - UC Davis, San Diego State, Utah, UCLA, Stanford and Washington - combined to go 46-30 (.605) a year ago.

▲ Six of the Beavers' 11 FBS opponents advanced to bowl games last season.

On The O-Line

▲ Oregon State returned four starters on the offensive line from last season, and the quartet has 85 career starts entering 2023.

▲ That's tied with Nebraska for the eighth-most nationally.

▲ OSU's returners have started 96 career games, which does not include Grant Starck. He started 12 career games at Nevada.

▲ OSU's offensive line returned 189 career games played, 18th most nationally. Again, that does not include Starck's 22 games played at Nevada.

3-And-Out

▲ Oregon State's defense forced 38 three-and-out drives by opponents in 2022. Conversely, the offense totaled 22 three-and-out drives.

▲ The 2021 Beavers, meanwhile, forced just 25 three-and-out drives in their 13 games.

▲ The 2023 Beavers have forced six.

Red Zone Return

▲ Oregon State was the best team in the nation last season in red zone defense, allowing opponents to score on just under 67 percent of their opportunities. Opponents scored on 28-of-42 opportunities.

▲ Twenty of those 28 scores went for touchdowns, a 47.6 percent success rate. The Beavers ranked 16th in that category.

Ground Notables

▲ OSU has scored 134 times on the ground during Jonathan Smith's tenure, with only Oregon (145) and Utah (145) totaling more among conference teams.

▲ The Beavers have averaged 4.8 yards per carry, which is tied for 29th nationally and third in the Pac-12. OSU trails Oregon (5.1 ypc) and Utah (5.0).

▲ Since 2021, the Beavers have scored 75 touchdowns on the ground, third in the Pac-12 and eighth nationally. Oregon State is tied for 10th nationally averaging 5.1 yards per carry.

Holding On To The Ball

▲ Oregon State has turned the ball over 68 times under head coach Jonathan Smith. That is the fewest in the Pac-12 over that stretch.

▲ Oregon State is tied for ninth fewest nationally.

▲ Oregon State has gone 18 games without committing a turnover under Smith, going 12-6.

▲ OSU has won nine consecutive games dating back to 2020 when not committing a turnover.

▲ The Beavers are one of nine teams nationally that have yet to commit a turnover this season.

Grads

▲ A total of 19 Oregon State players have earned their degrees prior to the start of the 2023 season.

▲ They are: Heneli Bloomfield (sociology), Andrew Chatfield Jr. (sociology), Michael Erhart (finance), Deshaun Fenwick (sociology), Anthony Gould (business administration), Ben Gulbranson (public health), Everett Hayes (mechanical engineering), Isaac Hodgins (speech communication), Jesiah Irish (public health), Alton Julian (public health), Jake Levensgood (kinesiology), John McCartan (sociology), Rhewa Munyagi Jr. (biology), Kitan Oladapo (design & innovation management), James Rawls (sociology), Jaden Robinson (digital communication arts), Riley Sharp (marketing), Tavis Shippen (sociology) and Cory Stover (tourism, recreation and adventure leadership).

Smith's Staff

▲ Oregon State added one assistant coach in the offseason leading up to 2023. Running backs coach Keith Bhonapha joined the program in January.

▲ Bhonapha had coached with Smith when the two were at Washington.

▲ Seven of Oregon State's assistant coaches have been on staff during Smith's entire tenure. Blue Adams (2019) and Anthony Perkins (2022) have also joined since Smith's first season in 2018.

▲ Jim Michalczyk (offensive line) is in his second stint at OSU after serving on Dennis Erickson's staff from 1999-2001. Trent Bray (defensive coordinator) was on Mike Riley's staff from 2012-14.

Captains, Our Captains

▲ Oregon State head coach Jonathan Smith announced the team's 2023 captains at the end of the Beavers' preseason camp.

▲ Five Beavers will serve as team captains this year. They are: offensive linemen Taliase Fuaga, Joshua Gray and Jake Levensgood, defensive lineman Isaac Hodgins and defensive back Kitan Oladapo.

▲ Hodgins and Levensgood are both captains for the second time. Hodgins was a captain in 2020, with Levensgood serving as one in 2022 as well.

▲ The home of the Beavers has had over \$360 million in fiscal improvements completed since the 2005 season.

▲ The stadium was re-named on that date after a personal seven-figure gift by Al and Pat Reser of Beaverton, Ore.

▲ The Valley Football Center, which houses the coaching staff's offices and the team's locker room, underwent an enhancement that was completed in the summer of 2020. It included new graphics to celebrate the accomplishments of Beaver football alumni and a stronger presence highlighting bowl victories.

▲ A new videoboard, measuring 145 feet high by 50 feet wide, was installed before the start of the 2022 season. It measures approximately 6,750 square feet and has more than 6.3 million pixels.

Beavers In The NFL

▲ As of Sept. 1, 17 Beavers are in the NFL.

▲ An Oregon State player has been an on NFL Super Bowl roster for 10 consecutive seasons. Most recently, Isaac Seumalo and Noah Togiai were on the roster of the Philadelphia Eagles, who competed against Kansas City in Super Bowl LVII.

• Jonathan Smith is in his sixth season as Oregon State's head coach, having been officially introduced on November 29, 2017.

• Smith led OSU to a 10-3 mark in 2022, the program's third 10-win season. OSU also finished with a 6-3 record in Pac-12 play in '22, the team's most wins since 2012 also tallied six. The Beavers had back-to-back winning seasons in conference play for the first time since 2008 and 2009.

• Smith was named the Co-Head Coach of the Year in the Pac-12 in 2022. He was also named the AFCA Region 5 Coach of the Year.

• Oregon State saw a school-record 18 all-conference selections in a vote by the Pac-12's coaches in 2022. The Beavers had five first-teamers, tying USC for the most. Oregon State's 18 all-conference selections also led the league.

• Anthony Gould, Jack Colletto and Taliese Fuaga were all named All-Americans in 2022. Damien Martinez, who was the Pac-12's Freshman Offensive Player of the Year, was named a Freshman All-American along with Jack Velling.

• Overall, eight Beavers have been named All-Americans during Smith's tenure, which also includes running backs Jermar Jefferson and B.J. Baylor, linebackers Avery and Hamilcar Rashed Jr. and offensive lineman Nathan Eldridge.

• OSU has tallied 59 All-Pac-12 selections the past five seasons.

• Prior to returning to Oregon State, Smith served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Washington Huskies, a program that he helped build into a conference and national championship contender. During his tenure he coached Husky record-setting quarterback and 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year Jake Browning, and helped the Huskies to the 2016 College Football Playoff and the 2017 Fiesta Bowl.

• Has played and coached in 12 bowl games. Coached in the 2017 Fiesta Bowl after playing in the game as a collegiate quarterback in 2000, earning the victory over Notre Dame.

• Was a four-year letterwinner at Oregon State. He was the Fiesta Bowl Offensive Most Valuable Player, earned Pac-10 Conference Offensive Player of the Week multiple times and was a two-time member of the league's Honorable Mention team.

• Smith left the Oregon State program as the program's all-time leader in passing yardage at 9,680. He also passed for 55 touchdowns during his collegiate career. He still holds the OSU record for longest touchdown pass at 97 yards to Chad Johnson in 2000.

• He and his wife, Candice, have three children: Robert, Bella, and Charles.
