The Records: San Diego State is 13-10 and 2-6 in conference play after a 70-53 loss to Utah on Saturday night at Cox Arena. Brigham Young fell to 14-7 overall and 4-4 in league action after a 73-70 loss at UNLV on Saturday.

SDSU Coach Steve Fisher: Fisher (Illinois State '67) is in his third season at San Diego State with a record of 32-47. Now in his 11th full season he has amassed a 216-129 mark. Fisher led Michigan to the 1989 national championship and made three trips to the national championship game in his eight full seasons in Ann Arbor. The 1991-92 national coach of the year led the Aztecs to a 14-14 mark last year.

BYU Coach Steve Cleveland: Cleveland (UC Irvine '76) is in his fifth season both at Brigham Young and overall. He has guided the Cougars to a 81-64 mark, including the 2001 Mountain West Conference championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament.

The Series: This will be the 49th meeting in the series with Brigham Young owning a 35-13 advantage. Overall, BYU has won eight straight in the series which dates back to 1940. The last time the Aztecs defeated the Cougars was Dec. 31, 1996, in Provo, when SDSU won 89-86 in overtime. BYU leads the series 14-11 in San Diego and has won the last four meetings at SDSU.

Aztecs Look to Snap Two-Game Slide Against Brigham Young on Monday Night

San Diego State (13-10 overall/2-6 Mountain West Conference) looks to break a two-game slide when the Aztecs play host to Brigham Young (14-7/4-4) on Monday evening at Cox Arena. Game time is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. PST at Cox Arena. The game will be televised by SportsWest and broadcast on XTRA-AM 690.

San Diego State suffered its worse loss of the season on Saturday, a 17-point setback to conference-leading Utah (53-70). The Aztecs were without head coach Steve Fisher, who left the team on Tuesday morning to be with his ailing mother in Illinois. The Aztecs have matched their season-long losing streak of two games. Each of the previous times SDSU has lost two straight, the Aztecs have responded with a 12-point victory (81-69 vs. Colorado State and 78-66 vs. Houston).

Brigham Young suffered a heartbreaking defeat on Saturday night, losing at UNLV, 73-70. Vince Booker hit a three-point basket at the buzzer to give the Rebels the victory. Although sporting the nation's second-longest homecourt win streak in the nation at 32 games, the Cougars have struggled away from home posting a 2-7 record outside of Provo and a 1-7 mark on opponents' home courts. BYU's lone road victory this season did come inside the San Diego city limits, defeating USD, 70-59, back on Nov. 17.

Monday will mark the 49th meeting between the teams, with Brigham Young enjoying a 35-13 advantage. The Cougars have won eight straight in the series dating back to an 89-86 Aztec overtime victory on Dec. 31, 1996. The Cougars, which have won 20 of the last 23 encounters overall, have won four straight in San Diego and own a 14-11 series advantage when playing in America's Most Finest City.

Coach Fisher Update

As previously mentioned, Aztec head coach Steve Fisher left the basketball team on Tuesday morning, flying from Colorado Springs to Herrin, Ill., to be with his mother. Fisher remained there until returning to San Diego late Sunday evening.

On the Line

► The Aztecs are going for victory number 14 on the season, which would match their win total from last season. The current win total of 27 victories since the beginning of the 2000-01 season is the highest two-year win total since SDSU won 33 games in the 1984-85 and 1985-86 seasons.

► After going 1-23 in their first 24 Mountain West Conference games, the Aztecs have posted a 5-7 mark in their last 12 league games.

► Through 12 home games this season, San Diego State has averaged 6,151 fans. That is well above the school-record average of 4,824 set during the 1981-82 campaign and is a 35.8 percent increase over last season. This season's attendance is an increase of 135.0 percent over Steve Fisher's first season (1999-2000).

► San Diego State players account for three of the top four scorers in the Mountain West Conference. Randy Holcomb (17.7 ppg), Tony Bland (16.8) and Al Faux (16.8) rank one, three and four in the league.

► San Diego State has played the 32nd most difficult schedule in the nation to date according to the RPI.

► The Aztecs have responded to their two two-game losing streaks this season with victories in their next outing.




