AZTECS WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON THIS WEEK AGAINST WYOMING, COLORADO STATE

- > Winners of two in a row and seven of its last eight, San Diego State concludes its 2017 regular-season schedule this week when it battles Wyoming and 24th-ranked Colorado State for the first time this year.
- > The Aztecs will square off against the Cowgirls in Laramie, Wyoming, on Wednesday, Nov. 15, beginning at 6:30 p.m. MT/5:30 p.m. before returning to the friendly environs of Montezuma Mesa to face the Rams on Saturday, Nov. 18, starting at 1 p.m. PT.
- > In addition to live stats, both contests will feature streaming video on GoAztecs.com., including Wednesday's tilt via the Mountain West Network.
- > Saturday's contest will also include Senior Day festivities, with the Scarlet and Black celebrating the accomplishments of Alexis Cage, Baylee Little and Devyn Pritchard.
- > The Aztecs recorded a pair of four-set victories at home last week, defeating UNLV (25-18, 16-25, 25-12, 25-13) before rallying past New Mexico (20-25, 26-24, 25-13, 25-12).
- > Against the Lobos, SDSU's comeback efforts were jump-started by a huge 12-3 closing run in the second set, which erased a 21-14 deficit.
- > With their results, the Aztecs took over sole possession of third place in the Mountain West with an 10-6 conference record.
- > Saturday's match will mark SDSU's third outing of the year against a nationally ranked foe. The Aztecs dropped a pair of 3-0 decision at No. 23 Michigan State on Sept. 1 and at No. 17 San Diego on Sept. 17.
- > SDSU is 16-0 this year when maintaining a higher hitting percentage and 8-0 when out-blocking their opponents.

SERIES RECORD VS. WYOMING

- > The Aztecs, who will play the Cowgirls just once this season, lead the all-time series between the two schools 35-17.
- > However, SDSU will be looking to snap a six-match losing streak at Wyoming. The Scarlet and Black is 10-14 in Laramie since 1990, logging its last victory there in 2009.
- > The Aztecs and Cowgirls split two encounters last year, with each side winning on its home floor in five sets.
- > In last season's match in Laramie, SDSU captured the third and fourth sets to even the contest at 2-2, but dropped a 15-13 heartbreaker in the final stanza.
- > Individually, Deja Harris led the team with 18 kills in the aforementioned contest, while Alexis Cage (16), Alexandra Psoma (16) and Ashlynn Dunbar (10) reached the double-digit plateau in put-aways.
- > Collectively, the Aztecs posted more kills (68-55) and digs (61-51); however, Wyoming committed 17 fewer attack errors (24-41) to help key their win.

SERIES RECORD VS. COLORADO STATE

- > The Rams won both matches against San Diego State last year to raise their record to 40-16 in the all-time series.
- > The Aztecs are 9-18 vs. Colorado State in San Diego and have dropped four straight in "America's Finest City."
- > The Scarlet and Black posted its last victory against the Rams in 2013, upsetting the No. 9 CSU squad on the road, which marked the last time SDSU knocked off a ranked opponent.
- > Baylee Little is the lone Aztec holdover from that contest, when she finished with 10 kills and hit .750 to go with five digs and three block assists.
- > SDSU last defeated the Rams at home in 2012 when it recorded a four-set triumph en route to winning the Mountain West championship.
- > In last season's five-set loss to Colorado State at home, Alexandra Psoma posted a career-high 24 kills, at least twice as many as any other player in the match, while Deja Harris came through with nine block assists.
- > As a team, the Aztecs held the edge in kills (54-52) and digs (54-41), but got out-blocked (18.0 to 15.0).
- > SDSU led 2-1 after three sets, but the Rams came back to capture the final two frames to escape with the victory (22-25, 25-21, 18-21, 25-20, 15-9).

SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION

> Wyoming (16-12, 11-5 MW) leads the Aztecs by one match in the conference standings after sweeping a pair of contests on the road last week at San José State (25-23, 25-22, 27-25) and Nevada (25-20, 25-17, 25-18). Against the Wolf Pack, sophomore outside hitter Halie McArdle recorded a match-high 14 kills, while junior outside hitter Emily Lewis finished with 11 put-aways of her own to help power the Cowgirls to victory. Offensively, Wyoming boasts three players who are averaging over two kills per set this season, including Lewis (2.85), sophomore outside hitter Tara Traphagan (2.79) and McArdle (2.49). In addition, the Cowgirls have received a boost from junior middle blocker Reed Copeland, who occupies the fourth spot in the Mountain West with a .326 hitting percentage and ranks sixth in blocks (1.23/set), while redshirt freshman Jackie McBride is ninth in blocks as well (1.11/set). Freshman Marissa Harmon, who has taken over Wyoming setter responsibilities this season, finds herself fifth in the conference this week with 9.52 assists and 0.31 aces per set, while sophomore defensive specialist Madi Fields is seventh in digs (3.91/set). As a team, the Cowgirls rank among the top half of the league in hitting percentage (2nd, .230), blocks (3rd, 2.62/set), kills (5th, 12.87/set) and assists (5th, 12.01/set). In addition, Wyoming has limited its opposition to a .185 hitting percentage, which is good for second in the MW. The Cowgirls are coached by Chad Callihan, who is in his fifth season on the Laramie campus after spending five years as head coach at Georgia Southern. He has also served as head coach at Appalachian State and Radford. Callihan's career record stands at 328-188, including a 101-53 mark at Wyoming.

> Colorado State (25-3, 15-1 MW) dropped five places into the 24th spot in this week's AVCA rankings after suffering a five-set loss at San José State last Saturday (25-20, 19-25, 25-19, 21-25, 11-15). With the defeat, the Rams had their 15-match victory streak snapped, along with their stretch of 16 consecutive sets won. Individually, CSU boasts the league's top two hitting percentage leaders in sophomore middle blockers Paulina Hougaard-Jensen (.464) and Kirstie Hillyer (.385), who rank third and 37th in the country, respectively. In addition, Hillyer (1st, 1.44/set) and Hougaard (4th, 1.27/set) are among the MW top 10 in blocks, while sophomore setter Katie Oleksak tops the conference with 12.05 assists per set, which ranks third nationally entering the week. Not to be outdone, senior outside hitter Sanja Cizmic owns the league's best average in service aces (0.39/set) while redshirt freshman outside hitter Breana Runnels (7th, 3.23/set) and sophomore defensive specialist Amanda Young (8th, 3.77/set) are also among the MW leaders in kills and digs, respectively. Collectively, the Rams top the league in most statistical categories, including hitting percentage (.313), which ranks sixth in the nation, as well as kills (14.05/set), assists (13.27/set), blocks (2.87/set) and aces (1.48/set). Colorado State is coached by Tom Hilbert, who has guided the Rams to the NCAA tournament in all 21 seasons on the Fort Collins campus. Previously, Hilbert was the head coach at Idaho from 1989-96. His career record is 708-197, including a 534-125 mark at CSU.

HARRIS TABBED MW OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- > Deja Harris was named MW Offensive Player of the Week on Nov. 13, after a pair of outstanding performances in the Aztecs' two home victories over UNLV and New Mexico.
- > With her award, Harris garnered her second career conference weekly accolade and the Aztecs' third this season.
- > For the week, Harris posted a .458 attack percentage and averaged a team-high 3.62 kills in eight sets played.
- > The SDSU middle blocker came up huge down the stretch vs. the Rebels and Lobos, hitting a combined .833 (10-0-12) with five kills in each of the fourth sets in those respective matches, helping the Aztecs secure their wins.
- > Against UNLV on Nov. 9, Harris tied for match-high honors with 14 kills, while hitting at a .360 clip. She also chipped in a pair of service aces to help the Scarlet and Black avenge an earlier loss to the Rebels in Las Vegas.
- > In SDSU's comeback victory over New Mexico on Saturday, Harris blasted a match-high 15 kills, marking her third straight contest with double-digit put-aways and 11th during conference play.
- > The Aztec junior also hit .565 on the afternoon, marking her fourth-highest clip of the year and second-best during MW competition.
- > In the second set against the Lobos, Harris knocked down two kills and added two block assists during a critical 12-3 run as the Aztecs overcame a 21-14 deficit to capture the frame and seize the momentum.
- > In addition, Harris excelled at the net last week with 1.62 blocks per set, helping the Aztec defense limit both opponents to a combined .125 hitting percentage.

WEEKLY WRAP

- > San Diego State took over sole possession of third place in the Mountain West with a pair of 3-1 victories at home over UNLV (25-18, 16-25, 25-12, 25-13) and New Mexico (20-25, 26-24, 25-13, 25-12).
- > Against the Rebels, the Aztecs avenged an earlier loss in Las Vegas, maintaining a hefty advantage in kills (60-32), hitting percentage (.295 to .070) and digs (66-38).
- > Despite getting out-blocked as a team 13.0 to 8.0 for the night, SDSU seized control of the contest in the third and fourth sets, posting a .348 hitting percentage and knocked down more kills (33-11) while limiting UNLV to a minus-.002 clip.
- > Individually, the Aztecs had three players reach double figures in kills, led by Ashlynn Dunbar and Deja Harris, who recorded 14 put-aways each, while Baylee Little finished with 12 non-returnables of own after hitting a career-best .857 with just two errors on 14 attempts, which marked the best performance in the MW so far this year.
- > Setter Gabi Peoples (12 digs) also got into the act with her third double-double of the season on a match-high 51 assists, while libero Devyn Pritchard surpassed the 25-dig plateau for the fifth time in nine outings after leading all players with 26 scoops.
- > Against the Lobos, SDSU held the edge in most statistical categories, including kills (58-48), digs (55-45) and team blocks (17.0 to 7.0) to complete the regular-season sweep of UNM.
- > The block total marked a season high for the Scarlet and Black, which also benefited from nine errant Lobo serves.
- > In addition, the Aztecs posted a greater hitting percentage (.296 to .175), including a .368 to .015 spread over the final two sets.
- > SDSU was in danger of falling behind 0-2, but overcame a 21-14 deficit in the second set with a dramatic 12-3 run to escape by a narrow 26-24 margin, allowing the Aztecs to seize control in the final two frames.
- > Offensively, SDSU was led by Harris, who blasted a match-high 15 kills and hit .565 for the contest with just two errors on 23 swings, while Dunbar (14), Little (12) and Alexis Cage (10) amassed double-digit put-aways.
- > Pritchard was solid along the back row once again with a match-best 21 digs, while Cage came up with 12 scoops as well to complete her team-leading sixth double-double of the year.
- > At the net, Little established a career high with nine block assists, while Harris finished with eight, followed by Erin Gillcrist, who also set a personal best with seven blocks of her own in just her third appearance of the season.

AZTECS AMONG MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- > Entering the week, Deja Harris, Devyn Pritchard and Gabi Peoples are among the MW leaders in various categories.
- > In overall matches, Harris ranks third in the league with a .346 hitting percentage and 1.28 blocks per set.
- > Pritchard also occupies third position this week with 4.66 digs per frame.
- > Meanwhile, Peoples moved into the fourth slot with 9.61 assists per set.
- > As a team, SDSU ranks among the top half of the conference in kills (3rd, 13.56/set), assists (4th, 12.43/set) and digs (5th, 13.62/set).
- > In Mountain West matches, Pritchard maintains the top spot in digs (5.30/set); Peoples ranks second in assists (11.25/set); Baylee Little also catapulted into the No. 2 position with a .366 hitting percentage, while Harris is third in blocks (1.37/set).
- > Collectively against conference foes, the Aztecs took over the No. 1 spot in the MW with 14.44 digs per set and rank second with 13.81 kills per set.
- > In MW action, SDSU also finds itself among the top half of the league in opponent hitting percentage (2nd, .191), assists (4th, 12.48/set) and blocks (4th, 2.44/set).

KEYS TO THE TURNAROUND

- > After starting Mountain West play with an 0-3 record, San Diego State has turned things around, winning 10 of 13 matches to take over third place in the conference standings.
- > During that stretch, the Aztecs have maintained a statistical advantage in several categories, including kills (726-563) and digs (750-613).
- > SDSU has averaged over three kills more per set than its opponents (14.24-11.04).
- > Similarly, the Aztec defense has held firm, averaging well over two digs per set more than the opposition (14.71-12.02).
- > SDSU also owns a modest edge in hitting percentage (.222-.166) despite committing more attack errors during that span (328-277).
- > In addition, SDSU has benefited in the service department, committing 28 fewer errors than its adversaries (84-112).

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- > Over the last 13 matches, San Diego State has also received balanced offensive production, with the quartet of Alexis Cage (159), Deja Harris (154), Ashlynn Dunbar (144) and Hannah Turnlund (125) combining for 582 of the team's 726 kills (80.2 percent).
- > During that span, Harris has posted double-digit kill totals in 10 matches, while Cage and Dunbar have accomplished the feat on nine occasions, followed by Turnlund's eight.
- > Cage has been particularly effective, averaging 3.12 kills and hitting .225 in 51 sets played, compared to the previous 16 matches when she averaged 2.03 kps and posted a .214 attack percentage.
- > Against New Mexico, Cage posted her sixth double-double of the year with 10 kills and 12 digs.
- > In addition, the Aztecs have profited from the play of Baylee Little (102 kills (2.27/set), 45 blocks (1.00/set), .376) and Sam McGrath (95 digs (1.86/set), 14 aces).

POWER TO THE PEOPLES

- > Setter Gabi Peoples is enjoying a strong freshman campaign, averaging 9.61 assists and 1.57 digs in 99 sets played.
- > The Beaverton, Oregon, native has cracked the starting lineup 20 times this season, including the last 19 matches.
- > Against Mountain West opponents, Peoples has averaged 11.25 assists, 1.66 digs and 0.59 blocks per set.
- > Three weeks ago, Peoples averaged 12.67 assists per set (114 overall), including a career-high 62 helpers in SDSU's dramatic five-set victory over Boise State, to capture MW Offensive Player of the Week honors.
- > Not only were her 62 helpers a career high, the total marks the second-best performance in the MW this season.
- > With her efforts, Peoples has compiled 40 or more assists in 10 of her last 13 matches and has posted over 50 helpers four times this year.
- > Last week, she recorded her third double-double of the year with 51 assists and 12 digs vs. UNLV.

DIGGIN' DEVYNN

- > Senior libero Devyn Pritchard has come on strong against Mountain West competition, averaging a conference-leading 5.30 digs per set in 16 league matches.
- > The Temecula, Calif., native also remained in third place this week with 4.66 digs per set in all matches.
- > On Oct. 19, Pritchard set a career high with 33 digs in a 3-2 thriller over Boise State, helping the Aztecs erase an 0-2 deficit in sets.
- > The 33 digs marked the highest total in a league match so far this year and tied for the second most overall, helping her garner MW Defensive Player of the Week accolades.
- > Last month, Pritchard posted back-to-back 29 dig performances on the road against New Mexico and UNLV for an average of 7.25 per set.

- > For the season, she has now surpassed the 20-dig plateau in 11 matches this year, including eight of her last 14 outings.

AZTECS COLLECT TWO MW WEEKLY AWARDS

- > San Diego State picked up two Mountain West awards on Oct. 23 as Gabi Peoples was named Offensive Player of the Week, while Devyn Pritchard was selected Defensive Player of the Week. The two accolades were the first career honors for the Aztec teammates.
- > In two matches, Peoples dished out 12.67 assists per set (114 total) averaging 4.10 helpers more than her season clip of 8.57 per frame entering the week, as the Scarlet and Black completed a 2-0 homestand with victories over Boise State and Utah State.
- > Against the Broncos, the freshman setter handed out a career-high 62 assists, which marks the highest total in the MW so far this year.
- > With Peoples' crisp passing, SDSU had five players surpass the double-digit plateau in kills vs. Boise State.
- > In the Aztecs' triumph over Utah State, Peoples contributed 52 assists, as three teammates reached double figures in kills.
- > Pritchard, meanwhile, posted 44 digs last week for an average of 4.89 per set and finished with a clean slate of zero reception errors.
- > Against Boise State, the senior libero recorded a career-high 33 digs, which marked the highest total in a MW match this year and tied for the second-most overall.
- > With her effort, Pritchard anchored a defense that limited the Broncos to 12.8 kills per set during the contest, which was 1.3 less than its league-leading season average of 14.1 entering the match.
- > Two days later against Utah State, she registered a team-high 11 digs, contributing to a defense that held the Aggies to a .186 hitting percentage, .025 points below their season average of .211 entering the contest.

NOTHIN' LIKE HOME COOKIN'

- > In 38 seasons of Aztec volleyball, San Diego State has compiled a 380-187 record (.669) at home, which represents the second-best home winning percentage among current Mountain West members.
- > This year, the Scarlet and Black has posted a 10-4 mark on Aztec Court at Peterson Gym compared to a 4-7 ledger in true road matches. In addition, SDSU has gone 2-2 in neutral-site encounters.
- > In head coach Deitre Collins-Parker's tenure, the Aztecs have amassed a 77-33 record (.700) at home, including a 14-0 mark during the 2012 season when SDSU captured the Mountain West championship.

HEAD COACH DEITRE COLLINS-PARKER

- > San Diego State head coach Deitre Collins-Parker is in her ninth season with the Aztecs after becoming the fourth head coach in program history prior to the 2009 campaign. Her record at San Diego State stands at 146-125 (.539).
- > Collins-Parker previously served as head coach at UNLV for eight seasons (1996-2003) and at Cornell for five years (2004-2008). Her career record stands at 308-316 (.494).
- > On Oct. 7, she collected her 300th career victory after the Aztecs defeated Air Force in four sets at home.
- > A three-time All-American as a collegiate player at the University of Hawai'i, Collins-Parker guided the Rainbow Wahine to consecutive national titles (1983-84) and was twice named the national player of the year.
- > Collins-Parker was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team and competed at the Goodwill Games and Pan Am Games prior to playing professionally in Europe for four years.
- > Collins-Parker is one of six players named to the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball 25th Anniversary Team in October 2005 and was inducted into the AVCA Hall of Fame in the fall of 2008.
- > This past summer, Collins-Parker was head coach of the Mountain West All-Star volleyball team that competed in the European Global Challenge. Current Aztecs Baylee Little and Indigo Thompson were also named to that squad.

DEJA VU FOR HARRIS

- > Middle blocker Deja Harris was named Most Valuable Player of the Denver Invitational in September, marking the second time this season the Aztec junior received such distinction after earning the same honor following the season-opening Aztec Invitational.
- > In three matches, Harris hit a team-high .427, averaging 3.21 kills and 1.36 blocks per set. She was also part of an SDSU defense that limited the opposition to a collective .179 hitting percentage.
- > Against UCR, the Las Vegas, Nevada, native knocked down a match-high 16 kills and hit .464 to go with six blocks.
- > Harris completed her seventh match of the year with a .400 attack percentage or higher after hitting .429 with 14 kills vs. Gonzaga.
- > In the second stanza against the Zags, she hit .625 with six kills to help the Aztecs build a 2-0 lead in sets.
- > In addition, Harris also led all players in the Gonzaga match with a season high-tying seven block assists.
- > She completed the weekend against Denver with a team-high 15 kills and six blocks, including three solo stops.
- > In fourth set vs. the Pioneers, she hit .750 with six kills, including two during a 4-1 match-clinching run.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS--PART IV

- > In addition to Harris, Alexis Cage and Ashlynn Dunbar were both named to the Denver Invitational all-tournament team.
- > For the weekend, Cage averaged 2.14 kills and 2.86 digs per set to go with six block assists.
- > The Newport Beach, Calif., product recorded two double-doubles in the tournament, finishing with 11 kills and 11 digs vs. Gonzaga, before before amassing kills and 19 digs against Denver, the latter of which marked a season high and fell one short of a personal best.
- > Dunbar, meanwhile, turned in a fine all-round performance as well with 2.36 kills, 2.14 digs and 0.79 blocks per set.
- > The Seabrook, Texas, native logged her first career double-double with 10 kills and 14 digs vs. Gonzaga and just missed out on another one against Denver, finishing with a personal-best 14 kills and nine scoops.
- > She also tallied a season-high five block assists in the opener against UC Riverside.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS--PART III

- > Following the JLABS Challenge, held Sept. 8-9 at Aztec Court, Alexis Cage was named to the four-player all-tournament team, joining Long Beach State's Megan Kruidhof, Pacific's Emily Baptista and Loyola Marymont's Savannah Slattery.
- > For the weekend, Cage knocked down 29 kills (2.64/set) and posted 26 digs (2.36/set).
- > Against LBSU, Cage logged San Diego State's first double-double of the year, recording season highs of 15 kills and 13 digs while hitting .324.
- > In the victory over Pacific, Cage turned in another solid all-round performance with nine kills, four digs and three block assists.

ALL-TOURNAMENT AZTECS--PART II

- > Deja Harris and Ashlynn Dunbar were named to the seven-player all-tournament team at Michigan State's Spartan Invitational, held Sept. 1-2 in East Lansing, Michigan.
- > Harris hit .432 for the weekend and served up five aces to go with six blocks.
- > Against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, the Aztec junior recorded her second-highest attack percentage of the year at .643, blasting 10 kills with just one error in 14 attempts.
- > Harris also posted a career-high three service aces in the opener against Michigan State and finished with a .562 hitting percentage (11-2-16) vs. Marshall.
- > Meanwhile, Dunbar compiled a .361 attack percentage in three matches while adding four assists and two blocks.
- > Against Marshall, the SDSU sophomore hit .474 on 12 kills - both season highs.
- > In addition, Dunbar added tied her career best with two assists against TAMU-CC and came up with a pair of blocks.

HARRIS NAMED AZTEC INVITE MVP

- > Middle blocker Deja Harris earned Most Valuable Player honors at the season-opening Aztec Invitational.
- > In three matches, the SDSU junior led all regulars in the tournament field with a .434 hitting percentage, averaging 3.00 kills in 10 sets played.
- > In SDSU's sweep of Portland State, Harris hit a season-high .733 on a team-best 11 kills with no errors in 15 swings.
- > She also recorded double-digit kills vs. CSUN, launching 10 put-aways with just three errors on 16 attacks for a .433 hitting percentage.
- > Harris excelled on defense as well, averaging 1.30 blocks for the tourney.
- > In the Aztecs' aforementioned victory over PSU, she came up with match-high six block assists, including two during a decisive 13-0 run in the opening set.

STAFF ADDITIONS

- > The Aztecs have added a new assistant coach and volleyball operations assistant to their 2017 staff.
- > Ken Murczek, a 1998 San Diego State graduate, joins the SDSU program after spending the past season as head coach of the men's volleyball team at the University of Charleston in West Virginia.
- > Prior to his stint in the Mountain State, Murczek served as head coach of the women's teams at North Texas (2010-12) and Wake Forest (2013-15). He also had previous stops as an assistant coach at Virginia (2007) and Kansas (2008-09).
- > Murczek played two seasons for the SDSU men's volleyball team, helping the Scarlet and Black to a top-15 ranking as a senior in 1998.
- > In his current role with the Aztecs, Murczek will be responsible for offensive development and will train the setters and defensive specialists.
- > Last spring, Makayla Westphal was hired as volleyball operations assistant after serving as an intern for the director of operations at the University of Nebraska.
- > As a player, Westphal was a four-year starter as an outside hitter/defensive specialist at Nebraska Wesleyan, where she was a member of the AD31 All-Academic Team and was twice named a Pflieger-Olson Scholar-Athlete.
- > Westphal led the Prairie Wolves in service aces as a senior, helping the team to a 22-7 record.
- > Westphal also coached at the Volleyball Club Nebraska (VCN) girls' club in Lincoln, Nebraska, where she was an assistant for the 15 and 17 Black teams and head coach for the 14 Black squad. She also served as an evaluator for the girls' National Junior and High Performance Team tryouts conducted by USA Volleyball in Omaha.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- > San Diego State was picked to finish third this year in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll released Aug. 16.
- > In the 18-year history of the Mountain West, SDSU has finished first (2012), second (2002, 2011), fourth (2000, 2001, 2003, 2013), fifth (2005, 2015), sixth (1999, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2014, 2016), seventh (2008) and eighth (2007) in the final league standings.
- > Last year, Colorado State had their streak of seven consecutive conference titles snapped by Boise State, which advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. However, the Rams still received an at-large berth for their 22nd straight postseason appearance.
- > Middle blocker Deja Harris was the only player on the seven-member all-Mountain West preseason team not to represent either Colorado State or Boise State. In 2016, the Las Vegas, Nevada, native garnered all-conference honors for the second year in a row.
